SHIP LEAVES PALESTINE WITH FOOD FOR GREEKS; FURTHER FOOD RESTRICTIONS FOR WARSAW GHETTO

LONDON, March 15. (JTA)-- British authorities today announced that a Swedish ship left Haifa yesterday for Greece carrying a cargo of wheat for the Greek people starving under Axis occupation. The ship was chartered by the British Government, the announcement said.

Jewish organizations here believe that their appeals for British permission to send food to the starving Jews in the ghettos of Poland will be dealt with as generously as in the case of the starving Greeks. A Jewish memorandum on this problem is now in the hands of the proper British authorities for consideration.

The Krakauer Zeitung, a Nazi paper published in Cracow, which reached here today via neutral countries, reports that the Nazi authorities in Warsaw have taken stronger measures to prevent food trickling into the ghetto from the surrounding villages. The paper states that Jews from the Warsaw ghetto have been stealing out to the neighboring townships where they buy food from local Polish peasants and even from Germans and find their way with it back into the ghetto. The Nazi commissar for Warsaw has therefore ordered that a thorough check be made on all trains and carts en route to Warsaw from neighboring districts.

JEWS FORBIDDEN TO ENTER NORWAY, DANISH PATRIOT ARRESTED FOR OPPOSING ANTI-JEWISH LAWS

STOCKHOLM, March 15. (JTA)-- The entrance of Jews and non-Aryans into Norway will henceforth be forbidden under a special order of the Quisling government announced over the Oslo radio today.

Swedish newspapers today report that the reason for the re-arrest of the famous Danish patriot Lacour was his open stand against the anti-Jewish laws in Denmark. Lacour and other Danish patriots have also openly criticized the anti-Jewish measures in Germany, the papers here state.

JEWISH CHILDREN FROM NAZI-OCCUPIED COUNTRIES EXCLUDED FROM SWISS WELFARE PLAN

BERNE, March 15. (JTA)-- No Jewish children will be included among the 10,000 starving boys and girls whom Switzerland is ready to admit from Nazi-occupied countries for short vacations, it was learned here today.

The exclusion of Jewish children from the vacation scheme is due to the inability to secure return visas for them since such permits are not issued to Jews in occupied countries, Swiss officials explained.

FORD SEEKS SUPPRESSION OF "INTERNATIONAL JEW" IN LATIN-AMERICAN COUNTRIES

DETROIT, March 15. (JTA)-- Acting upon instructions from Henry Ford, the lawyers of the Detroit auto magnate are now taking measures to suppress the circulation in Latin-American countries of the anti-Semitic book, "The International Jew," a Spanish edition of which is being spread by Nazi agents in Mexico, Argentina, Chile and other countries of the Western Hemisphere, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency was assured here today.

"The cowardly and insidious propaganda to which you refer had been previously called to Mr. Ford's attention and we have been doing everything that is humanly possible to stop it," Mr. I. A. Capizzi, Mr. Ford's attorney, said. He condemned "the treacherous men who seek to cause disharmony by sowing seeds of intolerance in the name of the man who is doing more than any other one manufacturer to protect our tolerant way of life."

Spanish editions of "The International Jew" giving Henry Ford as the author, have been printed in Argentina for the last three years, the last edition reaching 25,000 copies. An edition of the book has also appeared in Chile. Several Spanish editions of the anti-Semitic book have also been published in Barcelona.

Appeals to Mexican Government to Forbid Circulation of Anti-Semitic Book

Mr. Capizzi, acting on behalf of Henry Ford, addressed himself to Senor Miguel Aleman, Minister of Interior of Mexico, asking the Mexican Government to take measures against the dissemination of "The International Jew" in Mexico. The letter reads:

"On behalf of Mr. Henry Ford, as his legal representative, I write you relative to the alleged circulation in Mexico City and Pueblo, of a pamphlet entitled 'El Judio Internacional por Henry Ford'.

