U.S. BARS ALL IMMIGRANTS EXCEPT WHERE 'IN AMERICAN INTEREST'

WASHINGTON, June 12. (JTA) -- The United States today departed from her historic policy of an open door to immigrants and laid down a new doctrine that "none shall be admitted unless it affirmatively appears to be for the American interest."

The new policy was set forth by Attorney General Robert H. Jackson in a statement on the occasion of taking over the Immigration and Naturalization Service from the Labor Department. He announced plans for fingerprinting and registration of aliens, but promised that they would be treated "without prejudice, without malice and with scrupulous fairness."

The Justice Department's policy in regard to aliens was set forth as follows:

1--"There will be a more strict control of the privilege of entering this country. The doctrine that any person may come to this country unless it is shown that he is a menace must, at least temporarily, yield to the policy that none shall be admitted unless it affirmatively appears to be for the American interest. To that end, in cooperation with the Department of State, greater strictness will be exercised over privileges to enter and there will be an increased vigilance at borders.

2--"We favor a simple, straightforward registration and identification of all non-citizens who are in our midst. This of course carries no criminal stigma and no implications of any sort. It is a simple recognition of non-citizenship common in all countries. It must not be carried out offensively or oppressively.

"If I, as an American, were today a resident in a foreign country, I would welcome the opportunity to go to the authorities and explain the reason for my presence and what my activities were, and to obtain some kind of certification which I might show as evidence of my good faith. I believe that in this country alien registration will bring to those aliens who comply with it a large degree of protection from local harrassments and other embarrassments, and that this plan, if carried out properly, will be a benefit to the alien who complies.

5--"After registration is completed, there will be a residue of unregistered aliens who will not comply, either because it would disclose illegal entry, or because it might disclose other crimes, or because many of them are ignorant or uninformed or mistaken about our law. We must set up machinery to deal fairly and dispassionately with these cases according to the individual merits of the particular situation.

4--"I cannot emphasize too strongly that it is the duty of a department which claims to be a Department of Justice to deal with the non-citizen in this country without prejudice, without malice and with scrupulous fairness. The three and a half million aliens in this country are most of them loyal to our principles. We must remember that most of them have sought this country as a haven from other systems of government. Most of them, like millions of immigrants before them, have the makings of good Americans, but hateful or unjust treatment of loyal non-citizens may have the result of making them the prey of those who would organize a 'fifth column' here. No greater disservice to the cause of American unity and defense can be perpetrated than the wholesale arousing of hate against persons of foreign birth who have been attracted to this country by our promise of American opportunity.

"It will be the duty of this department, while firmly insisting upon alien observation of the precautions which we see fit to take for the national defense, also to insist upon American citizens showing due and decent observance of the rights of aliens who do so comply. And it may very well be that protection of the legitimate rights of aliens may become as important a duty of this new unit in the department as the enforcement of the law against them."

JEWISH GROUPS SET UP OFFICES IN BORDEAUX AS PARIS FALLS

NEW YORK, June 14. (JTA) -- Jewish relief organizations evacuated Paris before the German entry into the French capital, it was learned here today.

The Joint Distribution Committee completed the evacuation of its Paris office on Wednesday. Morris C. Troper, J.D.C. European chairman, and other American members of the staff remained until the last moment and then left for Bordeaux. Part of the staff had already been established in Angers, where the J.D.C. opened an office last September. All J.D.C. files were removed from Paris.

The HIAS-ICA Emigration Association evacuated to Bordeaux on Tuesday, according to a cable from Dr. James Bernstein to Isaac L. Asofsky, director of the HIAS here. It is hoped that emigration of Jewish refugees to the United States can be continued on whatever ships leave the southern coast of France.

FIFTH COLUMN SEEN ABLE TO RALLY 2,000,000 MEN IN AMERICAS

SANTIAGO, Chile, June 8. (JTA--By Airmail).--The fifth column can muster nearly 2,000,000 men with military training in nine countries of North and South America, it was estimated today by the newspaper Civilizacion, organ of the Anti-Racist Institute of Chile.

The newspaper, listing German Nazis, Italian Fascists and Nazi-Fascist natives in the potential army of the Fifth Column, said there were 1,040,000 effectives in the United States alone. Other nations with fifth columns having large rosters of army-trained men were listed as follows: the Argentine, 250,000; Brazil, 328,000; Canada, 157,000; Chile, 28,000, and Mexico, 39,000.

"The fifth column in the Western Hemisphere," the newspaper said, "has existed for eight years and waits only for the United States to enter the European conflict--it then will mobilize in a short time and stab the American democracies in the back."

