### NAZIS EXECUTE ALL JEWISH WAR PRISONERS TAKEN ON THE SOVIET FRONT

LONDON, Jan. 27. (JTA)-- Jewish soldiers in the Soviet armies are being shot by the German military command when taken prisoner, it was reported by Polish official circles here today.

The report states that Jewish soldiers and political commissars of the Red Army are executed as soon as they reach the war prisoners' camps. Every Russian prisoner, when arriving in camp, is asked whether he is Jewish. Those classified as Jews are stripped of their boots, clothing and underwear and executed. Ukrainians and Moslems are accorded special treatment, while Russians are sent to the huge camps established at Biala-Podlaska, near Brest-Litovsk, and at Bialystok and Lublin where they are treated with the utmost brutality and kept on a hunger-diet of a hundred grams of bread daily with some soup occasionally.

The roads in the neighborhood of the camps, the Polish report states, are filled with bodies of executed Jewish war prisoners. In many cases the Jewish war prisoners are ordered by the camp authorities to run barefoot in deep snow from the camps to open fields, where they are shot under the pretext that they were trying to escape. In the camp near Lublin, a group of Soviet-Jewish war prisoners was stripped naked and machine-gunned by the guards. In the city of Zamosc, Poles were driven frantic by the cries of Jewish war prisoners tortured at a camp established at the outskirts of the city.

### BERLIN AND ROME ATTEMPT TO SCARE ARABS WITH FALSE "ROOSEVELT POLICY" ON PALESTINE

ANKARA, Jan. 27. (JTA)-- America's participation in the war is being utilized by Nazi propagandists to arouse fears among the Arabs in Palestine and the neighboring countries that "Roosevelt's policy" is to establish an independent Jewish State "even bigger than any ever suggested before." Propaganda to this effect was broadcast last night in Arabic from the German station at Zeesen.

"The American greed is extending itself to the Near East," the Nazi broadcaster said. "America's entry into the war is a guarantee that the bigger Jewish state will be founded. The Arabs must not allow their destiny to be identified with Anglo-Saxon nations."

Simultaneously, the Nazi radio station in Leipzig last night utilized the message of greetings sent by Sir Archibald Sinclair, British Air Minister, to Sunday's annual meeting of the Federation of British Zionists in London, to attempt to show the "close interdependence of Britain and the Jews." This "interdependence" could not be expressed more clearly than it was done in this message, the broadcaster stated. At the same time the Rome radio last night carried a violent anti-Jewish speech by Antonio Petrucci, attacking the Jews of England and America and attempting to "prove" to the Arab world that the victory of the Anglo-Saxon nations would also mean victory for Jews.

POLISH OFFICIALS IN PALESTINE APPEAL FOR AID FOR POLISH JEWS IN RUSSIA

TEL AVIV, Jan. 27. (JTA)-- An appeal for aid for Polish Jews now in remote sections of Soviet Russia was voiced here today at a joint press conference held by Baron Korsak, Polish Consul-General in Jerusalem, Henryk Rosmerin, Polish consul in Tel Aviv and M. Anski, head of the Polish Information Service in the Middle East.

The Polish officials estimated that among the 2,000,000 Poles in Russia there are approximately 500,000 Jews who are in a desperate condition. At the same time they confirmed that a large number of Jews are enrolled in the Polish army in Russia. At one time Jews comprised thirty percent of all Polish troops, Kanski stated, but a recent influx of Poles has reduced the proportion to twelve percent.

Commenting on the recent reconstruction of the Polish Cabinet, the Polish leaders stated that it will not affect the government's attitude toward the Jews and that the policy of equality for all citizens in post-war Poland will be maintained. Referring to a statement by Tadeuz Bielecki, anti-Semitic right-wing Endek leader, that Jewish ghettos will remain in post-war Poland, Kanski stated that he had been authorized by Sikorski to deny such assertions. He explained that the Jewish delegation that had proceeded to Cairo last month to see Sikorski was not received for "purely technical reasons."

BRITISH PARLIAMENT URGED TO PROBE PALESTINE CENSOR'S SUPPRESSION OF JEWISH NEWS

LONDON, Jan. 27. (JTA)-- The extent to which the Palestine Government is censoring news of Jewish interest in Palestine is revealed today in an editorial in the Manchester Guardian demanding that Parliament probe the censorship policy of the Palestine administration.

The Guardian declares that in addition to suppressing reports concerning the Jewish recruiting campaign in Palestine, the censor has forbidden publication of "some purely political articles." Also suppressed was the story of the death of Leo Gutfreund, Czech Jewish refugee, who, after his release from the internment camp at Athlit, joined the Czech Legion and was killed in Libya. Another article which was censored, the editorial discloses, was one praising the exchange of visits between teachers and students of Hebrew and Arab schools. Publication of Prime Minister Churchill's statement in Commons on last July 30, when he stated that the British Government's policy on Palestine remained unchanged, was also prohibited.

"One would think it incredible that anything should be done to obstruct the earliest publication of an answer in the British Parliament by the Prime Minister," the Manchester Guardian writes. It asks that the House of Commons immediately insist on a full report of what happened.

MORE THAN 100,000 JEWS STILL IN LWOW; 40,000 JEWISH STORES LIQUIDATED IN LODZ

ZURICH, Jan. 27. (JTA)-- Nazi newspapers reaching here today from Poland report that there are still more than 100,000 Jews in the city of Lwow, the Nazi-held capital of Eastern Galicia. They also report that 40,000 retail Jewish shops "have disappeared" in Lodz since the city was occupied by Germany.