"I understand that this is the pernicious work of the German propaganda department attempting to undermine the esteem which the Mexican public have for the United States Government, by circulating a misleading and deceitful republication of articles that were retracted by Mr. Ford in 1928 and at that time disclaimed by him as being an expression of his sentiments.

"Although a copy of this pamphlet is not at our disposal, I understand that it indicates that Mr. Henry Ford is the author. This is a gross misrepresentation, because Mr. Ford in 1928 publicly denied that these articles were approved by him before their original publication, and denies that they were an expression of his views or opinions.

"In the intervening years, Mr. Ford has been diligent in his efforts to suppress any attempt to renew the circulation of these articles. Therefore, in this instance, any assistance which your office can render in effecting the cessation of this harmful exhibition of deceit and misrepresentation will be greatly appreciated."

BEN-HORIN, NZO LEADER, INJURED ON TORPEDOED LINER EN ROUTE TO NEW YORK

NEW YORK, March 15. (JTA)-- Eliahu Ben-Horin, a member of the presidency of the New Zionist Organization, was slightly injured when the ship on which he was proceeding from South Africa to New York was torpedoed off the British West Indies, the NZO office here was informed today. Ben-Horin will come the rest of the way by plane.

CASE OF POLISH JEW ARRESTED IN RUSSIA DEVELOPS INTO INTERNATIONAL ISSUE

LONDON, March 15. (JTA)-- The claim of the Soviet Government that the arrested Polish Jewish Socialist leader, Henryk Ehrlich, is no longer a Polish citizen and, therefore, Polish intervention for his release is useless, may develop into an international issue that will be raised with President Roosevelt by Gen. Wladyslaw Sikorski, the Polish Premier, it was learned here today.

Polish circles today disclosed that Gen. Sikorski is disturbed over the fact that Soviet authorities have notified the Polish embassy in Kuibyshev that some of the arrested Poles in Russia, including Ehrlich, who was born in the Lublin district, are considered Soviet citizens though they are holders of Polish passports. Their passports were delivered to the Polish embassy together with this notification. Gen. Sikorski is inclined to interpret this act as an indication that Soviet Russia lays claim to the part of Poland which was held by the Red Army before the territory was invaded by the Nazis. He therefore intends to proceed to the United States to take up the case with President Roosevelt, since it involves the post-war borders of Poland.

Jan Stanczyk, Minister of Labor and Social Welfare in the Polish Cabinet, just returned from a visit to America, today praised the American Jews in a lecture which he delivered on his impressions of the United States. "The Jews in America," he said, "are very sympathetic to the Polish cause, and they indignantly resent the efforts of Polish anti-Semites to deny them the right to love Poland."

The Polish Foreign Office today received information from Soviet Russia that Leopold Rosner, prominent Polish Zionist and former editor of the Polish-Jewish daily newspaper Nowy Dziennik in Cracow, has died in a hospital in Siberia from typhus. He is survived by his wife and son who are now in Russia.

BRITAIN OBSERVES EINSTEIN'S AND EHRLICH'S COMMON BIRTHDAY WITH BROADCASTS TO REICH

LONDON, March 15. (JTA)-- Tribute to the works of Prof. Albert Einstein and Dr. Paul Ehrlich, the two world-famous Jewish scientists, was paid by the British radio last night on the occasion of their common birthday, March 14th. The broadcasts were directed to all European countries in English and in German.

Sir Henry Dale, noted British scientist, president of the Royal Society and director of the Institute for Medical Research, speaking of Einstein's and Ehrlich's services to science, stressed the fact that "Einstein found welcome and a new opportunity to carry on his researches as a citizen of the United States." He called the two Jewish scientists "two prophets whose names are surely not without honor, save in their own country."

"Paul Ehrlich and Albert Einstein were born in Germany," Sir Henry said. "They learned German as their mother tongue. Ehrlich, indeed, never learned to speak any other. They grew up, studied, and did their work as Germans. Like all true men of science, they offered the results of their research to the world, but they offered them as part of the noble gift which German science has dedicated for the enlightenment of human happiness throughout the world. Their names are now no longer honored in Germany. At the dictation of men who now rule there, they were repudiated and marked for derision, for both were born of Jewish parents. It seems fitting that we should remember on this anniversary of their birth two men whose life and work has meant so much to science and for mankind."

