### BRITAIN INVESTIGATING CONDITIONS IN INTERNMENT CAMPS; EDEN PROMISES IMPROVEMENT

LONDON, July 9. (JTA) -- War Secretary Anthony Eden announced in the House of Commons today that he has launched an investigation into conditions prevailing at internment camps. The announcement climaxed a wave of criticism by Newspapers and prominent Britons both of indiscriminate internment of refugees and their treatment in the camps.

Eden said that any present deficiencies in the camps were due to the recent influx of internees and promised that every effort would be made to improve conditions.

Meanwhile, internment of refugees is resulting in considerable confusion with regard to emigration to the United States, since it is estimated that half of some 27,000 refugees awaiting visas here have been interned and thus are unable to keep appointments at the United States Consulate for medical and other examinations. To facilitate handling the cases of internees, the Consulate has opened an immigration department branch at Liverpool.

It is understood that the authorities are anxious not to interfere with the emigration of refugees and are considering, in conjunction with the American Consulate, methods of procedure under which the internees would be enabled to proceed with their arrangements. A number of internees, it was learned, have already obtained their visas and have been released for emigration.

The Star reports that the question of internment has resulted in considerable uneasiness among Parliamentarians and that it may soon be the subject of a debate in Commons.

### No Refugees on Arandora Star

LONDON, July 9. (JTA) -- There were no refugees on the Arandora Star when it was torpedoed off the Irish Coast last Tuesday while transporting German and Italian internees to Canada, Commons was told today by Minister of Shipping Ronald H. Cross.

All the Germans on board, Cross said in reply to a query by Laborite George Strauss, were Nazi sympathizers. None was in the B or C category of enemy aliens or came to England as refugees, he added.

Cross promised that in the future every effort would be made to separate pro-Nazi and anti-Nazi aliens.

### MANY JEWS MURDERED IN RIOTING IN NORTH RUMANIA, LONDON HEARS

LONDON, July 9. (JTA) -- A Bucharest dispatch to the Evening Standard said today that rioting was widespread in northern Rumania and that many Jews had been murdered. The dispatch reported that Dr. Axmer, a Jewish leader at Dorohoi, his wife and three children were killed in the course of anti-Jewish rioting there.

During the funeral, a report was spread that a Communist meeting was being held in the cemetery. Acting on the report, Rumanian troops were reported to have sped to the cemetery and machine-gunned the mourners.

(Dorohoi, in northern Moldavia, was the scene of a pogrom on the night of July 5 in which 40 Jews were killed and more than 100 wounded, a JTA dispatch from Budapest reported Sunday.)

The Times reported from Bucharest that 15,000 Jews, anxious to return to Bessarabia but refused admission by the Soviet authorities, were barred from readmission to Rumania and were marconed in lighters off Galati in insanitary conditions for several days.

### MANDEL'S ARREST ORDERED BY VICHY GOVERNMENT; RESISTED CAPITULATION

NEW YORK, July 9. (JTA) -- The London correspondent of the Chicago Daily News reported today, "on excellent authority," that Georges Mandel, former French Interior Minister, had been ordered arrested in Morocco by the French Government, together with ex-Premier Edouard Daladier and other former ministers.

Mandel was "the soul of France," in the days before the capitulation, fighting with "intelligence, stubbornness and patriotism for faith to an ally and war to the end for the honor of France," according to a London dispatch written for the North American News Alliance by Elie J. Bois, former editor of Le Petit Parisien. Bois said of Mandel:

"He animated the discouraged, inspired the brave and shamed the weak. He downed every poor argument, he forestalled all maneuvers...To M. Chautemps, who wanted Prime Minister Churchill to give the Cabinet a release for a separate peace, this brave Frenchman replied: 'It is not done. We must honor our undertaking.'...

