### JEWISH STATE IN PALESTINE WILL RESULT FROM VICTORY OF UNITED NATIONS, WEIZMANN SAYS

NEW YORK, June 10. (JTA)-- The belief that "a Jewish Homeland in Palestine" will inevitably result from the victory of the democratic nations in the present war was expressed here tonight by Dr. Chaim Weizmann, President of the Jewish Agency for Palestine and world leader of the Zionist movement, at a dinner tendered him at the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel attended, by leaders from all walks of Jewish life as well as by many prominent non-Jewish notables.

President Roosevelt sent a message of "personal greetings" to the dinner expressing his "high appreciation of Dr. Weizmann's scientific and humanitarian achievements during the course of his long and distinguished career." Messages of greeting were also received from Frank Knox, Secretary of the Navy, Henry Morgenthau, Jr., Secretary of the Treasury, the British Ambassador, Lord Halifax, Governor Herbert H. Lehman, Wendell Willkie and others.

Declaring that he is "unshakably convinced that all roads to the solution of the Jewish problem inescapably lead to the Jewish Homeland on the shores of the Mediterranean," Dr. Weizmann said that while Czechs, Poles, Greeks, Dutch, Belgians and Frenchmen, after the victorious conclusion of the war, will be able to return to a normal life, this is not so in the case of the Jews who have been robbed of all their possessions by the Nazis and whose livelihood has been destroyed.

"The Jews," Dr. Weizmann stated, "when military victory has been achieved, will be left as a floating population between heaven and hell, not knowing where to turn. How great their number will be is difficult to predict. To speak of 4,000,000 is no exaggeration. In any event, one thing is certain, beyond statistical speculation: These Jews will be homeless."

Appealing to the world to give the Jews "a place in God's wide world where we Jews could live and express ourselves in accordance with our character, and make our contribution to the civilized world in our own way and through our own channels," Dr. Weizmann emphasized that this place must be Palestine. "I believe that after the war Jews everywhere can gain in status and security only through the rise of a Jewish State, and this would be especially the case if that state is a part of the British Commonwealth," he said.

Dr. Weizmann assured his audience that in such a state there will be complete civil and political equality for all citizens, without distinction of race or religion, and, in addition, the Arabs will enjoy full autonomy in their own internal affairs. "We should be ready, if necessary, to consider joining, under proper safeguards, in a federation with Arab states," he declared.

Other speakers at the dinner included Dorothy Thompson, Dr. Stephen S. Wise, Judge Louis E. Levinthal and Dr. Israel Goldstein.

JEWISH GROUPS TOLD HOW TO HANDLE COMPLAINTS ON DISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT

NEW YORK, June 10. (JTA)-- The Jewish Occupational Council today issued a report explaining how Jewish groups can effectively handle complaints of employment discrimination. The report is prepared by the Coordinating Committee of Jewish Organizations Dealing with Employment Discrimination in War Industries.

Jewish groups accepting complaints of discrimination, the report recommends, should obtain the story first-hand from the person who has had the actual experience. Telephone calls, letters, or reports from friends are regarded as unsatisfactory.

A visit to a company is considered "sufficiently important to be taken to the top management" and "should raise the question of Jewish employment frankly." If discussion with the employer confirms the original complaint and fails "to evoke any change in the company's attitude to Jewish employment," the complaint should be certified to the Minorities Representative of the Regional Labor Supply Committee of the federal government. A list of the Regional Labor Supply Committees, together with addresses, is reproduced in the report.

Complaints reported to the federal government, according to the report, should contain all the necessary identifying information in addition to "everything you have found to substantiate the charge that the applicant was not hired because he was Jewish." In the event that a complaint is not satisfactorily handled by the Regional Labor Supply Committee, the Jewish Occupational Council will undertake to follow it up in Washington with the President's Committee on Fair Employment Practice.

JEWISH SOCIAL WORKERS PLEDGE UNSTINTING AID TO PRESIDENT AND UNITED NATIONS

ROCHESTER, N.Y., June 10. (JTA)-- A pledge of unstinting aid to the nation and President Roosevelt in the struggle for victory was adopted here yesterday at the closing session of the annual meeting of the National Conference of Jewish Social Welfare, which was attended by more than 700 social workers from all sections of the country.

