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GESTAPO IS AUTHORIZED TO DEAL WITH JEWS IN THE UKRAINE "AS SEEN FIT"; POGROMS PREDICTED

STOCKHOLM, Aug. 5. (JTA) -- Complete authority "to deal with the Jews in the Ukraine as seen fit" was given today by the Gestape to its Falestine-born official, the notorious Eichmann, who was last week appointed head of the Gestape department on Jewish effairs in Berlin, after "successfully solving the Jewish problem in Vienna."

Reporting the unlimited powers over the Jews in the Nazi-occupied part of the Ukraine given to Bichmann, correspondents of Swedish newspapers, in their dispatches today from Berlin, predicted that messacres of Jews are to be expected soon in the Ukraine, in addition to the severe enti-Jewish measures which Eichmann will impose.

Substantiating the gloomy predictions of the Swedish correspondents was a radio broadcast in Russian from the Belgrade radio, with the appearant intention of reaching listeners in Soviet Russia. "Everything is moving now towards the final settlement of accounts with the Jews," the broadcaster seid. "Jews will be massacred without exceptions. From the very beginning of their struggle the German people had declared war against the Jews - this Kolkhoz of liers which enslaved the whole world."

The Belgrade radio then went on to declare that the Eritish promises to aid Soviet Russia will never materialize. A similar broadcast was heard here last night from Rome. The broadcast, given in Serbian, indicated that Italy is rather worried over the sabotage and the pertisan fights which are going on in Yugoslavie. It warned the Serbians not to permit themselves "to be misled by Jews, by Britain and by Communists."

ENTIRE JEWISH MALE POPULATION IN RUMANIA ORDERED FOR WORK ON SOVIET FRONT

GENEVA, Aug. 5. (JTA) -- 2,500 Bucherest Jews were suddenly rounded up in their homes lest night by the police who took them out of bed and ordered them to dress in working clothes. They were then led to the railwey station and sent for forced labor into the "liberated mone" on the very battlefront in Bessarabia.

Simultaneously instructions were broadcast today over the Bucharest radio ordering all Jewish adults to hold themselves in readiness for departure, on short notice, to the front lines for forced labor under the very fire of the Soviet guns. At the same time the Rumanian press, led by the organ of Framier Autonesou started a renswed campaign demanding stricter measures against Jews in Rumania

CHECK ON NAZI TERROR AGAINST JEWS IN NORWAY IS ORDERED

STOCKHOLM, Aug. 5. (JTA) -- Masi terror against Jews has reached a point where the German occupational authorities have found it necessary to issue an order prohibiting "individual action with regard to the Jewish population, it is reported in the Swedish press today. The "individual action" of which the Masi order speaks consisted of invading Jewish homes, smeahing windows of Jewish stores, molesting Jews on the street and robbing Jewish property. Elaborate anti-Jewish laws exist in Norway as in the other occupied countries, despite the fact that there are only 1559 Jews in the whole of Norway.

PORTUGAL WILL CONTINUE TO ALLOW TRANSIT OF REFUGEES, GOVERNMENT ASSURES

LISEON, Aug. 5. (JTA) -- Portugal will continue to maintain a "liberal and humane" attitude toward refugees and will continue to permit their transit, the Portuguese Foreign Office today assured Dr. Gustav Kullman, League of Nations' Assistant High Commissioner for Refugees. Dr. Kullman is here investigating the future refugee situation in light of the new Washington regulations berring immigration of aliens with kin remaining in Next-occuried countries.

Although stressing the fact that Fortugal must be considered solely a country of trensit the Foreign Office and police officials assured Dr. Kullman that they welcomed the activities of the voluntary refugee relief organizations here.

Dr. Kullman, who is flying to London tomorrow, conferred extensively not only with the Portuguese authorities but also with the American end other embassies and with representatives of American refugee relief organizations. He declared that the results from these interviews were "very satisfactory."

At a conference of American relief groups held here under the chairmenship of Dr. Joseph Schwarts of the Joint Distribution Committee, Dr. Kullman outlined the activities and plans of both the Lesgue's Bigh Commission for Refugees end the Inter-Governmental Committee, and discussed specific problems which have recently erisem. The representatives of the various relief agencies thanked him for his visit and expressed their appreciation of the activities of the High Commissioner's office.

