25,000 MORE JEWS DEPORTED FROM RUMANIA; SIX SMALL BOATS LEAVE RUMANIA WITH 318 JEWS

JERUSALEM, Nov. 13.(JTA)-- Twenty-five thousand more Jews were deported from Rumania to Transnistria in the middle of October, it is reported in the Bukarester Zeitung reaching here today. The Nazi newspaper also reports that many Jewish leaders recently were sent from Bucharest to the concentration camp at Targusu. It states, however, that Dr. William Filderman, the most prominent Jewish leader in Rumania, is still in Bucharest.

Rumanian-Jewish circles in Palestine today received information that six small boats carrying 318 Jews recently left Rumanian harbors for unknown destinations. The report reveals that although Jews are not officially permitted to leave Rumania, it is still possible to secure an exit permit from Rumanian authorities by paying \$200 for it. About \$2,000 is usually paid for passage on a sailing vessel willing to carry Jewish passengers to Turkish or other shores.

NAZI ORDER JEWISH FARMERS IN GALICIA TO SURRENDER THEIR LAND TO GERMANS

LONDON, Nov. 13.(JTA)-- The Nazi governor in Galicia has issued an order instructing Jewish farmers in the district of Stanislawow to transfer all their land and property to either German or Ukrainian settlers, the Polish Government-in-Exile reported here today.

Ten percent of the entire Jewish population of the Stanislawow district were engaged in agriculture before the Nazi invasion. They were the last group of Jews in Poland permitted by the Nazi occupation authorities to retain ownership of their land.

JEWISH CHILDREN IN NORWAY SEIZED AS HOSTAGES; ZIONIST LEADER ARRESTED IN PRAGUE

LONDON, Nov. 13.(JTA)-- The Norwegian news agency here today reported that more than 2,500 Jews, including half-Jews and quarter-Jews, have been arrested by the Quisling regime in Norway since the last week in October. In cases where the Quisling police could not find the head of the family, they seized his children as hostages, the report states.

In Prague, the Nazis arrested Dr. Franz Kahn, well-known Zionist who was the head of the arrangement committee for the Zionist Congresses, and as such was the first to open the sessions of the World Zionist Congress wherever it took place, according to information reaching Zionist circles here today. Disregarding the fact that Dr. Kahn has only one arm, the Nazis deported him to the fortress of Theresien where Czech Jews are being held for further deportation to occupied eastern territory.

Reports from Hungary reaching here today through neutral countries reveal that an organization of baptized Jews there, with 3,000 members, has been dissolved.

J.D.C. REPRESENTATIVE LEAVES PALESTINE FOR IRAN TO STUDY REFUGEE SITUATION

JERUSALEM, Nov. 13.(JTA)-- Harry Viteles, manager of the Central Bank for Cooperative Institutions has left Palestine for Teheran in behalf of the American Joint Distribution Committee to investigate the situation of the Jewish refugees from Poland now in Iran and to report to the J.D.C. on the possibilities of aiding them.

Jewish refugees from Poland who finally reached Palestine after leaving Russia eight months ago, today sent a delegation to the office of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency here asking that it convey their "deepest appreciation" to the J.D.C. in America for the assistance which they received on every stage of their eventful eight-month voyage. The delegation, represented Polish Jews coming from various refugee centers in Russia.

At a mass-meeting in Tel Aviv today, opening the drive for medical relief to Russia conducted by the Palestine Victory League for Russia, David Romer, general secretary of the Histadruth, announced that the Jews of Palestine are prepared not only to send medical instruments and ambulances to the Russian people, but also hundreds of physicians despite the fact that the latter are needed in Palestine. He suggested that American Jewish organizations send their contributions to Russia via Palestine since those contributions would thus reach Russia much sooner.

