### AGENCY ASKS RAW MATERIALS TO INCREASE PALESTINE OUTPUT FOR ARMY

JERUSALEM, July 8. (JTA) -- Jewish industries in Palestine can increase their production for the army provided the military authorities supply the raw materials, Moshe Shertok, head of the political department of the Jewish Agency for Palestine, said at a press conference today.

Stressing the Agency's active support for the Palestine recruiting campaign, Shertok gave the newspapermen a comprehensive review of the external and internal political situation.

Rallies to encourage recruiting for the British armed forces were held over the weekend in Tel Aviv. Addressing a meeting of drivers and metal workers, Shertok emphasized that the Palestine Jews constituted the largest source of technical power in the Middle East and appealed for full support of the recruiting, especially for the Royal Air Force.

The Histadruth, Palestine Jewish labor federation, issued an appeal to its members to speed up recruiting and announced establishment of a special committee to negotiate with various settlements to increase the number of volunteers.

All members of the Palestine commission of the Zionist General Council have been summoned to a meeting on Wednesday.

### BRITISH PAPERS URGE EASING OF CURBS ON REFUGEES

LONDON, July 8. (JTA) -- An appeal for discrimination in the internment of refugees was voiced in The Times today by Prof. Gilbert Murray, chairman of the League of Nations Union. "We must not become so blinded by the emotions of war," Prof. Murray wrote, "as to be unable to distinguish between friends and enemies."

Writing in the News-Chronicle, A.J. Cummings, hailed steps taken by the Government towards revising the method of wholesale internment, declaring: "We cannot expect to win a war against persecution by persecuting the persecuted."

Hannen Swaffer, Daily Herald columnist, condemned wholesale internment of refugees, asking: "Have we shown equal vigilance in the case of higher-ups who for years boasted of their liking for Hitlerism?"

WILLKIE TO HIT ANTI-SEMITISM IN ACCEPTANCE SPEECH; FAVORS ANTI-AGITATION ACTION

NEW YORK, July 8. (JTA) -- Wendell L. Willkie, Republican presidential nominee, told the Jewish Telegraphic Agency today he will include a strong statement against anti-Semitism in his acceptance speech to be made in Elwood, Ind., on or about Aug. 1.

Willkie also indicated he was interested in legislation to check racial agitation, but said he did not wish to commit himself to any specific measure before he had had an opportunity to give the matter complete study.

Today's brief interview with Willkie, held at his office at 20 Pine Street, a few minutes before he left to catch a plane for Washington, followed his statement to The Day in which he termed anti-Semitism "a possible criminal movement," warned that the spread of anti-Jewish feeling would be a "calamity" and appealed for "tolerance and religious liberty."

"I was very glad to make that statement," Willkie said today. "Since then, I have received a large number of telegrams from various kinds of pressure groups." He took from his pocket a telegram from St. Louis, signed "Social Justice News," which demanded that Willkie, in view of his denunciation of anti-Semitism, also make a statement against "anti-Christianity."

The Republican nominee was asked what measures he would take to check anti-Semitic agitation. He was asked specifically about Senator W. Warren Barbour's bill which would ban material inciting racial and religious hatred from the mails.

"I would like very much to see a copy of that bill," Willkie said. "I wouldn't like to just make a hurried statement without giving full consideration. But I am going to give the question study, and I'll be able to make a complete statement when I get back from my vacation in Colorado. You can say that I intend to include a very strong statement on anti-Semitism in my acceptance speech."

JEWISH PAPERS BANNED, JEWS BARRED FROM PRESS IN RUMANIA

BUDAPEST, July 8. (JTA) -- Rumanian Minister of Propaganda Nichifor Crainic tonight announced complete elimination of Jews from the Rumanian press and banning of Jewish newspapers, the German wireless reported.

The Berlin broadcast quoted Crainic as stating before managing directors of Bucharest papers:

"Under the new government the right to speak to the Rumanian people will be conceded only to persons of Rumanian blood. Long, painful experiences have shown us that the Jewish press is incapable of adaptation to Rumanian ideals, and that Jewish papers represent only the ideals of another race which are deleterious from the Rumanian national viewpoint."

Crainic was also represented as stating that non-Jewish national minorities would be permitted to continue publishing their own newspapers.

Iron Guard, Peasant Leader Reported in Anti-Semitic Pact

NEW YORK, July 8. (JTA) -- The Associated Press reported from Bucharest today that the Iron Guard had reached agreement with Julius Maniu, Peasant Party leader, on a five-point program, including division of the Jewish population into categories so that restrictions could be introduced "without disrupting Rumania's economic life." The agreement opened the way to the possibility that the present cabinet would be replaced by a completely Iron Guard regime, it was said.

