RISE IN SABOTAGE BRINGS NEW 'PEOPLES' COURTS' IN NAZI POLAND

LONDON, July 22. (ONA) -- Belgrade dispatches reported today that additional "Peoples' Courts" have had to be set up by the Nazi authorities in Nazi-occupied Poland to deal with a pronounced increase in acts of sabotage. Seventeen Poles were reportedly sentenced to death at Litzmanstadt (Lodz). New courts have been established at Litzmanstadt, Warsaw, Hohensalze and Bromberg (Bydgoszcz).

S.S. RODI REFUGEES REACH PALESTINE

JERUSALEM, July 22. (JTA) -- One hundred and fifty seven Jewish refugees whose trip to Palestine was interrupted when the Italian steamship Rodi was captured by a British warship and taken to Malta were scheduled to arrive today in Palestine by way of Egypt. On June 20, following the capture of the ship, the Jewish Agency asked the Palestine Government to provide transportation for these refugees.

GERMANS LISTED ALL NOTED PARISIANS; OCCUPIED JEWS' HOMES

LONDON, July 22. (JTA) -- A Portuguese woman just arrived in Lisbon from Paris told a Daily Telegraph correspondent today that the Germans apparently had "a complete list of every Parisian resident of note, particularly Jews." The woman said that following the occupation of the French capital, German officers immediately took over the homes of all wealthy Jews and "installed themselves in luxury."

16 Children Reach 'Model Town'

WASHINGTON, July 22. (JTA) -- Sixteen refugee children today arrived at the Greenbelt, Md., "model town" built by the Government on the outskirts of Washington, to be guests of the community for a two-week vacation. Most of them are children of prominent Jewish professional people who fled from Vienna, Nuremburg and Frankfurt, and they include the son of Walter Kulka, noted pathologist, and the sons and daughters of Judge Freyberg.

Members of the Greenbelt Citizens' Association, only a few of whom are Jewish, underwrote the children's trip, paying transportation expenses and opening all the town's recreational resources, including swimming pools, tennis courts and theaters, to them free of charge. They will receive medical examinations from the town's Cooperative Health Association and will be guests of the town's Girl Scouts.

It was feared for a time that Maryland's refugee laws might forestall Greenbelt's offer to take the children and help adjust them to American surroundings, but J. Milton Patterson, director of the Maryland Department of Public Welfare, stated that "neither the licensing nor the importation laws apply in this case."

BENES REVEALS NAZI TERRORISM IN 'GERMANIZING' PROTECTORATE

LONDON, July 16. (ONA - By Airmail) -- The drastic methods adopted by the Nazis to bring about complete "Germanization" of Czech industry and bend the restive people in the Protectorate to their will are spotlighted anew in a booklet published here today under the pen of Dr. Eduard Benes, former president of Czechoslovakia, and in reports seeping through the strict German censorship.

In his booklet, entitled "Nazi Barbarism in Czechoslovakia" and published by George Allen and Unwin, Ltd., Benes assails the terroristic policy pursued by the Germans toward the cultural, economic and other activities of the freedom-loving Czechs.

Publication of the booklet coincided with reports that a new wave of arrests was underway in the Protectorate, indicating that the Czechs had overcome the discouragement caused by the French surrender and had resumed their passive opposition to the Germans. This resistance has continued to such an extent that the Germans have been obliged to maintain permanently in the Protectorate between 250,000 and 400,000 German troops and at least 10,000 Gestapo agents and Blackshirt guards, it was reported.

Benes charges that the Jewish question had been "misused" in Czechoslovakia by the Nazis to bring about a widespread mass Germanization of Czech industrial life."

"I consider it necessary in this present age of perverted moral ideas to declare with pride that Czechoslovakia for a period of twenty years knew no anti-Semitism," Benes says. "There were about 350,000 Jews in Czechoslovakia on an equal footing with the rest of the population, holding high public positions and enjoying considerable wealth."

When the Nazis enforced the Nuremberg anti-Jewish laws in the Protectorate in March against the wishes of the Czech Government it soon became clear that the aim of the Nazis was wholesale "Germanization" of the country, Benes pointed out.

