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CRISIS IN JEWISH AGENCY EXECUTIVE UNSOLVED; WEIZMANN'S REPLY EXPECTED

JERUSALEM, Oct.28.(JTA) -- The crisis within the executive of the Jewish Agency precipitated by the resignation of David Ben-Gurian as chairman remained unsulved today, notwithstanding the fact that both the executive and the Zionist Actions Committee voted not to accept the resignation.

In accordance with yesterday's decision, the Zionist Actions Committee today cabled Dr. Chaim Weismann to come from London to Palestine "within two weeks" in creder to settle differences between him and Ben-Gurion here. During these two weeks Ben-Gurion will probably remain inactive in the executive. Should Dr. Weismann not come to Palestine within the two-week period, Ben-Gurion will let his resignation stand, members of the Actions Committee today revealed.

Everything now depends on Dr. Weizmann's decision as to whether he can comply with the request to come to Palestine in the given time. It was indicated here that should it come to a break between Br. Weizmann and Ben-Gurion the former will have the support of the majority-of the Zionist Actions Committee and of other Zionist bedies in Palestine notwithstanding the fact that Ben-Gurion has a large following among the Jews here. (In Landan, it was announced today that Dr. Weizmann has not yet decided on the Actions Committee appeal that he urgently proceed to Palestine. The office of the Jewish Agency in Landan declared that it had no statement to make on the situation for the present.)

"Either Weismann or Ben-Gurien" Alternative Not Acceptable

Leaders of responsible Zionist institutions and today that the crisis in the executive which resulted in Fen-Gurin's offer of resignation had not been preciptated by differences between Ben-Gurion and the Zionist movement, but by "principal divergencies between Ben-Gurion and Dr. Chaim Weigmanns"

"The majority of the Zionist movement will not accept the alternative of "Either Weizmann or Ben-Gurion" but will strive for a democratic scluttion", the Masman, a daily newspaper, writes today. "The most responsible leader will have to yield to the decision of the majority, which will not let either Dr. Weizmann or Ben-Gurion go." The paper emphasizes that Ben-Gurion's resignation "marks a severe crisis in cur leadership." It says that "the Zionist movement has made Fon-Gurion the head of its executive to lead in the fight against the regime of Zionist liquidation and for a full Zionist solution of the world Jewish problem."

Taking an opposite view, the newspaper Mishmar, organ of the Hashmar Hatzair, the left wing of the Falestine Icbor Party, publishes an editorial sayang: "Rem-Gurian's departure will not be regretted by those who are aware of the disastrous nature of the Biltmore Declaration which demands a Jewish Commonwealth in Falestine and which could not withstand the test of practical statesmanship. The Biltmore Declaration, purporting to be the common reaffer the whole Zionist movement, proved a poor shelter for unity."

ZIONIST EMERGENCY COUNCIL TAKES IS: UE WITH AMERICA JEWISH COMMITTEE

NEW YORK, Oct.28.(JTh) -- Taking issue with the American Jewish Committee for its withdravel from the American Jewish Conference, the American Zionist Emergency Council, which represents all Zionist groups in this country, today issued a statement dealering that "there is the danger of emagerating the significance of the secession of the American Jewish Committee from the American Jewish Conference beyond all propertions in the light of the relative insignificance of the Committee in American Jewish lite."

"The American Jewish Committee and the American Jewish Conference are not correl tive bodies. The Committee is a self-constituted and self-perpetuating body representative of no one except a few individuals, and responsible to no one at all. On the other head, the Conference is the democratically elected body of American Jewry consisting of 502 delegates, of whom 375 were elected from every major community and the remainder were designated by 65 national erganizations of which the American Jewish Committee was one.

"The withdrawal of the Committee is nevertheless a calculated attack upon Jewish unity and it will be deeply resented by every American Jew who is eager to advance the Conference program of im edicte rescue of the Jews of Europe, their post-wer rehabilitation and the implementation of Jewish rights to Palestine.

