RUBLEE DELEGATION LEAVES FOR BERLIN TO "EXPLORE" REICH ATTITUDE ON EMIGRATION

PARIS, JAN. 9. (JTA) -- Two AMERICAN OFFICIALS OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL REFUGEE COMMITTEE LEFT HERE TODAY FOR BERLIN TO FACE HIGH LEADERS OF THE REICH GOVERNMENT FOR THE FIRST TIME ON GERMAN SOIL FOR A CONCRETE DISCUSSION OF THE EMIGRATION PROBLEM. GEORGE RUBLEE, DIRECTOR OF THE REFUGEE BUREAU, AND ROBERT PELL, ASSISTANT DIRECTOR, DEPARTED AFTER CONFERRING WITH FRENCH FOREIGN OFFICE OFFICIALS.

"OUR TRIP," THE DELEGATION INFORMED THE J.T.A. CORRESPONDENT, "IS AN EXPLORATION TRIP. WE WANT TO ESTABLISH WHERE THE GERMAN GOVERNMENT STANDS ON CERTAIN ASPECTS OF (REICHSBANK PRESIDENT DR. HJALMAR) SCHACHT'S PLAN WHICH ARE NOTABLY UNACCEPTABLE TO ALL GOVERNMENTS PARTICIPATING IN THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL REFUGEE COMMITTEE, AND ALSO TO CLARIFY OTHER MATTERS PRIOR TO THE MEETING OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL COMMITTEE OPENING IN LONDON ON JAN. 26."

THE DISCUSSIONS IN BERLIN, THE DELEGATION DISCLOSED, WILL CONCERN THE FOLLOWING POINTS: (1) WHAT ALTERNATIVES GERMANY IS WILLING TO OFFER INSTEAD OF THE UNACCEPTABLE DETAILS OF THE SCHACHT'S PROPOSAL; (2) HOW MANY THOUSANDS OF JEWS AND "NON-ARYANS" THE REICH GOVERNMENT WILL PERMIT TO EMIGRATE ANNUALLY WITH A CERTAIN PROPORTION OF THEIR CAPITAL; (3) THE SECURING OF A PROMISE THAT JEWS BE GIVEN AN OPPORTUNITY TO LIVE IN PEACE IN THE REICH UNTIL THEIR TURN TO EMIGRATE COMES; (4) ORGANIZATION AND FINANCING OF EMIGRATION.

THE DISCUSSIONS ARE EXPECTED TO LAST UNTIL JAN. 20. THE RESULTS WILL THEN BE REPORTED BY MR. RUBLEE TO A MEETING OF THE OFFICERS OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL COMMITTEE TO BE HELD ABOUT JAN. 22 IN PARIS, PRIOR TO THE PLENARY MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE IN LONDON ON JAN. 26.

EMPHASIZING THAT THE SCHACHT PLAN CONTAINS NOT ONLY FINANCIAL RECOMMENDATIONS, BUT ALSO SUGGESTIONS ON HOW EMIGRATION FROM THE REICH SHOULD BE ORGANIZED, THE DELEGATION SAID THAT WHEN THE CONVERSATIONS IN BERLIN CLARIFIED WHAT QUOTA OF EMIGRANTS GERMANY WAS WILLING TO PERMIT TO LEAVE THE COUNTRY ALONG THE LINES OF THE SCHACHT PLAN, IT WOULD THEN BE THE TASK OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL COMMITTEE TO ESTABLISH HOW THIS QUOTA WOULD BE DISTRIBUTED AMONG THE OTHER COUNTRIES FOR ABSORPTION.

ALTHOUGH NO ITALIAN REPRESENTATIVE WILL PARTICIPATE IN THE BERLIN CONVERSATIONS, THE DELEGATION STATED THAT THERE WAS A DEFINITE CONNECTION BETWEEN THE NEGOTIATIONS AND PREMIER BENITO MUSSOLINI'S PROMISE TO UNITED STATES AMBASSADOR WILLIAM PHILLIPS TO SUPPORT A SOLUTION OF THE REFUGEE PROBLEM. THE DELEGATION ASSUMED THAT PREMIER MUSSOLINI MAY SEEK TO INFLUENCE CHANCELLOR ADOLF HITLER.

