SEVERAL JEWS KILLED AS TEL AVIV IS BOMBED; NEW HAIFA RAID

JERUSALEM, June 12. (JTA)-- Enemy airplanes early today raided Tel Aviv, largest city in Palestine with a population of 200,000. Six Jews were killed and 17 were wounded, according to first reports. It was the first bombing of Tel Aviv since the Italian raid last Sept. 9 in which 121 persons were killed.

Today's raid found the modern Mediterranean coastal city in the process of intensifying its precautionary measures against attack from the skies. The Government has voted funds for construction of concrete underground shelters and the municipality has announced plans to build 100 new shelters. Hospital and fire-fighting services are also being expanded.

Haifa suffered a four-and-a-half-hour raid. There were two casualties and small property damage.

A British military spokesman declared satisfactory progress was being made in the Allied drive in Syria. He said resistance was scattered and sporadic. Some French officers, realizing the mistake of following Vichy's orders because of personal loyalty to Marshal Petain, no longer are ordering their troops to resist, the spokesman said.

He praised the Transjordan Frontier Force for taking the large burden of patrolling the Yarmouk River on the right flank of the advancing forces. He reported that the Royal Air Force had attacked Palmyra, scoring direct hits on airplane hangers. Railway traffic between Transjordan and Syria has been suspended.

Meanwhile, an eyewitness returned from Baghdad reported that British troops recaptured several truckloads of goods looted from Jews and restored them to the owners. The informant said that, entering Baghdad with the British, he saw looted Jewish goods piled up on Rashid Street and adjoining streets after a mob had attacked the Jewish quarter during the interregnum between the flight of Rashid Ali Beg Gailani and the Regent's re-entry.

Palestine Enlistments Continue

LONDON, June 12. (JTA)-- A steady flow of Palestinian enlistments into units of the British army and Royal Air Force is being maintained, War Undersecretary Richard K. Law, declared in Commons, replying to a question as to the progress of recruiting. Recruiting for the Palestinian company of Pioneer Corps is also satisfactory, he said.

No Jews of non-Palestinian citizenship, however, are being recruited, according to a statement by Colonial Undersecretary George H. Hall in reply to another question. He said the High Commissioner was empowered to accept the services of any Palestinian citizens, irrespective of race, desiring to join the volunteer force.

"The strength of the forces will be determined from time to time by the High Commissioner, in accordance with the military requirements of the situation," he added.

War Secretary David Margesson promised Sir George Jones examination of a request by the Jewish Soldiers' Welfare Committee to provide teachers for numerous Jewish soldiers in Palestine anxious to learn English, in the interest of military efficiency and good personal relations with their superiors and comrades.

Hall announced that the High Commissioner was being asked to report on the Palestine labor situation and said he had no information such as stated by David Adams, who called attention to complaints that Palestine agricultural production was being curtailed because of a growing labor shortage. Adams asked for additional immigration certificates for skilled workers, declaring they were essential for the war effort and to relieve the seriousness of the situation.

Careful preparations made on the Palestine frontier before the Allied entry into Syria are described by a special correspondent of the Daily Mail who travelled from the coastal column across northern Palestine to join the forces advancing towards Damascus.

"I met sunburnt women in shorts and children evacuated from the outermost Jewish settlements along the frontier in Hanita and Kfar Giladi," the correspondent said. "Here, behind stockades and sandbags, tough pioneer menfolk of the self-contained agricultural colonies had been standing since Saturday night, prepared for any emergency."

The correspondent revealed that innumerable newly-constructed strong points and three forts had to be taken directly north of the Jewish colony of Metullah.

POLISH COUNCIL BACKS SIKORSKI'S STATEMENT ON JEWISH QUESTION

LONDON, June 12. (JTA)-- Premier Wladislaw Sikorski's declaration on the Jewish question while in the United States was endorsed in a motion passed at today's meeting of the Polish National Council. The motion said:

"The Government of the Polish Republic shares the principles expressed by the Prime Minister in the United States concerning the Polish Government's policy towards the Jews and associates itself with his statement on this matter to the National Council on June 4, which reads:

"In accordance with the sincerely democratic policy of the Polish Government, the principle of equal duties and equal rights will be binding for all citizens of the Polish Republic, irrespective of nationality, race and faith. That is the attitude of the Polish Government, which considers any pursuence of an anti-Semitic policy as detrimental."

SOUTH AFRICAN MINISTER HITS ANTI-SEMITISM

JOHANNESBURG, June 12. (JTA)-- Finance Minister J. H. Hofmeyr declared at a dinner last night that "if anti-Semitism ever became the declared policy of South Africa, I would hang my head in unmitigated shame."

Chief Rabbi Isaac Herzog of Palestine has arrived here en route to Jerusalem from the United States.

JEWISH PRAYERS USED IN WESTMINSTER ABBEY; GREAT SYNAGOGUE RAZED

LONDON, June 12. (JTA)-- Chief Rabbi J. H. Hertz's prayers were used with slight adaptations in Westminster Abbey, Dean Paul Delabilliere revealed today in a letter expressing thanks for Dr. Hertz's message of sympathy on the bombing of Westminster.

