Spotted typhus is now reging in Berlin, Leipzig, Nuremberg and in many cities in German despite frantic efforts to check it. Similarly the German troops are suffering severely from the spread of typhus.

WERTHEIM OUTLINES DUTIES OF AMERICAN JEWRY AT AMERICAN JEWISH COMMITTEE MEETING

NEW YORK, Jan. 25. (JTA) -- The responsibilities which the war has placed upon American Jewry were outlined here today at the 55th annual meeting of the American Jewish Committee by Maurice Wertleim, its president. The meeting, held in the Hotel Astor, re-elected Mr. Wertheim as president of the American Jewish Committee. Louis E. Kirstein was re-elected chairman of the General Committee.

Hon. Irving Lehman and Abram I. Elkus were re-elected honorary vice-presidents; Lessing J. Rosenwald and Carl J. Austrian, vice-presidents and Samuel D. Leidesdorf, treesurer. Victor S. Riesenfeld of New York was elected to the executive committee, filling the vacancy left through the death last week of Dr. Solomon Lowenstein.

The ennual report of the executive committee was read at the meeting by Morris D. Waldman, general secretary. The gathering also heard reports on various activities of the American Jewish Committee delivered by George Z. Medalie, Carl J. Austrian, Harold K. Guinzburg and Morton Webster.

Future of Jews in the World Depends Upon American Leadership

Declaring that the war situation has imposed "tremendous responsibilities upon the American Jewish Committee," Mr. Wertheim, in his presidential report, urged American Jews to recall that "out of the 15,000,000 Jews in the world, about 5,000,000 are in America and the overwhelming majority of the other 10,000,000 are so situated that they are without the means, the influence, or even the energy to determine their own fate."

Today," Mr. Wertheim continued, "the American Jews almost alone must carry the grave responsibility. Upon our actions and upon our leadership will depend the fate of all the Jews in the forseeable future. And among American Jews the American Jewsh Committee stands as the body which may, if it will, be the moral powerhouse for the Jews in this country. I say this because there is no question but that we have the platform from which the proper basic direction can come, nately, that Jews in America are of American, and no other, nationality. In stending for this principle, we believe that we represent not merely the views of our Corporate Members, but the deepest and innermost aspirations of the overwhelming number of American Jews to integrate themselves further in the life and spirit of our beloved country."

Calls For Unity Between Zionists, Non-Zionists, Anti-Zionists

Calling for a "maximum of Jewish unity" in the United States, Mr. Wertheim seid: "The war and the tragedy that have befallen Jews throughout the world, impose upon us a mandate to make every effort for the maximum unity of action within the bounds of basic differences. I daressy that no one will maintain that we have at all times approached our differing points of view with calm intelligence and without prejudice. But we must do it now. The obstacles, of course, lie in the deep rift in American Jewish life that has been caused by the conflicting ideologies of Zionism and non- or anti-Zionism (or as I prefer to call it, anti-Nationalism) and the extremism that has invaded areas of Jewish activity where, by every rational standard, it has no place. Frankly, the dispassionate observer might well find it a deplorable spectacle. The lengths it has gone to, the activities it has paralyzed, and the personal antagonisms it has developed, have brought us to a point where the real issues have been obscured, if not almost forgetten. Fortunately, there is reason for optimism. On our part, I sense within this Committee the most sincere interest in Palestine and everything that it connotes as a home for Jews who wish to live there. Colonisation and immigration have been fostered by many of us individually, and this Committee tisself, under the Presidency of its great leader, Louis Marshall, officially endorsed the Belfour Declaration of 1918."

TWO GESTAPO LEADERS MARKED FOR REVENGE IN RETALIATION FOR THEIR CRUELTY TO JEWS

LONDON, Jan. 25. (JTA) -- Two leading Gestapo men were today marked to meet with "violent death" in reprisal for their cruel torturing of thousands of Jews in Germany and in Nazi-occupied Poland. The two are Adillo Globotchnik, the Nazi commissar of Lublin, and Karl Kanstein, who was chief of the Gestapo office in Berlin during the anti-ewish pogroms there in the autumn of 1938 and is now the chief of the Gestapo in Denmark.

These two Gestapo leaders were branded today over the British Broadcasting Company station as "arch-oriminals who will not be forgotten for punishment." The broadcast addressed from London to the nations in Nazi-occupied territories said that the two will meet with violent death."

Globotchnik is responsible for the very cruel treatment of Jews deported from various parts of the Reich into the Lublin district of which he was the chief. As former district commissioner of Vienna in 1959 he is also responsible for the torturing to death and murdering of many Jews in Austria. Kanstein is now pressing the Damish authorities in Copenhagen for the introduction of anti-Jewish legislation in the same menner as this was done in Germany.

POLISH-JEWISH REFUGERS IN SPAIN ISOLATED FROM OUTSIDE WORLD

LISBON, Jan. 25. (JTA) -- Polish Jews are now in a precarious position in Syain as a result of the severance of diplomatic relations this week between Spain and Poland, it was reported here today. The fear that they will be merconed in Spain as "enemy aliens" till the end of the war is expressed in the report.

The Polish Jews, all of them refugees from France and Belgium, have been herded into Spanish camps and were held under terrible conditions even before Spein decided to break off relations with Poland. Polish Consular officials in Madrid were, however, making constant efforts to secure permission for these refugees to proceed to Lisbon where they would have been aided in emigrating to oversess countries. With the closing down of the Polish consulates in Spain, the interned Jewsian refugees remain unprotected and completely isolated from the outside world.