AT THE SAME TIME THE DELEGATION DOUBTED THE TRUTH OF REPORTS THAT THE BANK FOR INTERNATIONAL SETTLEMENTS BOARD OF GOVERNORS, HOLDING ITS MONTHLY SESSION TODAY IN BASEL, SWITZ-

ERLAND, WOULD TAKE UP THE SCHACHT PLAN. IT WAS EMPHASIZED THAT THE BANK HAD NOTHING TO DO WITH THE PLAN. "MONTAGU NORMAN (GOVERNOR OF THE BANK OF ENGLAND) AND DR. SCHACHT, WHO ARE PARTICIPATING IN THE BASEL SESSION, WILL, HOWEVER, UNDOUBTEDLY CONTINUE THEIR PRIVATE DISCUSSIONS, WHICH TOOK PLACE IN BERLIN DURING MR. NORMAN'S VISIT THERE," THE DELEGATION SAID.

CERTAIN DETAILS OF THE SCHACHT PLAN HAVE BEEN REJECTED BY THE GOVERNMENTS PARTICIPATING IN THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL COMMITTEE AFTER A STUDY OF FINANCIAL ASPECTS OF THE PLAN BY THESE GOVERNMENTS' EXPERTS. AT ANY RATE, "OUR TRIP IS A STEP FORWARD IN THE EFFORT TO BRING THE JEWS AND "NON-ARYANS" OUT OF THE REICH," MR. PELL SAID.

ARRESTS, DENATIONALIZATIONS COMPLICATE RUBLEE'S TASK

BERLIN, JAN. 9. (JTA) -- TWO DEVELOPMENTS TODAY THREATENED FURTHER TO COMPLICATE THE TASK OF GEORGE RUBLEE, WHO IS ARRIVING TOMORROW.

FIRST WAS AUTHORITATIVE REPORTS THAT THIRTEEN TO EIGHTEEN THOUSAND POLISH JEWS RESIDENT IN GERMANY WERE DESTINED TO BECOME STATELESS BECAUSE OF SYSTEMATIC DENATIONALIZATIONS BY WARSAW. ABOUT A THOUSAND HAVE ALREADY BEEN DENATIONALIZED. THE NUMBER OF POLISH JEWS TO BE DENATIONALIZED COMPRISES 80 TO 85 PER CENT OF ALL POLISH JEWS RESIDENT IN THE REICH. THE FIGURE IS BASED ON A NEW ESTIMATE OF THE NUMBER DEPORTED TO POLAND IN OCTOBER. IT IS NOW ESTIMATED IN JEWISH QUARTERS THAT 25,000 WERE EXPELLED, IN CONTRAST WITH THE 15,000 FIGURE REPORTED BY BERLIN AND WARSAW. IF THIS IS CORRECT, THEN ONLY 15,000 TO 18,000 POLISH JEWS REMAIN IN THE REICH, OF WHOM ONLY 20 PER CENT ARE EXPECTED TO RETAIN POLISH CITIZENSHIP.

SECOND WAS THE FRESH ATTACK TO HASTEN EMIGRATION. SOME 300 JEWS WERE ARRESTED LAST WEEKEND ON CHARGES OF HAVING OVERSTAYED THEIR LEAVES ON REICH SOIL AND HAD FAILED TO MAKE SUFFICIENTLY STRONG EFFORTS TO EMIGRATE. THE POLICE DRIVE WAS RESTRICTED TO JEWS UNABLE TO FIND COUNTRIES OF ASYLUM. THEY WERE ARRESTED AND ARE NOW HELD IN BERLIN PRISONS, BUT MANY ARE EXPECTED TO BE REMOVED TO CONCENTRATION CAMPS.

