JAPAN REMOVES JEWS INTO INTERIOR; INTRODUCES ANTI-JEWISH LAWS IN MANCHUKUO

VLADIVOSTOK, Jan. 2. (JTA)-- All Jews in Japan were removed this week into the interior without a single Jewish family permitted to remain in Yokohama, Kobe, Tokyo and other Japanese cities, according to information reaching here today from Japan.

The same information reveals that Nazi anti-Jewish laws existing in Germany were introduced this week in the Japanese puppet-state of Manchukuo. The synagogue in Harbin, capital of Manchukuo, was closed down. Harbin has a considerable Jewish population consisting mostly of Russian Jews.

Jewish refugees from Germany and the Czech Protectorate were rounded up by the Japanese occupation authorities in Thailand. Families were separated when the men were isolated in prisons while the women and children were sent to a special concentration camp.

600 JEWS MASSACRED BY NAZIS IN ROSTOV BEFORE RETREATING; OTHER ATROCITIES REPORTED

LONDON, Jan. 2. (JTA)-- More than 600 Jews were massacred by the Nazis in the Soviet city of Rostov prior to their retreat from that city, according to a report received in London today from Moscow.

The report states that all along the line of the German retreat the bodies of large numbers of massacred Jewish civilians were found. The Jews were usually shot by the retreating Nazis on the charge that they were aiding the Russian military forces by signalling information to them concerning the location of the German troops. In one village on the Moscow front some 2,000 Jews who were being used by the Nazi military command for forced labor on the front line, were liberated by the advancing Russian army when the German soldiers had to leave their position hurriedly.

All Jews Evicted From Dwellings in Nazi-held Ukraine, White Russia

All Jews were evicted from their dwellings by the German occupation authorities in the cities of Berdichev, Zhitomir, Goeml, Minsk, Mohilev, Pskov, Orsha, Kremenchug, Nikolayev. Jewish homes are being used to shelter the German soldiers for the winter.

Addressing the German youth over the radio last night from Stettin, the Nazi district leader, Ditschlag, urged every member of the Hitler Youth Organization to "be able to show on his record that he caused the death of at least one Jew."

The Nazi-controlled Polish newspaper, Goniec Krakowski, reports that 200 Jewish families in Wlodzimierz near Piotrkow, Nazi-occupied Poland, are now homeless as a result of a fire which burned down their houses.

JEWISH WAR DUTIES TO BE DISCUSSED AT CONFERENCE OF FEDERATIONS AND WELFARE FUNDS

NEW YORK, Jan. 2. (JTA)-- Jewish federation and welfare fund leaders throughout the United States will discuss the communal duties and responsibilities facing American Jewish communities as a result of the war at the ninth annual General Assembly of the Council of Jewish Federations and Welfare Funds which will be held at the Drake Hotel in Chicago from January 31 to February 2, it was announced here today by the Council.

Reflecting the nation-wide demand for intensive examination of the new wartime problems, the plan for the 1942 General Assembly represents a departure from previous practice, according to Samuel Markell of Boston, chairman of the Program Committee. Invitations will be extended only to accredited delegates designated by member agencies.

Official notification of the 1942 Assembly was sent to the 216 member agencies of the Council together with the proposed by-laws' revision which will be submitted to the membership of the Council for final action at the Chicago meeting. Assembly sub-committees have been selected and are now meeting to prepare reports which will constitute the basis of the Assembly discussions.

\$400,000 WILL BE RAISED IN AMERICA FOR HEBREW UNIVERSITY'S WAR NEEDS

NEW YORK, Jan. 2. (JTA)-- Mr. Jacob Bleustein, chairman of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, Dr. Louis Finkelstein, president of the Jewish Theological Seminary, and Prof. Salo Baron of Columbia University have been elected as new members of the Board of Directors of the American Friends of the Hebrew University, it was announced here today by Dr. A.S.W. Rosenbach, president.

The Board of Directors at their annual meeting in December adopted an emergency budget to raise \$400,000 in the United States this year to cover the University's wartime needs. Since the war the Hebrew University's income has been cut by the destruction of Societies of Friends in European countries and by the loss of tuition fees of students who have been separated from their families and who are being granted tuition scholarships out of University funds.

A declaration of leading academicians and scholars of Great Britain acclaiming the Hebrew University in Jerusalem as a world influence providing a meeting place for the cultures of East and West, was released today by Dr. Rosenbach. The statement, which was received in a cable from Professor Norman Bentwich of London, points to the Hebrew University's significance in keeping "the scientific flame burning clear and free in the Orient while the lamps are put out in the countries of Europe." Special recognition is given to the war work being done by the Jerusalem University's scientists.

FUND TO PROVIDE COMFORTS FOR JEWISH TROOPS IN MIDDLE EAST ESTABLISHED IN CANADA

MONTREAL, Jan. 2. (JTA)-- American and Canadian Jews were urged today to make contributions to the newly-established Jewish Legion Service Fund which is to provide cigarettes, books and other comforts to the 10,000 Palestinian Jews serving with the British forces in the Middle East.

An appeal issued by F. Wolofsky, treasurer of the Fund and by Leon Cheifets, secretary, says that the Fund is registered in Montreal under the Canadian War Charities Act and is sponsored by veterans of the Jewish Battalions who saw service in Palestine during the first World War. "The support of the general public will be heartily appreciated," the appeal says.

