### OVER 100 JEWS SEIZED BY RUMANIA SINCE ISSUANCE OF ANTI-SEMITIC CODE

BUCHAREST, Aug. 15. (JTA) -- Since the publication of the anti-Jewish code last Friday, more than 100 Jews have been arrested and sent to concentration camps on a variety of charges, the most frequent being "alarmism."

Among those arrested for "alarmism" is Emmanuel Socor, a follower of Iuliu Maniu, leader of the former Peasant bloc, and former publisher of the Democratic newspaper Adverul, which has since been banned along with many other newspapers and magazines operated by Jews. In Satu Mare yesterday, Genuth Strul Iancu, the shochet of the Jewish Community and several others were arrested for the illicit distribution of kosher meat.

According to an official report, the police discovered a store of meat in a building erected by the Satu Mare synagogue. Iancu, according to this report, confessed to having killed the animals himself, in violation of the ban on ritual slaughter, for distribution of meat among members of the orthodox Jewish community.

Meanwhile, the disciplinary council of the Bucharest bar announced today that Jewish lawyers will be given until Aug. 27 to file documents confirming their right to continue practicing under the anti-Jewish code.

According to the code only second class Jews--war veterans and their descendants and all Jews living in Old Rumania who were naturalized by decree prior to 1919--may continue practicing law.

All Jews, however, are granted a delay of six months in which to produce their second class papers, if any, and to wind up their affairs if they cannot produce them. According to the decision of the Bucharest bar, however, even second class Jews will be required to cease practicing if they have not produced their papers within a week's time.

### OSE TO AID 1,000 ALSACE-LORRAINE CHILD REFUGEES

VICHY, Aug. 15. (JTA) -- The OSE, JEWISH health protection society, will care for 1,000 Jewish children from Alsace-Lorraine, it was announced today following conclusion of an agreement with evacuated Alsatian Jewish communities which involve 500,000 francs additional monthly expense for the OSE.

The arrangement was made necessary by the continuing expulsion of Jews from Alsace-Lorraine by the Nazis, creating a new refugee problem for Jewish organizations in unoccupied France.

The maximum amount of capital which Jews expelled from Alsace-Lorraine may take with them has been reduced from 5,000 to 700 francs. Thus, Jewish families arrive in the free zone practically penniless.

#### R.A.F. DECISION TO TAKE PALESTINIAN PILOTS SPURS AVIATION CLUBS

JERUSALEM, Aug. 15. (JTA) -- Palestine Jewish youth is showing the keenest interest in aviation, following the announcement that the Royal Air Force would accept Palestinian pilots.

Three aviation clubs, supported by the Jewish Agency and the Jewish National Council, are intensely active and are graduating scores of pilots, all of them--including several girls--licensed by the Government and anxious to fight on the side of Britain.

President Lev of the Palestine Anti-Nazi League, has sent a memorandum to Pinchas Rutenberg, president of the Jewish National Council, urging that he inaugurate a collection for a Jabotinsky aviation fund to supply fighting planes for Britain and also to prepare Jewish pilots.

#### ANTI-SEMITIC ACTIVITY LAID TO POLISH REFUGEES IN ENGLAND

LONDON, Aug. 15. (JTA) -- Polish refugees have begun serious anti-Jewish activity in England, the Jewish Chronicle charged today.

Polish anti-Semitic National Democrats, led by Marian Seyda, a member of the Polish National Council, are publishing a weekly called "I Am a Pole," the first issue of which is violently anti-Semitic, the Chronicle declared.

Refugees are distributing leaflets violently attacking Jews, while three Poles have been arrested after serious attacks on Jewish refugees at the Norwood Center, it was said.

The Chronicle warned editorially that the Polish authorities must realize the effect of the anti-Jewish campaign. "It is calculated to revolt decent English sentiment and help to reproduce here the causes which led to the overthrow of their own country," the editorial said.

The Chronicle added that if the Polish authorities were unable to control their own countrymen or dispense with the cooperation of notorious Jew-baiters, public opinion might be expected to ask what authority they could be expected to command in a resurrected Polish State.

#### 10 SEMINARY STUDENTS HELPED TO LEAVE LITHUANIA
