BRITAIN REPORTED AGREEING TO JEWISH APMY PROPOSAL; RECRUITING TO OPEN SCON

LONDON, Jan. 27. (J7A) - Negotiations between the British Government and the Jewish Agency for Palestine for formation of a Jewish any to serve in Palestine and elsewhere are expected to be successfully concluded soon, it was reliably learned today.

According to unconfirmed rumors, recruiting of 16,000 Jews in Palestine and 4,000 in Britain will be started as soon as the negotiations are consummated.

Zionist leaders have been seeking establishment of a Jewish legion since the cutbreak of the war. The force would be recruited principally among Palestine Jews and those in Allied countries, as well as in neutral countries, so far as compatible with local legislation.

Approximately 8,000 Palestine Jews are now serving in the British forces, including 1,500 in the Royal Air Force, 500 in infantry compenies, 1,600 in engineer, technical and transport corps, and more than 2,500 in the Auxiliary Military Pioneer Corps. Some are stationed in Egypt and Greece.

At the outbreak of the wer, the Jawish Agency held registration of Palestine Jews between the ages of 18 and 50 willing to offer their services for the Allied cause. More than 136,000 man and women volunteered.

Sir Norman Angell, the author, recently predicted that the British Government would accept the Jewish Agency's offer to establish an army 100,000 strong.

In the early days of the war the Government took an unfavorable attitude towards the proposal for a segarate Jewish force. On May 24, 1940, Capt. Authory Eder, then War Secretary, said: "In the upinion of His Majesty's Government the reising of separate Jewish formations would present difficulties and it would be of more advantage if Jewe who are emitions to serve would entils in His Majesty's force in the ordinary may."

One reason for former official opposition to the Jewish army plan it was learned, was that the Government did not desire to make any commitments to Zionist leaders in return for such assistance. Presumably this difficulty has been cleared away during the current nerotiations.

Seek to Strengthen Palestine Air Raid Precautions

TEL AVIV, Jan. 27. (JTA) -- Air Raids Precautions Week was opened here today by Mayor Israel Rokach. He told a press conference that the city so far has spent £25,000 for A.R.P. and that 6,000 persons were presently in service, but added that 30,000 more were urgently needed, especially for fire brigade purposes, since experience had shown that the enemy was using more incendiary bombs.

HOMES BURNED, BUCHAREST JEWS BEG FOR SHELTER

LONDON, Jan. 27. (JTA) -- Jewish survivors of the Iron Guard revolt in Bucharest in which hundreds were slain crept out of hiding places today in a desperate attempt to secure food, while others formed weeping queues asking for shelter because their homes had been destroyed by fire, according to reports from the Rumanian capital.

Many Jews tried to reach the mortuary in the hope of identifying relatives, said a Daily Mirror dispatch from Belgrade. The full truth of the anti-Jewish orgies will probably never be known, the correspondent said. Neked and mutilated bodies were still lying in the Moldavian forest.

. The Jewish quarter of Bucharest was described as "a smoldering wilderness of misery."

It was still barred by the military this morning.

Other Bucharest reports said 25 synagogues and temples had been destroyed in the Rumanian capital during the revolt.

BULGARIAN JEWS ORDERED TO REGISTER BY FEB. 23

POLISH BOOK RENEWS TALK OF JEWISH EMIGRATION

LONDON, Jan. 27. (JTA) -- Polish quarters are still talking of Jewish emigration from Polund, it appears from the newly-published book, "All About Poland," by Whitinger, private secretary of Fremfer Whadislas Sikoraki of the exiled Polish Government.

Devoting a special chapter to the Jewish problem, the author concludes that "the only solution of this burning question is that offered by emigration." Polish Jewish circles said this policy was incompatible with the Government's promise of Jewish equality in a restored Poland.

POLISH JEWISH RELIEF GROUP AIDS NON-JEWS

LONDON, Jan. 27. (JTA) -- The Council of Polish Jewry has received 22 bales of Colothing from the Federation of Polish Jews in Canada for distribution among refugees. On the suggestion of Ignacy Schwartzbert, part of the consignment will be turned over to the Polish Government's relief committee for distribution among Polish refugees, regardless of race or or seed, a second part to the fund for poor Polish Jewish refugees and the rest to the United Synapogue for distribution among air raid victims of all denominations.

HERZOG HERE, SEEKS \$1,000,000 TO ALD REFUGEE STUDENTS, PALESTINE YESHIVAS

NEW YORK, Jen. 27. (JTA) -- Chief Rabbi Issac Herzog of Palestine, arriving here today on the United States liner President Adams for a three-month visit, said he would seek \$1,000,000 from American Jews to bring 1,500 yeshiva students and 200 rabbis to Palestine from Europe and to assist 150 Palestine religious institutions.

In an interview with the JTA at the Hotel Waldorf-Astoria, Rabbi Herzog said he would visit principal cities of the United States in the campaign for American assistance. The Soviet Government has already promised transit for the immigrants and application has been made to the Pelestine Government for immigration certificates, he said.

"I expect that American Jewry will rise to the height of this historic emergency and will respond perhaps more than its wonted magnaminity," the Chief Rabbi said. Dr. Hersog left Palestine by air six weeks ago and embarked on the President Admas at Cape Town. He is accompanied by his wife. It is his first visit to the United States.

Discussing conditions in Palestine, he denounced the deportation of illegal immigrants to a British colony. This, he said, fills "the cup of our sorrow to overflowing." He asserted that "Palestine Jewny is not dismayed by the thick-gathering clouds which threat-med the Boly Lend. Our faith inspires us with ever renewed hope end that hope in turn reinvigorates our faith." The Jewish community's economic position is "increasingly difficult," he said.

PROF. YAHUDA, AT RECEPTION, DEFENDS BIBLE'S AUTHENTICITY

NEW YORK, Jam. 27. (JTA) -- The authenticity of the biblical version of history was defended tonight by Prof. Abraham S.E. Yahada, of London, who declared at a reception for him at the Temple Emanu-El Community House that "every new excavation has only confirmed the Bible and confused the critics."

Prof. Albert Einstein, in a message to the meeting, expressed the hope that "Yahuda's convincing arguments and lucid presentation will contribute to strengthen and to revive the influence of the moral contents of the Bible, the greatest creation of the people of Israel." Speakers at the reception included Rabbi Moses Hymmon, Prof. Fernando de los Rios, Rabbi William Rosenau, Prof. Chaim Tchnerowitz and Arbhur Meyerowitz.

Prof. Yehuda declared: "The close relationship which I discovered between Hebrew and Egyptian made it clear to me that the development and growth of Hebrew from a primitive Censanite dislect to a perfect literary language could only have taken place in a time and an environment when and where the Hebrews-lived in the most intimate contact with the Egyptians. This I illustrated by quoting a number of Egyptian lonwords and typically Egyptian pursases from the Fentateuch. Proofs were so cumulative, that the ecould be no doubt that the Fentateuch could not have been written at my other time than the time of the Exodus. This implies that the Hebrew language was a genuine creation of the Hebrews during their stey in Egypt, developed by them under the influence of the Egyptian language from the Cananite dislect which they spoke when they immigrated into Egypt, and that it was Mosse who brought Hebrew to that high degree of perfection in which the Pentateuch is written.

"I wish to point out that the esteblishment of this fact is of far-reaching importence. By spplying the combined method of comparative philology and archaeology, based
on the monuments excavated not only in Egypt but also in Palestine, Syria and Mesopotemia,
the antiquity of the Pentateuch, as well as the accuracy of the Biblical records can be
proved."