REPORT MUSSOLINI WILL PROPOSE JEWISH STATE TO CHAMBERLAIN

LONDON, JAN. 9. (JTA) -- THE EVENING STANDARD REPORTED FROM ROME TODAY THAT PREMIER MUSSOLINI WOULD PROPOSE TO PRIME MINISTER NEVILLE CHAMBERLAIN, DURING THEIR MEETING THIS WEEK, A COMPREHENSIVE SOLUTION OF THE JEWISH REFUGEE AND "SURPLUS POPULATION" PROBLEM BY CREATION OF A JEWISH STATE IN HARAR, ETHIOPIA, IN EXCHANGE FOR FRENCH CESSION OF ZEILA, IN BRITISH SOMALILAND. THE JEWISH STATE WOULD BE INDEPENDENT AND NEUTRAL, THE DISPATCH SAID.

EMIGRATION BANK PLANNED, STOCKHOLM HEARS

STOCKHOLM, JAN. 9. (JTA) -- THE SVENSKI DAGBLADET REPORTED TODAY THAT JEWISH FINANCIERS IN SWEDEN AND POLAND WERE PREPARING TO FOUND A BANK IN AMERICA TO FACILITATE JEWISH EMIGRATION FROM GERMANY AND POLAND. THE BANKER OLAF ASCHBERG WAS TO LEAVE TODAY FOR PARIS FOR NEGOTIATIONS ON THE PLAN, FROM WHERE HE IS TO LEAVE FOR NEW YORK ON JAN. 18. THE SCHEME WILL BE PLACED BEFORE A NUMBER OF GOVERNMENTS FOR OFFICIAL BACKING, THE REPORT SAID. THE MAIN OFFICES OF THE BANK WOULD BE IN POLAND AND THE UNITED STATES.

BRITISH JEWS REJECT 'RANSOM PLAN'

MANCHESTER, ENGLAND, JAN. 9. (JTA) -- ANY "RANSOM" PLAN FOR THE RESCUE OF GERMAN JEWS WAS EMPHATICALLY REJECTED TODAY IN AN ADDRESS BY NEVILLE LASKI, PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF DEPUTIES OF BRITISH JEWS, AT A MEETING UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE BALDWIN FUND FOR REFUGEES. "I SAY WITHOUT ANY EQUIVOCATION," MR. LASKI DECLARED, "THAT JEWS ARE NOT PREPARED TO BUY THE BODIES OF OUR PEOPLE AT THE PRICE OF SACRIFICING CIVILIZATION TO A BEAST."

HUNGARY PLANS TO PARCEL JEWS' LAND; OPPOSITION TO CURBS RISES

BUDAPEST, JAN. 9. (JTA) -- MEASURES TO PARCEL ALL ESTATES ACQUIRED BY JEWS AFTER JUNE 1, 1914, AND PROHIBIT NEW PURCHASE OF LAND BY JEWS WERE ANNOUNCED TONIGHT BY COUNT TEL-ECKI, MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE, ADDRESSING A MASS MEETING. MEANWHILE, PREMIER BELA IMREDEY, IN AN ADDRESS, JUSTIFIED HUNGARY'S "RACE PROTECTION" MEASURES. HE DECLARED THAT "NOT A WEAK, BUT A MILITANT CHRISTIAN LOVE IS NECESSARY TO DRIVE THE MONEY-CHANGERS OUT OF THE TEMPLE OF THE HUNGARIAN NATION."

AT LEAST TWO CATHOLIC BISHOPS AND MANY OTHER LESSER CHURCH FIGURES WOULD LEGALLY BE CLASSIFIED AS JEWS UNDER HUNGARY'S NEW ANTI-SEMITIC LEGISLATION, IT WAS POINTED OUT LAST NIGHT BY FATHER BELA BANGHA, LEADER OF HUNGARY'S CATHOLIC ACTION, IN A SPEECH ROUNDLY CONDEMNING THE MEASURES. THE NEWSPAPER HETFOR REGGEL REPORTED THAT PROJECTED REVISION OF THE ANTI-SEMITIC BILLS WILL EXEMPT CHURCHMEN OF JEWISH ORIGIN FROM THEIR PROVISIONS. WAR ORPHANS ALSO WILL BE EXEMPT, IT WAS ADDED.