YIDDISH NEWSPAPERS RESUME PUBLICATION IN URUGUAY; BAN ON FOREIGN LANGUAGES MODIFIED

MONTEVIDEO, Uruguay, March 15. (JTA)-- The two Yiddish newspapers, "Folksblatt" and "Unzer Frint" resumed publication here today following a decree issued by the Uruguayan Government modifying the ban on foreign-language newspapers, which had been proclaimed in January. The new decree authorizes the re-appearance of all foreign-language democratic publications and permits Yiddish radio broadcasts.

GERMAN-JEWISH GROUP OPPOSES FORMATION OF NATIONAL FIGHTING UNITS WITHIN U.S. ARMY

NEW YORK, March 15. (JTA)-- German-Jewish aliens in the United States today voiced their opposition to a proposed plan of organizing special national fighting units within the American Army when the American Federation of Jews from Central Europe adopted a resolution urging that German Jewish aliens be permitted to serve as American soldiers within the ranks of the American army.

The resolution declared that Jews who emigrated from Germany have come here to find "a new homeland" and to become citizens of the United States. "As American citizens of tomorrow," it stated, "we desire to become American soldiers of today." Rudolf Callmann is president of the Federation and Max M. Warburg is chairman of the Board of Directors.

POST-WAR SETTLEMENT MUST PROVIDE FOR ALL MINORITIES, MASARYK DECLARES AT UJA MEETING

NEW YORK, March 15. (JTA)-- Jan Masaryk, Minister of Foreign Affairs and Deputy Premier of the Czechoslovakian Government-in-exile, declared today that he would never consent to a post-war settlement which did not provide for the rights of all minorities, including the Jews.

The statement was made at a conference of 5,000 representatives of Jewish fraternal and benevolent organizations in this city assembled at Manhattan Center to formulate plans for the participation of their organizations in the War Emergency Campaign of the United Jewish Appeal. The conference was held under the auspices of the Council of Organizations of the United Jewish Appeal. Max Ogust, executive chairman of the Council, presided. The Polish Government-in-Exile was represented by Consul J. K. Krasicki who read a message of support from Polish Foreign Minister Raczynski. Baroness Bethsabée de Rothschild, of the French branch of the Rothschild family, who is now a refugee in the United States, gave the conference an eye-witness account of the work of the Joint Distribution Committee, one of the agencies of the United Jewish Appeal, in France.

Other speakers included Rabbi Jonah B. Wise, chairman of the U.J.A.; Dr. Stephen S. Wise, Judge Jonah J. Goldstein, of the Court of General Sessions, and William Rosenwald, associate chairman of the United Jewish Appeal and President of the National Refugee Service.

ZIONIST GROUPS PRESENT RABBI WISE WITH "SCROLL OF TRIBUTE" ON HIS 68th BIRTHDAY

NEW YORK, March 15. (JTA)-- The political and military importance of the Middle East lands, including Palestine, to the cause of America and the United Nations, was emphasized by Dr. Stephen S. Wise, Mayor LaGuardia, Senator William H. King, Dr. Israel Goldstein and other speakers who addressed the "Land for Victory" banquet held last night in the Hotel Astor in tribute to Dr. Stephen S. Wise on the occasion of his 68th birthday and to mark the 40th anniversary of the Jewish National Fund.

More than 1,200 guests attended the function which was arranged by the fraternal organization Order Sons of Zion. About 120 Jewish organizations and groups were signatories to a Scroll of Tribute which was presented to Dr. Wise by Judge Rothenberg. Each of the signatories contributed to the Jewish National Fund for the acquisition of one acre of land in Palestine.

Messages of tribute to Dr. Wise were received from Vice-President Henry Wallace, Secretary of the Navy Frank Knox, Secretary of the Interior Harold L. Ickes and Governor Herbert H. Lehman.
