#### 3,000 KILLED IN 6-MONTH ANTI-JEWISH 'BLITZKRIEG' IN RUMANIA

BUDMPEST, Jan. 7. (JTA) -- Rumania's so-called "Jewish problem" no longer exists. By New Year's all but a few scattered hundreds of Rumanian Jews had been reduced to pauperism in the most successful anti-Jewish Blitzkrieg the world has seen to date.

In the opinion of this correspondent, who has just returned from Bucharest, not even Germany can beast such a record as that attained by the Iron Guard in Rumenia-except possibly in occupied Poland, where the situation is not exactly comparable. Whereas the current plight of the Jews in Poland is mainly the result of military conquest, the plight of the Rumenian Jews, which is almost as bad, is the result of an internal comparing which began only six months ago.

Before the Soviet occupation of Bessare is created the need for a scapegoat—in order to save the face of the Rumanian Amy and, the Government which had ordered surrender of the province—the Rumania. Jewn were better off than the Jewn in many other European countries, not counting Humany. How, however, the Humanian Jewn may consider themselves lucky, despite all the restrictions to which they have been subjected; even the Jewn in Hitler's Germany have more security than their co-religionists in Rumania, where no central control yet exists to direct or limit the persecution of members of their rece.

The occupation of Bessarebia late in June was the signal for the July pogrous, in which hundreds of Jews were killed. These pogrous were followed by the enti-Semitic code of the Gigurth Government, a series of lews far harsher even than the Nuremberg laws in Germany.

Then came cession of Transylvania and more pogroms and arrests of Jews, even bankers and industrialists, on charges of "Communium." No sooner had this outbreak subsided than the Iron Guard seized power, custing King Carol, redoubling persecution of the Jews and organizing still more pogroms.

An estimated 3,000 Jews lost their lives between June 28, when Soviet Russic sent its ultimatum on Besserbis, and Jan. 1, 1941.

Meenwhile, the Jewish population of Rumania has been reduced to 175,000 or onequarter of the 700,000 living in the country when the Soviet seized Bessarabia. Approx-

imately 500,000 then became Soviet subjects and another 150,000 went to Hungary in the occupation of Northern Transylvenia last September. Since then at least 55,000 have fled to Bessarabia and 10,000 to Greece, Turkey and Palestine in an exodus which continues despite every obstacle and hardanto.

It may at first be difficult to conceive that Jewish doctors, lawers, businessmen and other bourgeois elements are voluntarily emigrating to Communist Russia along with poor artisms and peasants. But it is less difficult to understand this when co observes, as this correspondent has, the treatment to which Rumania's 175,000 remaining Jews have been subjected.

Recently, Iron Guard bands dug up the bodies of Jews and balf-Jews buried in a Christian consteuy in Bucharest and threw their bones on the municipal refuse dump. At the gateway to the Jewish consteuy they erected a cross and next to it the crossed bar insignia of the Iron Guard (signifying the cell windows through which Codreamu and other "martyrs" stared during their prison terms). Bemeath the insignia is displayed the following legend: "Even here you will not be forgiven."

In a country where hatred for a racial minority has been whipped up to such extremes, mass expropriation of Jewish businessmen, firing of Jewish employees and confiscation of Jewish wealth and property without regard to the economic consequences for the country no longer seem extremalinary.

TYPHOID IS ENDEMIC JEWISH DISEASE, " NAZIS SAY IN ISSUING WARSAW CHETTO RULES

BUDAFEST, Dac. 15. (JTA-By Mail) -- New traffic regulations for Warsaw street cars and busses are announced in the Warscheuer Zeitung, Nazi organ in Poland.

Street cars and busses marked "Aryans Only" may no longer stop to take on or discharge passengers in the Jewish reservations of the city. Street cars and busses marked "News Only" may no longer make any stops in the non-Jewish sections of the city.

Where it is necessary far street cars or busses of either category to stop on the heavily guarded boundaries of the Jewish reservations, special double platforms have been constructed, one for Jews and one for Centiles. Jewish street cars or busses must be emptied of Jewish as passengers before they emerge from a Jewish reservation into a non-Jewish district.

All these measures have been taken, the Warscheuer Zeitung explains, "to avoid any possible danger to the health of the non-Jewish population by coming in contact with Jews."

As the same newspaper recently explained, announcing the introduction of the special Jewish streetears and busses, Jews have been found by the Nazi authorities to be "typhus carriers." The disease, the paper added, has been found to be "endemic among members of the Jewish rece."

Jaws have been forbidden to enter the central post-office of Cracow, sprording to the Zeitung. The only post-office they will be permitted to enter in the future is Branch No. 14, in the suburb of Podgorse.

#### NRS TO PLAN FUTURE FINANCING AT CLEVELAND PARLEY

NEW YORK, Jen. 7. (JTA) -- Leaden's in refugee work will attend the semi-annual meeting of the Board of Directors of the National Refugee S wice on Jen. 18 and 19 in Cleveland. Board members and guests invited from the 750 local committees cooperating with the NRS will review the 1940 program and plan for 1941. The question of financing the 1941 services of the NRS, following dissolution of the United Jewish Appeal, is expected to be one of the most important problems facing the meeting.

# B'NAI B'RITH GIVES \$1,000 FOR GREEK WAR RELIEF

WASHINGTON, Jan. 7. (JTA) -- A contribution of \$1,000 to the Greek War Relief Association's appeal for civilian end to embattled Greece was announced today by President Henry Monsky of B'nai B'rith. Monsky reported that B'nai B'rita expended \$65,000 for war relief and refugee end in 1940.

# SYDNEY JEWS DONAT'S BUILDING TO ANZACS

SINKE, Dec. 6. (JTA-By Mail) -- The Jewish community of Sydney has presented, for the use of the Assac forces, a new Assac Suffet and Sir John Monash Recreation But at a cost of 15,000. In opening the buildings, Lord Wakeharst, the Governor, said that no happier thought could have been conceived than to link the new but with the neme of the greatest soldier Australia had yet produced.

The recreation knt contains a stage for concerts, a reading room and twelve showers, and will seat 1,000 men. The buffet, which is fitted with full kitchen equipment, will seat 250. More than 550,000 free meals have already been given.

## YIDDISH ELUCATION EXTENDED IN WHITE HUSSIA

STOCKHOLM, Dec. 25 (ITA-By Meil) -- The opening in 1941 of a Yiddish section at the Bialyatok Institute of Pedagogica has been decided upon by Ath Education Commissariat of the White Russian Soviet Republic, scorning to reports in the Soviet Yiddish press.

The network of Yiddish schools in the newly incorporated Western areas of the Republic has been considerably enlarged, it is stated in the reports, and the necessity of training more teachers to take charge of still more classes to be opened has become urgent.