THE JESUIT'S CRITICISM, TYPICAL OF COMMENT VOICED IN MANY QUARTERS, WAS ECHOED IN A RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY A WING OF THE HUNGARIAN WAR VETERANS' ASSOCIATION. STRONG ADMONITION AGAINST RACIST PRINCIPLES ALSO WAS VOICED BY GEZADES SZULLO, A MEMBER OF THE UPPER HOUSE, IN AN ARTICLE PUBLISHED IN PESTER LLOYD, SEMI-OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER WHICH USUALLY REFLECTS GOVERNMENT VIEWS IN THE FOREIGN POLICY DOMAIN.

SPEAKING AT ERSEK-UJVAR, FATHER BANGHA WARNED: "ONE MUST REMAIN ON GUARD LEST A STATE CALLING ITSELF CHRISTIAN ENTER INTO CONFLICT WITH THE CHURCH REGARDING THE VERY PRINCIPLES OF CHRISTIANITY." THE CATHOLIC ACTION LEADER PARTICULARLY SPOKE IN DEFENSE OF THOSE HUNGARIAN JEWS WHO HAD BEEN CONVERTED TO CHRISTIANITY AND WHO HAD SINCERELY ADOPTED THE FAITH.

"SOME OF THEM," HE SAID, "WERE BAPTIZED TWENTY, THIRTY OR MORE YEARS AGO AND HAVE FURTHERMORE RAISED THEIR CHILDREN IN SEMINARIES." THE SPEAKER WARMLY URGED PARLIAMENT TO SEEK AN EQUITABLE SOLUTION OF THE ENTIRE JEWISH QUESTION AND TO AVOID ANY MEASURES LIKELY TO DISHONOR OR TERRORIZE THE COUNTRY'S BAPTIZED JEWS.

THE WAR VETERANS GROUP ARGUED THAT THE ANTI-SEMITIC LEGISLATION CREATED AN UNFAIR DISTINCTION AMONG MEN WHO HAD FOUGHT TOGETHER IN DEFENSE OF THEIR MUTUAL FATHERLAND.

SENATOR SZULLO MAINTAINED IN PESTER LLOYD THAT IT WAS DANGEROUS TO ATTEMPT THE APPLICATION OF RACIST PRINCIPLES IN HUNGARY, WHOSE PECULIAR GEOGRAPHICAL POSITION AT THE CROSSROADS OF EUROPEAN MIGRATION HAD MORE OR LESS MADE IT THE CONTINENT'S "MELTING POT."

53 U.S. IMPORTERS WARN CZECHS ON ANTI-SEMITISM

PRAGUE, JAN. 9. (JTA) -- A REPRESENTATIVE OF 53 LARGE AMERICAN IMPORTING CONCERNS IS STUDYING THE ATTITUDE OF THE PRESS HERE TOWARD THE JEWS WITH THE INTENTION OF PLACING ORDERS IN CZECHO-SLOVAKIA ONLY IF ANTI-SEMITIC MEASURES ARE NOT ADOPTED, NARODNY OSVOBOZENI, WAR VETERANS' ORGAN, REPORTED TODAY. CZECHO-SLOVAKIA FACES LOSING HER THIRD BEST MARKET, THE UNITED STATES, IF PRAGUE EMULATES OTHER EUROPEAN NATIONS' SOLUTIONS OF THE JEWISH QUESTION, THE PAPER WARNED, ADDING THAT CZECH TRADE WAS ALSO THREATENED IN OTHER ANGLO-SAXON COUNTRIES AND IN SOUTH AMERICA.

