RUMANIA OUSTS JEWS FROM LABOR ORGANIZATIONS

BUCHAREST, July 29. (JTA) -- In line with the policy of eliminating Jews from public life in Rumania, the Labor Ministry today ordered the discharge of all Jews in the employ of that ministry. Jews also will be eliminated from labor organizations, which now have been transformed into Labor Guilds.

The spreading of rumors was sharply criticized by Napoleon Cretu, Undersecretary in the Ministry of Education, in a radio address to young Rumanian Nationalists. He declared it was the duty of real nationalists to curb such rumors effectively. The Undersecretary charged these rumors were spread by Jewish Freemasons seeking to undermine the regime.

RABBIS HERE OFFER \$75,000 TO MOVE POLISH YESHIVAS TO PALESTINE

LONDON, July 29. (JTA) -- Colonial Secretary Lord Lloyd is receiving a delegation of the Agudath Israel, Jewish religious organization, to discuss transfer of Polish rabbis and religious seminary students now in Lithuania to Palestine, it was learned today.

The Rabbinical Association of America has cabled an offer to guarantee \$75,000 for maintenance of the seminaries if they are transferred to Palestine. The Agudath Israel here believes that Soviet Russia will permit transit of the refugees.

POLISH AMBASSADOR PROTESTS CESSION OF WILNO TO LITHUANIA

WASHINGTON, July 29. (ONA) -- Polish Ambassador Count Jerzy Potocki today delivered to Acting Secretary of State Sumner Welles a note from the Polish Government in exile protesting the inclusion of the Wilno district within the Soviet Union following the Russian absorption of Lithuania. Welles said he would answer the note in due course.

The Wilno district was ceded to Lithuania by Moscow after Russian forces had occupied it last year. The Russians contended that the area had been seized by Poland from Lithuania in 1920.

PARIS PAPER DEMANDS ACTION AGAINST FRENCHMEN, JEWS WHO FLED

GENEVA, July 29. (ONA) -- Edouard Herriot, former French Premier and ex-president of the Chamber of Deputies, has come under fire in the increasingly-violent French press campaign for punishment of leaders held responsible for the French "disaster," the German wireless reports.

According to the German reports, the newspaper Le Journal-Echo de Paris, sharply attacked the veteran French statesman in an article headlined: "Ruthless justice against those who were in power yesterday."

The newspaper assertedly raised the question of whether it would be right to be lenient toward a man who, in the National Assembly, tried to defend those who deserted the country at the moment when Marshal Henri Petain, French chief of State, requested all Frenchmen to do their duty in the positions allotted them.

The newspaper demanded ruthless action against all those Frenchmen who fled to England, representatives of "international Jewry" who fled to Spain and Portugal and all politicians, ministers and diplomats who fled aboard the steamer Massilia. The newspaper said that foremost among the latter were Edouard Daladier, former Premier, Georges Mandel, former minister of the Interior, Cesar Campinchi, former Navy Minister and Yvon Delbos, former Foreign Minister.

(A French language broadcast over the Italian radio picked up in New York said that Mandel has been arrested in Spanish Morocco and taken to Algiers on charges of plotting against the French Government).

MOST AMERICANS IN PALESTINE REMAIN, BUT HUNDREDS RETURN VIA INDIA ✓

WASHINGTON, July 29. (JTA) -- A majority of the Americans in Palestine, 90 per cent of whom are Jews, have informed foreign service officers that they intend to remain in the Holy Land despite Italian air bombings, the State Department said today.

Many of the Americans have moved to Jerusalem in the belief that this hallowed religious center would be spared enemy air attacks. The wives and children of American consular officials in Cairo also have taken refuge in Jerusalem.

Although most of the 8,000 American citizens in Palestine plan to remain, many hundreds are attempting to leave the country and return to the United States by the "back door" route which will carry them half-way around the world. There are no American ships now in the Mediterranean and sea travel in the Persian Gulf and the Red Sea has been disrupted so the only sure egress from the Holy Land is by plane.

An air service is now operating between Palestine and Karachi, India, with all seats reserved six weeks ahead. From Karachi, Americans are transported to Bombay where they board American President liners to return to this country via the Cape of Good Hope.

The State Department said it had not yet received a request (reported in a Jerusalem dispatch) from the Association of American Jews in Palestine to provide the same facilities for evacuation from the Near East that have been provided in other parts.

McWILLIAMS NOW CALLS HIMSELF "INDEPENDENT REPUBLICAN"

NEW YORK, July 29. (JTA) -- Joseph E. McWilliams, anti-Jewish candidate for Congress from the 19th Congressional District, New York, will run as an Independent Republican, according to the election petitions he began circulating today.

Originally a candidate on his "American Destiny Part," McWilliams now has atop his election petitions the designation, "Republican Party candidate" for Congress. He needs 3,000 signatures to have his name placed on the ballot.

STRONG NAZI FOOTHOLD IN BOLIVIAN GOVERNMENT SEEN

NEW YORK, July 29. (JTA) -- The Nazi fifth column has a strong foothold in the Bolivian Government and army, Russell Porter, New York Times correspondent, reported in a dispatch from Lima, Peru, today.

Hugo Ernst, the Commerce Minister, is half German and the agent of ten German firms, according to Porter. Neilsen Reyes, the half-German director of the protocol of the Bolivian Foreign Ministry and director of the Government's sports program for Bolivian youth, is an ardent admirer of Hitler, it was said.

The Minister of Defense and Minister of the Interior are both generals trained by the Germans and are sympathetic to the Nazis. President Enrique Penaranda de Castillo, who was commander-in-chief of the army before his election last March, also was trained by German officers in military strategy.