BARON MAURICE DE ROTHSCHILD ARRIVES IN SCOTLAND

SWEDISH JEWS AIDED BY PAULINE WARBURG BEQUEST

STOCKHOLM, July 8. (JTA) -- A bequest of 3,000,000 Swedish crowns for Jewish causes was left by the late Pauline Rosalie Warburg, widow of Danish Consul General Simon Elias Warburg, it was disclosed today. This includes 100,000 crowns for the Stockholm Jewish community, 60,000 for the Gothenborg community, a 500,000-crown fund for the poor and distressed and the remainder for establishment of homes for Jews in Palestine and also for needy Jewish savants.

2,991 JEWS ENTERED PALESTINE IN FIRST HALF YEAR

BUND LEADER IN CLASH WITH SENATOR CONNALLY AT HEARINGS ON NAZI BAN

WASHINGTON, July 8. (JTA) -- Repeated clashes between Senator Tom Connally, Chairman of the Senate Judiciary Subcommittee, and William Kunze, national leader of the German-American Bund, marked hearings held today before the subcommittee, which is considering legislation affecting the status of the Bund and Communist organizations.

Senator Connally minced no words in showing his dislike for the Bund as an organization, or Kunze as its leader, and rebuked Wilbur Keegan, counsel for the Bund, for interfering in Kunze's testimony.

Kunze appeared before the subcommittee to object to the projected legislation, but protested that the Bund was innocent of any un-American activities. Connally maintained that if the Bund was not engaged in subversive activities it would not object to the proposed law.

### BUCHAREST CHARGED WITH FRAMING 'SPURIOUS ALIBI' FOR POGROMS

NEW YORK, July 8. (JTA) -- Dominant elements in Bucharest are creating a "spurious alibi" for pogroms against Rumania's Jews in order to divert attention from the Soviet invasion, it was charged today in a statement signed by Adolph Held, president of the Jewish Labor Committee; Henry Monsky, president of B'nai B'rith; Sol M. Strock, chairman of the executive committee of the American Jewish Committee, and Dr. Stephen S. Wise, president of the American Jewish Congress. The statement follows:

"Recent dispatches based on Government propaganda releases in Berlin, Rome and Bucharest describe what purport to be armed uprisings of 'Jews and Communists' in the Rumanian territories of Bessarabia and Northern Bukovina which have been annexed by the Soviet Government. The official German news agency and the Bucharest Curentul have also published inflammatory anti-Jewish articles accusing the 300,000 Jews of the lost area of 'excesses' designed to cause internal unrest.

"This language, published by permission of the Rumanian censor, is familiar to any American who recalls the 'justifications' advanced by the Nazis for their persecutions in the past. In order to divert the attention of the Rumanian people from the loss of territory to the Soviet Government it is apparent that the dominant elements in Bucharest are whipping up a spurious alibi for a deliberately plotted pogrom against Jews.

"The Rumanian Government is cooperating with the Nazi Government. The newly formed totalitarian 'Party of the Nation,' which bars Jews from membership, is now all-powerful. Newly instituted laws now applied with redoubled severity aim at eliminating Rumania's Jewish citizens--some four per cent of the population--from the nation's political and economic life. Now, by spreading inspired stories, unconfirmed by any impartial observer, the Nazified elements in control at Bucharest are attempting to throw a mask of terror and pogroms over their own shortcomings.

"The reported massacre of 800 Jews in Galati may be followed by even more awful slaughter, as the Rumanian people is whipped up to seek an outlet for despair at seeing their land so brutally partitioned. The smokescreen of 'insurrection' attached to an impoverished, weak and politically helpless group, will not mislead intelligent Americans."

### REPORT FRANCE WILL SET UP FASCIST STATE, MODELLED ON REICH, ITALY

NEW YORK, July 8. (JTA) -- A Berlin dispatch of the United Press today quoted the German press as stating that the French Parliament would vote itself out of existence on Wednesday and clear the way for establishment of a French Fascist state on the model of Italy and Germany.

A Geneva dispatch of the Associated Press said the press in unoccupied France had carried reports that Marshal Henri Philippe Petain would be "Chief of State" in the new regime like General Franco in Spain, with a triumvirate of Vice-Premier Pierre Laval, General Maxime Weygand and Minister of Interior Adrien Marquet ruling the country under Petain's titular leadership.