"In these historic days this man was the soul of France. Georges Mandel showed himself to be the true spiritual son of Clemenceau--the Clemenceau of 1918...M. Mandel followed in his footsteps when he said to the defeatists at a Cabinet meeting, 'I am surprised to hear of capitulation from Ministers newly appointed to strengthen the war Cabinet...M. Mandel might have won had not the plotters exploited his 'non-Aryan' origin, in spite of his obvious patriotism."

### WAR CAUSES SHIFTING OF ROUTES FOR EUROPEAN JEWISH EMIGRATION

LISBON, June 29. (JTA Airmail) -- Jews holding immigration visas for the United States and Palestine, unable to cross territories dominated by the Nazis and Fascists, are trying to adjust their emigration plans to the latest changes in European geography brought about by the war.

Preparations are being completed by the Portuguese steamship company for weekly sailings from Portugal to Palestine by a route requiring a voyage completely around Africa to Mozambique, from there through the Red Sea and thence to Palestine. The trip will take 45 days.

Arrangements have been completed with a Japanese line to transport Jews holding American visas across the Pacific Ocean and disembark them at San Francisco. This route will require the crossing of Russia and Siberia by land to Shanghai, where they will embark on Japanese stemmers.

In Rumania and Hungary, holders of Palestine certificates are organizing a pilgrimage to Palestine by land, since the Mediterranean is closed. They will proceed by train and foot to Greece, thence through Turkey and Syria to the Holy Land.

Telegraphic appeals received here today by the HLAS-ICA Emigration Association indicate that Jews in Italy holding United States visas are trying to find their way from Trieste to Lisbon on Greek steamers, hoping to embark from Lisbon on Portuguese or Greek freighters, since American ships for the time being accept only American citizens.

An appeal received by the HIAS-ICA from Wilno Jewish Relief Committee said there were more than 150 Polish Jewish refugees in Lithuania holding United States quota visas which were nearing expiration. The message urged that some way be found to bring them to Lisbon or secure for them transit visas through Soviet Russia to Shanghai, from where they could embark on Japanese Steamships.

The Soviet authorities are permitting transit by the Trans-Siberian Railway to Jews holding German, Lithuanian and Latvian passports. No transit visas are available, however, to holders of Polish passports. Polish Jewish refugees therefore are apparently stranded in Wilno since they cannot be brought to Lisbon. (A cabled appeal from these refugees to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency asked that a ship be chartered in America to embark them at Petsamo, Finland.)

In permitting German Jews to cross Russia, the Soviet authorities accept fare for the 12-day railway trip in German marks. At Shanghai, however, the Japanese line insists on payment for the trans-Pacific crossing in American dollars at the rate of \$250 per person. The high fare will come as a heavy burden on the emigrants.

It is interesting that the new far eastern route for emigration of Jews to the United States will shift the emphasis from New York to San Francisco as the port of arrival for immigrants. (The Hebrew Immigrant Aid Society of New York has announced that it now has an office in San Francisco to assist the incoming immigrants.)

According to latest information received here, 600 Folish Jews who had been en route to Palestine before Italy entered the war are now stranded in Trieste. They may reach Palestine by land should they succeed in crossing Greece, which many of them are trying to do. Others are seeking permission to enter Portugal to proceed to Palestine by the round-Africa route.

### 120 Land at Casablanca

LISEON, July 9. (JTA) -- A group of 120 French and Belgian Jewish refugees have been permitted to land at Casablanca, French Morocco, following intervention by the Tangier Jewish community, it was learned here today. The group, which had arrived on a small steamer after enduring many hardships, had originally been barred from disembarkation.

### Refugees in Wilno Send Appeal

NEW YORK, July 8. (JTA) -- An appeal from several hundred Polish Jewish refugees in Wilno, Lithuania, having American immigration visas, to Jewish organizations in the United States for aid in obtaining transit via Soviet Russia or for the sending of a special ship to embark them at Petsamo, Finland, was received by the Jewish Telegraphic Agency. The appeal, signed by Rabbi Chaim Oser Grodzenski, said the refugees included many wives and children wishing to join their husbands and fathers in the United States. Their situation, he said, is "extremely critical."

