HUNGARY BARS 4,000 JEWS FROM GRAIN TRADING

BUDAPEST, Aug. 7. (Delayed) (JTA) — In a new move to throttle Jewish economic activity, the Hungarian Government today issued a decree which virtually excludes about 4,000 Jews from grain trading.

Exporting and trading in wheat, rye and oats is reserved for the State-owned grain trade company, Futura, and specially licensed non-Jewish traders.

Local authorities expelled 450 Jewish market vendors from the markets of the Budapest suburbs, Ujpest and Erzsebetfalva. Families with mobilized sons-or fathers constitute the few exceptions. The very poor Jewish people are facing great misery.

SLOVAKIA TO HONOR ALL TOWNS WITHOUT JEWS

ZURICH, Aug. 9. (JTA) -- Slovak Interior Minister Sano Mach has decided that the Hlinka Guard should honor with special festivities all communities having no Jews among their inhabitants, a German wireless report said today.

The German wireless also reported that Slovak authorities had uncovered a central bureau for propaganda against the state. The four heads of the bureau were stated to have been arrested and a considerable amount of printed matter was confiscated. Court proceedings against 10 other persons accused of complicity in these activities were opened. All the persons involved are Jews, according to the German report.

10,000 JEWS TO REMAIN IN CRACOW, GENEVA HEARS

GENEVA, Aug. 9. (ONA) -- Ten thousand of the 65,000 Jews ordered expelled from the city of Cracow, Poland, by the Nazis will be permitted to remain to prevent a dislocation of commerce, the newspaper Le Journal de Geneve reported today in a dispatch from Berlin.

THORKELSON HITS JEWISH PRESS IN CONGRESSIONAL RECORD -- COSTS TAXPAYERS \$125

WASHINGTON, Aug. 9. (JTA) -- Jacob Thorkelson, anti-Semitic Representative defeated for renomination in the Montana primaries, violently attacked Jewish newspapers in a statement printed in today's Congressional Record.

Headlining his statement, "Shall organized minorities control the destiny of America?" Thorkelson said: "The fact is that in the 400,000 words I have written into the Record no statements I have made on money, government or subversive activities have been disproved by anyone.

"I leave my case in the hands of the American people and if any one can find the slightest criticism of the principles which I have supported I should like to hear such criticism from the American people and not from an alien-minded, organized minority."

In his statement Thorkelson quoted Jewish Telegraphic Agency dispatches and editorials printed in The American Jewish World of Minneapolis, The American Jewish Outlook of Pittsburgh and The Detroit Jewish Chronicle.

Based on Thorkelson's own estimate of 400,000 words included in the record, some of them proven forgeries, Thorkelson cost the American taxpayer more than \$13,000 for printing alone. Today's diatribe added \$125 to that total.

BRAZIL READY FOR TALKS ON JEWISH IMMIGRATION, OFFICIAL SAYS

SAO PAULO, Brazil, Aug. 9. (JTA) -- The Brazilian immigration authorities are prepared to negotiate with "recognized, responsible Jewish organizations" on the question of Jewish immigration for colonization, Immigration Director Carlos Muniz today told Rabbi J.X. Cohen of New York, who is here as a member of the American Commission for Cultural Exchange With South America. The commission has been given an official reception by President Getulic Vargas and Foreign Minister Oswaldo Aranha.

Dr. Cohen, who represents the American Jewish Congress and the World Jewish Congress quoted Dr. Muniz as stating that immigration of 150 Jewish capitalists monthly and 3,000 relatives of Brazilian residents was possible this year. Dr. Cohen is chairman of the Commission on Economic Problems of the American Jewish Congress.

17 JEWISH NEWSPAPERMEN INTERNED IN RUMANIA

NEW YORK, Aug. 9. (JTA) — Twenty-two newspapermen, including 17 Jews, have been arrested and interned in a concentration camp by Rumanian authorities in what is expected to be a major round-up of "alarmists" by the pro-Nazi Gigurtu regime, the United Press reports in a dispatch from Bucharest. The Jewish Telegraphic Agency correspondent (Adolf Grindee) was among those seized, the dispatch said.

An official communique quoted by the U.P. said many of the newspapermen had been arrested in coffee houses because they were "spreading alarm." Most of the Jewish correspondents, it was understood, were employed by local newspapers until recently, when Jewish newspapers were suppressed by the new regime. Some of these journalists, it was alleged, illegally continued their activities.

LOUIS-DREYFUS DENIES LEAVING FRANCE

NEW YORK, Aug. 9. (JTA) -- Louis Louis-Dreyfus, prominent French banker, has personally denied reports that he had left French soil since the start of the war, the United Press reports in a dispatch from Yichy, France. It had been reported by the German wireless that Louis-Dreyfus was on a list of Frenchmen whose citizenship would be canceled and property confiscated on charges of leaving France during the German offensive.
