# HEBREW PRESS IN PALESTINE WILL TREAPPEAR TODAY; BANNED FOR REPORT ON RAMATH HAKOVESH

JERUSALEM, Nov. 29. (JTA) -- The entire Hebrew press in Palestine will appear tomorrow for the first time since the newspapers were suspended by the Palestine Government for allegedly publishing "tendencious" reports concerning the events at the colony of Ramath Hakovesh which was raided by British and Polish military police seeking illegal arms and deserters from the Polish army.

The papers were given varying terms of suspension, and several of them could have appeared several days ago had they chosen to do so. However, when the suspensions were announced the publications agreed not to reappear until the ban had been lifted on all of them.

# UNRRA WILL BE ASKED TO TAKE SPECIAL MEASURES TO AID JEWS IN POLAND

ATLANTIC CITY, Nov. 29. (JTA) -- Mobile convoys of food to supply ghettos will be one of Poland's first needs after reoccupation, the Polish delegation to the United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation Administration said in a report made public here.

Asked to mention the special problems that will call for UNRRA's help during the first period after liberation, the Polish group, headed by Vice-Premier Jan Kwapinski, pointed out that "the ghettos and sections designated by the Germans as living quarters for the Jewish population are deprived of the most elementary and primitative necessities."

In view of this situation, the Poles said they might ask UNRRA to supply equipment and food for mobile convoys to feed "the Jewish population during the period of the liquidation of ghettos and centers of forced settlement."

Another Polish report took occasion to mention "the specially tragic situation of the Jews and of the Sewish children. "It is known that thousands of Jewish children have perished together with their parents and relatives during the liquidation of the ghettos in Poland," the report said. "These children died with the adults. Mown down by machine guns, perishing in sealed death trains, executed by electrocution, and in poison gas chambers."

This report also explained: "Foodstuffs are exported to Germany, and the Poles are allotted incredibly small food rations, amounting to 800 calories per diem for Christians, and 400 calories for Jews." According to League of Nations studies, the first symptoms of starvation appear when a diet drops below the 2,200 calory marks

## Polish-Jewish Deputy Submits Rescue Plan for Jews of Europe

LONDON, Nov. 29. (JTA) -- Emanuel Szerer, one of the two Jewish deputies in the Polish National Council, was received today by Polish Premier Stanislaw Mikolajczyk with whom he discussed measures to rescue the Jews of Poland.

Szerer submitted to Mr. Mikolajczyk a four point rescue program providing that;

1 - In view of the extreme danger in which the surviving Polish Jews find

themselves, the government work out an effective plan for their rescue.

2 - The Polish Government approach other Allied nations to enlist their cooperation in the carrying out of any measures decided upon.

3 - The rescue plan be submitted to the European Commission established by

the Moscow Conference to decide Allied policy in liberated Europe.

4 - An inter-governmental body be formed with the sole function of rescuing any section of the population in occupied Europe which is threatened with extermination.

The other Jewish deputy, Dr. Ignacy Schwartzbart, saw Polish Defense Minister Marjan Kukiel to discuss the position of Jews in the Polish forces in Great Britain and the Near East. There have been persistent reports of discrimination by Polish military authorities against Jews in their commands. Dr. Schwartzbart also saw Foreign Minister Tadeuz Romer concerning the situation of Polish Jews in Russia.

# MASSACRE OF KIEV JEWS SUFFICIENT REASON FOR BOMBING OF BERLIN, SAYS BEC BROADCASTER

LONDON, Nov. 29. (JTA) -- The massacre of 50,000 Jews in Kiew, detailed reports of which were made public today, was cited by a broadcaster on the BBC today as an answer to Dr. Joseph Goebbels charge that the bombing of Berlin by the RAF was "not wer." "If Goebbels claims that the attack against Berlin is not war, what then was the assult on the Warsaw Ghetto and the massacre of Jews at Kiew," the speaker said.

