TRIPOLI JEWISH QUARTER BOMBED; 30 CASUALTIES REPORTED

ROME, June 25. (JTA) -- An official communique announced today that aircraft had bombed Tripoli, a number of bombs landing in the city's ancient Jewish quarter and claiming about 30 victims.

REICH REFUGEE CHILDREN IN ENGLAND NOT TO BE EVACUATED, COMMONS TOLD

LONDON, June 25. (JTA) -- German-Jewish refugee children definitely will not be included in the Dominions evacuation scheme, the House of Commons was told today by Geoffrey E. Shakespeare, *Parliamentary Secretary to the Admiralty.*

Under Secretary for the Dominions
Replying to a question by Labor M.P. Josiah Wedgwood on whether children of German Jews now in England would benefit by the plan, Shakespeare said: "No. The scheme only applies to the children of Allied refugees." Asked why, Shakespeare replied: "The scheme was agreed upon in harmony with the wishes of the Dominion governments."

BLUM REPORTED IN ENGLAND; MANDEL EN ROUTE

LONDON, June 25. (JTA) -- Arrival in England of former French Premier Leon Blum was reported in the News-Chronicle today by Vernon Bartlett, journalist and Independent M.P.

Bartlett also reported that former French Interior Secretary Georges Mandel was en route to England. He added that many thousands of political refugees, including numerous notables, had not been heard from. "These unhappy people," he said, "are under no illusions with regard to the further miseries in store unless British and American ships immediately transfer them to relative security."

Blum had variously been reported held by the Nazis in Paris and a refugee in Switzerland.

Feuchtwanger in Lisbon

LISBON, June 25. (JTA) -- Lion Feuchtwanger, famous novelist and one of the earliest refugees from Nazi Germany, arrived here today from France where he had made his home. Morris C. Troper, European director of the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee, was scheduled to arrive today from Spain after a trip from Bordeaux.

Would Bring Imperiled Notables to U.S.

NEW YORK, June 25. (JTA) -- Listing a number of celebrities who have been imperiled by the Franco-German armistice clause demanding return to Germany of German subjects residing in France, the New York Times urged in an editorial today that refugees whose lives have thus been endangered be brought here on American ships for temporary refuge.

The editorial cites America's record as a home of the oppressed, recalls that "even the Exclusion Act of 1917 exempted from the literacy test aliens who seek admission to avoid religious, racial and political persecution," and concludes:

"Since the right of asylum is traditional, the refugees whose lives now hang in the balance should be brought here in American ships, granted a temporary right of asylum and distributed among the democracies of the Western Hemisphere. Even the relief of the stricken millions who are now wandering homeless in conquered territories is not so urgent."

Among those listed by the Times as endangered by the armistice clause are: Lion Feuchtwanger, novelist (now reported safe in Lisbon); Dr. Rudolf Neumann, noted pediatrician; Dr. Herman Buszislowski, successor to Karl von Ossietzky as editor of Die Weltbuehne; Theodore Balk, social medicine authority; Dr. Adolph Hofmeister, Czech cartoonist; Rudolph Leonhard, German poet; Anna Saghers, Kleist prize winner, and Dr. Friedrich Wolf, author of "Professor Mamlock" and other plays.

SONS OF BARON DE ROTHSCHILD REPORTED MISSING IN FRANCE

LONDON, June 25. (JTA) -- Both sons of Baron Robert de Rothschild, French financier and philanthropist who is now here with his wife and one daughter, were reported today to be missing in France. The younger son, Eri, was believed to have been killed in action. Both youths were serving with the French forces.

NAZIS SEEK TO REPATRIATE DUTCH, BELGIAN REFUGEES IN FRANCE

LONDON, June 25. (JTA) -- Arthur Seyss-Inquart, Nazi Commissioner for Holland, was reported today to have appointed a commission to proceed to France to organize repatriation of Dutch and Belgian refugees, among whom thousands are Jews.

PALESTINE JEWS SET TO AID IN ANY EMERGENCY, MacMICHAEL TOLD

JERUSALEM, June 25. (JTA) -- A half million Palestine Jews are anxious to fight on Britain's side and urge establishment of a Jewish military force, a delegation of Jewish leaders today told High Commissioner Sir Harold A. MacMichael in an interview.

The Jewish community's loyalty and preparedness to volunteer for any emergency required for defense of Palestine and the Empire was voiced by the delegation, which included the executive committee of the Jewish National Council, Moshe Shertok, head of the Jewish Agency's political department, and Dr. Altman, leader of the Zionist-Revisionists.

MacMichael expressed thanks and promised to transmit to London immediately the Jews' requests.

THOUSANDS OF ROMANIAN JEWS FACE LOSS OF LIVELIHOOD AS DECREE BANS PARTY MEMBERSHIP

BUCHAREST, June 25. (JTA) -- Thousands of Rumanian Jews faced loss of livelihood today as a result of a decree, made public here last night, forbidding all Jews to join the totalitarian Party of the Nation.

The decree followed on the heels of formation of the pro-Nazi party by King Carol, swinging Rumania into line with the Rome-Berlin axis, with one of its basic tenets limiting to party members the right to hold public office, serve as an executive in any commercial or industrial enterprise, or practice a profession.

The measure, which had been expected, places new disabilities upon uncounted thousands of Rumania's 800,000 Jews, some 225,000 of whom have already suffered a severe economic setback by virtue of their having been deprived of citizenship under the Citizenship Revision Law.

Meanwhile, members of the violently anti-Semitic Iron Guard, many of whom had been in jail since the Iron Guardist assassination of Premier Armand Calinescu in September, 1939, began to join the Government party, in which the terrorist organization is assigned an important role. First of the Iron Guardists to join the party were Ion Zelea Codreanu, brother of the slain Iron Guard leader, and a brother-in-law.

