SYRIA SUPPLIES NAZIS WITH GRAIN; UPSETS BRITISH FOOD POLICY IN PALESTINE

LONDON, Oct. 6.(JTA) — The sensational assertion that Syria, which is now under the central of the United Nations, is supplying Nami Germany with substantial wheat supplies affecting the feed situation in Pelestine and in the entire Middle East, is made today in an article written by the Jorusalen correspondent of the London Economist, Britain's leading paper on occurring questions.

The writer believes that large quantities of wheat and other grains are delivered from Syria to Germany through Turkey which is serving as a transit market for the Hazis. German troops and efficials in Greece are similarly being fed on wheat coming from Syria, he declares. He substantiates this charge with figures indicating that for the last few menths there has been an abnormally heavy demand for wheat and other grains in Syria, with prices much higher than the price fixed by the governments.

This development, the article points out, is harmful to the Allied cuase not only because it helps food the Mazia and their armics with food secured in countries under Allied central, but also because it upsets the price stebilization policy of the Palestine Government and of the British relitary authorities in the Hear Easts. It also nokes it increasingly difficult for the British authorities in Palestine to suppress blackmarketing of grain by Arabs who are in constant touch with Arab grain norchants in Syrias

It has been established that though the Palestine Government is now paying as high as \$140 for a ten of wheat, which is three times higher than the pre-war price, government purchasing agents are encountering great difficulties in obtaining the necessary quantities of grain in the Near East, the article reveals. Somehow, despite the strict making against suggling, the grain in the Near Eastern countries gravitates towards the highest harket, thus upsetting the grain monopoly in Palestine and other British-controlled countries which can only function when standard prices and a uniform market is maintained throughout the Edddle East.

Palostino Mayors Ask Government to Roduco Price of Wheat

JERUSALEM, Oct. 6.(JTA) — A plea to the Palestine Government to reduce the price of wheat from the present level of \$140 per ten to the former price of \$84 will be submitted by the municipalities of Palestine's four largest cities, it was announced here today following a meeting of the mayors of Jerusalem, Tel Aviv, Heifa and Jaffa.

The meeting was one of the series of consultations hold at intervals by the mayors to discuss supply-and-price questions. The meeting also decided to request that the price of fish be fixed.

SWEDISH PAPER SCORES HITLER'S THREAT TO STOP JEWISH LAUGHTER

STOCKHOIM, Oct. 6.(JTA) -- Hitler's threat to Jows that "their laughter will coase gverywhere," which he voiced in his address at the Sport Palace in Berlin last week, is sharply conderned today by the Swedish conservative newspaper, Nya Wermlands-Tidningon.

"One receils in herror before the cold, deliberate cynicism of these words, envisioning a termented, misorable people," the paper writes. "They have been beited; hunted without limit. Relembless persecutions have been carried out with nother dical prefoundness, and the concentration camps in which they have been placed have written a new chapter in the history of European 'civilizations' Their herrible fate, and the risery into which they have been plunged, appeals to the sympathy of the ordinary people. Hitler is exalted above such human wedness and looks forward to a world wherein fanaticism and racial hatred will obliterate all chance for life.

"If Hitlor attains his goal, laughter will cortainly become a rare thing, in our world. Joy has already died in Poland, Belgium, Helland, France, Greece, Yugo-slavia, Donnark and Norway," the paper concludes.

NAZI SOLDIERS USE JEWISH INFANTS FOR FOOTBALLS, JEWISH RED ARMY MAN RELATES

KUIBYSHEV, Oct. 6.(JTA) - A Red Arry soldier new fighting on the Stalingrad front today gave an account of a horrible massacre of Jewish children which took place last July in Pogrebistchi, in the Masi-cocupied Kiev district, from where he escaped last months

In a story appearing in the Soviet press, the soldier, twenty-six-year-old Abraham Fivusavitsch, stated that one reisy day last July 600 Jowish families from the towns of Lipowitz, Kastin and Skaira were driven to Pogrebistohi, There the men were ordered to the Reshevoutsky Forcet where they hauled logs for four days. On the fifth day they were assembled and instructed by an Italian efficer to clean the athletic statium in Pogrebistohi "otherwine they would be hung from the logs they hauled into town." By July 27 the stadium was cleared. That evening all the Jows - mon, weren and children, well or ill - were ordered to be at the stadium. The near were placed in one section and the wemen in another. The women, of whem there were about 500, were instructed to held their children in their arms.

"A fow minutes after we had all assembled, a group of German soldiers, drossed in athletic uniforms, entered the stadium," Fivuscritech relates. "The Germans smatched the infants from their mothers' arms and used them for balls, beuncing and kicking them around the arena. In a short time the ground was dremand with blood and the stadium was filled with the anguished cries of the wenon whose child-ran ware being mardered before their eyes. I succeeded in escaping that same might, and reached the Red Army lines in August. I learned, however, that many of the Jows who had been forced to witness the mass are became insame while others died of frights"

CANADIAN GOVERNMENT DONATES \$60,000 MACHINERY FOR ORT SCHOOL TO TRAIN WAR WORKERS

IDNITERAL, Oct. 6.(JTA) — The fodoral Government in Canada has denoted machinery worth \$60,000 for a new ORT institution to train war workers, it was announced here today by Louis Fitch, president of the Canadian ORT Organization. The new vocational training school, located in Montreal, will open soon with an annual capacity of about 600 traines, men and women, who will be employed in war factories upon completing the short-term courses in mechanical trains.

