JAPANESE GENERAL PROCLAIMS CAMPAIGN TO EXTERMINATE JEWS IN THE ENTIRE FAR EAST

ZURICH, Jan. 15. (JTA)-- A campaign for the extermination of Jews in the entire Far East was proclaimed today by the Japanese General Shoitou, according to a report broadcast by the German radio stations.

Explaining the reason for this campaign, the Japanese General is quoted in the German broadcast as stating to the Japanese press that the Jews in the Far East are as dangerous to Japan's interests as are the United States and Great Britain. "We have broken the British and American influence in Eastern Asia, we must, also, not overlook the Jewish influence there, otherwise our military victories will not be properly exploited," says a statement issued by General Shoitou to the Japanese newspapers.

"The Jewish conquest of Eastern Asia," the statement continues, "began with the arrival of David Sassoon and with his securing certain trade monopolies in China in 1867." The statement concludes with the allegation that the Sassoon family in 1939 controlled some 270 hotels "employing thousands of Jewish emigrants." The Japanese General also charges that "the Jews control 11 daily newspapers and a number of periodicals in China."

NAZIS COLLECT \$10,000,000 FROM JEWS IN FRANCE; JEWS MUST LEAVE OCCUPATIONS TODAY

BERNE, Jan. 15. (JTA)-- Half of the fine of a billion francs (about \$20,000,000) imposed by the German occupation authorities on the Jews of occupied France has already been collected, according to reports reaching here today.

Simultaneously, it was reported today over the Paris radio that the Chief of Police there has notified all Jews engaged in businesses and professions which involve their coming in contact with non-Jews to surrender their licenses and permits to the Paris police authorities by tomorrow. They are also to discontinue practicing their professions as of tomorrow, the order said. It applies both to native and foreign-born Jews.

JEWISH SCIENTISTS IN PALESTINE DEVISE METHOD FOR PRODUCING CONCRETE FROM ORANGE PEEL

JERUSALEM, Jan. 15. (JTA)-- Jewish scientists in Palestine have devised a method for making concrete out of orange peel, it was announced here today by the office of the Jewish Agency. They have also patented a process by which it will be possible to use orange peel for producing plastic material for the manufacture of buttons, the announcement said.

Millions of cases of oranges which cannot be exported because of a shipping shortage will now be used for valuable military and civilian construction. The citrus skins treated under the new process and mixed with cement form a strong, yet light, building material of high insulating quality, the announcement disclosed.

NAZI MASS EXECUTIONS, TORTURES AND PERSECUTIONS OF POLISH JEWS RECORDED IN LONDON

LONDON, Jan. 15. (JTA)-- Documentary information on the mistreatment of Jews in Poland by the Nazi administration there is given in six chapters of a "Black Book" published by the Polish government here yesterday and submitted to the British government today.

While one of the chapters summarizes the anti-Jewish laws issued by the Nazis, including the wearing of yellow badges and the restrictions on travel in street cars and railways, the other chapters are devoted to recording the massacres and terror against Jews carried out by the Nazis in all parts of Poland since 1939, when they occupied the country.

The chapter on the murder of Jewish civilians by Nazis starts with an account of how 53 Jews in a single house in Warsaw were executed by the Nazis in reprisal for the shooting of a Polish policeman in the neighborhood who acted as an informer for the Nazis. It then reports on the mass execution of 600 Jewish men and women in Ostrow-Mazowieck and on the massacre of 800 Jews in the city of Przemysl. It also reveals that 100 Jews were shot by the Nazis in Lask where the synagogue was razed to the ground, and that in Bendzin the entire Jewish quarter was set on fire after all the Jews of the city had been confined there by the Nazi military officials.

Terrible details of mass execution of Jews in Warsaw, Pabianice, Laskarszew and other Polish towns are given in the chapter on Nazi savagery. Some 180 Jews were tortured to death in Cracow in the course of an organized three-day pogrom soon after the Nazis occupied the city. Organized raping of Jewish girls amid orgies in confiscated Jewish houses in Warsaw is also reported in the official Polish "Black Book."

Jews Forced by Nazis to Destroy Polish Religious and National Monuments

The Jews, the document states, have been forced by the Nazis to destroy Polish religious and national memorials such as the Kosciuszko Monument in Lodz, the Polish Religious Seminary in Plock, and others. Among the favorite tortures of the Nazis mentioned in the Polish "Black Book" is driving naked Jews into the street, where they are sprinkled with water in temperatures as low as thirty degrees.

Enumerating the anti-Jewish economic measures and reviewing the effects of the compulsory labor which the Nazis have introduced for Jews in Poland, the document also devotes many of its pages to the Nazi expulsions of Jews from Polish cities, to the misery in the Jewish ghettos of Warsaw, Lodz, Cracow and Lublin and to the demolition by the Nazis of synagogues in Pozen, Przemysl, Sosnowiec, Wloclawek and other towns. Quoting President Roosevelt's comment on the pogrom against the Jews in Berlin in November, 1938, that "it could scarcely be believed that such things could occur in the twentieth century civilization," the Polish "Black Book" says: "Yet such things occurred and are still occurring on a larger scale and with fiercer fury, and there is no sign of abatement until the perpetrators -- Hitler and his confederates -- are wiped off the face of the earth."