Taking up the fifth column in Chile, the newspaper charged that it was under the direct leadership of employees of the German Embassy and consulates. The duties of these diplomatic employees, Civilization said, have been subordinated to their work for the fifth column. At the head of the column is the Partido Nacional Socialista Aleman (National Socialist German Workers Party), which takes orders directly from Ernst Bohle, head of the Foreign Office of the German Nazi party in Stuttgart.

Membership in this party is drawn largely from the German colony in Chile, the newspaper said, adding that as German subjects they were bound to blind obedience to Hitler, thus forming a state within a state in Chile. Chileans of German descent have founded a separate organization, whose main purpose is to raise funds for the Nazi party.

While previously the Chilean Nazis maintained their own offices and conducted propaganda openly, they are now working under cover, using large commercial enterprises and the German Embassy and consulates to conceal their insidious activities, the newspaper stated. The Chilean fifth column includes a majority of the German teachers, who owe their positions in the German schools here to the Nazi Party, although these schools are subsidized by the Chilean Government.

The newspaper charged also that a large proportion of the Germans employed by commercial and industrial enterprises in Chile were members of the German Labor Front and were active as German spies.

Civilization asserted that the rightist press in Chile was playing an important role in fifth column activities. It listed in this category such newspapers as the two German daily newspapers, The German Newspaper for Chile and the West Coast Observer; the provincial papers controlled by the Nazi-owned syndicate Sociedad Periodistica Del Sur; El Chileno and El Imparcial of Santiago, and a number of weekly papers.

FASCIST PAPER SUSPENDS IN BRITAIN

LONDON, June 14. (JTA) -- The newspaper Action, organ of the Fascist British Union, ceased publication today. Arrests of Fascists are continuing. Among those arrested today is R.G. Jebb, a Fascist leader in Dorsetshire and a close friend of Sir Oswald Mosley.

JEWISH CONGRESS ANNOUNCES SUPPORT OF COMMITTEE TO AID ALLIES

NEW YORK, June 14. (JTA) -- The American Jewish Congress announced today that its Governing Council has voted to support the Committee to Defend America by Aiding the Allies, chairman of which is William Allen White. Purpose of the committee is to extend aid to the Allies short of war.

The Congress, it was announced by President Stephen S. Wise, is seeking signatures to a petition circulated by the Committee, enlisting the help of Congress branches throughout the country. The petition calls upon President Roosevelt and the United States Congress to make available to the Allies planes and relief funds, to stop export of war materials to aggressor nations and to take any other necessary measures short of war to aid the Allies.

In announcing support of the White Committee, Dr. Wise said: "The American Jewish Congress holds that the surest defense of America will lie in aiding the Allies and thus to keep the war out of America and America out of the war. The action of the American Jewish Congress is in fullest support of the President of the United States."

HADASSAH EMERGENCY COMMITTEE SET UP IN PALESTINE TO CONDUCT HEALTH WORK

NEW YORK, June 14. (JTA) -- Hadassah announced today the appointment of an emergency committee in Palestine to supervise and safeguard its network of health institutions there. According to Mrs. David de Sola Pool, president of Hadassah, the plans for the committee were made several weeks ago when conditions in the Near East became threatening.

The committee is headed by Dr. Judah L. Magnes, president of the Hebrew University, and includes Miss Henrietta Szold, Pinchus Rutenberg, president of the Palestine Jewish National Council, and Julius Simon, president of the Palestine Economic Corporation. The group will cooperate with other Palestine health agencies to set up a countrywide system of rural field hospitals and provide for the acceleration of general medical and public health services to the entire population, regardless of race or creed, Mrs. Pool stated.

A cable received today from Dr. Haim Yassky, director of the Rothschild-Hadassah-University Hospital and Medical School, revealed that 200 additional beds have already been made available in the new hospital and in the Nathan and Lina Straus Health Center. Subsidies have been given to the Magen David Adom, the Jewish equivalent of the Red Cross, to provide more first-aid service. There has also been an extension of Hadassah's home visiting, obstetrical and pediatric health services in the rural areas to assure the maintenance of previously established health standards, Mrs. Pool said.

111 LITHUANIAN JEWS EMIGRATED IN 3 MONTHS

KAUNAS, June 14. (JTA) -- It was officially announced today that 111 Jews emigrated from Lithuania to the United States and Palestine from January to April, not including refugees.

At the first session of the new Wilno Municipal Council, one of the two Jewish members, Jacob Wygodzky, pledged loyalty of the Jewish minority to Lithuania. The other Jewish member is Engineer Abraham Kavenoki.

POLISH RELIEF COMMITTEE GETS RED CROSS SUPPLIES

GENEVA, June 14. (JTA) -- Forty-eight wagonloads of foodstuffs, sent by the American Red Cross, have arrived in Warsaw and have been turned over to the Polish Relief Committee, it was disclosed here today.