THE JEWISH PROBLEM IN SLOVAKIA WILL BE SOLVED AGAINST PRAGUE'S WISHES IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FIRST AUTONOMOUS SLOVAK DIET, ACCORDING TO A DECLARATION BY SLOVAK MINISTER OF JUSTICE MILOS VANCO IN BRATISLAVA PUBLISHED BY THE GERMAN MINORITY PAPER, BRUENNER TAGESBOTE. "WE DO NOT KNOW OF SLOVAK JEWS, BUT ONLY OF JEWS AND AGAIN JEWS," THE MINISTER WAS

QUOTED AS SAYING. "THERE WILL NOT BE A NUMERUS CLAUSUS BUT A NUMERUS NULLUS IN THE PROFESSIONS, ALTHOUGH A GRADUAL SOLUTION WILL BE PROVIDED."

MEANWHILE, INCREASING DESPAIR AMONG JEWISH REFUGEES FROM SUDETENLAND WAS ILLUSTRATED BY THE SUICIDE OF AN 86-YEAR-OLD WOMAN BY LEAPING FROM A WINDOW.

BRITAIN STRESSES DIFFICULTIES OF FIGHTING PALESTINE TERRORISTS; BLAMES MUFTI

LONDON, JAN. 9. (JTA) -- THE WAR OFFICE TONIGHT ISSUED A LENGTHY STATEMENT ON THE PALESTINE SITUATION IN WHICH IT EMPHASIZED DIFFICULTIES FACED BY THE BRITISH MILITARY AND REFUTED CHARGES THAT BRITISH SOLDIERS HAD BEEN GUILTY OF ATROCITIES. THE STATEMENT CONSTITUTED A REPLY TO "BASELESS" ATROCITY CHARGES MADE BY "PERSONS AND ORGANIZATIONS" CALLED UNFRIENDLY TO GREAT BRITAIN.

THE DOCUMENT POINTED OUT THAT THERE IS NO ORGANIZED REBEL ARMY AGAINST WHICH TROOPS "CAN ACT TO THE EXCLUSION OF THE REMAINING PEACEFUL CITIZENS." IT SAID: "THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY ACTIVE REBELS AND PEACEFUL CITIZENS ARE INEXTRICABLY MIXED. THE TOTAL NUMBER OF PERMANENT ACTIVE REBELS IN THE WHOLE COUNTRY PROBABLY DOES NOT EXCEED 1,000 TO 1,500 MEN, SPLIT UP INTO SMALL BODIES UNDER THE COMMAND OF VARIOUS LEADERS."

THE WAR OFFICE POINTED OUT THAT THE TERRORISTS AVOID ORGANIZED FIGHTING AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE, USING THE HOURS OF DARKNESS FOR THEIR RAIDS AND MINGLING "INDISTINGUISHABLY" WITH PEACEFUL CITIZENS DURING THE DAY. IT CHARGED THAT THE GENERAL POLICY OF THE TERRORISTS WAS MORE OR LESS DIRECTED BY THE EXILED EX-MUFTI OF JERUSALEM AND THE ARAB SUPREME COMMITTEE BUT THAT WITHIN PALESTINE THE FIGHTING LEADERS WERE PRACTICALLY INDEPENDENT IN THEIR OWN AREAS.

DISORDERS IN HOLY LAND GO ON

JERUSALEM, JAN. 9. (JTA) -- TWENTY-FOUR HOUR CURFEW WAS IMPOSED ON THE MUSRARA QUARTER OF JERUSALEM, ADJACENT TO THE OLD CITY, TODAY FOLLOWING THE WOUNDING OF A JEW BY ARAB TERRORISTS. THE VICTIM WAS AARON SHABATAI PIRAN, 28. ANOTHER JEW, EPHRAIM COHEN, WAS SERIOUSLY WOUNDED WHEN A BAND OF TERRORISTS ATTACKED A GROUP OF JEWISH WORKERS AT THE MIGDAL ZEDEK QUARRIES. AN AUTOMOBILE DRIVER, FISHEL TELER, 42, WAS SHOT DEAD IN THE BURJ QUARTER OF HAIFA, LEAVING A WIFE AND FOUR CHILDREN.

