ALLIED FORCES MOVE ON DAMASCUS AND BEIRUT: SURRENDER SEEN NEAR

CAIRO, June 10. (JTA)-- The Allied forces, advancing rapidly into Syria and Lebanon, today were reported to be within striking distance of Damascus and Beirut.

A communique issued by the British Middle East command here said: "The penetration of the Allied forces is proceeding satisfactorily and the general impression is that the Arab reaction to the arrival of our forces is favorable.

An officer of the Lebanese police who arrived in Palestine was quoted in Jerusalem reports as saying that if French officers and men continued to join the Allied forces at the rate maintained for the last two days, French High Commissioner Henri Dentz would be forced to surrender.

LONDON, June 10. (JTA)-- Stressing the importance of building zone airfields around Suez, the Evening Standard's military correspondent today proposed that "eager Palestinian volunteers" be put to the task. He expressed the opinion that at least two Pioneer divisions could be enrolled for the purpose.

THREE-QUARTERS OF ITALIAN JEWS JOBLESS AS RESULT OF FASCIST LEGISLATION

ROME, June 10. (JTA)-- The position of the Jews in Italy is becoming more and more uncertain and economic restrictions have been increased to such an extent that the position is becoming unbearable. Approximately 75 per cent of the Jews of Italy are now estimated to be out of employment as a direct consequence of anti-Semitic legislation.

Emigration of Jews is being encouraged by the Italian authorities and a number of facilities are granted for this purpose. They include the ready issue of passports to intending emigrants and the allotment of foreign exchange amounting to about \$500 to each person for travelling expenses. Difficulties of transport are, however, preventing many would-be emigrants from leaving the country.

From Milan comes the report that a number of women refugees in that city have been expelled to Germany, despite the fact that their husbands are in Italian concentration camps. No explanation has been advanced for this action, which is thought to have been the result of a misunderstanding.

PARIS JEWISH QUARTER TO BE DEMOLISHED

LONDON, June 10. (JTA)-- The Jewish-populated St. Paul's district of Paris will be demolished shortly, the Nazi-controlled Hilversum radio announced today. Other reports said Jewish businesses in Paris were obliged to display large yellow signs, "Jewish Business," which they were required to buy from the police for 2.50 francs each.

REFUGEES IN SWITZERLAND INVITED BACK TO GERMANY

ZURICH, June 10. (JTA)-- German consulates throughout Switzerland have issued an "invitation" to Jewish and non-Jewish refugees from Germany now in this country to register with the Nazi consular offices for repatriation, it was learned today. It is understood that the step was taken in connection with the shortage of labor in the Reich and that those returning would be used for compulsory labor.

There are approximately 6,500 refugees in Switzerland of whom more than 2,000 are supported by the Union of Jewish Communities. During 1940 approximately \$580,000 was spent by the Union for refugee aid, towards which the Joint Distribution Committee contributed about \$200,000.

Criticism of the Swiss Government for the treatment given interned refugees in Swiss labor camps is voiced in a number of Swiss newspapers. The Schweizer Republikanische Blaetter, demanding better pay for the working refugees, says that "when people are compelled to do a soldier's job, they must also be granted a soldier's maintenance."

Other newspapers demand that refugee students be released from labor camps to continue their studies. They point out it is especially unjust to deprive the students of the famous Yeshivah College in Montreux of their studies by sending them to labor camps as refugees at a time when Polish students are permitted freely to continue their studies in any of the Swiss higher schools.

The Federal court in Bern has rejected the appeal of Dr. Zander, editor of the suppressed Swiss Nazi publication, Schweizerdegens, who was in 1939 sentenced to 18 months' imprisonment for anti-Jewish propaganda. In approving the sentence of the lower court, the Federal Court declared that "the manner in which the publication of Dr. Zander carried its polemics against the Israelites does not justify any reference to freedom of speech and press. This does not mean that one cannot discuss the Jewish question in an objective way."

600 REFUGEES HELD AT DAKAR TO BE RELEASED.

VICHY, June 10. (JTA)-- More than 600 refugees, 150 of them Jewish, who have been stranded at the French West African port of Dakar since January, will be moved to Portuguese Guiana, from where they will be permitted to proceed to Lisbon, the Joint Distribution Committee learned here today.

The refugees have been held all this time aboard the 12,000-ton French steamer Alsina on which they sailed from Marseille for South America on Jan. 15. While the steamer was on the high seas, it received orders on Jan. 23 to put in at Dakar, the French authorities apparently fearing that the Alsina might be intercepted and seized by the British Navy.

About 50 of the Jewish refugees on the Alsina, upon reaching Lisbon, could immediately continue their voyage to South America on neutral steamers. The cost of continuing the voyage for the 50 would amount to over \$10,000 which the J.D.C. is being asked to supply through the HIAS-ICA.

JEWISH M.P. IN NAVY KILLED

LONDON, June 10. (JTA)-- Dudley Jack Barnato Joel, Conservative Member of Parliament, financier and sportsman, who was serving in the Royal Navy, is missing and presumed to have been killed, it was stated today. He was 37 years old.

DICKSTEIN BILL SEEKS PROBE OF ANTI-SEMITES' 'WARMONGER' CHARGES

WASHINGTON, June 10. (JTA)-- Rep. Samuel Dickstein (Dem., N.Y.) today introduced a resolution calling for appointment of a seven-man House committee to investigate charges of anti-Semites that Jews were attempting to push the United States into war, as a challenge to the authors of these accusations to produce proof.