JEWISH STUDENTS EXPELSED FROM UNIVERSITY OF BUDAPEST AFTER ANTI-SEMITIC RIOTS

LONDON, Jan. 25. (JTA) -- Jewish students in the technical school of the University of Budspest were expelled recently after having been attacked by bands of anti-Semitic students who sought to force the Jews to don yellow Mogen David badges, it was reported today by Free Hungarian circles here.

The demonstrations occurred when anti-Semitic students passed a resolution that the few Jewish students still permitted to study in the University under the "numerus clausus" must wear yellow Mogen Davids. Jewish students not complying with this arbitrary order were attacked. As a result of the outbreak the Jewish students were expelled from the University while the anti-Semites went unpunished.

The Hungarian Minister of Education speaking in Parliament confirmed the fact that the Jewish students had been attacked first and admitted that this was done without the rector's permission. The government, however, he stated, did not consider it necessary to intervene.

WASHINGTON, Jun. 25. (JTA) -- President Roosevelt's feir employment practices complifies returned to Washington tonly from Chicago to consider testimony presented to a to substantiate charges that six Chicago firms and five Milweukee firms holding defense contracts discriminated against Jews and Nogroes.

CONFERENCE OF BRITISH ZIONISTS SENDS GREETINGS TO AMERICAN, SOVIET JEWS

LONDON, Jan. 25. (JTA) -- A resolution expressing greetings to the Jess of the United States and Soviet Russin "who together with the Jess of the pritish bore, Palestine and the Allied countries are determined to carry on the struggle against want and Fascist type may and to fight for freedom and justice which would governntee equality for Jess the world over and a national status for Jess in Palestine's was adopted nere today at the forty-first ennual conference of the British Zionist Federation of Great Britain.

Other resolutions adopted by the 300 delegates perticipating in the conference demand that; 1. The aims of the Ballour Declaration be included as, part of the post-war program of the United Nations; 2. The executive of the Jewich Agency should solution in the efforts to secure the recognition of the Jewich people as an ally of the United Nations in the present war; 2. In a message sent to the Conference he stated that the whole future of the Jewish people depends on their ability to maintain unity. The Conference was addressed by Prof. Selig Brodetsky, Bernett Janner, Paul Goodman and others.

PRINCIPALT ROOSEVELT WILL GET REPORT ON RACIAL DISCRIMINATION IN DEFENSE EMPLOYMENT

WASHINGTON, Jun. 25. (JTA) -- President Roosevelt's feir employment practices complifies returned to Washington tonly from Chicago to consider testimony presented to a to substantiate charges that six Chicago firms and five Milweukee firms holding defense contracts discriminated against Jews and Nogroes.

All of the compenies which were summoned to the hearings appeared execut the Allie Chalme's Co. of Milwaukee. Representatives of those who enswered the charges assured the common tee they will not violate Frisident Roosevelt's executive order that he firm holding defense contract—thall discriminate against workers because the page, color or creed.

The committee will study the cases which have been reported to it and rill report directly to the President on its findings. The con-appearance of the Ailis Chaimers Co. representatives will be considered a plea of nolo contendere, Chaimen Bark Sthridge said.

CONFERENCE OF BRITISH ZIONISTS SENDS GREETINGS TO AMERICAN, SOVIET JEWS

LONDON, Jan. 25. (JTA) -- A resolution expressing greetings to the Jess of the United States and Soviet Russin "who together with the Jess of the pritish bore, Palestine and the Allied countries are determined to carry on the struggle against want and Fascist type may and to fight for freedom and justice which would governntee equality for Jess the world over and a national status for Jess in Palestine's was adopted nere today at the forty-first ennual conference of the British Zionist Federation of Great Britain.

Other resolutions adopted by the 300 delegates perticipating in the conference demand that; 1. The aims of the Ballour Declaration be included as, part of the post-war program of the United Nations; 2. The executive of the Jewich Agency should solution in the efforts to secure the recognition of the Jewich people as an ally of the United Nations in the present war; 2. The British Government should organize the Jewish volunteers in Falestine into Jewish units under the Jewish national emblem.

Another resolution expresses "the deep conviction in the victory of the united Rations over the dark forces of tyranny and violence." It emphasizes the hope that the forth-coming peace will solve the Jewish problem "by providing a new home for a large number of Jews." Sympathy for the Jews in the Nazi-occupied countries and the belief in their speedy liberation was voiced in still another resolution.

Dr. Chain Meizmann, who is leaving shortly for the United States, was reelected President of the Federation. In a message sent to the Conference he stated that the whole future of the Jewish people depends on their ability to maintain unity. The Conference was addressed by Prof. Selig Brodetsky, Bernett Janner, Paul Goodman and others.

"ENERTY ALIENS" ENTITLED TO UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE, LABOR DEPARTMENT SAYS

NEW YORK, Jan. 25. (JTA) -- Refugees entitled to unemployment insurance do not forfeit their right because they are nationals of Germany, Austria or Italy, according to information received today by the Netional Refugee Service from the New York State Department of Labor. Aliens entitled to unemployment insurance will receive the full amount to which they are entitled, the NRS was advised.