SYRIA ASKED TO PERMIT ARAB PARLEY

CAIRO, JAN. 9. (JTA) -- BELIEVING THE LONDON CONFERENCES ON PALESTINE WILL BE UNSUCCESSFUL WITHOUT PARTICIPATION OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EXILED EX-MUFTI OF JERUSALEM, PREMIER MAHMOUD PASHA TODAY ASKED FRENCH MINISTER DE WITASSE TO GRANT ARAB LEADERS WHO HAVE JUST BEEN RELEASED FROM THE SEYCHELLES ISLANDS A WEEK'S UNCONDITIONAL STAY IN BEIRUT, DURING WHICH THEY MAY CONFER WITH THE EX-MUFTI. THE REQUEST WAS FORWARDED TO M. PUAUX, NEW FRENCH HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR SYRIA.

CROWN COLONY ADVANCED AS SOLUTION

NEW YORK, JAN. 9. (JTA) -- THE LONDON CONFERENCES ON PALESTINE MUST BE BASED ON PRESENT REALITIES RATHER THAN ON PAST PROMISES, DECLARES MRS. ANNE O'HARE MCCORMICK, ROVING CORRESPONDENT OF THE NEW YORK TIMES, IN THE SECOND OF A SERIES OF DISPATCHES FROM PALESTINE. THE CRUCIAL QUESTION IS IMMIGRATION, SHE SAYS, "AND NOTHING ELSE REALLY MATTERS." THE ONLY SOLUTIONS POSSIBLE, MRS. MCCORMICK SAID, ARE AN ARAB-ZIONIST AGREEMENT TO ACCEPT THE PRESENT RATE OF IMMIGRATION FOR A FIVE OR TEN YEAR PERIOD -- WHICH SEEMS IMPOSSIBLE -- OR THE TEMPORARY CONSTITUTING OF PALESTINE AS A CROWN COLONY. THE FACT THAT SUCH A COURSE IS ADVANCED AS A POSSIBILITY, SHE SAID, MAY HAVE A SALUTARY EFFECT ON THE LONDON CONVERSATIONS.

JEWISH VETERANS MAP CAMPAIGN AGAINST COMMUNISM

ATLANTIC CITY, N.J., JAN. 9. (JTA) -- REAFFIRMING A 42-YEAR STAND AGAINST "ANTI-AMERICAN DOCTRINES," 600 DELEGATES TO A MID-WINTER CONFERENCE OF THE JEWISH WAR VETERANS OF THE UNITED STATES YESTERDAY RESOLVED UNANIMOUSLY TO INTENSIFY THE ORGANIZATION'S "HISTORIC MILITANT OPPOSITION" TO COMMUNISM BY ENLARGING ITS STANDING COMMITTEE AGAINST COMMUNISM.

THE RESOLUTION, INTRODUCED BY PAST-COMMANDER WILLIAM BERMAN OF BROOKLINE, MASS., DIRECTS THE COMMITTEE TO CONTINUE ITS STAND AGAINST COMMUNISM "TO THE END THAT THIS MENACE MAY BE ROOTED OUT AND DESTROYED." FIFTEEN MEMBERS WERE ADDED TO THE COMMITTEE BY NATIONAL COMMANDER ISADOR WORTH OF CAMDEN, N.J., INCLUDING SEVEN PAST-COMMANDERS AND OTHER OFFICERS.

"FOR MANY YEARS PAST," THE RESOLUTION SAID, "THE JEWISH WAR VETERANS OF THE UNITED STATES HAVE, AT EVERY ANNUAL CONVENTION AND AT EVERY POSSIBLE OPPORTUNITY, NOT ONLY WARNED THE AMERICAN PEOPLE AGAINST THE INSIDIOUS SPREAD OF COMMUNISM, BUT HAVE EXERTED EVERY EFFORT POSSIBLE TO ERADICATE THIS MENACE FROM AMERICAN LIFE."

