FRANCE MUST GIVE UP ALL REICH SUBJECTS UNDER ARMISTICE TERMS

LONDON, June 23. (JTA) -- Terms of the Franco-German armistice provide, among others, for the handing over of all German subjects indicated by the German Government, it was revealed today.

The provision applies to all German subjects residing in France or French overseas territory.

MOBILIZATION OF MANPOWER, PROPERTY AUTHORIZED IN PALESTINE

JERUSALEM, June 23. (JTA)-- Mobilization of Palestine's manpower and property was authorized today in an amendment to the Emergency Powers Act of 1939 published in a special edition of the official Palestine Gazette.

The amendment provides for "requiring persons to place themselves, their services and property at His Majesty's disposal as appears to him expedient for public safety and the defense of the realm, maintenance of public order or efficient prosecution of any war or maintenance of supplies or services essential to the life of the community."

Anti-aircraft batteries opened fire on an unidentified plane flying over Haifa late yesterday.

Rumanian Shipping to Palestine to Be Partly Resumed

JERUSALEM, June 23. (JTA) -- Rumanian shipping to Palestine, interrupted by Italy's entrance into the war, will soon be partially resumed, it was learned here today.

Sixteen Polish Jewish refugees have arrived in Haifa by way of Yugoslavia and Beirut after escaping from Trieste.

THOUSANDS OF JEWS AMONG POLISH TROOPS CROSSING FROM FRANCE INTO SWITZERLAND

GENEVA, June 23. (JTA) -- Several thousand Jews were among the Polish troops who crossed the border from France and were interned in Switzerland. There are few Jews among the civilian refugees from France.

TOTALITARIAN RUMANIA BARS NON-PARTY MEMBERS FROM VITAL POSTS

BUDAPEST, June 23. (JTA) -- Rumania's new totalitarian Government yesterday officially decreed that no one who is not admitted in the next two months to the newly created Party of the Nation, which has succeeded the less militantly Fascist Party of National Rebirth, will be permitted to continue as an executive in any commercial or industrial enterprise, to practice a profession or to hold public office.

Although Jews are not mentioned specifically in the decree, it is thought unlikely that they will be admitted to a party in which the anti-Semitic Iron Guard will admittedly play a dominant role.

The decree may be tantamount to exclusion of all Jews in business, professional and public life throughout Rumania in the opinion of observers here.

Rumanian Situation Watched in London

LONDON, June 23. (JTA) -- Latest developments in Rumania, restoring the Iron Guard to a place of prominence in the country's political life, are being closely watched by Jewish circles here because of their important bearing on the Jewish position. The new move, a direct result of intense German pressure coupled with the collapse of France, brings Rumania more than ever under German influence.

While it is expected that King Carol will do his utmost to maintain the present situation, it is believed here that he will be obliged to increase economic relations with the Reich and to give Iron Guardists cabinet posts, but may try to offset them by including National Peasant Party leaders as well. In any case it is believed that the new Party of the Nation will be anti-Semitically inclined and Jews will be excluded, as they were from the Party of National Rebirth.

JEWS, WALLOONS TO BE SUPPRESSED IN HOLLAND, MUSSERT STATES

LONDON, June 23. (JTA) -- Influence of Jews and Walloons in Holland and the power of the Church in politics will be suppressed, according to a Dutch radio broadcast quoting a statement by Anton A. Mussert, Netherlands Nazi leader.

The broadcast is taken here to indicate that the Germans are utilizing the Dutch Nazis to create a Nazi puppet state in Holland. Dutch circles here report that signs are multiplying that the "Aryan paragraph" is being increasingly enforced in Holland and that "non-Aryans" will be removed from all important positions.

46,000 VIENNA JEWS REPORTED IN ACUTE DISTRESS

BUCHAREST, June 23. (JTA) -- Reports from Vienna indicate acute distress among the city's 46,000 Jews. Men are forced to work at loading trains and as building laborers, receiving 75 pfennig hourly. Women are forced to work in the fields.

