JEWS GIVEN JOBS AS REICH FEELS LABOR SHORTAGE; BERLIN POPULATION RISES

RIGA, June 16. (JTA) -- Many enterprises in the Reich have been employing Jews because of the shortage of labor, it was reported today by the Berlin correspondent of Jaunakas Zinas, Latvia's largest newspaper.

The correspondent said 1,500 "non-Aryans" were now employed in the electrical trade. It was officially announced in Berlin that 1,500 Jews were now employed in railways and agriculture.

The Jewish population of Berlin increased from 80,000 to 90,000 last month, it was said.

ARMY COURT DEATH SENTENCES DISCONTINUED IN PALESTINE

JERUSALEM, June 16. (JTA) -- Military court sentences of death, instituted on Nov. 18, 1937, to cope with terrorism in Palestine, were discontinued today.

High Commissioner Sir Harold A. MacMichael explained in a broadcast address that elimination of the death penalty, applying only to offenses committed after June 15, was made possible by the country's return to normalcy.

Referring to fifth column activities, MacMichael warned that the men and women of Palestine would "unmask these traitors." Warning against listening to rumors, he concluded by expressing firm belief in the final victory of the Allies.

Haifa Jews Pledge Loyalty

HAIFA, June 16. (JTA) -- A Jewish delegation yesterday visited the District Commissioner, presenting a £100 donation for the British war effort and expressing the Jews' loyalty to the Allies.

Aid to 'Vanguard Entrenched in Palestine' Urged

NEW YORK, June 16. (JTA) -- The Emergency Committee for Zionist Affairs today called upon American Zionists "to organize their strength" and "to give all possible assistance to the vanguard of the Jewish people entrenched in Palestine."

A statement issued by the committee, which includes representatives of the Zionist Organization of America, Hadassah, Mizrahi and Poale-Zion, declared that Palestine Jewry was calm and prepared for any eventuality, pointed out that communications between American and Palestine Jewry were unbroken, and concluded:

"The Yishuv expects American Jewry to give all possible assistance to the vanguard of the Jewish people entrenched in Palestine and to maintain its positions in this supreme emergency. American Zionists are called upon to rally and organize their strength, and be prepared to assume the responsibilities arising out of this situation."

VAIDA-VOEVOD, ANTI-SEMITIC, LISTED AS POSSIBLE PREMIER IN RUMANIA

BORDEAUX, France, June 16. (JTA) -- A Havas News Agency dispatch from Bucharest reported today the imminent fall of the Tatarescu Cabinet, with the pro-French Premier in all likelihood being replaced either by Foreign Minister Ion Gigurtu or former Premier Alexander Vaida-Voevod, both of whom are pronouncedly pro-Nazi. Gigurtu is a personal friend of Nazi Economics Dictator Hermann Goering. Vaida-Voevod, once a Peasant Party leader and three times Premier of Rumania, headed the anti-democratic Rumanian Front and has long been one of the country's leading anti-Semites.

NAZIS THREATEN TO KILL ONE JEW FOR EVERY DEAD GERMAN SOLDIER

BUCHAREST, June 5. (JTA--Airmail). -- A warning that the Germans will avenge those killed during the war by killing one Jew after the war for each dead soldier was contained in the Rumanian-language broadcast tonight from Vienna.

The Vienna broadcasts are attempting to incite the Rumanian population by every means against the Jews in this country. These efforts are being supported by the hundreds of Nazi agents conducting propaganda activities here.

RUMANIA COMPILES LIST OF LAWYERS WHO CHANGED SURNAMES

BUDAPEST, June 4. (JTA--Airmail). -- The Rumanian Ministry of Justice has instructed the Rumanian Bar Association to compile lists of all lawyers who have changed their surnames, the newspaper Pester Lloyd reports from Bucharest.

In accordance with these instructions, the Bar Association of Arad has summoned all lawyers known to have changed their names and also those suspected of having done so. According to Pester Lloyd, the association is interpreting the instructions very freely and is even registering the names of lawyers whose family names were changed by their fathers or grandfathers.

The lists to be submitted to the Ministry will contain both the present and original names of the lawyers concerned. It is believed in legal circles that the Ministry's instructions are connected with preparation of a new law introducing a numerus clausus in the legal profession. The lists would be used in this case to establish the exact racial and religious proportions.

SMOLAR, PARIS JTA STAFF NOW IN BORDEAUX

BORDEAUX, France, June 16. (JTA) -- Boris Smolar, chief European correspondent of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, and members of the J.T.A. Paris staff have arrived in Bordeaux from Paris and have established headquarters.

CUBAN ARMY ACTS AGAINST SPANISH FIFTH COLUMNISTS

HAVANA, June 16. (JTA) -- A drive against Spanish fifth column activities has been launched by the Cuban Army intelligence service, it was reported today. Action followed detention of Honorary Consul Ramon Rodriguez Fernandez on charges of possessing literature identified with the Spanish nationalist group Falange which was outlawed here two years ago. He is the second Spaniard arrested this week on suspicion of subversive activities.