"The Conference deliberations revealed the virtual unanimity of American Jewry on all major problems and the profound desire for unity in achieving their solution. On the Palestine resolution only four of the 502 delegates dissented, while less than 20 abstained. The mass enthusiasm for the Conference program was persuasive upon the chairman of the American Jewish Committee who announced at the time that the Palestine resolution was adopted that the Committee would remain within the Conference. But t is now seems to have been only a temporary maneuver. The Committee now refuses to accept the will of the majority. It quits the Conference. It has always preached unity but evidently only on its own terms. The Committee must rule or rain. It will do neither.

Calls Arguments of American Jewish Committee "Absurd"

"As an excuse for isolating itself from the overwhelming majority in American Jewish life, the American Jewish Committee complains that the Conference subordinated all other issues to the question of Palestine. This is absurd. Every major problem affecting Jewish interests was seriously and at great length considered by the Conference and its committees, and this in spite of the chairman of the American Jewish Committee who, it should be recalled, resisted the inclusion of the question of rescue in the Conference agenda. If Palestine's future played a major role in the Conference, and absorbed in a large measure the interests of the delegates, it is precisely because they realized that Falestine offers the one great constructive solution both to the problem of immediate rescue and the problem of Jewish national homelessness.

"The American Jewish Committee wishes now to ignore not only the expressed wishes of American Jewy but also the facts of history and its own record on the subject of Falestine. It is clear that a new regime his come into control of the policies and attitudes of the Committee. In the past, the Committee approved of the Balfour Deckaration and of the Falestine Mandate which recognizes the historic connection of the Jewish people with Falestine and its right to rebuild its national home there. Under the inspiration of the late Louis Marshall, who was president of the American Jowish Committee, an enlarged Jewish Agency for Palestine was achieved, which included both Zionists and non-Zionists and which was based upon the acceptance of the principle of the Jewish Mational Home.

"But today the American Jewish Committee studiously and pointedly omits any reference to the Jewish National Home, the Malfour Declaration or the Mandate. These annoying facts of history it would like to Trace. It speaks of a Commonwealth for Pelestine but not of a Jewish Commonwealth. Its present position would liquidate the Jewish National Home. As the American Jewish Committee would have it, the Jewish National Home must not be Jewish and it must not be national. Inevitably, it would cause to be a home.

Sees Retreat to Committee's 1916 Stand

"The American Jevish Committee has always represented itself as desirous of safeguarding Jevish rights all over the vorld. But as far as Jevish Palestine is concerned, where our people has obtained internationally accredited rights for the rebuilding of its actional home, the Committee interposes compromises and reservations and would oppose every safeguard essential for the realization of that home.

"It generously allows that Jews should have the right to immigrate to Pelestine as to other countries. This we are to regard as a tramendous concession! But it insists that the Jewish Agency must under no circumstances be vested with control over immigration, for that would mean that in the course of time, a Jewish majority would be established in Palastine and as a result the Jewish Commonwealth would be constituted. This must not be allowed to happen! Immigration is therefore to be entrusted to some international trusteeship which the American Jewish Committee now improvises out of thin cir.

"This reversal on the part of the American Jewish Committee, representing a new and disruptive line in its policies, is clearly a retreat to 1916, when a small handful of Jews in this country and in England violently opposed the Balfour Declaration and attempted to arrest the march of the Jewish people to its rightful place in the world's family of nations. They failed them. They will fail now!"

HADASSAH CONVENTION CLOSES; MRS. MOSES P. EPSTEIN ELECTED PRESIDENT

NEW YORK, Oct.28. (JTA) -- Resolutions expressing "full support" for the American Jewis: Conference and appealing to the British people and government to abandon the White Paper policy were adopted here today at the closing session of the 29th annual convention of the Hadassah, which elected Mrs. Moses P. Epstein president of the organization for the next terms

The resolution on the White Paper also urged the U.S. Government and the American public "to add its voice" in support of the Jewish demand. Another resolution appeals to the "conscience of the democratic peoples and the governments of the United Nations "to help bring about the rescue of 29,000 Jewish children in Euseph for whom certificates of entry into Palestine have been promised by the British Government.

