GESTAFO TORTURE OF JEWS IN WARSAW PRISONS REFORTED, LIST OF GUILTY HAZIS FUELISHED

LONDON, Oct. 18.(JTA) -- Hazi cruelties inflicted upon Jews in Gestage prisons are described today in the official organ of the Foliah Government, which announced last night that it had compiled a list of 5,000 Nesi wer oriminals in Poland selected for post-war trial on charges of instigating structies against the civilian population, including the mass-executions of Polish Jews and the introduction of ghettos.

The first ten Nazi leaders slated for punishment include the German governor for Poland, Hans Frank, charged among other things with the establishment of ghettes, Ludwig Fischer, the Hazi governor for Warsaw, responsible for mass-executions of Jews, and the Gestapo leader S. Globotchnik, charged with killing thousands of Jews in the Jublin district.

The torture of Jews in the prisons was related in testimony given by a Polish civilian who succeeded in escaping from Poland after being held for six months in a Gestapo prison in Warsaw. He revealed that Jews are shot daily in the courtyards of the prison after being compelled to dig their own graves.

Jewish Prisoners Compelled to Dance and Shouts"Hitler is a Great Man"

The Jewish prisoners, his report states, are separated from the non-Jewish when taken into the prison ward for exercise. Then they undergo a special kind of exercise which consists of holding hends and dancing around in a circle shouting "Hitler is a great man."

"The favorite sport of the Gestapo quards is to force non-Jowish prisoners to punch the faces of the Jewish prisoners," the eye-witness writes. "Jewish new-comers are forced to sleep during the first two weeks of their confinement in a cupboard containing two pails which serve as an improvised lavatory. They always faint. But when other prisoners try to help them by opening the cupboard door, the Gestapo guards who keep an all-night watch rush in and beat up all the prisoners in the cell."

The escaped Polish civilian also relates a story of how a Jewish prisoner in the Worsew joil went mad and shricked as he had been taught to. "I am a dirty Jew," when witnessing another Jew being tortured in the cell. The tortured Jew was charged by the Gestapo with having a large stock of clothing hidden away.

"In front of all of us prisoners, the Gestapo men tried to force the Jewish merchant to "confess" that the charge against him was justifici and to reveal where the clothing was hidden," the Fole writes. "When the Jew repeatedly denied the charge, he was highed with a leather whip intermoven with strends of steel wire. He collapsed and was loft on the floor unconscious for several hours. When he regained consciousness, the torture was resumed in front of us with such brutality that it was no wonder that one of the Jewish prisoners became insens."

ZOA, HADASSAH CONVENTIONS CLOSE; AS UNRESTRICTED JEWISE IMMIGRATION TO PALESTINE

NEW YORK, Oct. 13.(JTA) -- A resolution demanding that "the gates of Palestine be opened to Jewish immigration;" that the Jewish money be vested with control of immigration into Felestine; and that "Pelestine be established as a Jowish Commonwealth integrated into the structure of the democratic world" was adopted last night at a joint session of the Lionist Organization of America and the Hadassah, meeting at the Hotel Waldorf-Astoria.

The resolution also opposed the program of the newly-formed Ichud party, which advocates a bi-national state in Falestine, but endorsed "the policy of friendship and cooperation with the Arabs of Falestine affirmed by successive Zionist Congresses."

Judgo Louis E. Levinthal of Philadelphia was reelected president of the Zionist Organization and Dr. Junes G. Heller of Cincinnati was reelected as chairman of the national advisory committee of the ZOA. Dr. Earry Friedenwald of Egitimore and Judge Julian Ecok of New York were chosen as henorry vice-presidents.

Mrs. Tamar de Sola Pool was reclected president of Radassah after a heated session provoked by her announcement that she did not wish to run for reclection because of the delegates' adoption of the resolution repudiating the Ichud program. Since she had been a leader of the fight to have the Ichud policy endorsed by the Radassah, has Pool said she did not feel that she should continue as president after the organization had demonstrated that it disagreed with her on this issue. However, she was eventually prevailed upon to accept the nomination and was elected. Mass Juliette Bonjanin was reelected secretary of the Radassah. At the same session the women's Zienist organization adopted a budget of \$1,210,000 for war emergency activities, health and education programs, child welfare, refugee care and land reclamation work in Palestine. The delegates veted to send \$5,000 to Miss Henrietta Szeld in Palestine "to be used for any project she wishes to further."

