### THOUSANDS OF JEWS AMONG CIVILIANS KILLED IN NAZI-SOVIET WAR; 500 EXECUTED IN LUBLIN

STOCKHOLM, July 9 (JTA) -- Not less then 500,000 civiliens, including many thousands of Jews, have been killed during the first 17 days of Maxi-Soviet war, it was estimated here today by Axel Bergengren, correspondent of the Swedish newspaper Aftonbladet, in a report which he wired from the German-Soviet front.

Accompanying the German General Staff, this correspondent describes how dosens of towns and villages have been completely wiped out by the fire of German and Soviet artillery. The Jewish-populated cities Pinsk and Baranovics are entirely demolished, the correspondent reports. Tens of thousands of homeless victims fill the woods end the fields, including thousands of children who have lost their parents. They are without food and will not be able to find any shelter for many days to come.

The German and the Soviet armies, the correspondent continues, are not providing any aid to the unfortunate civilians. No medical aid is given even to the wounded.

The Moscow radio heard here last night reported that 500 women and children, majority of them Jewish, were executed in Lublin publicly by the Mexis in retaliation for alleged sabotage. The victims were, according to Moscow, rounded up in their homes and led to the Lublin public market where they were machine-gunned by German soldiers. Renewed mass-executions which resemble those of the early days of Mezi occupation are also reported from the Wersaw district.

Official German information which reached Stockholm today reveals that in addition to expelling all Jews from the territory on the left bank of the Vistula River in the Warsaw district, the Wazi authorities have also expelled the entire Jewish population from the Warsaw suburbs Zolyborss, Mokotow, Czerniakow and Sielce.

## PALESTINE ORANGES USED FOR WAR INDUSTRIES

LONDON. July 9, (JTA) -- The citrus crop in Palestine is now being utilized for various acids needed in connection with the war industry, Colonial Under-secretary Hall disclosed in the House of Commons today.

Hall reiterated that the Palestine Government had guaranteed L517,000 in advances to citrus growers over two years and that the British Government was prepared to give financial assistance if Palestine's resources were insufficient to meet liabilities.

General Wauchope, former High Commissioner of Palestine, today sent a message to the Jewish Mational Fund in London in connection with the laumening of its Victory Campaign for Palestine. "I wish all the good fortune to the Jews of Palestine who range themselves alongside the British forces to repel and defeat the Mazi hordes", the message read.

#### PALESTINE GOVERNMENT PREPARES LAW AGAINST STRIKES, LOCKOUTS

JERUSALEM, July 9, (JTA) -- A new labor ordinance similar to the one in England, aiming to prevent interruption and disturbances of industry especially of those connected with war efforts, will soon be promulgated by the Palestine government under the Emergency Law, it was announced here today.

The ordinance as drafted prohibits strikes and lockouts in Palestine except in cases where the Palestine government decides not to intervene. Offenders will be punished in the case of lockouts by a maximum of \$500 or three months imprisonment or both. Strikers will similarly be subjected to severe penalties.

Labor disputes in which the Palestine government will decide to intervene are to be adjusted by an arbitration committee, consisting of three members, including the chairman, appointed by the High Commissioner. In addition, employers and employees are each to be represented by one or two members on the committee. The decision of the Arbitration Committee is to be enforced without any appeal.

### JUSTICE DEPARTMENT TO LAUNCH NATIONWIDE CITIZENSHIP PROJECT

MASHINGTON, July 9, (JTA) -- A nationwide educational campaign financed by \$14,000,000 in WFA funds, designed to prepare aliens in America for the rights and duties of citisenship, was announced today by the Immigration and Naturalization service of the Justice Department.

A Mational Advisory Council of four members from the Justice department and the WPA and one member at large who will act as chairman will supervise the project.

"The program", the Justice department said, "will supplement and amplify citizenship educational projects now in operation in most states and will set up similar projects in states where such facilities are not yet available. The Program contemplates particular emphasis on citizenship education in areas where a heavy alien population indicates special need, by making use of the immigration and naturalization service field organisation and material from the Alien Registration Division".

### INDEPENDENT JEWISH STATE IN PALESTINE URGED BY MANCHESTER GUARDIAN

LONDON, July 9, (JTA) -- Criticism of the British Government for its failure to make adequate military use of the Jews in Palestine was expressed today by the Manchester Guardian, leading liberal English newspaper, in an editorial dealing with the British policy in Palestine.

Pointing out that it is not the fault of the Jews that no greater war use is made of them in Palestine, the editorial says: "It is a mistake to be always talking as though only Arabs must be considered although undoubtedly the attachment of the Jews to the British side cam always be assumed. If we raise the Arab question in connection with Syria as Minister Anthony Eden did, them we must remember that Palestine lies in the very heart of this problem. We settlement of the problem is conceivable which would not include the establishment of what Chief Rabbi Hertz called a Jewish Mational Home in a free Palestine where there will be no domination of Arab over Jew over Arab - An independent Jewish state is compatible with a Federation of Arab countries

#### PLANES BOMRING HATFA IDENTIFIED AS FRENCH

HAIFA, July 9, (JTA) -- The enemy planes which attacked Haifa this week from the air causing great damage were established to be French, it was reported here today.

