### BLUM MAY PLEAD OWN CASE IN WAR GUILT TRIAL; VICHY OUSTS 6 JEWISH OFFICIALS

VICH, Dec. 10. (JTA) -- Former Premier Leon Blum, leader of the Fopular Front government, intends to plead his own case in the war guilt trials opening in Rich next month, it was indicated today.

While ex-Premier Paul Reynaud, ex-Premier Edouard Daladier, ex-Interior Minister Georges Mandel and General Gustave Gamelin engaged prominent attorneys to defend them, Blum chose a little-known Paris Jewish lawyer of Russian origin named Semuel Spanien.

Meanwhile, it was announced that six "maitres de requete" of the Council of State were dismissed under the anti-Jewish statute of Oct. 18, which bars Jews from public service. They are Julien Reinach, Pierre Bloch-La Roque, Christian Valensi, Andre Helbronner, Michel Pontremoli and Jean Cahen-Salvador.

Reinach was appointed honorary State Councillor and the others were made honorary "maitres de requete." Bloch-La Roque also resigned as member of the Labor Ministry staff, together with another official of the Labor Ministry, Narcisse Netter.

## FASCIST ORGAN COMPLAINS OF ITALIANS! RESISTANCE TO ANTI-SEMITISM

ROME, Nov. 25. (JTA-Airmail) -- The continuing opposition to official anti-Semitism among the Italians is indicated by an article in Roberto Farinacci's newspaper; Il Regime Fascista, which denounces persons who refuse to mention the Jews in attributing blame for the war.

The article notes that residents of Milan mention "capitalism" and "plutocracy" in noon-hour discussions of the war, but hardly ever employ the word "Jews." It continues:

"There is no law against talking about Jews. When discussing the war with the populace, call bread bread, a dog a dog, a Jew a Jew...

"Well, it is possible to understand how the bourgeois, who owe their privileges to the French Revolution engineered by the Jews, find anti-Semitism inconvenient. They prefer not to speak of it. How much international, financial and Masonic complicity

#### CLINCHY SEES GROWING TOLERANCE AS ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES OF CENTURY

NEW YORK, Dec. 9. (JTA) -- Director Everett R. Clinchy reported to the semi-annual meeting of the National Conference of Christians and Jews executive committee last night that "good fellowship among Protestants, Catholics and Jews is slowly but markedly increasing in the United States" and hailed this development as "one of the most important social changes occurring in the twentieth century." Dr. Clinchy received the new title of president of the NCCJ.

National unity "achieved in hysteria" can "easily become a uniformity that penalizes the holding of an opinion at variance with popular opinion," Dr. Clinchy said. Prof. Arthur H. Compton, co-chairman of the National Conference, presided.

Dr. Clinchy asserted: "America needs solidarity among Protestants, Catholics and Jews for two purposes. First, to arouse citizens against the dangers of disunity invoked by the activities of individuals inciting hatred of particular religious and racial groups; second, to supply the spiritual power and vision adequate for the difficult social and economic problems in our own country which lie ahead."

Two women were elected to membership in the National Committee, the first time that women have been so honored. They are Mrs. Edward C. Bailly, New York prominent Catholic worker, and Mrs. Parker O. Griffith, Newark, N.J. It was also decided to establish a permanent Committee of the Motion Ficture Industry. J. Robert Rubin, vice-president of M-G-M was appointed chairman of this committee.

### ICKES RENEWS PLEA FOR VIRGIN ISLANDS REFUGEE HAVEN

NEW YORK, Dec. 10. (JTA) -- Secretary of Interior Harold L. Ickes renewed his plea for opening of Alaska and the Virgin Islands as refugee havens, speaking last night at a dinner for aid to anti-Fascist refugees in Europe sponsored by The Nation and The New Republic at the Hotel Commodore.

There are "thousends of men and women of intellectual achievement and democratic thought who are now in danger of the firing squad," Ickes said. "It is a simple matter to bring these men and women across the ocean to the various countries of the Western Hemisphere. It involves no more than a little money, visitors' permits and a helpful attitude on the part of the government.

"My own department is doing what lies within its power to open the way. We are urging that, under the proper safeguards, the "irgin Islands be made available to political refugees, without visas, without diplomatic formality. We are urging the hospitable reception of all for whom there may be room and that they be allowed to stey in the Virgin Islands as visitors until they are otherwise provided for.

The article brought into the open the long-undercurrent unpopularity of anti-Semitism and the Italians' coolness to the use of "international Jewry" as the explanation of war and all kindred evils.

