NAZIS EXPEL ALL JEWS FROM LUCK; HANG JEWISH LAWYER IN LUBLIN CHETTO

LONDON, Jan. 12. (JTA) -- The entire Jewish population of the city of Luck, in Nazi-occupied Poland, has been expelled from the city, Reuters. Britain's leading news agency, reported today. No details of the expulsion were given. The place to where the 50,000 Jewish inhabitants of Luck were deported was also not mentioned in the report.

Polish government circles here today received a report that a Jevish lawyer was hanged by the Gestapo in the Lublin ghetto for alleged anti-Nazi activities. The name of the lawyer was not revealed, but it was said that he was an active member of the illegal Jewish Socialist Bund which is working hand-in-hand with the Polish underground groups in spreading anti-Nazi information picked up from foreign broadcasts. The Jewish lawyer, according to the report, was caught by Gestapo agents, half-frozen, on the road leading to Lublin from a neighboring town where he had spread illegal leaflets.

Despite the fact that the ghetto in Lublin is strongly guarded, many young Jews there, according to the Polish report, are risking their lives and taking secret trips to neighboring townships and villages to keep the Polish peasantry informed as to what the Polish Government in London is doing for the liberation of Poland. The young Jewish lawyer whom the Gestapo hanged was termed by Poles here as "one of the most fearless organizers of anti-Nazi opposition in Poland."

ARGENTINE JEWS SEND ANTI-TYPHUS SERUM TO THE JEWISH GHETTOS IN WARSAW, CRACOW

BUENOS AIRES, Jen. 12. (JTA) -- Anxious to check the spreed of typhus in the Jewish ghettos of Warsaw and Cracow, the Federation of Polish Jews in Argentina has reached an arrangement with the Argentinian Red Cross to send 4,000 anti-typhus injections to the Jewish communities there, it was announced here today.

The shipment will be delivered to Cracow under the auspices of the International Red Cross. Part of it will then be delivered to Warsaw, where, according to the specific request of the Federation, it will have to be handed over to the Jewish hospital there for the treatment of Jews who, it is understood, receive no medical aid from the Nazi administration:

LEON BLUM'S TRIAL SET FOR NEXT MONTH; JEWS FORBIDDEN TO TEACH IN ALGERIA

Another report states that the French administration in Algeria has introduced further restrictions against Jews there by forbidding them to be private teachers.

GROWING MISERY DRIVES THIRD OF JEWISH POPULATION IN WARSAW GHETTO TO SOUP KITCHENS

ZURICH, Jan. 12. (JTA) -- Starvation in the Jewish ghetto in Warsaw has reached a point where a third of the 500,000 Jews there subsist entirely on the meals which they receive in the Jewish soup kitchens, it was reliably reported here today.

The report stated that due to ever-growing misery emong the Warsaw Jews, the number of soup kitchens for children in the ghette has been increased from 55 to 45, while the number of kitchens for adults has been increased to 105 as compared with 88 a few weeks ago. Two special kitchens have been opened for Jewish policemen and three kitchens were established to feed Jewish forced laborers. Some 155,000 meals are now being served daily in the Jewish soup kitchens in the ghetto, the report said.

The extent of the growing need in the Warsaw ghetto can best be judged from the fact that more than 60,000 meals are supplied daily to Jewish immates in hospitals, in homes for sged as well as to omildren's homes. This is in addition to the 155,000 meals distributed in the ghetto kitchems, the report points out.

8,000 JEWISH ESTATES WILL BE CONFISCATED IN HUNGARY IN 1942

BERNE, Jan. 12. (JTA) -- A "calendar of Hungarian Life for 1942" published in the Nazi newspaper, Donau Zeitung, which reached here today, estimates that 8,093 Jewish-owned estates, each exceeding \$100 in value, will be confiscated by the Hungarian government during the coming year.

Meanwhile, reporting on new political developments in Hungary, the Budapest correspondent of the Neue Zuricher Zeitung writes today that under a new law reconstituting the municipal councils, persons falling under the Jewish laws have been ousted and their places taken by the next highest on the lists. In Budapest 24 Jewish delegates have already been removed as have 15 in Szeged and 12 in Miskolc.

ADMIRAL CUNNINGHAM CREDITS TWO PALESTINE JEWS WITH SAVING BRITISH STEAMER

TEL AVIV, Jan. 12. (JTA) -- Two Jewish instructors of the Zebulun Seafaring Society in Palestine were credited by British Admiral Cunningham with having saved a British freighter when it caught fire during an attack by enemy bombers in the harbor of famagusta, Cyprus. The two are Dov Gelinski and Bmil Fuchs.

An official communication from the Admirel addressed to the Zebulun Society acknowledges the bravery of the two Jewish naval instructors. It reads: "It has been brought to my notice that during an enemy air attack on the steemer El Fath on August 21, considerable presence of mind and courage was exhibited by the above officers. I shall be glad if you would inform them that their good services have been noted by me with much satisfaction."