ONLY 100,000 JE'S LEFT BY THE NAZIS IN WARSAN GHETTO; MASS-DEPORTATIONS CONTINUE

GENEVA, Oct. 6.(JTA) - Only about 100,000 Jows have been left by the Mazis in the Warsam ghette where only a few norths ago 500,000 Jovs were concentrated, it was reliably reported here today on the basis of information reaching Switzerland from cocupied Feland.

Large-scale mass-deportations of Jows from the warsaw chette have been going on during the last few months. The Jows are being deported to unknown destinations. Families are being term apart, probably never to be reunited. The deportations have increased since the dissolution by the Gestape of the Jowish Geumeil in the Warsaw chette which followed the suicide of Adam Cherniakev, president of the Council, who preferred to take his life rather than sanction the first mass-deportation of 100,000 Jows from the Chette to the devastated sections of Mazi-eccupied Russia.

Deportations of Jows from the Warsaw ghette are new taking place every day, the information reaching here states. It emphasizes that the Maxis have definitely embarked on a program of "dissolving" all ghettes in Feland by deporting the Jows from there to unknown destinations in devestated regions.

AMERICAN FEDERATION OF LABOR URGES U.S. TO PLAN POST-WAR RELIEF FOR EUROPE

TOROFTO, Oct. 6.(JTA) - A recommendation that the United States, as the leading world power, should take upon itself the responsibility of planning and preparing post-war relief for the people of Europe, suffering from mass-starvation and enddenies, was made here today in a report submitted by the Executive Council of the American Federation of Labor to the 62nd annual convention of the AFL which opened here yesterday. Another recommendation urges that racial equality be assured in the European continent after the fell of the Nazi regime.

William Groom, president of the American Federation of Labor, addressing a protest necting against Mazi atrocities held at the Royal Park Motel here, pointed out that what is happening to the Jows of Burope "is our business." He emphasized that the compaign which Hitler started against the Jows was but canouflage to hide his propertions for the present war. "How could any community witness the exprepriation of the Jows, the deprivation of their civil rights, their displacement from the occasional life, the beatings and the concentration camps and the poprous, without becoming aware of the danger to itselft," he asked. He expressed his confidence in the defeat of Mazism and in the post-war establishment of a denocratic section where there will be no distinction between people as to race, religion or colors.

SWISS GOVERNMENT APPOINTS SPECIAL COMMISSIONER TO SUPERVISE REFUGEE PROBLEMS

BERN, Oct. 6.(JTA) -- The Swiss Government has appointed a special corresionor in charge of refugee problems as a result of the recent influx into Switzerland of more than 2,000 refugees from France, it was auncumced here today.

It was stated at the same time over the Swiss radio that persons who have flod to Switzerland may be exempt from ponalties for illegal crossing of the border if this is justified by the seriousness of their situation.

GOVERNMENT URGED TO MODIFY THE NATURALIZATION PROCESS BY EASING REQUIREMENTS

NEW YORK, Oct. 6.(JTA) -- Stating that "certain parts of the present procedure too often serve to lower the norale of non-citizens, who become discouraged and confused by the lengthly waiting periods involved in each step of the naturalization process, unnecessary technicalities and arbitrary procedure," the harriest Cornttoo for Protection of Foreign Born today urged adjustment of the naturalization procedure as a "war-time necessity" in a special memorandum submitted to the Innigration and Naturalization Service.

The nonorandum recommends substitution of a new 6-step precedure for the naturalization of non-citizens in place of the present 12 steps required before an alien can become an American citizens. It recommends also that the present requirements for a Cortificate of Lanful Entry be made less severe and that the present date of July 1, 1924, be advanced to 1930.

Two other recommendations are the elimination of educational and literacy requirements for non-citizens, 50 years of age or elder, who have resided in the United States since 1924 and that the naturalization laws be amended to enable all non-citizens inducted into the armed forces of the United States to become citizens invadiately, regardless of the namer in which they entered the country.

CLERGYMEN OF ALL FAITHS MEET TO STUDY POST-WAR RESPONSIBILITIES

NET YORK, Out. 6.(FA) - The Institute for Religious Studies, a graduate . school conducted by Catholic, Jowish and Protestant scholars, opened today at the Jowish Tohological Schinary. This institute has been established by a gift from Lucius N. Littauer to enable ministers of all faiths to study under the guidance of eminent theologicals of the various denominations.

MINUMEAFOLIS, Minne, Oct. 6. JENISH AIRMAN FROM CANADA AWARDED DISTINGUISHED FLYING CROSS IN ENGLAND