ALTAR PAINTINGS FOR JEWISH AND CHRISTIAN MILITARY CHAPELS EXHIBITED IN NEW YORK

WAR DEPARTMENT RECOMMENDS FLYING CROSS FOR JEWISH FLIER WHO BOMBED JAPANESE WARSHIP

WASHINGTON, Jan. 15. (JTA)-- The War Department has recommended that President Roosevelt award the Distinguished Flying Cross to a Brooklyn Jewish youth, who, very likely, actually launched the bomb from Captain Colin P. Kelly's plane which sent the Japanese battleship Haruna to the bottom of the Pacific, it was announced here today. The hero is Corporal Meyer Levin, U. S. Army Air Corps, son of Samuel and Leah Levin of 1504 E. 33 Street, Brooklyn. He, it was disclosed, was the bombardier on board the Kelly plane, which twice attacked and finally sank the Haruna off the Philippines.

Levin is 25, a graduate of Brooklyn Technical High School, who also studied at the Brooklyn Engineering School of Aviation. He enlisted in the Air Corps June 6, 1939, served at Fort Slocum for a while and then in Hawaii. Last September he was one of the 75 men who made the hazardous flight to Manila under Major Emmet O'Donnel. He is still "somewhere in the Philippines" among the seven members of Captain Kelly's bomber crew who survived, bailing out to safety at their commander's orders when the plane was hit after the Haruna sinking.

MEASURES INTENSIFYING "ROMANIZATION" OF JEWISH PROPERTY ANNOUNCED IN BUCHAREST

GENEVA, Jan. 15. (JTA)-- A total of 2,400 large Jewish enterprises have been "aryanized" in Rumania during 1941, according to information announced today over the Bucharest radio. The announcement said that the "aryanization" of Jewish enterprises in Rumania continues on a large scale.

Simultaneously, the Rumanian Minister of Finance today issued a decree aimed at intensifying the "Romanization" of commercial establishments in the country. The decree says that the reduction in taxes which was granted since last June for properties passing from Jewish hands into Rumanian will not be granted to property acquired after March 31, thus it is up to Rumanians to secure all the Jewish property which they plan to buy before that date.

Food restrictions for Jews in Rumania are expected as a result of the growing shortage of bread there. A report reaching here today from Bucharest states that all bakers there were yesterday summoned to a special meeting at which they received instructions with regard to the baking of "ersatz bread" mixed with maize. Practically all the flour available in Rumania is being shipped by the Nazi military authorities there into Germany, for use by the German army.

SYRIAN JEWISH YOUTHS ATTEMPTING TO JOIN BRITISH ARMY RECEIVE FLOGGING AS REWARD

JERUSALEM, Jan. 15. (JTA)-- Four young Jewish boys, none older than fifteen, who this week attempted to slip across the Palestine border from Syria to join the British army, were rewarded by a flogging at the hands of the British authorities, it was disclosed today.

The four youths, Charles Antebi, Raymond Levi, Moshe Kuvranski and Joseph Kisti, all students in the Jewish school at Beirut, stole away from home one morning, leaving letters for their parents stating that they were off to Palestine to become soldiers, and begging their parents not to order them brought back. They took a taxi Sidon near the Syrian-Palestine border, where, with the assistance of the local authorities, they succeeded in crossing the mountains and reaching the border.

There, however, they were arrested by the British border patrol as "illegal immigrants" and were taken before a magistrate in Safed. Accepting their plea that they were motivated by pro-British sentiments when they tried to enter Palestine, the magistrate sentenced them to only one stroke each.

U.S. CONSULATE IN MARSEILLES CONTINUING TO ISSUE VISAS TO REFUGEES, DR. BERNSTEIN SAYS

NEW YORK, Jan. 15. (JTA)-- The United States consulate in Marseilles was continuing to issue immigration visas to Jewish refugees at the rate of about forty a day as of the middle of December, it was disclosed today by Dr. James Bernstein, European director of the HIAS-ICA Emigration Association, who arrived here on board the Portuguese steamer, Guine, yesterday.

Tens of thousands of Jewish refugees, however, remain in France, Spain and Portugal with almost no chance of emigrating because they do not possess any visas at present, nor have they prospects of obtaining them, Dr. Bernstein stated. The HIAS-ICA offices in Marseilles, Casablanca and Lisbon are still functioning normally, he said, and it is expected that at least 1,600 of the 2,000 refugees in Marseilles who possess immigration and transit visas will be able to come to the Western Hemisphere on two Portuguese boats slated to sail this month.

Mr. J. Dijour, secretary of the HIAS-ICA, who also arrived on the Guine, stated that among the 255 refugees who arrived yesterday fifty percent had come directly from French internment camps and were only released on the assurance that they would immediately emigrate. Both Dr. Bernstein and Mr. Dijour had warm words of praise for the cooperation of Dr. Joseph Schwartz, the Joint Distribution Committee representative in Lisbon, and expressed the hope that cooperation between the two refugee aid organizations will continue.

DAVIDSON LIBRARY OF JUDAICA PRESENTED TO CITY COLLEGE IN NEW YORK

NEW YORK, Jan. 15. (JTA)-- The Davidson Library of Judaica, 7,500 volumes of medieval Hebrew literature, was presented last night to the City College Library by Mrs. Israel Davidson, widow of Dr. Israel Davidson, an alumnus of the college and former Professor of Hebrew Literature at the Jewish Theological Seminary.

The collection, reputed to be the largest of its kind in the world, was gathered by Professor Davidson over forty years at an expense of \$20,000. It is the largest single gift ever presented to the college library and will be housed in two rooms in the college tower. Scholars from all parts of the world are expected to use it for research purposes. President Harry N. Wright accepted the gift on behalf of the college. Dr. Louis Finkelstein, President of the Jewish Theological Seminary, delivered an address on the "Role of Scholarship in the Modern World."