The delegates promised to "contribute fully, generously and unstintingly all our resources as individuals and our abilities as professional persons and all the resources of our Jewish agencies and institutions as our contribution towards victory of the United Nations under the leadership of our Commander-in-Chief, our President Franklin D. Roosevelt."

A resolution urging the Jewish community to "build the inner defenses through Jewish religious education, particularly in war-time, as a means of maintaining and promoting morale in this period of trial" was adopted by the National Council for Jewish Education, which held its annual meeting here in conjunction with the welfare group. Rabbi Samuel M. Blumenfeld, Dean of the College of Jewish Studies in Chicago, was re-elected president of the Council.

NAZIS ESTABLISH NEW GHETTO IN VILNA DISTRICT; ORDER JEWS TO FORCED LABOR

STOCKHOLM, June 10. (JTA)-- The establishment of a ghetto for the Jewish population in Swir, a town in the Vilna district, and the mobilization of all able-bodied Jews there for forced labor was ordered by the local Nazi occupation authorities, according to a report published in the Deutsche Zeitung im Ostland which reached here today.

PROMINENT BRITONS, CZECHOSLOVAKS, POLES PROTEST PERSECUTION OF SLOVAKIAN JEWS

LONDON, June 10. (JTA)-- A mass-meeting of 300 prominent Jewish and Christian Englishmen, Czechoslovaks and Poles today adopted a resolution protesting against the persecution and deportation of the Jews of Slovakia and expressing the hope that "a speedy-victory of the United Nations will bring a righteous peace and restore freedom to Czechoslovakia."

Lord Strabolgi, British Laborite peer, told the meeting, which was called by the Federation of Czechoslovakian Jews, that he would demand that the British government issue a formal protest to the world. Oliver Locker-Lampson, Conservative M.P., stated he would do likewise. Rhys Davies, Laborite M.P., revealed that he had placed on the agenda of the House of Commons the question of whether it was possible to send food and medicine to Slovakia's Jews. Messages from Cardinal Hinsley, Catholic Primate of England, President Benes of the Czechoslovakian Government-in-exile and others were read to the audience.

JEWISH PIONEER WOMEN'S CONFERENCE CALLS FOR ALL-OUT EFFORTS IN WAR EMERGENCY

DETROIT, June 10. (JTA)-- With 300 delegates, representing 235 clubs in the United States and Canada, in attendance, the eighth national convention of the Pioneer Women's Organization of America opened here today at the Book Cadillac Hotel. The keynote address tonight was delivered by Dr. Haym Greenberg, editor of the Jewish Frontier.

Speakers at the opening session reaffirmed their faith in Palestine and called for renewed efforts in the present war emergency, especially in behalf of the women's activities inaugurated as emergency measures, with the aid of the Pioneer Women of America.

DUBINSKY PRESENTS \$50,000 CHECK FOR BRITISH RELIEF TO SIR WALTER CITRINE

NEW YORK, June 10. (JTA)-- A check for \$50,000 was presented here today by David Dubinsky, Jewish labor leader and president of the International Ladies Garment Workers' Union, to Sir Walter Citrine to be used as initial payment for a home in London to be used as a club for American and British sailors.

The ceremony took place at a luncheon tendered Sir Walter, British Labor leader, at the Hotel Commodore. Speakers at the luncheon disclosed that the Jewish Labor Committee in New York has raised more than \$500,000 which was spent on war relief activities and in helping leaders of the labor movement in Nazi-held Europe seek safety in overseas countries.

ARGENTINE COMMITTEE SENDS 17,000 FOOD PARCELS TO REFUGEES IN FRENCH CAMPS

BUENOS AIRES, June 10. (JTA)-- More than 17,000 parcels of food have been sent to interned refugees in French concentration camps by the Argentine committee to aid prisoners in French camps, which was founded by Dr. Bruno Weil, who is now in New York, it was announced here today. About 9,000 of these parcels were sent by friends and relatives of the internees, while the remainder were sent by the committee from funds contributed by interested persons.

BRITISH RELIEF AND WRITERS' GROUPS MOURN DEATH OF ABRAHAM GOLDBERG

LONDON, June 10. (JTA)-- The Federation of Relief Organizations here and the Polish-Jewish Relief Fund today cabled the Federation of Polish Jews in America expressing their condolences on the death of Abraham Goldberg, Zionist leader and writer, who died last Friday in New York. A similar message was sent to the Yiddish Writers' Union in New York by the Association of Jewish Journalists and Authors.