POST-WAR BILL OF RIGHTS FOR REICH JEWS DEMANDS GOVERNMENT AID FOR RETURNING REFUGEES

LONDON, Nov. 13.(JTA)-- A post-war "bill of rights" for German Jews, embodying a demand for state aid to all returning refugees until they can rehabilitate themselves, will be made public here on Sunday at a meeting called to mark the fourth anniversary of the destruction of many synagogues in Germany by the Nazis.

The declaration of rights, which has been drawn up by German non-Jewish refugees, provides:

- 1.-- Introduction of legal statutes repealing all the anti-Jewish laws.
- 2.-- Maximum penalties for attempted anti-Semitic propaganda and discrimination against Jewish citizens.
- 3.-- The arrest and trial of those responsible for murdering and looting Jews.
- 4.-- All expatriation measures are to be declared null and void.
- 5.-- The return of German Jews forcibly deported to Nazi-occupied territory will be regulated by an international body.
- 6.-- The state will be responsible for rebuilding all destroyed synagogues and making restitution for the destroyed property of Jewish communities.
- 7.-- Every immigrant will be able to claim state assistance until he or she is able to resume regular work.

The "bill of rights" will be read at Sunday's meeting by Johann Flading, former member of the Prussian Parliament. The meeting has been arranged by the German League for Culture.

NO POST-WAR EMIGRATION OF POLISH JEWS FROM POLAND EXPECTED, FINANCE MINISTER DECLARES

WASHINGTON, Nov. 13.(JTA)-- Dr. Henryk Strasburger, Polish Minister of Finance, who is here to discuss with American officials detailed plans with regard to feeding the population of liberated Poland immediately after the defeat of the Axis powers, today declared at a press conference that there will probably not be any emigration of Polish Jews from post-war Poland.

DARING RAID BY RUSSIAN PARTISANS SAVES 1,000 JEWS FROM EXECUTION BY NAZIS

KUIBYSHEV, Nov. 13.(JTA)-- One thousand Jews who were slated for execution by the Nazis in Simferopol, in the Crimea, were saved by a daring raid of a partisan group which drove off the Germans and recaptured a section of the city, it was revealed by Mendel Luboshitsky, one of the rescued Jews, who arrived today in Kuibyshev.

Luboshitsky, who had been evacuated to the Crimea from his home in Kiev, related that the Nazis after capturing Simferopol rounded up 12,000 Jews on a public square on the pretext that they were to be sent to forced labor. All day long groups of several hundred Jews were led to the outskirts of the city where, it was subsequently discovered, they were shot. As the last contingent of about 1,000, including Luboshitsky, arrived at the execution grounds, groups of armed partisans appeared and attacked the Germans. After a bloody battle the Nazis were routed and the Jews rescued.

The Kiev Jew, whose hair turned completely gray as a result of his experiences also told how previously the German soldiers had sprinkled gunpowder in the shape of a Soviet star on the shoulder of a Jewish tailor Moishe Wolynski and then set the powder afire in an attempt to force Wolynski to reveal the whereabouts of the partisans, among whom was his son.

Press Pays Tribute to Jewish Partisans

An article in the local press today pays tribute to the activities of the thousands of Jews who have joined partisan bands, especially in the Ukraine. Veterans of the Civil War, collective farmers and young boys are working behind the German lines, blowing up bridges, destroying telegraph wires, and harassing the Nazi troops generally. The Jewish guerrilla units are particularly active in the Dniopropetrovsk, Chernigov and Nikolayev sections, it is reported.

One Soviet correspondent recounts the adventures of a Jewish partisan, Yankel G., whom he met in a hospital where the young Jewish guerrilla was recovering from wounds suffered during a battle with Nazi units. Yankel and a companion were operating with a partisan unit in the vicinity of Rostov. Nearing the German front lines, after cutting telegraph communications, they sought temporary refuge in the hut of peasant women, since the peasants always sheltered the guerrillas. The two youths had only been in the house a few minutes when a German officer threw open the door and shouted to the woman: "Who are those two?"

