JEWS IN VIENNA PERMITTED TO APPEAR IN STREETS FOR ONLY ONE HOUR DAILY

BERNE, Sept. 3. (JTA) -- Jews in Vienna are not permitted to leave their homes for longer than one hour, during which they are required to do all their shopping and attend to the various formalities which they have to take up with the authorities and with Jewish relief institutions, it was reported here today.

The majority of the Jews in Vienna now depend entirely on relief, the report states. The Nazi authorities exercise strict control over the relief activities conducted by the Vienna Jewish community. They even fix the salaries of the employees in Jewish relief institutions.

Reports received here from Nazi-occupied Poland state that Nazi authorities in Warsaw have lifted the order prohibiting Jews to have on hand more than 2,000 zlotys in cash. At the same time the German press reaching here today reports that Kutno, one of the larger towns in Poland, which had a large Jewish population before the war, has now been "purified" of Jewish influence and is rapidly being "Germanized." All Jews have had to move out of the city to a special ghetto quarter in the outskirts.

LAW PROHIBITING JEWS TO EMIGRATE FROM REICH EXTENDED TO CZECH PROTECTOR/TE

LISBON, Sept. 5. (JTA) -- The introduction of forced labor for all Jews in the Czech protectorate was foreseen here today as a result of an order issued in Prague this week barring emigration from the Protectorate of all able-bodied Jewish men and women aged between 18 and 45.

The order issued in Prague follows the line of a similar order issued in Berlin a fortnight ago prohibiting Jewish men and women in the same age group from leaving the Reich. An Order issued in Berlin today supplements the decree with a provision that Jews older than 45 who are permitted to emigrate abroad will no longer be allowed to carry with them records showing their military service in the Germany army during the last world war.

German police raided Jawish homes in Prague in the course of last week and seized typewriters, clothing and other articles. The victimized owners were then forced to report to police headquarters and sign statements that they had "voluntarily" contributed the articles to the German Red Cross.

NAZI ADMINISTRATION IN HOLLAND INTENDS TO ESTABLISH CHETTO SCHOOLS

STOCKHOLM, Sept. 3. (JTA) -- Plans of the Nazi authorities in Holland to segregate the Jewish children into separate "ghetto schools" when the new school year begins this month, were indicated today by the Nazi Commisser for Holland. An announcement published in the Dutch press today, under the signature of the Nazi Commisser, invites applications from teachers willing to serve "in schools to be established exclusively for Jewish pupils." CZECH LEGATION WILL INTERVENE IN MOSCOW FOR BALTIC AND RUMANIAN REFUGEES

LONDON, Sept. 5. (JTA) -- Intercession on behalf of Jewish war-refugees from the Beltic states and Bessrabia now in Soviet Russie, was promised here today to Jewish organizations by Jan Masaryk, foreign minister of the Czechoslovekian Government-inexile. Masaryk stated that the Czech minister in Moscow would intervene in the "border-line" cases, where the refugee is neither a Soviet citize nor Polish citizen.

Meanwhile, the first official response to the appeal by prominent Soviet Jewish writers, artists and scientists to world Jewry came today from ultra-conservative Jewish religious circles here. Addressing a meeting in North London, H. A. Goodman, secretary of the World Agudes Israel, referred to the appeal as "not the least important development in recent days."

"We cordially reciprocate the greetings of our bret ren in Russia who have been cut off from Jawish life for some twenty yeers," he said. "w., echo the words of the speaker at the Jawish meeting in Moscow: 'The Nazis are determined to make the Jawish uation disappear but the Jaws are resolved to live not die.'"

USA TO SUPPLY ENGLAND WITH ETROGIM FOR SUCCOTH

LONDON, Sept. 3. (JTA) — Citrons and palm branches, the Etrog end Lulab used 1. the Succoth ritual, will this year be sent from the United States to England inemmuch as they cannot be secured from either the Greek island of Corfu, the place which provided strogim for the whole of Europe, or from Palestine, because of the wer situation.