As part of his investigation, Dr. Kullman, accompanied by Dr. Sebwartz, visited Cladas Darainha and conversed with the ninety-three refugees jailed there last week when their residence permits for Portugal expired.

SLOVAKIAN PRESIDENT IS ASKED TO ORDER "A FINAL SETTLEMENT" WITH JEMS

BUDAPEST, Aug. 5. (JTA)-Slovakian soldiers fighting on the Soviet front under Mazi military command addressed themselved by telegrem to Dr. Joseph Tiso, President of Slovakia, demanding that the Jews in the Mazi puppet-state be annihilated, it is reported today in the Grenzbote, a Mazi paper published in Bratislava, capital of Slovakia.

"Please order a final settlement with the Jews in Slovakia," the telegrem is quoted as reading. The message to the Slovakian President is signed "your soldiers."

Meanwhile the Jews conscripted in Slovakia for forced lator have been ordered by the Hlinks guards to work on Saturdays. The majority of the Jews in Slovakia are extremely orthodox, and the new order is therefore a great blow to Slovakian Jewry. In addition to forcing them to work on the Sabbath day, the Hlinks guards who are acting as supervisors over the Jewish labor corps, ennounced that only the poor Jewish laborers will be fed and only during working hours, while those Jews who will be classified as being able to pay for food will have to provide their own.

LEEDS UNIVERSITY TO BECOME CENTER OF JEWISH EDUCATION

LONDON, Aug. 5. (JTA) -- Dr. Simon Rawidowics, refugee scholar and former librarian of the Jawish Community in Berlin, who has recently been appointed to the newly-created cheir of Hebrew at Leeds University, today stated that Leeds will become a training center for Hebrew scholars. Such a center, said Dr. Rawidowics, will fill an important gap in Jawish education and alleviate the great shortage of teachers of Hebrew and Jawish history. The first lectures by Dr. Rawidowics will be given in September on the subject of encient and modern Hebrew and on Jawish history and philosophy.

ARAB ATTITUDE ON JEWISH FUTURE IN PALESTINE HINGES ON OUTCOME OF RUSSO-GERMAN WAR

JERUSALEM, Aug. 5. (JTA) -- The attitude of the Arab would toward the position of the Jews in a post-war Palestine hinges on the outcome of the Russo-German war, it became clear here today when it was established that Arab leaders in Palestine have adopted a policy of "watchful waiting" until the developments on the Busso-German front become more crystallized.

As the situation stands today, uncertainty and bewilderment exists among the Arabs in Iraq, Syria, Palestine and Transjordan, as their leaders waver between Allied promises and Axis propagenda. Despite British and De Gaullist pronouncements that Syrian leaders and the tribal shieks are rallying to the Allied cause and despite Britain's promise to live up to her pledge of Syrian independence, Axis agents continue to exploit this political uncertainty on the part of the Arabs in the Mear East.

Broadcasts in Arabic emanating from Radio Rome continue, almost daily, to reiterate the impossibility of creeting a pan-Arab federation while a Jewish Mational Home exists in Palestine. Axis circles are also circulating stories that "Syria, Lebanon and Iraq are to be added to the Jewish National Home as a result of Weizmann's successful intriguing in London." Although certain Arab circles have stated that the existence of Palestine as a Jewish National Home within a pan-Arab federation is possible, many Arab leaders remain doubtful on this point.

Axis propaganda coming from Rome and from the radio stations in Nasi-held Balkan countries is on the whole not taken seriously by the Arabs, nevertheless it tends to create confusion in Arab minds, especially since various reports coming from the Allied side are also contradictory insofar as the Arabs are concerned. This is especially true with regard to the reports about a projected pan-Arab federation. How, some Arabs ask, can Britain live up to its promise of securing independence for Syria, when it talks at the same time of the establishment of a pan-Arab federation to link up Syria with Iraq, Palestine and Transjordan.

25,000 AMERICAN JEWS READY TO JOIN JEWISH ARMY, DR. WEIZMANN REPORTS IN LONDON

LONDON, Aug. 5. (JTA) -- At least 25,000 young American Jews would volunteer immediately if a call for a Jewish Army were issued, Dr. Chaim Weizmenn, president of the World Zionist Organization, stated today at a press conference.