Reporting that the Jewish population of Lwow today numbers 104,126 persons, the Krakowski Vistki, a Nazi paper in the Ukrainian language published in Cracow, says that the Jews constitute a third of the entire population of the city. The number of Jewish stores liquidated in Lodz "demonstrates the great extent to which trade in Lodz was controlled by Jews," the Nazi newspaper Donau Zeitung states.

PALESTINE POLICE OFFER \$12,000 REWARD FOR CAPTURE OF TERRORISTS IN TEL AVIV, HAIFA

JERUSALEM, Jan. 27. (JTA)-- A reward of £2,000, approximately \$8,000, was announced today by Palestine police headquarters for information leading to the capture of the persons responsible for the bomb explosion in Tel Aviv last Tuesday, which took the lives of three policemen. An additional £1,000 reward was announced by the police, payable to anyone revealing the whereabouts of a certain M. Stern, who, according to the police authorities, is the head of "Jewish terrorist groups."

The outbreak of terrorism spread to Haifa last Saturday evening when a hand grenade was thrown into a crowded Jewish cafe in the Hadar Baccarmel quarter of the city. Fortunately, the bomb did not explode. The person who threw the grenade escaped under cover of darkness. Abraham Tabori, a member of the Palestine Labor Council, was blackjacked by three unknown assailants the same evening in Tel Aviv. Tabori was seriously injured and had to be rushed to the Hadassah hospital for treatment.

The executive of the Jewish National Council today issued a manifesto vigorously condemning the outbreak of terrorism. "We will not tolerate a small terrorist group which aims to impose a reign of terror on Palestine and the Yishuv," the manifesto said.

"GHETTO FISH MARKET" ESTABLISHED FOR JEWS IN FRENCH COLONY OF TUNIS

ZURICH, Jan. 27. (JTA)-- A special "ghetto fish market" has been set up for the Jewish residents of the French North African city of Tunis, it is reported in the Tunisian newspaper Petit Matin, reaching here today.

Because of the serious food shortage the authorities have decreed four "meatless days" every week, resulting in a great increase in the demand for fish. This has taxed the facilities of the general fish market to such an extent that the Jews have been relegated to a small market set up for them and they are forbidden to purchase fish elsewhere, the report in Petit Matin states.

FRENCH PRIEST DOUBLES DONATION WHEN TOLD IT GOES TO AID JEW

LONDON, Jan. 27. (JTA)-- The shame and sorrow felt by the French clergy at the anti-Jewish measures taken by Marshal Petain's "Christian regime" are reflected in an episode reported in the underground French paper Valmy, the editor of which, Paul Simon, reached London this week.

Simon brought with him one issue which reports how a young French girl approached a high dignitary of the Church and asked for a donation to aid a distressed woman. Offering fifty francs the priest asked: "Is this woman's condition very deplorable, my child?"

"Yes, father," the girl answered. "She is seventy and she is a Jewess."

Upon hearing this reply, the church leader handed the girl a hundred francs, and said: "I thank you for still having faith in Christian charity."

NZO EXECUTIVE IN SO. AFRICA PROPOSES REUNION WITH WORLD ZIONIST ORGANIZATION

LONDON, Jan. 27. (JTA)-- The executive of the World Zionist Organization today received from the executive of the New Zionist Organization in Johannesburg, a proposal that the two groups re-unite. "The attitude of the World Zionist executive has always been to welcome the re-entry of the Revisionists into the Zionist Organization under proper conditions," Prof. Selig Brodetsky, member of the Zionist executive, commented.

YESHIVAH STUDENTS FROM GERMANY BEING RELEASED FROM INTERNMENT IN CANADA

MONTREAL, Jan. 27. (JTA)-- Forty Yeshivah students, formerly of the Talmudical Seminary in Frankfurt-on-the-Main, Germany, who have been interned in Canada, are being released to continue their studies in Montreal and Toronto Yeshivoth, it was announced here today.

The British and Canadian authorities have, after prolonged negotiations carried on by the United Jewish Refugees and War Relief Agencies, consented to release the interned Yeshivah students on condition that they continue their studies and that they do not become a burden on the community. Both conditions are being met.

The Yeshivah students, all citizens of an enemy country, were brought to Canada in the summer of 1940 after the wholesale round-up of enemy aliens in Great Britain. Of the more than 2,000 Jewish refugees who were then brought to this country for internment, over a thousand have since returned to the United Kingdom, many of them to join the Pioneer Corps and others to join the Cholutz training farms. A number of students have been released in Canada under a sponsor plan and nearly a hundred are being absorbed in Canada's war industries. It is also expected that a number of internees with agricultural training will be placed on private farms owing to the shortage of farm labor.

N.R.S. CLARIFIES SITUATION OF ALIENS WHOSE FUNDS FROZEN BY U.S.

NEW YORK, Jan. 27. (JTA)-- Agencies giving relief to individuals who are nationals of countries affected by Government freezing orders, and who arrived in the United States subsequent to June 17, 1940, may make application to the Federal Reserve Bank in their district for a blanket license, it was learned here today by the National Refugee Service.

Under this license, the agencies are permitted to make relief payments to any and all refugees affected by the blocking. The blanket license will permit the payment of relief grants by each agency up to a total monthly amount, and will also provide for a maximum for each individual grant. Licenses of this sort are generally granted for a period of three months, after which they may be renewed. Alternatives to obtaining a blanket license are: to pay each relief grant into a blocked account in a domestic institution in the name of the blocked refugee, or to obtain a special license for each grant. In the case of committees making loans to refugees as distinct from relief payments, the blanket license should include the provision for such loans.

The National Refugee Service has offered its services to cooperating agencies concerning the form and content of the application which they should make. The necessity for such a license, its terms, and its availability may vary from one Federal Reserve District to another.