The convention adopted a budget of \$1,620,000 to be spent during the next year for medical, post-war health, child welfere, vocational education, youth, refugee and land reclemation projects. Tribute was paid by the convention to Ring Gustaf V of Sweden for the heroism with which their peoples have defended Jewish citizens and refugees in both countries against the Nasis, by announcing the planting of two groves of trees in the name of these memorahs in the Holy Land.

Dr. Stephen S. Wise and Dr. Abba Hillel Silver, of Cleveland, co-chairmen of the American Zionist Emergency Council, the chief sp. k.rs at the concluding session, concentrated upon a plac for the abrogation of the White Paper, which if implemented would curtail Jewish immigration into Palestine by March 1944; upon an attack on the British Palestine administration, which was accused of "staging" the recent arms-smaggling trials; and upon a demand for the creation of a Jewish Commonwealth.

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GERMAN'S KILLED 20,000 JEWS IN DNEFROPETROVSK, MOSCO RADIO REPORTS

STOCKHOLM, Oct.28.(JTA) -- The Moscow radio reported today that the Germans had murdered 20,000 Jews in the city of Dnepropetrovek, liberated this week by the Russian Army. It added that the last 12,000 Yilma Jews, deported by the Germans some time ago to isolated places in lithuanta had parished.

Swedish press reports say that property of Danish Jews which the Germans confiscated and shipped to the Reich is now being distributed among "femilies in Germany who have shown courage during the Anglo-American air raids" on various German cities.

ROOSEVELT'S D.CISION E PECTED ON ACTION MULLIFYING BAN ON RACE BIAS IN WAR JOBS

VASHINGTON, Oct.28.(JTA) -- President Roosevelt is expected to decide within the next few days whether government contractors; must promise not to discriminate for racial or religious reasons in their hiring.

Under an executive order of the President, contracts "shall include" a clause obligating the contractor not to discriminate. Yesterday, Comptrollar-General Lindsay C. Warren ruled that this order need not be obeyed in all cases, that it is "directory" and not "mandatory,"

According to Warren's ruling, the clause need not be included if the Government is prevented from getting vital goods or services by the contractors' refusal to agree to it. He cited the Southwestern Bell Telephone Company of Kansas City, Mo., as having refused to furnish telephone service to war agencies if the non-discrimin tion clause is invoked. His ruling constituted a victory for the company.

Presidential Secretary Stephen Early said today that he thought any question of the President's meaning should have been referred to Attorney General Francis Biddle. The Justice Department said Warren had not asked its advice, but that he was under no obligation to do so.

The President's Committee on Fair Employment Practises, charged with enforcement of the President's order, has asked him to make his meaning unmistakeable. Although he will probably consult with the Justice Department, as well as other interested agencies, it is not legal but political advice the President will need. Racial and religious minority groups are urging him to insist on the anti-discrimination of use, but pressure from southern politicians is being exerted against thems

If the President supports Warren's ruling, it is agreed here that the FEPC will lose much of its potential effectiveness, Warren said:

"It seems that the most that can be accomplished by government contracting agencies in currying out the national policy of non-discrimination in the employment of workers as declared by the President is to secure the assent of contractors to such provisious wherever and whenever possible."

BOSTON COURT FINES JEWISH BOYS IN TRIAL ON ANTI-SEMITIC CLASHES

LOSTON, Oct.28.(JTA) -- Disappointment was felt among Jewish leaders here today over the fact that two Jewish boys were found guilty by the district court yesterday of participating in an affray in the Dorchester section of the city where anti-Jewish assaults have been going on for some time. The boys, Marvin Blaustein and Jacob Hodes, were fined ten dollars each. Both appealed to the Superior Court today against the verdict.