TOLERANCE NOTE STRESSED AT REPUBLICAN CONVENTION; ANTI-FIFTH COLUMN ACTION URGED

PHILADELPHIA, June 25. (JTA) -- Tolerance, sympathy with oppressed peoples in Europe and the necessity of a vigorous fight against the fifth column in the United States were among the notes struck at the Republican National Convention.

The party's platform, being prepared for submission to the convention, includes a statement of sympathy for all "oppressed peoples" in their fight for freedom and approval of such aid to beleaguered governments as may be extended without violation of international law or peril to American defense.

Governor Harold E. Stassen of Minnesota, in the keynote address last night, declared that "we must brush aside the brambles of prejudice, bitterness and hatred and lead through to national unity based upon understanding, tolerance and confidence."

Listing "fifth column defense" as one of the nation's "four major fronts," he reviewed "the boring from within," "treachery" and "treason" which had contributed to the destruction of European countries and asserted that "we must prepare our defense against similar actions here, carefully and vigorously but without any ill-considered witch-hunts."

As part of the anti-fifth column drive he urged (1) barring of supporters of Communism, Nazism and Fascism from the public payrolls, (2) encouraging trade unions to oust officers sympathetic to these "isms," (3) unmasking and exposing "those un-American organizations that are parading under false fronts," (4) punishment of "every violation of law committed by the fifth columnists," (5) correction of economic and social maladjustments to "take away the grounds of discontent upon which these fifth columnists seek to flourish."

Governor Stassen stated that America cannot allow "governments in this hemisphere to be undermined by subversive elements linked to foreign aggressors. It is essential

that we plan in advance and take decisive steps to establish hemisphere defense."

The musical keynote of the convention was also one of tolerance. The meeting opened with the singing of the Robinson-Latouche "Ballad for Americans," whose theme is the building of America by immigrants of various origins.

VITAL ROLE OF U.S. JEWRY IN CRISIS STRESSED AS RABBINICAL ASSEMBLY PARLEY OPENS

DETROIT, June 25. (JTA) -- On the keynote of American Jewry being "the sole surviving remnant of Jewish life in the diaspora," the 40th annual convention of the Rabbinical Assembly of America, body of Conservative rabbis, opened this morning at Shaarey Zedek Synagogue with 100 rabbis and a number of guests attending.

In his presidential address, Dr. Max Arzt, of the Jewish Theological Seminary, asserted that "our deliberations will have the sole aim of exploring and defining our increased responsibilities in the face of the present world crisis."

"By virtue of our knowledge and training, our consecration to the service of our people and our faith, we are best equipped to guide our people through these perilous times," Dr. Arzt said. "We must make them keenly aware of the new role which American Jewry must play as the sole surviving remnant of Jewish life in the diaspora."

He asserted that "organized religion, instead of thundering forth in the name of God and strict justice, surrenders to the jingoistic elements that destroyed the hope of the world." He said Americans must recall with "uneasy conscience" the shelving of the Wagner-Rogers refugee children's bill because of the action of "super-patriots."

"Even now," Dr. Arzt declared, "these very elements are utilizing the hysterical fear of the fifth column to hound innocent aliens and to close the doors of America against the victims of Hitler and his hordes. There are those who propose a program of repression and persecution which will affect the innocent even as it will overlook the guilty, who are by no means limited to the strangers within our gates."

Dr. Arzt, criticizing isolationists, proposed mobilization of all our resources for strengthening the democratic system and erecting a powerful defense against "the bloodthirsty brutalitarians." He proposed not only a military conscription and training program, but also immediate economic rehabilitation of the 12,000,000 unemployed to save their morale.

Urging increased generosity in maintenance of an overseas relief program, Dr. Arzt proposed that American religious forces champion legislation for immediate admission of European children for the duration of the war.

Dr. Arzt paid tribute to the late Dr. Cyrus Adler and congratulated Prof. Louis Finkelstein on his election as president of the Seminary to succeed Dr. Adler. At an evening public meeting, Dr. Finkelstein also eulogized Dr. Adler.

Increased participation by rabbis in Jewish communal life and national organizations was urged in papers prepared for a symposium on "The Rabbi and the American Community." Speakers included Rabbi Morris Adler, Detroit, and Rabbi Armond E. Cohen, Cleveland.

SPAIN ADMITS 600 POLES, JEWS FROM FRANCE; MOST PARIS JEWS EVACUATED

LONDON, June 25. (JTA) -- Spain has admitted a trainload of 600 Poles and Jews from France, while Portugal is admitting only those in transit to other countries, it was reported today by Dr. Ignacy Schwartzbard, member of the Polish National Council, who arrived from France on Sunday.

Practically all the Jews in Paris, except the poorest, managed to evacuate Paris before the Nazi occupation of the French capital, Dr. Schwarzbard said. Marc Jarblum and Isaac Naiditch, French Zionist leaders, are in Toulouse, he added.

BUDAPEST CABBY DEPRIVED OF POST BY ANTI-JEWISH LAW

BUDAPEST, June 16. (JTA--By Airmail). The last Jewish horse-cab driver in Budapest has now been deprived of his license by the municipal authorities under the anti-Jewish laws.

Samuel Schoengut, who was the only Jew among the 20 survivors of a by-gone era in transportation, had been one of the capital's best-known figures. He and his cab had been seen on Budapest streets for 46 years.

Schoengut made several appearances on the screen with his horse and cab and had also been used by Hungarian impressarios to play the part of a cab-driver in several stage productions.