Although the peasant knew she was risking her life, she replied: "They're my sons." The officer then ordered his men to arrest the three and shouted: "If they're Jews you will all be hanged tomorrow." That night, however, the Red Army troops advanced and the village was recaptured.

Z.O.A. OBSERVES 86TH BIRTHDAY OF JUSTICE BRANDEIS; PUBLISHES HIS ADDRESSES

WASHINGTON, Nov. 13.(JTA)-- The 86th birthday of the late Supreme Court Justice Louis D. Brandeis was observed here today in the headquarters of the Zionist Organization of America, which honored the memory of the Jewish leader by publishing a collection of his addresses and statements on Jewish and Zionist problems in a volume entitled "Brandeis on Zionism."

The book, which includes a preface by Justice Felix Frankfurter, gives Brandeis' views on the Arab-Jewish issue, on how the Jewish question can be solved, on true Americanism, on the preservation of the Jewish people and on problems concerning various aspects of Jewish national life.

COL. PATTERSON, ON 75TH BIRTHDAY, CERTAIN THAT PALESTINE WILL BECOME "ERETZ ISRAEL"

LA JOLLA, Calif., Nov. 13.(JTA)-- The conviction that after the war "Palestine will once again become Eretz Israel" was expressed here today by Col. John Henry Patterson, Commander of the Jewish Legion during the last World War, who celebrated his 75th birthday this week.

In a statement addressed to the Jews of Palestine, Col. Patterson said: "Fight on no matter what the odds; fight on indomitably until Victory is won! Then when your goal is reached and Palestine once again becomes Eretz Israel, as it surely will, let peace, mercy and justice be your watchwords, and so prove to all mankind your unquestionable right to an honored place among the free peoples of the World." Messages congratulating him on his birthday have reached Col. Patterson from Jewish groups in Palestine, Argentina, England and from various cities in the United States.

DR. WISE LEAVES MEXICO AFTER CONFERENCE WITH FOREIGN MINISTER

MEXICO CITY, Nov. 13.(JTA)-- Dr. Stephen S. Wise, president of the American Jewish Congress, left for the United States today after conferring with high Mexican Government officials and Jewish leaders on matters of Jewish interest.

At a press conference last night, Dr. Wise stated that he had been received by Foreign Secretary Padilla who, he said, was sympathetic to the proposed convention next spring or fall in Mexico City of the Inter-American Jewish Council.

ALL JEWISH CAUSES ASSURED 100 PERCENT ALLOCATIONS BY DETROIT WAR CHEST

DETROIT, Nov. 13.(JTA)-- Metropolitan Detroit's War Chest went over the top in its \$5,800,000 drive and it is expected that the goal will be exceeded by half a million by the time all contributions are reported, it was announced at a Victory Dinner last night.

Isidore Sobeloff, executive director of the Jewish Welfare Federation and the Allied Jewish campaign, announced that while there will be no Allied Jewish Campaign in the Spring, since all Jewish causes are provided for in the War Chest budget, the budget committee of the Federation will meet in the Spring, as usual, for allocation of funds. All causes included in the War Chest - the local, national and overseas agencies - will receive 100 percent of the funds they are scheduled to get, Mr. Sobeloff stated.

COUNCIL OF JEWISH FEDERATIONS AND WELFARE FUNDS PUBLISHES STUDY ON HEBREW UNIVERSITY

NEW YORK, Nov. 13.(JTA)-- A detailed study of the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, condensed from a more extensive analysis of the early history and development of that institution, was published today by the Budget Research Committee of the Council of Jewish Federations and Welfare Funds. Mr. Jacob Bleustein of Baltimore is chairman of the Budget Research Committee.

The first completed research undertaking of the Committee, the Hebrew University study will be followed by similar analytical reports on other agencies supported by Jewish welfare funds. Studies of the World Ort Union, Histadruth and Hadassah are in preparation.