Reporting on his impressions of his four-months stey in the United States and Canada, hr. Weizmann said he believes that the young Jews in the United States will respond enthusiastically to any recruiting call for a Jewish Army. The sky is the limit as far as these young American Jews are concerned, he stated.

Dr. Weigmann said that he noticed a remarkable change in the attitude of the American non-Eionists towards Palestine. This change, he explained, has come gradually, and many developments contributed to it. The result is, however, now visible. A year ago neoterritorial ideas were floating about in America, including the projects of settling Jews in Alaska, in the Dominican Republic, and in British Guiana. But when the need of a place for Jewish mass-immigration became more acute, the hopelessness of all schemes, outside of Palestine, became obvious. Now Palestine alone holds first place with American Jews. Furthermore, the Jews in America have now perceived that if Palestine is to supply the solution to Jewish immigration, there must be a Jewish State, because settlement of Jews on the needed scale can no longer be carried out by voluntary organizations. The financial needs will require power to impose texation and ability to secure large loans.

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In the past, Dr. Weizmenn declared, the Jewish Mational Fund and the Keren Hayesod, as well as other Zionist institutions, have done pioneer work in the economic upbuilding of Palestine, though the bulk of imported Jerish capital came from private sources. In the future, due to the fact that European Jewry has become impoverished, Palestine will have to absorb immigrants who have lost all their possessions, and the part which national Jewish capital will have to play will thus become even more important.

Dr. Weismann concluded by saying that the serene feith of American Jews in Palestine has made him very happy. He pointed out that he found in America an attractive and keen generation of young Jews of Russian and Polish origin, educated in the United States. The apparatus of the Zionist organization in America is adapted to their needs. "I saw no signs of communist tendencies emong the Jewish youth there, and Jewish leaders in America express no serious feers in this direction," Dr. Weizmann reported.

UNION OF ORTHODOX RABBIS SUPPORTS SENDING OF FOOD PARCELS TO EUROPE

NEW YORK, Aug. 5. (JTA) -- The Union of Orthodox Rabbis of the United States and Canada today made public a statement protesting against the Joint Boycott Council for stationing pickets in front of the Agudas Israel headquarters with a view toward forcing the orthodox organization to discontinue acting as agent for sending private food parcels to Nasi-held territories.

Pointing out that the picketing is conducted with the intention "of weekening the relief activities for our Jewish brethren who are dying of starvation," the Union of Orthodox Rabbis says in its statement that it "sees no crime in the work of saving Jewish lives from hunger." Regret is expressed over the fact that the Council rejected arbitration before stationing its pickets.

Boycott Council Urges Conference on Advisability of Sending Food to Jews in Poland

NEW YORK, Aug. 5. (JTA) -- in answer to a charge by the Agudas Israel of America that consultation and arbitration was refused by the Joint Boycott Council, Dr. Joseph Tenenbaum, Chairman, made public today a letter received from the British authorities, which said in part that "the Agudas were fully informed of the attitude of the British Government long before the present controversy reached its peak," and also that "Conferences and negotiations have been tried and failed through the uncompromising attitude adopted by Agudas."

"After three weeks of continuous picketing," Dr. Tenenbeum stated, "the Agudas Israel of America still continues in the sorry role of being the only organization breaking the British blockade and Jewish solidarity."

"If it be necessary to start a large-scale project to feed the Jewish population in Poland, Dr. Tenembeum suggested, the large Jewish organisations in this country should take up the matter with the proper authorities. In no case should it be left in the hands of such groups as the Agudas İsrael, coting in a haphaserd, irresponsible, and unsupervised way."

"Specifically," Dr. Temenbaum said, "we propose that the four leading Jewish organisations, including the Joint Distribution Committee, should consult together on the advisability of Such measures, and if agreed, should send a delegation to Washington to negotiate with the State Department and with the British authorities as well as the Red Cross, so that a more lawful method may be found to feed the unfortunate victims of Masi terrorism, under the surveillance of Red Cross authorities. No single organization has the right to arrogate to itself the authority to act on its own in a matter as grave and dangerous as this. Under no circumstances will the Joint Boycott Council permit single organizations to subsidize the Hitler regime under the guise of helping the Jewish organization, whether through ignorance or lack of conscience."