Jews are faced with famine since, being restricted to certain hours in making purchases, they often find supplies exhausted when they go to shop. Dr. Josef Loewenherz, president of the Vienna Jewish Community, has issued an appeal for material aid.

Nazi anti-Jewish propaganda over the Vienna radio is increasingly violent, having a marked effect throughout Rumania.

BUCHAREST, June 23. (JTA) -- A steamship carrying clothing and food donated by American Jews for Polish refugees has arrived in Constanza.

BRITISH VICTORY PREDICTED IN SERMON BY CHIEF RABBI HERTZ

LONDON, June 23. (JTA) -- The spiritual qualities that guided Abraham Lincoln to victory actuate Great Britain today in its struggle with Germany and Italy, it was asserted today by Chief Rabbi Joseph H. Hertz in a Great Synagogue sermon marking a day of prayer and intercession for triumph of the forces of freedom.

Dr. Hertz compared Britain's attitude to the "spirit of anxiety to be on the side of the Lord which dominated Abraham Lincoln and led him to victory." He expressed confidence in Britain's ultimate victory "desperate as our enemies proclaim the situation to be."

AGUDATH ISRAEL AIDING EVACUATION OF CHILDREN FROM ENGLAND

LONDON, June 23. (JTA) -- The Agudath Israel is telegraphically contacting its affiliated organizations in the United States and Canada to facilitate evacuation of Jewish children from England under the general evacuation scheme. It is seeking housing of Jewish children in Jewish homes or hostels supervised by Jewish bodies.

A small yeshiva has been established at the internment camp on the Isle of Man for the internees who had been students of the London Gateshead yeshivas.

It is learned that numerous refugees from Belgium who had gone to France arrived in England during the past week.

Dr. Ignacy Schwartzbart, member of the Polish Parliament-in-exile, arrived here today from France.

500 REFUGEES SOON TO START ROUND-THE-WORLD TRIP TO NEW WORLD HAVENS

BUDAPEST, June 23. (JTA) -- Within two weeks approximately 500 refugees from Nazi persecution will embark on a journey that will take them almost entirely around the globe before they reach their destinations in the new world, it was learned today.

With the assistance of the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee, the refugees will leave Berlin, Prague and Vienna and proceed across Soviet Russia and China to Japan. From Japan they will be transported across the Pacific to the countries of their destination.

The refugees, all of whom bear immigration visas for the United States and countries in South America, have been unable to book passage by way of Atlantic and Mediterranean ports because of the war.

BRATISLAVA SYNAGOGUE, GHETTO TO BE RAZED IN 'BEAUTIFICATION' PROGRAM

BUDAPEST, June 23. (JTA) -- A new public works program for beautification of Bratislava, capital of Nazi-controlled Slovakia, has been officially launched by the Slovak Government, which declares that the first step will be the razing of the city's historic synagogue and the entire ghetto. The Government declaration fails to state what provisions will be made to provide new living quarters for Bratislava's Jewish population.

4 ENDEKS GET JAIL TERMS FOR WILNO EXCESSES LAST FALL

WILNO, Lithuania, June 23. (JTA) -- The District Court has sentenced four anti-Semitic Polish Endeks, including a woman, to prison terms ranging from three months to six years for participation in anti-Jewish excesses last Oct. 31. Others will be tried shortly.

The trial established that the police were derelict in their duty to defend the Jews. It was recalled that former Interior Minister Kazys Skucas administratively fined a Jewish journalist 1,000 lits, with the alternative of 50 days in jail, for "defamation" of the police by accusing them of remissness during the excesses.

MONSKY URGES B'NAI B'RITH LODGES TO GIVE FULL AID TO RED CROSS

WASHINGTON, June 23. (JTA) -- The American Red Cross announced today that Henry Monsky, president of the B'nai B'rith, has urged all lodges and auxiliaries to give the greatest financial assistance to the Red Cross. The Supreme Lodge has contributed \$2,500 and many lodges have sent individual contributions. "I am confident that B'nai B'rith, for 98 years a devoted servant of mankind, will not fail in this, the greatest crisis of our time," Monsky said.