"According to the Protector's decree any concern is considered to be Jewish if there is a single Czech or Jewish origin in the management. As the Jewish participation in Czech industry was very widespread, most of this industry has come into German hands.

"The so-called Aryanization of Jewish property in Czechoslovakia was realized in such a way that no single piece of confiscated or transferred Jewish property could be given to a citizen of Czech nationality. That means that almost the whole of the great Czechoslovak industry is today confiscated by the Germans."

Reports reaching here from other sources said that approximately 70,000 Czechs were in concentration camps. The dread Gestapo has absolute power in the protectorate and killed or tortured thousands who fell under Nazi displeasure, it was said.

More than 100,000 Czech workers have been sent to Germany for forced labor and have been replaced in industrial plants and other enterprises by native Germans. All men up to 50, including ex-officers and civil servants, can be ordered to the Reich to work on German fortifications, it was said.

Some of the many Czech students arrested after demonstrations earlier this year were recently sent home in a pitiable state, reports said. In some cases their faces were so severely mutilated that their parents could scarcely recognize them.

PROF. OLSCHKI, EXILED ITALIAN SCIENTIST, DEAD IN GENEVA

ROME, July 13. (JTA-By Airmail) -- The death of Leo S. Olschki, internationally-known Jewish publisher and paleologist, at Geneva after a brief illness was reported today. He was 80.

The Jewish scholar, one of the world's leading collectors of ancient manuscripts, first editions and rare editions, had been in voluntary exile from Italy after his Italian citizenship had been revoked by Premier Mussolini's anti-Semitic laws of Sept. 1938. King Victor Emmanuel by special decree had personally granted him Italian citizenship several years ago in recognition of his many important contributions to Italian literature.

NAZI WIRELESS SPREADS REPORTS OF ARAB ATTACKS ON JEWS

ZURICH, July 22. (JTA) -- Renewed Nazi efforts to provoke unrest in Palestine were seen today in German wireless reports that Arabs were increasing their attacks on the Jews in the Holy Land, particularly in the orange-growing districts.

The German reports, assertedly based on information received by the Spanish Orange Syndicate from Jaffa, said that the general situation in Palestine had become very grave. Arab terrorists put to the torch and destroyed many large Jewish orange plantations in the Jaffa region. Many plantations have been ruined by lack of water due to sabotaging of irrigation systems, the reports claimed.

Campaign for Arab Federation

NEW YORK, July 22. (JTA) -- An intensive Arab campaign for the complete independence of all Arab states is underway in the Near East, Joseph M. Levy, New York Times correspondent, reports in a Cairo dispatch. This movement is aimed at eventual creation of a federation which would include Egypt, Palestine, Syria, Transjordan, Iraq and Saudi Arabia.

The collapse of France and the consequent uncertainty and ambiguity concerning the future status of Syria have strongly revived Arab nationalist trends, it was said.

THOUSANDS JOIN CITIZENS' MILITIA IN DRIVE ON URUGUAY'S 5TH COLUMN

MONTEVIDEO, Uruguay, July 10. (ONA-Airmail) -- Interest continues to be focussed on Nazi fifth column activities following the recent revelation of the military plot to seize Uruguay as Germany's first "agricultural colony" in South America and use it as the base for a drive to take Brazil and Argentina under German "protection."

Dr. Thomas Brena, Catholic leader in the Chamber of Deputies, stated in an interview with the semi-official newspaper El Pueblo: "It would be suicidal to think that we have escaped all danger. The danger has only been temporarily avoided." Dr. Brena is chairman of the Parliamentary commission which uncovered the Nazi plot.

Tens of thousands of citizens have joined the special Citizens' Militia, organized to defend Uruguay against any fifth column putsch. More than 1,000,000 pesos have been voted by the Chamber for purchase of armaments from the United States.

The ten Germans arrested following disclosure of the plot were released pending trial, reportedly as a result of German Legation pressure, but one of them, Adolph Dutine, Nazi chief in the city of Paysandu, was rearrested when he entered the police station at Paysandu and demanded the names of the policemen responsible for the arrest originally.

According to the newspaper Orientacion, numerous German "tourists" continuously arrive in this country, suspiciously like those who filtered into Belgium and Holland several months ago.