### RUMANIAN CABINET MAPS ANTI-JEWISH MEASURES

EUCHAREST, July 9. (JTA) -- A communique issued today after a Cabinet meeting indicated that the Rumanian Government was drafting anti-Jewish measures. The communique said that following a detailed discussion, some of "the chief elements of future Government activity" were decided upon concerning the Jewish question and economic problems.

### Paper Published by Jew Reported Banned

BUDAPEST, July 9. (JTA) -- The German wireless reported today in a Bucharest dispatch that the French-language newspaper Le Moment, published by the Jewish journalist Alexander Hefter, was ordered to suspend publication by the Bucharest military censorship as a threat to "public safety."

### HUNGARIAN JEWISH WAR HERO COMMITS SUICIDE OVER ANTI-SEMITIC LAWS

BUDAPEST, July 9. (JTA) -- Laszlo Gosztony, prominent Jewish industrialist and a distinguished war veteran, committed suicide today in protest against the Hungarian anti-Jewish laws.

Gosztony, who was 52 and executive director of one of Hungary's largest coal mining concerns, before taking his life wrote the following letter to friends, including high army officers, members of the Government and editors: "My dignity as a human being has for the first time been offended without the possibility of gaining satisfaction."

When found, Gosztony was wearing his medals for distinctive service and valor. Friends expressed the opinion that he committed suicide when he found, upon responding to mobilization, that as a Jew he was required to serve as a private instead of his former rank of lieutenant.

### REFUGEES IN HUNGARY PUT IN GOVERNMENT CAMP

EUDAPEST, July 9. (JTA) -- Eight hundred Austrian, Czech and Polish Jewish refugees were today transferred from Budapest hostels maintained by the Jewish community to a Government camp at Satoraljaujhely, Northern Hungary. The refugees were shifted, it was explained, because they had no immediate emigration prospects.

# FEUCHTWANGER REPORTED SEIZED BY NAZIS IN FRANCE

LONDON, July 9. (JTA) -- Exchange Telegraph Agency reported in a Zurich dispatch today that Lion Feuchtwanger was among the refugee authors who had fallen into German hands since the capitulation of France. (A JTA Lisbon dispatch on June 25 said Feuchtwanger had reached the Portuguese capital.)

# NYE DENIES PRO-NAZI SYMPATHIES; AROUSED OVER FBI PROBE

WASHINGTON, July 9. (JTA) -- Senator Nye, a leading member of the Senate isolationist bloc, today hotly denied any sympathy for, or tie-up with, pro-Nazi movements and threatened to launch a probe of the instigators of an investigation of himself by the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

J.E. Hoover today informed Nye that the F.B.I. had made a thorough investigation of the Senator because of an alleged pro-Nazi tie-up. Nye stated: "It seems to me that my position is clearly evident in the record. I have had no sympathy for the Nazi cause at any time and the investigation by the Bureau of Investigation will bear that out."

# PALESTINE EASES CURB ON IMPORT OF GAS MASKS

WASHINGTON, July 9. (JTA) -- Revision of the import regulations of gas masks into Palestine was noted today in a Department of Commerce report, and government officials indicated that the new regulations will permit larger quantities of gas masks to be imported into Palestine.

Prior to the revision only gas masks approved by the United Kingdom Home Office were permitted to enter Palestine. The regulations now permit any gas mask approved by the Palestine Government to enter. The revision also permits travellers to take their own gas masks into the country regardless of their manufacture.

# NAZIS SET UP NEW COURTS IN POLAND; NO APPEAL FROM THEIR VERDICTS

BUDAPEST, July 9. (JTA) -- Special courts under German judges have been established in the Government General of Poland, it was learned here today, to deal with all criminal cases no matter what the nationality of the accused. There will be no appeal from verdicts handed down by these courts.

The courts will also try all civil and commercial cases involving Germans, it was learned. Special courts will be set up later to deal with civil and commercial cases involving Poles.
