ZIONISTS ASK BRITAIN HOW IT EXPECTS TO DEFEND PALESTINE; URGE JEWISH MOBILIZATION

LONDON, Jan. 29. (JTA)-- With military authorities in England expecting a Nazi attempt to invade Turkey and break through to Syria and Palestine, Zionist leaders here today posed the following question to the British:

"What are the authorities going to do to prevent such disasters in the Middle East as have been experienced in Malaya?"

The question asked in an editorial which appeared today in the Zionist Review, official Zionist organ, is answered in the same editorial with a suggestion urging the immediate mobilization of all able-bodied Jews in Palestine. Pointing out that "some of the Arab leaders are still sitting on the fence while others, including the ex-Mufti of Jerusalem, are already in the Axis camp," the editorial says: "The only wise course to take would be the immediate mobilization of Jews in Palestine for the defense of their own homeland. Further delays are not justifiable on any grounds. They would sooner or later have unfavorable repercussions on the welfare of the Arab people as well as on those whose whole future depends entirely upon the victory of the United Nations."

In a second editorial the Zionist Review condemns the terroristic acts which have been taking place in Tel Aviv and Haifa during the past few weeks. "It is too early as yet to express any view regarding those responsible for the terror, but the Jews in Palestine are determined to do everything in their power to discover the criminals whose murderous deeds and danger for the country should not be underestimated," the Zionist organ writes.

Legend of Jews "Dispossessing" Arabs From Their Land Revived in England

Zionist circles here are disturbed over the fact that the Earl of Harewood, the King's brother-in-law, is reviving the allegation that poor Arabs in Palestine are being dispossessed by Jewish land purchasing agencies.

Addressing a luncheon in Leeds today under the chairmanship of Hyman Morris, the Jewish mayor of the city, Harewood criticized the fact that "a large number of Jews were put in Palestine and allowed to buy land there." He asserted that the Jewish land purchasing companies in Palestine are selling land to Jews "under the distinct provision that nobody but Jews can be employed to work on that land."

The Earl of Harewood concluded his address by claiming that the British land policy in Palestine has "divorced the Arab peasantry from the land" since it enabled Jews to buy land from Arabs at high prices and thus dispossessed the poorer Arabs from their lands. "The Jews," he said, "have bought up Arab land at high prices and paid more than the land is worth. But 600 or 700 pounds in cash are not the same for an Arab family divorced of its land as is 500-pounds-worth of land. We have made a mistake by encouraging such land transactions in Palestine."

ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF JEWISH FEDERATIONS AND WELFARE FUNDS OPENS TOMORROW IN CHICAGO

CHICAGO, Jan. 29. (JTA)-- More than 400 leaders of Jewish Federations, Welfare Funds and Community Councils throughout the United States will gather here on Saturday to attend the opening session of the ninth annual General Assembly of the Council of Jewish Federations and Welfare Funds at which methods will be discussed on gearing the Jewish social welfare activities in this country to war requirements.

Meeting for the first time since America's entry into the war, the Assembly, at which 219 member agencies from 185 cities will be represented, will study the effects of the war on current Jewish programs for relief and reconstruction overseas, refugee needs in this country, national and local phases of civic protective programs, and problems of fund-raising and budgeting in local communities.

The confidence that "the Assembly will develop policies which will aid American Jewish community organizations in making a maximum contribution to the nation's war effort" was expressed here today by Sidney Hollander, president of the Council. He stressed the importance of the first war-time Assembly and urged American Jewish leaders "to strive for unity and harmony of purpose in 1942."

War-Time Programs To Be Discussed Saturday and Sunday

The opening session on Saturday night will be devoted to a discussion of "Welfare Programs on a War Basis." Mr. Hollander will open the Assembly and Samuel Markell of Boston, chairman of the General Assembly Program Committee, will introduce the Assembly program. Speakers at this session will be Harris Perlstein, President of the Jewish Charities, Chicago; Amos Deinar, Board Member, Federation for Jewish Service, Minneapolis; Leon Sunstein, President of the Jewish Welfare Fund, Philadelphia, and William J. Shroder of Cincinnati, chairman of the Council's board of directors.

The second general session, Sunday morning, February 1, will deal with "War-Time Programs of Federations." The discussion leaders will include George Z. Medalie, President of the Federation for the Support of Jewish Philanthropic Societies, New York; Maurice B. Hexter, assistant executive vice-president of the New York Federation; Samuel A. Goldsmith, executive director, Jewish Charities, Chicago, and Robert J. Koshland, Board Member, Federation of Jewish Charities, San Francisco.

A review of the status of the civic protective programs will highlight the Sunday afternoon meeting. Opening the discussion will be James Marshall of New York, Edgar J. Kaufmann of Pittsburgh, Max Simon of Cleveland, and Maurice Taylor, executive director of the Federation of Jewish Philanthropies, Pittsburgh. A discussion of fund-raising problems in 1942, with particular regard to the war situations, will take place Sunday night.

UNITY BETWEEN ZIONISTS AND REVISIONISTS IN SO. AFRICA IS RESULT OF PALESTINE PACT

LONDON, Jan. 29. (JTA)-- The administrative committee of the New Zionist Organization today decided to request the NZO in South Africa to cable the full text of the agreement which it has reached with the South African Zionist Federation. Meanwhile the administrative committee is refraining from issuing any comment on this act which brings the Revisionists back into the ranks of the general Zionist movement.