Dr. Hertz's letter disclosed that the 250-year-old Great Synagogue on Duke's Place had been completely destroyed in a recent raid. The Central Synagogue was also destroyed.

Synagogues recently damaged include the Borough, Dalston, Hackney, East London, New West End, Bethnal Green Philpott Street and Sidney Street. Many commercial buildings in the Hounds Ditch and Osborne Street areas were destroyed.

The pianist Myra Hess is created Dame Commander of the Order of the British Empire in King George's birthday honors list. Miss Hess has won widespread admiration for the National Gallery concerts she has been conducting since the beginning of the war, which were moved into an underground shelter when the most severe stage of the Blitzkrieg started.

Meanwhile, the Daily Mail reports that farmers on the Isle of Man have shown hostility to Mosley Fascists arriving for internment. Though their need for extra labor is great, the farmers' dislike of the hundreds of Fascists who are now detained in the island is greater. When the Fascists have appeared on the streets they have been booed by onlookers.

"We look upon these men as traitors to the Empire," one of the farmers is reported to have said. "I would rather work till I drop than have one of them about my land."

PLAN EMIGRATION OF GROUP OF CZECH JEWS TO TANGIER

ZURICH, June 12. (JTA)-- A number of Jews in the Protectorate will proceed soon to Tangier as result of a new arrangement reached with the authorities there, it was reported here today. They will be transported in sealed German trains to Madrid from where they will be taken by the Iberian airline to Teuten.

Reports from Bratislava declare the Slovakian authorities have issued an order requiring Jewish homes in the country to subscribe to Vestnik, weekly Jewish newspaper published in Bratislava under Slovak control.

Slovak newspapers are openly expressing dissatisfaction with the handing over of Jewish firms to Germans arrived from Bukovina and Bessarabia. The Slovak press asserts "Aryanisation" of Jewish commercial enterprises was proclaimed with a view to having them pass into Slovak hands, not into German.

A report published by the Bratislava Jewish community reveals that over ninety per cent of the total income of about 10,000,000 kronen obtained in 1940 by the central relief committee in Slovakia was secured through the Joint Distribution Committee clearance. More than fifty per cent of the expenditures were for direct relief. In addition, two major refugee camps required approximately 3,000,000 kronen. The report states that a total of 53,062 adults and 23,082 children were registered with the 63 local branches of the central committee. It adds that about 7,500 Jewish refugees were supported by the Bratislava committee in 1940.

ILLINOIS LEGISLATURE PASSES BILL TO BAR ALIENS FROM 14 FIELDS

SPRINGFIELD, Ill., June 12. (JTA)-- The State Senate, by a vote of 34 to 11, yesterday adopted and sent to Governor Dwight Green a bill, previously passed by the House, barring aliens from 14 professions and occupations. The measure would prohibit issuance of licenses to practice even to refugee professionals who have filed declarations of intention to adopt American citizenship.

In a vigorous fight against the bill, Senator A. L. Morowitz warned: "If the bill is passed, the democratic system in Lincoln's state is endangered because that's the way they started in Germany. Legislating against the refugee, representative of the groups who made America a free country, is criminal."

An amendment to free eminent European physicians from the restrictions was defeated. The bill was supported by the American Legion and several other organizations.

STATEMENT HITTING RANKIN SPEECH READ INTO CONGRESS RECORD

WASHINGTON, June 12. (JTA)-- A statement issued by the Citizenship Educational Service, coordinating body of 24 national patriotic, religious and welfare organizations, declaring that Rep. Rankin's anti-Jewish attack "is something that should never be permitted to happen again in a land which prides itself on its democracy," was inserted in the Congressional Record today at the request of Rep. M. J. Kennedy (Dem., N.Y.), who urged that it be read by every member of the House.

ILGWU OFFICIAL JOINS THE DAY

NAZIS "PROVE" PRESIDENT AND MRS. ROOSEVELT OF JEWISH DESCENT

ZURICH, June 12. (JTA)-- A so-called "scientific investigation" into the ancestry of President Roosevelt and of Mrs. Roosevelt, published in the entire German press, "proves" that both of them are of Jewish descent.

The article, which was originally published in the National Socialist Party Correspondence, states that "experts" who examined the genealogical tree of the Roosevelt family discovered that the President's progenitor was one Claus van Martensen, who immigrated to New York (then New Amsterdam) in 1649 and married a Jewess named Janet J. Samuels (alias Thomas). The mother of the President is also stated to be a Jewess, being the descendant of an Italian Jewish family "de Illen."

Mrs. Roosevelt is alleged to be a daughter of "the Jewess Rebecca Hall."

The "scientific investigation" proceeds, with typical German thoroughness, to prove its case twice over by showing that the Roosevelt family, having reached New Amsterdam in 1649 and being descended from the van Martensens, also reached New Amsterdam in 1621 and was descended from a Spanish Jewish family named Rossocampo. The task of reconciling these two statements is not attempted.
