ENTIRE JEWISH POPULATION IN MANY UKRAINIAN CITIES EXTERMINATED, NAZI SOLDIERS REVEAL

KULBYSHEV, Nov. 8. (JTA) -- All the Jews who remained in the cities of Berditchev, Vinnitza, Pervenniak as well as in the districts of Deepropertovsk and Zapac-reshie in the Utraine have been exterminated by the Maxis, according to testimony of German war prisoners made public here today.

Not a single Jew remains alive in all those cities, the German soldiers testified. In Odessa, Kharkov and other of the larger Ukrainian cities, ghettos have been established for Jews, the war prisoners stated. In the city of Taganrog, the extermination of the entire Jewish population was followed by a wholesale slaughter of gypsies.

In Odessa, one of the German prisoners reported, Jews have been humiliated and tortured by the occupation authorities to a point where many of them committed suicides. An average of twenty-five Jows took their lives each day in Odessa during the early months of the Axis occupation in addition to thousands who were massecred during wholesale executions. Runger and opidemic diseases are taking a heavy toll among the Jows in the Odessa ghetto, the German soldiers said.

14,000 Jews Massacrod by Nazis in Vitebsk, Shklov, Krupki

The Jowish Anti-Fascist Committee teday also published reports revealing that the Mazis massacred 7,000 Jows in Vitebsk, more than 6,000 Jows in the city of Shklov, and 1,080 Jows in the township of Krupki, all in Byelorussia.

In Vitebsk all Jows - men, women and children - were driven from the ghette to a square behind the local hospital where they were lined up in groups and machine-gumed. Their bodies were leter thrown into pits dug on the square. A number of Jows were also hanged by the Masis on gallows erooted in the yard of a local church.

In Shklov the 6,000 Jaws who constituted the entire Jawish population were executed within two days. As in Vitebsk they were driven to a square outside of the city where they were machino-gunned. During two days in succession, groups of Jaws were brought by Nasi units to the graves prepared on the square and moved down. On the third day the Nasis ordered the local non-Jawish population to come to the square of the cover the open graves, but none of the non-Jawish population to designated time. Thirty byelorussians were then rounded up by the German soldiers and forced to comply with the order. Six of them were executed for "having shirked their duty" and as a warning to other non-Jaws. Many of the Jawish victims were still alive when the graves were covered up, the horrified Byelorussians related later.

In the township of Krupki, where the Masis massered 1,080 Jews in one day in a similar manner, only two Jews were left alive. They were a sheemaker and a smith whem the Germans needed for local work.

JEWISH CONCENTRATION CAMP IN NORWAY OVERCROWDED; NAZIS OPEN NEW CAMP FOR JEWS

STOCKHOLM, Nov. 8. (JTA) -- The pro-Nazi Swedish newspaper Aftonbladet today publishes a report from Norway disclosing that the mass-arrests of Jows there are being conducted at such a rate that the "Jowish internment camp" near Bredtvedt is already overcrowded, and a second concentration camp for Jows is now being set up near Toomsberg.

The pro-Nasi paper admits that the Jows are being treated "very brutally" when taken from their homes to be transported for internment. The Quisling police strip all the jewelry from the wives and daughters of the arrested Jows, and every article of value in the ranscoked Jewish homes is stolen by the officials conducting the search, the Aftenbladet writes.

The paper believes that the majority of the arrosted Norwegian Jews will be deported to remote sections of Northern Norway for forced labor, but other reports reaching here from Norway reveal that some of the interned Jews are already being sent to Nazi-held territory in the East. Among the Horwegian Jews held in the camp near Bredtvedt are a number of rabbis, including the Chief Rabbi of Oslo, the pro-Mazi paper reports.

DUTCH JEWS URGED TO DONATE ANY CLOTHING THEY CAN SPARE TO JEWISH DEPORTEES

STOCKHOLM, Nov. 8.(JTh) -- The Jewish Council of Amsterdam today issued an appeal to the Jews in Helland who have not yet been arrested by the Nazis for deportation, asking them to denote any winter elothing and warm blankets they can spare to the Jews now held in Camp Westerbork, from where internoes are usually transported to Nazi-held territory in the Easts

Pointing out that any surplus pieces of warm clothing "will scener or later be confiscated" by the authorities, the Jowish Council urges that Jows still enjoying freedom aid the deportees by providing them with any kind of warm wearing apparel in order to keep them warm during the winter menths in the places to which they may be deported.

At the same time, the Chief Rabbi of Holland issued an appeal to religious Jows in the country to donate Bibles, philacteries, prayer showls, prayer books and other articles of Jowish ritual for the use of the Jows intermed in the Westerbork comps.

CABINET COMMITTEE PROBES EFFECT OF JEWISH DEPORTATIONS UPON RUMANIA'S ECONOMY

BERN, Nov. 8.(JTA) -- The committee appointed by the Rumanian Cabinet to investigate the effects of the Jewish deportations and the anti-Jewish laws upon the country's economic development began work today, the Bucharest radio announced.

The committee is composed of leading members of the Cabinot, including the Ministers for Interior, Laber, Rumanization and the Under-Secretary of the Navy, as well as representatives of the General Staff and of the government of Transmittria, the amnouncement stated. It failed to mention that the committee was formed as a result of internal dissension in the Cabinot with regard to the further custing of Jows from commercial life and in view of the protests by many Rumanians against the morelless expulsion of tens of thousands of Jows to Transmistria.

RELEASED BRITISH FASCISTS RESUME ANTI-JEWISH PROPAGANDA IN ENGLAND

LONDON, Nov. 8.(JTA) -- Anti-Jewish and Fascist propaganda coupled with anonymous domands for a negotiated peace have suddenly received a new imposus in England, especially in Liverpool, where walls and sidewalks are being chalked with such inscriptions, it was reported here today.