COUGHLIN ORGAN RESUMES STRONG ANTI-SEMITIC TONE

NEW YORK, June 16. (JTA) -- The current issue of Father Charles E. Coughlin's Social Justice resumes a distinct anti-Semitic character after having more or less played down the Jewish issue in recent weeks. The general tenor of the edition is identification of the Jews and "international bankers" with Government defense plans and the movement to aid the Allies.

One article speaks of the New Deal, "upon whose brow destiny has woven the bay leaves of Mosaic deliverance." Another item speaks of "the Rothschild clan" as meeting in Paris to discuss the affairs of the Suez Canal and predicts that they will seek refuge in the United States rather than don uniforms and fight the Germans. The Rev. Leon Birkhead, national director of the Friends of Democracy, is called a "Gentile Jew."

An editorial is devoted to intimating that the United States, although she mitigated her "immigration laws to receive the wandering Jew," is not equally interested in British, Belgian and French children. Another editorial is given over to denouncing Rabbi Stephen S. Wise as an "erstwhile public consorter with Reds."

ITALIAN BODY HERE HITS ROME'S WAR ENTRY, PLEDGES UNITY ON NON-RACIAL BASIS

NEW YORK, June 16. (JTA) -- The New York State division of the Order of the Sons of Italy was on record today with a pledge of loyalty to the United States which included an expression of regret at Italy's intervention in the war and of "indissoluble unity of the American people, regardless of racial background."

MAP PLANS FOR TRANSPORT OF 1,000 REFUGEES TO PALESTINE DESPITE WAR SPREAD

NEW YORK, June 16. (JTA) -- The United Jewish Appeal announced today that the Joint Distribution Committee and the United Palestine Appeal, two of its component groups, were working on plans for the immigration to Palestine of more than 1,000 Jewish refugees despite closing of the Mediterranean by Italy's entry into the war.

"Not the closing of the Mediterranean," a statement by the U.J.A. said, "but only failure to remit the necessary funds to these refugees will prevent them from reaching their new home in Palestine."

The statement pointed out that prior to the spread of the war to the Mediterranean an agreement had been reached with the British and Russian governments which permits immigrants leaving Stockholm and Wilno to go to Palestine by way of Odessa.

The statement added that the U.J.A. was in immediate need of funds to make possible maintenance by the J.D.C. of 850 relief stations in Nazi-held Poland, where 80 per cent of the estimated Jewish population of 1,300,000 were said to be facing starvation.

RAISING OF ZIONIST REORGANIZATION ISSUE DEPLORED

NEW YORK, June 16. (JTA) -- A statement deploring raising of the "Goldman Reorganization Plan" issue in connection with the forthcoming annual convention of the Zionist Organization of America was made public today by the Committee on Zionist Convention Problems.

Signed by 12 Zionist leaders from various sections of the country, the statement asserted that official minutes of the ZOA Executive and Administrative Council proved that the reorganization plan, although supported by the Executive, had been abandoned by President Solomon Goldman himself for lack of funds with which to implement it. The signatories include: David Bernstein, St. Louis; Harry Friedberg, Kansas City, Kansas; Charles A. Cowen, Abraham Goldberg, Dr. Harris J. Levine, Meyer Levy, Charles Ress, Rabbi Irving Miller, Carl Sherman, and William I. Siegel, all of New York; Abraham Goldstein, Hartford, and Ludwig Lewisohn.

WOMEN'S GROUP TO BUY AMBULANCE FOR ALLIED USE

NEW YORK, June 16. (JTA) -- The women's division of the American Jewish Congress announced today that it is raising a fund for the purchase of an ambulance to be presented to the American Red Cross for the use of the Allies. The ambulance will be contributed by the women's division in honor of Mrs. Stephen S. Wise, president of the organization, on the occasion of completion of ten years of service to the organization.

The World Jewish Congress announced that a collective shipment of pharmaceutical products addressed to the Jewish community of Warsaw and sent via the International Red Cross has safely reached the president of the community.

FIFTH COLUMN HYSTERIA BREEDS RACE HATRED, NEW ENTRY CHIEF WARNS

WASHINGTON, June 16. (JTA) -- Fear of fifth column activities has made some sections of our population "hysterical," and one form of this hysteria is wholesale denunciation of all aliens living in America, Solicitor General Francis Biddle, now in charge of the Bureau of Immigration, said tonight in an address over a National Broadcasting Company network.

Asserting that the Justice Department will not abandon "the fundamental principles of American democracy, which includes a generous and just treatment to innocent sufferers from any country who have sought refuge with us," Biddle added:

"The footprints of the Trojan Horse are first found in the treacherous propaganda which leads to the ruthless persecution of minorities, and thereafter their purpose is to make us break down our American democratic insistence on freedom of speech, religious worship, and freedom of assembly by stirring up racial and religious hatred within the United States."

Biddle warned that "a house divided against itself cannot stand" and then said: "Do not let the subtle propaganda of race hatred turn you against any group in this country as a group."