TEL AVIV'S FASHION SHOW ATTRACTS BUYERS FROM NEAR BASTERN COUNTRIES

TEL AVIV, Jan. 12. (JTA) -- Tel Aviv's third fashion show opened here today before commercial representatives from most of the neighboring Mear Eastern countries. Large orders were placed by buyers from firms in Egypt, Syria and Iran. Feature of the show is the large exhibit of new fashions in furs, an industry which has developed tremendously here within the last few years. Curtailment of imports from Eusope to the Near East as a result of the war has greatly increased the importance of Palestine as a feshion center.

NAZIS DECREE DEATH PENALTY FOR SERBS FOUND HIDING, ASSISTING JEWS

ZURICH, Jan. 12. (JEA) -- The death penalty will be enforced against any persons in Serbia who are found to be hiding Jews or financing or assisting them, it is reported in the Serbian newspaper, Novo Vreme, reaching here today.

All property being taken care of for Jews must be reported to the German military authorities in Belgrade before January 15, the paper writes. Any agreement or contract entered into with Jews since April 6 must also be reported. Failure to observe these regulations will be punished by death.

JEWISH REFUGEE GROUPS ASK HEARING BEFORE ALLIED COUNCIL PROBING NAZI ATROCITIES

LONDON, Jan. 12. (JTA) -- Representatives of Jewish relief organizations of Central Europe have petitioned the Allied Council, which will convene here this week to probe Nazi atrocities in occupied Europe, to grant them a hearing, it is reported in the press here today.

The Allied assembly will investigate and prepare lists of "Nazi and Quisling oriminals" to be punished after the war is over. A special documented index for all occupied countries is being prepared.

SPLIT IN THE NEW ZIONIST ORGANIZATION MOVEMENT IN ENGLAND; NEW LEADERSHIP FORMED

LONDON, Jan. 12. (JTA) -- The resignation of all members of the Administrative Committee of the New Zionist Organization, and the establishment of an Emergency Committee to conduct the affairs of this organization has been announced here today in an official communique issued by the reorganized NZO administration.

The Emergency Committee has also announced that it will no longer consider itself responsible for the activities of A. Abrahams, member of the former Administrative Committee who is also the editor of the Jewish Standard, official organ of the New Zionist Organization. The Jewish Standard is no longer to be considered the organ of the NEO as long as it remains under Mr. Abrahams! editorship. In making these announcements, the newly-formed Emergency Committee issued as tatement saying that it adheres to the policy adopted by the NEO congress in Vienna in 1935, as defined and formulated later by the late Revisionist leader Vladimir Jabotinsky and as it is being carried out now by the Presidency of the NEO in New York.

SOVIET REFUSES PERMISSION TO POLISH EMBASSY TO VISIT ARRESTED POLISH-JEWISH LEADERS

LONDON, Jan. 12. (JTA) -- No member of the Polish embassy staff in Soviet Russia has as yet been permitted to visit Henryk Ehrlich and Victor Alter, arrested Polish-Jewish socialist leaders, in the Soviet jail where they are confined, but Stanislaw Kot, the Polish Ambassador, has received permission to send them food, information received here today by the Polish government revealed.

The information, coming from the Polish embessy in Kuibyshev, says that Ehrlich is ill and under the care of the prison doctor. Instructions were again cabled by the Polish Foreign Office here to Ambassador Kot in Kuibyshev advising him to do everything possible to obtain the release of the two Polish-Jewish labor leaders.

The Polish government today also cabled Kot asking him to obtain details concerning the circumstances of the death of Prof. Moses Schorr, Chief Rabbi of Warsaw, in Soviet Russia on July 8, 1941.

VINCENT SHEEAN, NOTED WRITER, CONDIMINS SOCIAL ANTI-SEMITISM IN UNITED STATES

He appeals to the American people to destroy "social anti-Semitism" within which, he says, political anti-Semitism is nurtured.

Adding that anti-Semitism is not a danger to Jews alone, Sheean states:
"Experience has abundantly shown that anti-Semitic prejudice, once it gets organized
into a party, is the ally of every reactionary force, utilizes any end all methods
and develops straight into violence as a way of action. The beliet box is too slow
for the anti-Semites and their colleagues - the Fascists in general. The club or
revolver suits their temperaments better. The democratic state is explicitly recognized as their permanent enemy."

B'NAI B'RITH WILL ESTABLISH COLONY IN PALESTINE NAMED AFTER DAVID YELLIN

JERUSALEM, Jan. 12. (JTA) -- The B'nai B'rith lodge in Jerusalem today announced that it will establish an agricultural settlement in Palestine to be named after David Yellin, the noted Palestinian scholar, who died here a month ago. Yellin was the founder of the B'nai B'rith in Palestine.

Funds to establish the Yellin colony will come from part of the \$200,000 gift donated some time ago by the B'nai B'rith in America as well as from an additional L50,000 which will be raised by contributions, it was stated. Memorial meetings for Yellin were held here last night by the B'nai B'rith, by the Hebrew University and by the Jewish National Council of Palestine on the occasion of the thirtieth day after Yellin's death.
