RUMANIA BARS JEWS FROM SCHOOLS; PERMITS 'GHETTO' EDUCATION

BUCHAREST, Oct. 7. (JTA) -- Premier Ion Antonescu today signed a decree barring Jews from Rumanian schools.

Under this ruling, Jews will be permitted to establish their own schools and their own educational system but the teaching staffs and students must be exclusively Jewish. Jews are barred from schools run by other minority groups. Certain exemptions will be granted by the Government for the baptized children of wounded war veterans. Persons of Jewish race in Rumanian schools will be dismissed.

School Curb Extended to Transylvania

ZURICH, Oct. 7. (JTA) — The Hungarian Government has issued a decree extending the education provisions of the Hungarian anti-Jewish law to annexed Transylvanian territory, it was reported here today. Under this ruling Jewish students will be obliged to attend Jewish schools and only will be admitted to secondary schools on a six per cent basis.

JEWS OUSTED FROM PUBLIC POSTS, SCHOOLS IN HOLLAND

ZURICH, Oct. 7. (JTA) -- New regulations barring Jews from public employment and from the education system have been issued by the Nazis in Holland, it was reported here today.

Until recently Jews, with some exceptions, were permitted to engage in all activities, except law and journalism, in the Netherlands. The Nazis apparently now have abandoned their original plans to refrain from cracking down too hard on the Jews to avoid irritating the population.

The new measures specify that no public institution henceforth may employ versons who are wholly or partly Jewish, it was reported. The same applies to the educational system. Provincial local councils have been instructed to send in lists of Jewish employes.

LA ROCQUE OPOSES CURBS ON ASSIMILATED JEWS IN FRANCE

VICHY, Oct. 7. (JTA) -- Complaints against the alleged "invasion" of certain professions by Jews were scored by Col. Francois de la Rocque, Franch rightist leader, in the first press comment on the proposed Jewish statute published in the newspaper Le Petit Journal today.

Col. de la Rocque demanded that "fully assimilated" Jews be not treated with discrimination since they belong to "one big family of citizens" and such discrimination would be "unconceivable." He advised Frenchmen to safeguard their positions "not by the way of legal requisition but by strenuous work."

Reasonable precautionary measures regarding future naturalization are not only practical but just to avoid overcroading in the liberal professions, he said.

While expressing approval of the recently-ordered naturalization revision, the rightist leader said that only those who have violated french laws and traditions should lose their citizenship. At the same time he urged abrogation of the Gremieux Law of 1870 which ordered wholesale naturalization of Algerian Jews.

2 Jewish Industrialists Interned

VICHY, Oct. 7. (JTA) -- Two prominent Jewish industrialists, Louis Weiller, head of the Gnome et Rhone Airplane and Motor Company, and Marcel Bloch, noted airplane manufacturer have been arrested and placed in a concentration camp at Pellevoisin, it was reported here today.

GERMAN-ITALIAN COLONY FOR JEWS PLANNED IN AFRICA

LONDON, Oct. 7. (JTA) Nazi circles admit that their attempt to establish a Jewish reservation in Lublin, Poland, has failed hopelessly and that the scheme has been jettisoned with the explanation that it is impossible to solve the Jewish problem while the war is under way the Daily Herald reports in a Stockholm dispatch.

The Nazi newspaper Die Morgenpost, published in Upper Silesia, was quoted as saying that Germany planned to solve the Jewish problem in Europe by expelling all Jews to Africa, where a special colony would be established under German-Italian supervision.

R. A. F. RENEWS RECRUITING IN PALESTINE

JERUSALEM, Oct. 7. (JTA) - Recruitment started today for additional volunteers between the ages of 18 and 41 for the Royal Air Force ground services. In an announcement yesterday, the R.A.F. Officer Commanding indicated that volunteers might also be used for air crews.

Although enlistment of Jews for the fighting units of the army has been completed the Jewish Agency yesterday called for additional volunteers to create a reserve for anticipated further recruitment.

MILITARY FUNERAL TODAY FOR GOV. HORNER

CHICAGO, Oct. 7. (JTA) -- A military funeral will be held Tuesday morning, with hundreds of persons from every walk of life attending, for Governor Henry Horner, who died at his home in suburban Minnetka early Sunday morning at the age of 61 after a long illness. Rabbi Louis I. Mann of Sinai Temple, the Governor's congregation, will conduct the service, assisted by a Catholic priest and Protestant minister. The body was lying in state today at a local armory.

Governor Horner will be buried beside his mother's grave in Mt. Mayriv Cemetery. He is survived by two brothers and four cousins. He was unmarried.

The Governor was the son of Solomon A. Levy and Dilah Horner Levy. He took his mother's maiden name when the parents separated in 1892. Born in Chicago, he was educated here and began the practice of law in 1898. He entered public life in 1914 when he was elected probate judge. After 18 years on the bench he ran for governor and won, despite the opposition of the strong Kelly-Nash machine. Anti-Semitism was one of the weapons used against him during the bitter campaign.

Governor Horner was active in Jewish affairs, being a leader of various Jewish philanthropic organizations and an honorary chairman of the Joint Distribution Committee. He was also active in legal organizations and was known for his deep interest in the life of Abraham Lincoln.

ROOSEVELT GETS BILL TO REGISTER "ISM" GROUPS; SENATE APROVES DEFENSE PROBE

WASHINGTON Oct. 7. (JTA) - Congress today took action on two measures designed to strengthen U.S. defenses against totalitarian influences.

The House took finel action on legislation which will compel the Communist Party and German-American Bund to register as agents of foreign governments. The House adopted a conference report previously appoved by the Senate and sent the measure to the White House.

In the Senate, a voice vote gave Senator Wheeler (Dem. Mont.) authority to launch an investigation of the extent of foreign domination of U.S. defense industries.

Although not mentioning the Bund or other groups by name, the registration measure adopted today is admittedly aimed in that direction. If approved by the President, it will require registration with the Justice Department of all organizations subject to foreign control with details as to officers, membership financing and activities.

Wheeler's investigation was inspired by reports that German control over certain industries through patent and security holdings was hampering defense activities and that profits acruing to Nazi ownership were going to finance propaganda and other subversive activities in this country.