It was disclosed here today that the agreement between the Revisionists and the Zionists in South Africa was signed on the basis of a pact concluded between the Revisionists and the Histadruth leaders in Tel Aviv in November, 1940. This pact provided for the acceptance by the Zionist organization of a number of points advocated by the NZO program.

NO CENSORSHIP ON JEWISH RECRUITMENT APPEALS IN PALESTINE, BRITISH OFFICIAL SAYS

LONDON, Jan. 29. (JTA)-- Statements voiced at various times in the British Parliament charging that the censor in Palestine has prevented Jewish newspapers there from publishing reports stimulating Jewish recruitment were denied here last night by George Hall, British Under-Secretary for Colonies.

Answering a question posed by A. Creech Jones, Independent Conservative member of the Parliament, Hall declared that recruiting leaflets prepared by the Jewish Agency were approved by the British military authorities and were distributed without any material alterations being ordered. There was no attempt to expugn appeals to Jewish national feelings from these leaflets, he maintained.

The Under-Secretary for Colonies also informed the House of Commons that Jewish recruits were allowed to wear blue-and-white armbands, the only proviso being that a red stripe be added to the badges to indicate, by the color combination, that the soldiers had joined the British forces. To this the Agency agreed, Hall said. The Colonial Under-Secretary also denied that Jewish recruiting meetings had been suppressed.

SWITZERLAND LIFTS BAN ON JEWISH RITUAL SLAUGHTERING

ZURICH, Jan. 29. (JTA)-- Jewish ritual slaughtering which has been prohibited throughout Switzerland since 1893 on the assumption that Jewish slaughtering methods are cruel to animals, will henceforth be permitted in Zurich municipal abattoirs, according to a decision adopted by the municipal council here.

The decision authorizes the municipal abattoirs to slaughter cattle in accordance with the Jewish laws, providing that the animals are stunned first by electricity. This method, which also existed in Holland until the Nazi occupation was approved by the Zurich rabbinate which was consulted by the municipality prior to its adopting the new regulations.

The Health Department, announcing the decision of the municipal council, added the following statement: "The method of slaughtering authorized by the Zurich municipality in order to enable the Jewish population to secure meat is humane in the best sense of the word."

JEWISH INTERNEES IN AUSTRALIA TO BE RELEASED FOR WAR WORK, ARMY MINISTER ANNOUNCES

MELBOURNE, Jan. 29. (JTA)-- "Friendly internees" confined in camps in Australia, after having been brought here from the United Kingdom, will be used for war work on a voluntary basis, it was announced here today by Army Minister Francis M. Forde.

According to Mr. Forde's announcement, the decision to use the refugees, most of whom are Jewish, for war activities followed assurances from the British Government that the majority of them were friendly to the Allied cause. The men, it was announced, will be used in labor corps, while those under eighteen years old will be taught occupations. Women internees and aged and infirm men will also be released providing that they have adequate means of support.

YESHIVA COLLEGE LIBRARY SETS UP AIR-RAID PROTECTION SYSTEM

NEW YORK, Jan. 29. (JTA)-- Plans for protecting its 40,000 books and manuscripts in the advent of an air-raid have been formulated by Yeshiva College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, it was announced here today. The Yeshiva Library possesses a number of rare manuscripts and valuable 16th century books.

NEW YORK ASSEMBLYMAN PROTESTS ADMISSION OF ANTI-SEMITIC LEADER TO THE BAR

ALBANY, Jan. 29. (JTA)-- A resolution protesting the admission to the bar of John F. Cassidy, leader of the Christian Front in Brooklyn, has been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Assemblyman Patrick H. Sullivan of New York City. Cassidy was charged with conspiracy to overthrow the U.S. Government, but was subsequently acquitted.

In his resolution, Mr. Sullivan states that "the ideology of the Christian Front, as exemplified by Cassidy, is contrary to true Americanism and true Christianity. The doctrines of hate preached by Cassidy on the street-corners of Brooklyn against the President and the Jews are un-American and un-Christian." Cassidy's application for admission to the bar has been before the Appellate Division's Committee on Character and Fitness in Brooklyn for two years. Secret hearings have been held since last July before a special committee including William Pinkney Hamilton, Jr., Oscar Lewis and Joseph F. Rudden.

Sullivan charged, in his resolution, that among other things, on November 24, 1941, at a Coughlinite meeting in Philadelphia, Cassidy stated that "President Roosevelt is either insane or a liar - is a pagan - and is misleading and misguiding everybody..." and the "Christian people" don't know the truth of what's going on "because the people who talk with their hands control the press and radio." On April 4, 1939, at a meeting held in Brooklyn, Cassidy declared that President Roosevelt could not be impeached, but "the only possible way of getting rid of him was for somebody to murder him."

EQUALITY FOR NEGROES ASKED BY CENTRAL CONFERENCE OF AMERICAN RABBIS

ST. LOUIS, Jan. 29. (JTA)-- Stressing the "Jewish belief in the equality of all races," the Commission on Justice and Peace of the Central Conference of American Rabbis today issued a statement here asking equality for Negroes who "are victims of harsh discrimination and flagrant injustices which cry aloud to God and man for remedy and redress."

Released in connection with "Race Relations Week," which begins February 8, the statement points out that "we Jews who ourselves have been victims of injustice should be especially sensitive to this. If our prayers and repentance, joined with that of Americans of other faiths, truly touch us...we shall proceed in cooperation with men of good will to remove barriers and to eliminate injustices which undermine democracy and weaken faith, to the end that the pleas of millions of useful, decent Americans for justice will be answered."