#### Italy's Richest Jew Becomes "Aryanized"

ROME, Dec. 10. (JTA) -- Italy's wealthiest Jew, Senator Abraham Jacob Isaac Levi, has succeeded in obtaining Government certification that he is an "Aryan," it was learned today, under the section of the racial law of 1959 which makes it possible to obtain "Aryanization" by proving illegitimacy and showing that one's actual father was an "Aryan."

Persons who know Senator Levi find it difficult to understand his action since he is 77 years old, has no children who could benefit by his "Aryanization" and lives alone with his 70-year-old wife, whose maiden name is Cohen. They reside in his showplace palace in Rome which he is rumored to have offered to Premier Benito Mussolini as a residence at one time.

It is indicated that he will shortly be officially known as Senator Leva.

Levi has been a supporter and close friend of Il Duce since the early days of Fascism. His philanthropic work in the remks of Fascism brought him a senatorial nomination in 1935 on the Premier's recommendation. He was one of Italy's ten Jewish senators.

Born in Turin of foor parents, Levi built up his enormous fortune in shoes, clothing and department stores. He is considered one of the most important businessmen in Italy. At one time he omed most of the leading department stores in Italy, having obtained most of his business ideas through wide traveling, particularly in the United States. He is generally referred to as the "king of ready-made clothes" and is recognized as a leading figure in the development of several branches of Italy's industry. He is reputed to possess \$50,000,000.

### ASK JEWISH MINORITY REPRESENTATION IN CZECH COUNCIL

LONDON, Dec. 10. (JTA) -- In connection with the opening session of the Czechoslovak State Council, the National Council of Jews of Czechoslovakia issued a statement today expressing deep regret that no representatives of the Jewish minority had been included in the State Council. Stressing that the Jewish minority had participated for 20 years in the Republic's development and consolidation, the statement voiced hope that the claim of the national Jews for representation would be acceded to in the near future.

Two Jews were included in the council in a personal capacity. They are Dr. Julius Friedman, former head of the economic section of the Czech Foreign Ministry, and Dr. H.J. Stransky.

### U.S. PROVIDED 59% OF J.N.F. INCOME IN 1940

### GENERAL SENDS GIFT TO UNITED JEWISH APPEAL

NEW YORK, Dec.10. (JTA) -- Sending an unsolicited contribution to the United Jewish Appeal for Refugees and Oversees Needs, General W.H. Hodges Jr., of Elm Grove, La., declared that it was his "firm conviction that the world is now paying the penalty of its indifference to the persecution of Jews by Hitler and his kind," the U.J.A. revealed today.

General Hodges, who is now stationed at Camp Beauregard, Louisiana, said the movement to provide relief for the distressed should be supported by "all people of every race and creed in this free country."

#### COLORADO STOPS ASKING RELIGION OF JOB APPLICANTS

NEW YORK, Dec.10. (JTA) — The practice of requesting and recording applicants for employment as Catholics, Protestants and Jews has been discontinued by the Colorado State Employment Service, the Commission on Economic Problems of the American Jewish Congress reported today. The action followed negotiations by State Senator A.B. Hirschfeld of Denver, a member of the Governing Council of the Congress.

The Commission on Economic Problems is continuing its efforts to secure the elimination of the question of religion by state employment bureaus throughout the country, Chairman J.K. Cohen stated.

### Z.O.A. URGES EMPHASIS ON ZIONISM DURING CHANUKAH

WASHINGTON, Dec. 10. (JTA) — The Zionist Organization of America today urged that emphasis be placed on the Zionist cause during celebration of Chanukah. "Jewish pioneers who are valiantly defending their position in Palestine, which they have built with sacrifice and toil in the past two decades, are the true descendants of the Maccabeans of old," E.I. Kaufman, 20A president declared.

### 2 SPIES WHO ENTERED ENGLAND AS REFUGEES EXECUTED

LONDON, Dec. 10. (JTA) -- Two German spies who entered Britain disguised as refugees and were caught with a portable radio transmitter with which they intended to broadcast information to Germany were executed today at Pentonville Prison. They were Jose Waldberg, 25, and Karl Meier, 24-the first spies executed in Britain in this wer.

### CHIEF RABBI KISS DEAD IN BUDAPEST

BUDAPEST, Nov. 14. (JTA-By Meil) -- Chief Rabbi Arnold Kiss of the Buda Jewish Community died today in the Pester Chewra Kadischa hospital. Member of a noted rabbinical family of Nagybecskerek, southern Hungarian town now belonging to Yugoslavia, he was rabbian Zsolna and Veszprem and came to Budapest in 1900. He was for more than 40 years leader of the Jewish community of Buda, one of the two sections forming the capital city. He was known as a gifted speaker, poet and writer.