NAZIS SUSPEND ONLY JEWISH PAPER IN POLAND; EXECUTE FIVE JEWS FOR LEAVING GHETTO

ZURICH, Jan. 2. (JTA)-- The closing down of Gazeta Zydowska, the only organ of the Jews in Nazi-held Poland, and the execution in Czenstochows of five more Jews, including a woman, for leaving the ghetto there without permission, are reported here today.

The report states that the Nazi authorities in Poland suspended the publication of the Gazeta Zydowska under the pretext that the information on Jewish life in the ghettos is detrimental to the German interests abroad. The items which this ghetto organ carried, including advertisements, were all published after having been approved by Nazi censorship. The suspension of the Gazeta Zydowska is a blow to the Jews in Poland since the publication was practically the only means of contact between the isolated Jews in various sections of the occupied territory where free traveling is prohibited to people wearing the Mogen David badge.

GERMAN RADIO TELLS PALESTINE ARABS THAT MUFTI IS WELL PROTECTED IN BERLIN

BERNE, Jan. 2. (JTA)-- Arabs in Palestine were told today in a broadcast over the German radio station in Zeesen that the ex-Mufti of Jerusalem who has taken up permanent residence in Berlin "is protected by the friendship and strength of the German people."

Broadcasting in Arabic, the announcer said that the "ex-Mufti is closely cooperating with the forces of Hitler and Mussolini to defeat the British Empire which is already on the verge of a breakdown." He emphasized that the presence of the ex-Mufti in Berlin "is one of the main factors which will lead to the liberation of the Arab people from British domination."

ROOSEVELT URGES AMERICAN EMPLOYERS NOT TO DISMISS ALIENS

WASHINGTON, Jan. 2. (JTA)-- President Roosevelt, in an official statement, today said that he is "deeply concerned" over reports that aliens are being dismissed from their employment in American enterprises. He urged all employers in the country to adopt a "sane policy" regarding the employment of aliens and foreign-born citizens.

"This is a very serious matter," President Roosevelt declared. "It is one thing to safeguard American industry, and particularly defense industry, against sabotage; but it is very much another to throw out of work honest and loyal people who, except for the accident of birth, are sincerely patriotic."

JEWISH UNITS WILL BE SET UP WITHIN PALESTINE'S WOMEN'S AUXILIARY SERVICE

JERUSALEM, Jan. 2. (JTA)-- Special Jewish units will be set up within the Palestine Women's Auxiliary Territorial Service, the formation of which was announced last week, it is reported here today.

Under an agreement between the Jewish Agency and the British military authorities the recruitment of Jewish women for the Palestine W.A.T.S. will be based on the establishment of Jewish units within the organization, similar to the Jewish units within the Palestine forces serving with the British army.

Moshe Shertok, political chief of the Jewish Agency, today returned to Cairo, where he has spent much time recently conferring on political problems affecting Palestine.

WIVES OF PALESTINE JEWISH SOLDIERS SEEK RELIEF

MANCHESTER, Jan. 2. (JTA)-- More than 2,000 wives of Jewish soldiers in Palestine have been forced to apply to Jewish relief organizations for aid because of the meager pay given their husbands serving with the British forces, it is disclosed today by the Manchester Guardian.

Palestine soldiers are paid half the allowance given to soldiers in England, despite the fact that the cost of living is equally high in both places, the Guardian points out. It adds that there are also no provisions for the dependent parents of Palestine soldiers or pensions for disabled fighters.

JEWS IN TRIPOLI FORBIDDEN TO LEAVE HOMES AFTER 4 P.M.

LONDON, Jan. 2. (JTA)-- All Jews in the Italian North African colony of Tripoli, are now forbidden to leave their homes between four o'clock in the afternoon and six o'clock in the morning, under an order issued by the military commander of the colony, it was learned here today. The order which followed the British capture of the Axis Libyan stronghold of Benghazi, was issued "because all Jews are suspected of pro-British activities."

COOPERATION OF PROTESTANTS, CATHOLICS, JEWS IN WARTIME HELD ESSENTIAL

NEW YORK, Jan. 2. (JTA)-- Protestant, Catholic and Jewish leaders associated with the National Conference of Christians and Jews were urged by prominent Americans today to perform five important services to the nation during the war period. In a report submitted to a meeting of the board of trustees of the National Conference, Dr. Everett R. Clinchy, president of the organization, summarized the five "duties" as follows:

1. Military effort is not the business of religious organizations. Nevertheless, every true Protestant, Catholic and Jew will accept as his first civic duty the full support of the national effort.
2. The nation must be made aware that involvement in war does not of itself insure continued unity. The National Conference has a war-time job to reduce friction and increase the will to pull together.
3. The National Conference must help to keep before the nation the values for which the American people are fighting.
4. The National Conference must serve among Americans of all faiths as a clearing house for the exchange of purposes and programs accenting religion and justice.
5. The people of this nation will hope for a better world to justify the suffering of the present war. It is the duty of the Churches to stand for and work for the creation of a better post-war world. The National Conference can render a great service in stimulating and correlating the efforts of Protestants, Catholics and Jews in this field.

PROF. LEVI-CIVITA, ITALIAN-JEWISH MATHEMATICIAN, DIES AT VATICAN CITY

GENEVA, Jan. 2. (JTA)-- Prof. Tulio Levi-Civita, 69, Italian-Jewish mathematician and physicist, died yesterday at the Vatican City. He was considered by Prof. Albert Einstein to be his ablest disciple and was regarded as Italy's foremost mathematician. He was a member of the Pontifical Academy of Sciences and the first Jew to broadcast on the Vatican radio.