IN INTRODUCING THE RESOLUTION, MR. BERMAN SAID: "LET US NOT FORGET THE DANGERS OF NAZISM AND FASCISM, BUT LET US REMEMBER, AS THE JEWISH WAR VETERANS HAVE REMEMBERED AT OUR ANNUAL CONVENTIONS EVER SINCE 1933, THAT COMMUNISM CONTINUES TO THREATEN ALL THOSE THINGS WHICH MEAN LIBERTY AND DEMOCRACY FOR AMERICA."

OTHER RESOLUTIONS ADOPTED PROVIDED FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF A COMMITTEE TO AID REFUGEES OF ALL FAITHS, REAFFIRMED THE ORGANIZATION'S FAITH IN DEMOCRACY, ATTACKED NAZISM AND FASCISM AND WIDENED THE J.W.V.'S AMERICANIZATION PROGRAM.

LAWYERS GET RESOLUTION CONDEMNING REICH PERSECUTION

CHICAGO, JAN. 9. (JTA) -- A RESOLUTION CONDEMNING TREATMENT OF RACIAL AND RELIGIOUS MINORITIES IN GERMANY "AND OTHER LANDS" WAS PRESENTED TODAY TO THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES OF THE AMERICAN BAR ASSOCIATION. THE RESOLUTION WAS SIGNED BY WILLIAM L. RANSOM, OF NEW YORK, FORMER PRESIDENT; FORMER ATTORNEYS GENERAL HOMER S. CUMMINGS AND WILLIAM D. MITCHELL; HENRY L. STIMSON, FORMER SECRETARY OF STATE; FRANK J. HOGAN, OF WASHINGTON, ASSOCIATION PRESIDENT AND OTHERS.

"WE EXPRESS OUR DEEP REGRET AND OUR STRONG PROTEST THAT THE RIGHTS OF RELIGIOUS AND RACIAL MINORITIES ARE BEING OVERRIDDEN BY ARBITRARY POWER AND WITHOUT DUE PROCESS OF LAW IN LANDS WHOSE CULTURAL BACKGROUND HAD GIVEN CAUSE FOR THE BELIEF THAT THEY WERE FRIENDS OF HUMAN FREEDOM," THE RESOLUTION SAID. "WE EXPRESS OUR SENSE OF DISMAY THAT HUMAN BEINGS HAVE BEEN SYSTEMATICALLY PERSECUTED AND PROSCRIBED BY THE FORMAL ACTS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE GERMAN REICH AND HAVE BEEN ARBITRARILY DEPRIVED OF ALL RIGHTS AND LIBERTIES AND REDUCED TO A MERE EXISTENCE IN UTTER FEAR AND WANT."

REICH PUNISHES 181 PASTORS FOR PROTESTING ANTI-JEWISH EXCESSES

BERLIN, JAN. 9. (HAVAS) -- ACCORDING TO CONFESSORIAL CHURCH FIGURES ISSUED YESTERDAY, 130 PASTORS HAVE BEEN REMOVED FROM THEIR POSTS, 40 HAVE BEEN FORBIDDEN TO PREACH AND 11 HAVE BEEN EXPELLED FROM THEIR PARISHES. (THE ACTION AGAINST THE PASTORS WAS TAKEN BECAUSE THEY PROTESTED AGAINST ANTI-JEWISH EXCESSES, ACCORDING TO THE NEW YORK TIMES.)

2 FASCISTS OUSTED FOR SYMPATHY TO JEWS

ROME, JAN. 9. (JTA) -- FASCIST OFFICIALS TODAY WITHDREW THE PARTY CARDS OF TWO MEMBERS AT VERONA AND TRIESTE BECAUSE THEY HAD SHOWN SYMPATHY FOR JEWS. SUCH AN ATTITUDE BY PARTY MEMBERS IS CONSIDERED CONTRARY TO THE NEW RACIAL POLICY, IT WAS ANNOUNCED.