The Food Ministry in London has issued special licenses to Jewish religious bodies to import the citrons and the palm branches from the United States, it was announced here today. The Bank of England has released the currency necessary for the transaction and British shipping authorities in New York were given instructions to facilitate the shipping, so that they will reach England before the Succoth holiday. The shipment will be distributed by the Keren Hatorah in London to all the synagogues in the United Kingdom. A few sets of strogim and hulabim will be sent gratis to the internment camps for use there

PEVISIONIST LEADERS TO HOLD WORLD CONFERENCE IN PALESTINE

LONDON, Sept. 5. (JTA) -- Decisions which will bring about a readjustment in the leadership of the New Zionist Organization, as a result of the death of Vladimir Jabotinsky leader of the Revisionist movement, will be taken at a world conference of NZO leaders to be held in Pelestine in the middle of this month, it was announced here today by the Administrative Committee of the NZO.

The American NZO will be represented at the conference by Ben-Horin who is now in Capetown on his way from New York to Palestine. Other countries represented will include Poland, Czechoslovakia, Germany, France, Yugoslavia, Bulgaria, Hungary, Rumania, Greece and Belgium, since the leaders of the NZO in these countries are at present in Palestine. Delegates will also fly from London and South Africa.

VISTADRUTH GREETING DISTRIBUTED AT BRITISH TRADE UNION CONGRESS

LONDON, Sept. 5. (JTA) -- A leaflet issued by the Histodruth, Palestine Labor Tederation, and addressed to "Our compades of the British Trace Union Congress" was distributed today at the Edinburgh meeting of the Congress.

Outlining the echievements of Pelestine labor in the spheres of trade unfonism, connerstives health services, education and unemployment relief, the leaflet stressed Pelestine J wry's part in the fight against Hitlerism.

DR. SOLOMON GOLDMAN REGRETS KAUFMANN'S DECLINATION; SUPPORTS LEVINTHAL

CHICAGO, Sept. 3. (JTA) -- Regret over Edmund I. Kaufmann's announcement that his health does not permit him to run for reelection to the post of president of the Zionato Organization of America and support for the candidacy of Judge Levinthal for the presidency was expressed in a statement issued here today by Dr. Solomon Goldman, former ZOA president. The statement reads:

"I learn with the deepest regret that Mr. E. I. Kaufmann, president of the Zionist Organization of America, has had to accept the opinion of his physician and not stand for reelection at the coming convention. I am sure that he would have been reelected with acclaim and that the Zionists throughout the country will miss his leadership the coming year.

"At the same time, I greet with enthusiasm Mr. Kaufmann's recommendation of Judge Louis C. Levinthal of Philadelphia. I do not think that Mr. Kaufmann could have had a more worthy and distinguished successor. Judge Levinthal is a scion of an outstanding American Zionist family whose name is known to and revered by thousands of Jews throughout the land. Judge Levinthal brings to the office not only a judicial temperament, a deep loyalty to America and its democratic institution, but a thorough Jewish background and devotion to the rebuilding of Palestine."

Robert Szold Backs Kaufmann's Statement

NEW YORK, Sept. 3. (JTA) -- Robert Szold commenting on the statement issued by Edmund I. Kaufmann, president of the Zionist Organization of America, yesterday said: "The statement will naturally cause a great deal of surprise and regret to his host of admirers and friends throughout the country. In view of the fact of Mr. Kaufmann's forthright statement as to his personal position, however, the proposal that Judge Levinthal of Philadilphia be elected president of the Zionist Organization of America for the coming year, will, I am sure, meet with widespread and enthusiastic approval and support. I look forward to a great convention and a useful year of Zionist activity in this country."

EDUCATION OF ALIENS FOR CITIZENSHIP DISCUSSED IN WASHINGTON

WASHINGTON, Sept. 3. (JTA) -- At two coordinated conferences which opened here today the Federal Government moved forward with its plans for regulation of its elien population and for the reduction of the number of non-citizens through a program of education in democracy.