In his resolution Dickstein said: "Statements were made on the floor of this House that little groups of 'international Jewish brethren are attempting to harass the President and the Congress of the United States into plunging us into the European war unprepared,' and it is in the interest of the people of the United States to determine the truth or the falsity of such charges. Such charges should be substantiated by competent legal proof and evidence."

In an interview later, Dickstein said his challenge was particularly levelled at Senator Burton K. Wheeler and Rep. John A. Rankin. Last Wednesday Rankin made an attack on Jews on the House floor which provoked a reply from Rep. M. Michael Edelstein that was followed by the latter's death of a heart attack.

Introducing his resolution, Dickstein declared on the House floor: "In the last several years charges have been made on the floor of Congress by members--and outside of Congress by certain groups--charging that People of the Jewish faith are warmongers, seeking to bring this country into war. Similar charges were made in Congress, in which it was charged that Jewish bankers or 'international Jewish brethren are attempting to harass the President of the United States and the Congress of the United States into entering the European war.'

"Others on the floor have made similar charges, to the effect that certain Jewish international bankers are responsible for present conditions. These charges, in my opinion, are of a serious nature, not only from the standpoint of condemning a race of people of American birth, but also affecting the interest of our country in this particular time when we are trying to strive as a unit for the protection and defense of the United States."

"If these facts are not true and certain groups are using the Jewish minority as a scapegoat by accusing certain racial groups in this country, the country and the American people should know, if it wishes to continue unity and tolerance in this country."

CHIPKIN NAMED HEAD OF SOCIAL WELFARE GROUP

ATLANTIC CITY, June 10. (JTA)-- Israel S. Chipkin, associate director of the New York Jewish Education Committee, was elected president of the National Conference of Jewish Social Welfare at the closing session of its annual meeting yesterday. He succeeds Dr. Maurice Taylor, Pittsburgh.

Other officers elected are Louis Kraft, New York, and Joseph E. Beck, Philadelphia, vice-presidents; Harold Silver, Detroit, treasurer, and Marcel Kovarsky, New York, secretary.

Resolutions were adopted expressing admiration for philanthropic institutions and social workers continuing to serve Jewish communities in Nazi-dominated areas "in the face of seemingly insuperable difficulties" and voicing "earnest hope that the Holy Land be spared the horrors of violence and war."

J.N.F. APPEALS FOR LAND-BUYING IN "PALESTINE VICTORY CAMPAIGN"

LONDON, June 10. (JTA)-- Stressing that "your brethren in the citadel of Palestine are calling for land," the Jewish National Fund today issued an appeal for support of its "Palestine Victory Campaign" in Britain, which opens on June 13.

"Palestine's courageous defenders ask you to give your share of land," the statement said, "for food is the ammunition of war. Land for development of soldiers of Israel! Land for settlement of Hitler's victims! Land for homes for post-war European Jewry! Land for war--to organize Palestine defense! Land for peace--to await the homeless!"

The Palestine Jews "will fight to the death" in defense of the country, the appeal asserted, "but in the midst of preparing for war, the Yishuv does not stand still. Like the valiant people of Britain, their watchword is 'Carry on!' They are tilling fields, working in factories, preparing for war but laboring for peace, for they have faith in victory."

"The men and women of Palestine are prepared to write another imperishable page in the scrolls of Jewish history," the appeal concluded. "Will you give them courage to sustain them in the great struggle which lies ahead of them? Will you show how deep is your faith in victory?"

A message received from the Zionist Organization and Jewish Agency executives in Jerusalem said: "The approach of war merely enhances the significance of land's guarantee of the national future. Demonstrate your faith in the solidarity of the Yishuv by giving the utmost support to the Keren Kayemeth, precisely at this hour."

NAZIS REPORTED DRAFTING JEWISH BOYS FOR MUNITIONS WORK

LONDON, June 10. (JTA)-- The German authorities have issued a decree closing Jewish schools for boys over 12 years of age and ordering the pupils to work in munitions factories, the Daily Express reported today. In addition, Jews of both sexes up to the age of 50 have been assigned to various jobs, paid two-thirds of the normal "Aryan's" wage for the same work the report said.

In view of the housing problem that has arisen in Vienna, Jews are forced to leave their homes and live 20 and 30 to a small flat to make room for German workers accompanying aircraft and other factories, which are constantly transferred from bombed Western Germany to Austria.

U.P.A. GIVES \$25,000 FOR AID TO 'OLD YISHUV'

NEW YORK, June 10. (JTA)-- The United Palestine Appeal has allocated \$25,000 to be used for relief purposes in the Old Yishuv at the discretion of Chief Rabbi Isaac Herzog, it was announced today by Dr. Abba Hillel Silver, UPA Chairman. Rabbi Herzog will distribute the funds in Jerusalem and elsewhere to alleviate the effects of unemployment due to the war and other conditions.

500 REFUGEES IN RHODES APPEAL FOR AID

LISEON, June 10. (JTA)-- Urgent appeals describing the critical position of more than 500 Jewish refugees stranded on the Italian-controlled island of Rhodes for almost a year have been received here. The refugees were said to be desperate and threatening to try to reach some asylum in small boats. Efforts were being made to find some means of relief for the refugees. All attempts so far to arrange their departure have failed.