. It is bolieved that the revived Fascist activity is due to the fact that the district leaders of Mesley's party have all been released from prison on the basis that they are no longer dangerous. Many members of the British parliament today expressed the opinion that the generous policy of the British Goyermment in having these Mesleyites released has proven unjustified. They emphasized that a wholesale re-intermment of the leaders of the British Fascist Party must be carried out since the released fascists have violated their word of honer given upon release.

ZIONIST UNDERGROUND ACTIVITIES IN AXIE COUNTRIES REPORTED AT SYRACUSE CONFERENCE

SYRACUSE, N.Y., Nov. 8.(JTA) — The underground activities of the Zienist Laberite movement in eccupied Poland as well as the Zienist work conducted in the Maxi-dominated countries of Rumania and Hungary were outlined today by A. Tartakower, secretary of the World Confederation of Poale Zien, addressing the conference of the Zienist Laber Party of America now taking place here.

Though the Zionist offices have all been closed down in Rumania, there is still a Pelestine office functioning there to advise Jows on emigration to Palestine, Er. Tartakower reported. Similarly there are still Zionist activities being conducted in Rungary.

Declaring that in Nasi-held Poland the Zionist laborite movement suffers more than the non-Joylsh underground movement because its members are confined in ghottes. For Tartakower said that one of the principal tasks of the World Conference of Peals Zion is to support the Zionist laborite underground movement in Axis-held countries, as well as to maintain the Hechalutz and pioneer training centers in these occupied countries where they still exist. He reported that the Peals Zion movement is very active new in Latin american countries but is illegal in Brasil.

Joseph Schlossberg, American Jowish Labor leader, addressing the conference, called on American Jowish youth to become more active in American Jowish 11fo and in Zionist activities. He predicted a great wave of anti-Semitism in post-wear Europe which, he said, will affect the United States with the aid of "powerful anti-Jowish elements" in this country.

JAPAN STAMPS PASSPORTS OF SHANGHAI JENS WITH LETTER "J"

ZURICH, Nov. 8.(JTA) -- The Berlin radio teday reported from Shanghai that all Jows there have been ordered by the Japanese authorities to have their identification papers stamped with the letter "J".

The measure was taken after an order issued last week instructing the Jewish owners of automobiles in Shaughai to display a special marker on their cars which would indicate that the vehicles belong to Jews.

JEWISH ALDERMAN ELECTED LORD MAYOR OF HULL

JEWISH ASSISTANT OF U.S. NAVAL ATTACHE IN RUSSIA DECORATED BY SECRETARY KNOX

NEW YORK, Nov. 8.(JTA) -- Commander Samuel B. Frankel, 37, of Stapleton, Statem Island, has been presented with the Distinguished Service Medal by Secretary of the Newy Frank Enox, at the latter's office in the Newy Department, it was amnounced here today by the Army and Navy Commander for the Jewish Welfare Board. The citation accompanying the decoration lauds Commander Frankel for his "extraordinary initiative and tireless energy" in redeeming men and vessels.

The award for "exceptionally meritorious service" was bestowed on the Commander for his work as Assistant Naval Attache in Muranask and Archangel, US.5.S.R., during the period from Nov. 1941 to Sept. 1942. "Under adverse conditions," the laudatory citation to Commander Frankel reads, "he displayed extraordinary initiative and tireless energy in the direction of repairs to damaged United States vessels, in the salvaging of stranded and abandoned vessels, and in the supervision, rescue, hospitalization and repatriation of survivors of sunken vessels."

Commander Frankel is further credited in the Navy citation with saving for future service in the war effort certain vessels which would otherwise have been lost. "His efficient execution of an extremely difficult task and his conscientious syction to duty were in keeping with the highest traditions of the United States aval Service," the commendation concludes.

J.D.C. PAID \$5,444,000 FOR REFUGEE TRANSPORTATION SINCE PEARL HARBOR

NEW YORK, Nov. 8.(JTA) -- The American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee has received from the U.S. Treasury Department licenses to pay out 33,444,000 for cluges transportation since Fearl Harbor, it was announced here today, in connection with the arrival last week of the Portugese vessel Carvahlo Araujo with 140 of Ugees from Lisbon and unoccupied France whose passage was arranged by the J.D.C.

In making this announcement, the J.D.C. headquarters here stated that 7,500 persons have been helped by the J.D.C. to emigrate from Europe and Africa to the Western Hemisphere and Falestine. Among the passengers on board the Carvalho Araujo were thirty Folish refugee engineers who were em-route to Canada. This group brought to 200 the number of Polish engineers for whom the J.D.C. has booked passenger space in accordance with an arrangement with the Polish Government-in-Exile, the announcement declared.

CUBAN INCIGRATION DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES MORE LIBERAL FOLICY ON ADMITTING REFUGEES

HAVANA, Nov. 8.(JTA) -- A more liberal policy towards the refugees from war sones and the lands of oppression in Europe will be applied by the Cuban authorities to those seeking refuge in the Western Hemisphere, especially in allowing refugees temporary shelter pending receipt of permanent immigration visas elsowhere, it was announced here today.

Assurances to this effect were given by Dr. Alexandro Vergoda, the newly appointed chief of the Guben Immigration Department, in an interview with Mr. Isaac Yagodnik, president of the Centre Israelita de Guba, an affiliate of the Hias-Ica ingration Association. An official decree, which will enable refugees from Europe come to and stay temporarily in Guba until their immigration visas to South, Central and North American countries are obtained, will be issued soon.