AID TO ALLIES BACKED BY RABBINICAL GROUP

CHARLEVOIX, Mich., June 23. (JTA) -- The 51st annual meeting of the Central Conference of American Rabbis was on record today in favor of supporting "the Government of the United States in all measures it is taking to aid the Allies."

Reaffirming concern with Israel's historic ideal of peace, the report of the Committee on International Peace, submitted by Chairman Joseph Rauch of Louisville, expressed hope that "the voices of liberalism and justice will not be silenced throughout the world. Regardless of the turn of events, it is our sacred duty to keep our hearts free of bitterness."

The report advocated a union of Jewish forces before the peace conferences following the present conflict. Among the aims of such united action, it was stated, should be the securing of civil rights for Jewish people everywhere, cessation of evacuation policies instituted against the Jews and the unhindered upbuilding of Palestine.

The meeting set up a committee on chaplaincy service charged with the duty of cooperation with "all national organizations which seek the cooperation of the Reform rabbinate and prosecution of their work." The secretary was instructed to send a special message of greeting and encouragement to colleagues "serving congregations in countries now at war and laboring under grave and extraordinary responsibilities."

SAFEGUARD DEMOCRATIC PRINCIPLES IN ANY ANTI-FIFTH COLUMN PROGRAM, PARLEY URGES

NEW YORK, June 23. (JTA) -- A plea to the legislative and executive branches of the Federal Government and to American public opinion to safeguard "the fundamental texture of democracy" in any program of action against the fifth column was sounded today at a conference of presidents of synagogues, fraternal lodges and welfare agencies, held under the auspices of the Hebrew Sheltering and Immigrant Aid Society (HIAS).

The conference adopted a resolution expressing "wholehearted approval" of all legal measures necessary "for the protection of the interests of the United States" but stressing the importance of differentiating between fifth column elements and "the overwhelming majority of immigrants" who are loyal to the ideals of Americanism.

Support of the \$1,000,000 "Rescue Through Emigration" campaign of the HIAS was voted by the conference, which was attended by more than 600 representatives of religious and fraternal groups. Speakers included President Abraham Herman of HIAS, Justice Mitchell May, campaign chairman, who presided, Isaac L. Asofsky, HIAS executive director; Rabbi A.D. Burack, vice-president of the Union of Orthodox Rabbis, and others.

GROUP URGING RESTRICTED FRANCHISE WOULD TAKE VOTE FROM U.S. JEWS

NEW YORK, June 23. (JTA) -- An organization calling itself the "American-by-Statesmanship Crusade for the Restricted Franchise" is distributing throughout the United States a manifesto urging "Gentile people" to join in a crusade against "equality, fraternity, etc."

The manifesto implies that among the "inferiors" who should be disenfranchised are the Jews, who, the statement says, "have organized a state within our state which has corrupted Christian economics." The organization's address is the building in which the Hamburg-American and North German Lloyd Steamship lines are located.

Addressing the opening session, President Stephen S. Wise of the American Jewish Congress urged that America send all help short of war to England, which he described as "the Maginot Line of the United States." Grand Master Max F. Wolff collapsed of a heart attack shortly before the convention opened and Herman Hoffmann, First Deputy Grand Master, presided.

ALL REVISIONISTS BUT ERI JABOTINSKY REPORTED RELEASED IN PALESTINE

(JTA) -- All detained Zionist-Revisionists in Palestine have been released with the exception of his son, Eri, President Vladimir Jabotinsky of the New Zionist Organization disclosed today on the basis of private information. Young Jabotinsky has been detained since last February and in March was sentenced administratively to one year in the Acre concentration camp on charges of helping smuggle Jewish immigrants into Palestine.

Young Jabotinsky has been detained since last February and in March was sentenced administratively to one year in the Acre concentration camp on charges of helping smuggle Jewish immigrants into Palestine.