At the final combined session, at the Penhatten Center today, Mayor La Guardia, Mrs. Pool, Louis Lipsky, former president of the ZOA, and Dr. Alexander Loudon, Methorlands Ambassacor to the United States were emong the speakers. Dr. Stephen S. Wise, who presided, referring to last night's joint session at which the resolution calling for a Jowish Commonwealth in Polestine had been adopted, declared that "the common action of the two organisations spelled the certain end of all defeations" Mrs. Pool, discussing Pelestine's port in the war, declared that "the Proc French and the Free Poles have a foothold in the Middle Eastern buttle area today only because free men live in Pelestine." Mrs. Lipsky assailed the British administration of the Pelestine mandate and emphasized that the Jows there have "used their opportunities to their own credit and to the credit of the Empire."
Drs. Loudon also landed Falestine's war efforts for their great value to the United Nations.

Also stressing the role that Palestine is playing in the Allied war effort in the Wear East, Dr. Chaim Weizmann, president of the World Zionist Organization, who was unable to be present at the convention because he is convuleating from a recent illness, sent a message in which he urged that the democracies of the world, including the United States, further the demand of the Jewish people "to rebuild Palestine as their commonwealth, free and unhampered." Dr. Weizmann's message deprecated Britain's failure to make full use of the available Jewish manpower in Palestine. He appealed to American Zionists to maintain unity in their ranks so as to best Coster the Zionist cause.

NAZIS SEND ANOTHER 600 BELGIUM JEWS TO CONSTRUCT COASTAL FORTIFICATIONS IN FRANCE

LOHDON. Oct. 18.(JTA) -- Another 600 Belgian Jovs have been shipped to the coast of northern France by the Mazi occupational authorities to work on the fortifications the Germans are constructing there, in fear of an Allied invasion of the continuit, it was disclosed today by official Selgian circles.

PALESTINE GOVERNMENT WILL SUPPLY STANDARD "UTILITY" CLOTHES AT FIXED PRICES

JERUSALEM, Oct. 10.(JTA) -- The population of Palestine will henceforth be able to purchase standard "utility" clothes, supplied by the Palestine Government at fixed prices, it was announced today in the Official Gasetto. The clothes will be made of standard cloth in a few styles. Such wearing apparel has been available to the poople of England for some time.

Other regulations governing the purchases of foodstuffs were issued today by the administration. A purchaser of sugar, flour or bread must do all his buying in one store. At the request of the consumer, a retailer will issue a "commodity linking card" for those products. The card must be presented when making all purchases and does not take the place of ration coupons which still must be surrandered for each product bought.

New Ration System for Food Will be Introduced in Palestine

Sharp dictary differences among the Palestine population will result shortly in institution of a new rationing system based on points, it was learned today.

The government will soon announce a "point restriction scheme" to go into offcot Novombor 1 in order to "onsure equitable distribution" of commodities which are source by limiting purchases and to comble the poorer classes to buy a fair share.

The new system will be modelled on the British system except that it will cover a far larger number of food and clothing articles. Each person will be alleted 800 points monthly. Other systems of rationing are impractical in Palestine, it was explained, because one million people (Araba) cat one diet, and a half million (Jews) cat another that is totally different. Therefore, any system of direct rationing, as of . Sigar, for example, must give one section of the community more than it wants and the other loss.

SOUTH AMERICAN GOVERNMENTS ASKED TO ADMIT JEWISH CHILDREN FROM FRANCE

MEN YORK, Oct, 18. (JTA) -- An announcement made public here today by the Mias-lea Emigration Association discloses that Sir Herbert-Emerson, the League of Nation's High Commissioner for Refugees, has addressed an urgent plea to all South American Governments, urging them to follow the example of the United States and admit refugee children from unoccupied Frence whose parents have been deported to Mari-hold territory.

1,500 JEWISH FRATERNAL ORGANIZATIONS FLEDGE SUPPORT TO NEW YORK CHARITY APPEAL

NEW YORK, Oct. 18.(JTA) -- Delegates from 1,500 Jewish fraternal and benevolent organizations, representing memberships of 500,000, unanimously passed a resolution today to support the 1942 morgod appeal of the New York and Brocklyn Federations of Jewish Charities on behalf of the 116 health and welfare agencies affiliated with the two Federations.

The delogates, assembled at the eighth Annual Convention of the Council of Fraternal and Benevolent Organizations, also elected Judge Jonah J. Goldstein of the Council of General Sossions, as president of the Council. Judge Coldstein succeeds James S. Hays who served as president for the mocessive terms. In a resolution adopted by the delegates, appreciation was expressed to Mr. Hays for his "sincere loadership and able guidance."