While the Haifa air raid lasted over two hours, a two hour alarm was sounded in Tel Aviv also. Jerusalem had an air raid alarm lasting for fifteen minutes.

Following the bombardment of Haifs, a delagation representing the Jewish Soldiers Welfare Committee visited the Jewish training comps in Haifa and voiced the pride of the Yishub in the men. The delegation headed by Mrs. Edwin Samuel and Dr. Soloveitchik presented the camps with wireless sets, as gifts of the committee. The steadfastness of the Jewish trainees was emphasized to the delegation by the British officers in command of the camps.

#### PALESTINE JEWS PERMITTED TO SEND FUNDS TO SUFFERING RELATIVES IN IRAQ

JERUSALEA, July 9, (JTA) -- Despite the prevailing currency regulations, which prohibit the transfer of capital from Palestine to other countries, the Palestine government today permitted the sending of money by Palestine Jews to relatives in Iraq, victims of the recent pogrou in Bagdad who are in need of assistance.

A maximum of L100 yearly may be sent by individuals to such relatives, providing that local Jewish institutions certify to the need.

#### VICHY THREATENS JEWS WITH SPECIAL CONCENTRATION CAMP

VICHY, July 9, (JTA) -- Jews in occupied France were officially informed today that even if Franch born, they will be sent to special Jewish concentration camps, if found guilty of violating the new anti-Jewish decrees, recently issued by the Vichy government.

This warning came in the form of an official decree which empowers the Prefect of Folice in every community to decide whether the statutes have been violated. A penalty of imprisonment in a concentration camp of from six months to two years and a fine of five hundred to ten thousand francs, either or both, is to be imposed on such offenders.

The new anti-Jewish decrees, to which the warning has reference to, limits the occupations and general economic life to which the Jew is to be circumscribed. The decree bars the Jews from all public office, going into great details to include such posts as Head of the State, Order of the Legion of Honor, Ambassadors of France, down to functionaries of "all grades and officials of the police." Included in "the exercise of public functions" from which Jews are barred is also the teaching profession. Jews must not be engaged to teach in any Franch schools.

Within this category of "public service" however, some exceptions are made. The restrictions are not to apply in the following cases: 1. The holder of a Soldier's Gard. 2. Any Jew oited during the course of the campaign of 1959-40, entitled to wear the Croix de Guerre. 5. Any Jewish recipient of the Legion of Honor or the Military Madel for heroism in war. 4. Jewish widow or orphan or descendant of soldiers who died for France.

### CAMPAIGN AGAINST SENDING FOOD PARCELS TO RELATIVES IN MAZI-HELD TERRITORIES

MEM YORK, July 9, (JTA) -- A drive "to end the food package racket" and prevent the "feeding of Hitler's war mechine" by sending food parcels to relatives in Nasi-held territories was announced here today by the Joint Boycott Council of the American Jewish Congress and the Jewish Labor Committee.

In announcing this drive, Dr. Josef Tenenbeum, chairman of the Council, declared that white German firms which formerly solicited orders for the delivery of food parcels to the Third Beich have been forced to halt by the President's proclamation freezing Mazi funds in talk country, certain organizations and companies continue to ship food parcels to German-occupied Poland and other European territories under Hitler's control.

"The Council has definite information that food packages shipped so far to Poland have been rifled of their contents by the occupying military authorities", Dr. Tenanbaum said. "We are in possession of letters from those who received parcels originally containing butter, egg products, and cereals, the letters stating: 'I received your gift of a little tea. Thank you wery much.' Some packages were stuffed with paper, and little else, when they arrived at their destination.

"The food goes to feed Hitler's armies and Gestapo agents, while the money goes by an indirect route to pay Hitler's expenses outside Europe. The firms engaged in this traffic, whether in the hope of alleviating the misery into which Nasian has plunged the European continent, or out of the desire for profit, will be forced by an informed public opinion to cease their unwitting aid to the Hitler juggernaut."

## DR. DAVID JOCHELMAN, NOTED JEWISH LEADER, DEAD

LONDON, July 9, (JTA) - Dr. David Joshelmen, prominent Jowish leader, who was closely associated with the late Israel Zengwill in the Jewish Territorialist movement, died today at his home in Reading. He was 75 years old.

The deceased was chairmen of the Federation of Jewish Relief Organizations in England of which he was also the founder. Though his health condition was poor since 1915, he remained active in Jewish 11fe. In 1919, during the Jewish massacres in the Ukraine, he organized a huge and impressive street perede in London professing against the Petlura and Demikin regimes which were responsible for carrying out the pogroms. In 1920 he held a conference with Maxim Litwinow in Copenhegen which was considered as laying the foundation for the settlement of declassed Jews in Seviet Russia on the land. Later, despite failing health, he made a special trip to Moscow to negotiate an arrangement which enabled the Federation of the Jewish Relief Organizations in London to send assistance to Jews in Seviet Russia.