Meeting behind closed doors at the Department of Justice this morning, Immigration and Naturalization officials went into the first of five days discussion of administrative policies recently developed to meet war-born problems of alien regulation and the administration of the new nationality code and other laws passed by Congress during its current session.

After a greeting by Acting Attorney General Francis Biddle, and a warning by Marshall E. Dimock, Asst. Commissioner of Immigration and Naturalization, that the national emergency had placed responsibility for the protection as well as the policing of the foreign born on the Department, the Justice officials joined Forces at a White House conference with delegates to the National Citizenship Education Committee meeting. The latter conference was called to draft plans for state and local cooperation in a nation-wide program for the education of aliens for citizenship, which was drawm up by leading educators and is to be carried out with the aid of W.P.A. funds. Mrs. Eleenor Roosevelt was the principal speaker at the White House conference.

CAMPAIGN TO COMBAT "MEIN KAMPF" WITH THE BIBLE PROCLAIMED IN USA

NEW YORK, Sept. 3. (JTA) -- A nation-wide compeign to counteract "Mein Kempf" with the Bible, sponsored by 200 leeding American citizens of all faiths, was announced here yesterday by the Layman's National Committee, in order "to stimulate and unify America's spiritual defense."

A "Bible Week" will take place from Dec.8 to 14 throughout the country in cooperation with the American Bible Society and other groups. Dr. Frank Kingdon, chairmen of the New York Fight for Freedom Committee to Defend America, accepted the honorary founder chairmanship of this nation-wide drive to beeve an annual Bible Week in America, stating that he is certain that "it will help forg: American unity of spirit against totalitarian aggression."

A statement issued by the Layman's National Committee declares that the proposed campaign will be conducted "on a Red Cross scale with coast-to-coast hock-ups, nationally known speakers, pegeents in the schools, movie trailers, posters in every nublic place and educational institution. Nothing will be left undone to make every American, young end old, realize that the hope for our future lies in faith, and that the answer America is looking for in her present crisis is a spiritual enswer," the statement said.

CZECH MINISTER LAUDS JEWISH ACHIEVEMENTS IN PALESTINE AS AID TO ALLIES

LONDON, Sept. 3. (JTA) -- Jewish achievements in the unbuilding of Pelestine have "not only been a contribution to the "Lend of Jewish Destiny" but also to the victory of the Allies." declared Jaromir Neces, Czechoslovekian Minister of State in an address today before a Pelestine Victory Compaign luncheon at Newcestle.

Necas stressed the identity of Czech and Jewish aims, and stated that Czechoslovekirms have fought for centuries for freedom for themselves and their fellowmen. "Jews in a free Czechoslovakia had all rights granted to other citizens, and now by a curious twist of fate both Czecho and Jews have been deprived of their rights as free men," he concluded.

The Czech Minister pledgec Czechos ovakian support to Jewish efforts for a national revival in Palestine.

CUBA IMPOSES SEVERE PUNISHMENT UPON NAZI LEADER FOR ANTI-JEWISH PROPAGANDA

HAVANA, Sept. 3. (JTA) -- The first action against anti-Semitic propaganda ever teken by a court in Cuba was announced here today when Franz Thol, local Nazi leader, was santened to six months imprisonment and deportation after having served his term.

Thol was charged with conducting anti-Jewish agitation among the Cuban population. Six other members of the Nazi Bund in Cuba were acuitted due to lack of evidence. In issuing the verdict against Thol, the Court applied the law existing in Cuba against Negro Viscrimination, pointing out that anti-Jewish racial propaganda is as harmful to the courtry as the racial propaganda against Negroes.

AUDITIONAL 150 PATRIA REFUGEES RELEASED FROM INTERNMENT CAMP AT ATHLIT

IRRUSALEM, Sept. 5. (JTA) -- An additional 150 refugees from the steemer Petria, interned since the vessel exploded in Heife harbor last November, were released today from the internment camp at Athlit. About one hundred of them immediately enlisted in the Palestine forces. Of the first group of one hundred released last week some eighty joined the army.