British and American correspondents who visited Babi Yar, a ravine cutside Kiev, report evidences of large-scale massacres. Three Soviet soldiers who were among several hundred Russians compelled to disinter the remains of the victims, most of whom were massacred in Sept. 1941, in order that they might be incinerated to hide the German atrocities, told the correspondents of what transpired before the Germans evacuated the city. They described the giguntic bonfires in which the bodies of the Jews were consumed and the careful efforts to fill in the ravine with fresh earth.

The chairman of the Kiev Atrocity Commission disclosed that the massacres began on Sept. 28, 1941 and continued for several days. Russian war prisoners were forced to bury the bodies. Another report, quoting a Russian newspaper, says that Red Army troops who entered Gomel on Thursday found evidences of similar massacres of the Jewish population of the White Russian center.

## 300,000 CASES OF CITRUS FRUITS WILL LEAVE PALESTINE FOR ENGLAND THIS WEEK

JERUSALEM, Nov. 29. (JTA) -- The first shipment of citrus fruits to leave Palestine for Britain since the middle of 1940 will be shipped this week, it was learned today. It is expected to consist of about 300,000 cases of oranges and lemons, provided equally by Jewish and Arab growers.

Oranges and lemons have been a war-time casualty in Britain, where it has been almost impossible to secure one since Italy's entry into the war closed the Moditer-ranean to shipments from Palestine and made shipments from elsewhere too hazardous to risk\_freighters.

# SOVIET JEWISH DELEGATION EN ROUTE HOME AFTER TOUR OF JEWISH COMMUNITIES IN U.S. BRITAIN

LONDON, Nov. 29. (JTA) -- Prof. Solomon Mikhoels and Lieut.-Col. Itsik Feffer, the Jewish cultural delegation from the Soviet Union, left here lest night en route home. The two Russian Jewish representatives spent several months touring the principal Jewish communities of the United States and England. They were the first Jewish delegates to visit these countries since the Soviet Revolution.

#### SOUTH AFRICAN JEWS PROCLAIM DAY OF MOURNING FOR EUROPEAN JEWRY

JOHANNESBURG, South Africa, Nov. 29. (JTA) -- Tuesday, Dec. 7 has been proclaimed a Day of Mourning for Europe's Jews by the Board of Deputies of South African Jews. Jewish businesses will close on that day and synagogue services will be held.

It is also planned to hold mass rallies in the larger cities protesting the extermination of European Jewry and demanding action to save the survivors. In Johannesburg, the meeting will be addressed by Minister of Justice Colin Steyn and the Bishop of Johannesburg.

#### PALESTINE JEWISH LEGION APPEALS TO BRITAIN TO ABROGATE WHITE PAPER

WASHINGTON, Nov. 29. (JTA) -- Six officers of the American Falestine Jewish Legion, the 5,300 Americans who fought in the British army in 1918 to help liberate Falestine from the Turks, today called on the British Embassy to plend for the abrogation of the Chamberlain White Paper of 1939 which bars new Jewish immigration into Falestine after March 31, 1944.

The delegation submitted to First Secretary W. D. Hayter a resolution adopted by the Legion which termed the White Paper a violation of England's covenant with the Jewish people and of its obligation under the Pelestine Mendate to facilitate the establishment of the Jewish National Home in Palestine. The spokesmen were Elias Ginsburg, national commander of the legion; Samuel Marche, first national vice commander; Oscar I. Kahn, second national vice commander; Robert Lemberg, national adjutant, and Joseph Brainin and Arnold K. Isreeli, members of the national executive board.

### AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT APPEALED TO FOR ADMISSION OF JEWISH REFUGEES

MELBOURNE, Australia, Nov. 29. (JTA) -- A mass-meeting in the town hall of the city of Hobart in the state of Tammania this week adopted a resolution appealing to the Australian Government to cooperate with other nations in offering asylum to Jews who can flee German-occupied Europe, it was reported here todays

The meeting, which was addressed by Prof. H. A. Woodruff of Melbourne-University and Rabbi H. Saenger of this city, who are touring Tasmania under the auspices of the League of Nations Union, also urged the United Nations to take immediate rescue measures. The resolution said that the Australian Government will earn the respect of the entire world if it admits refugees.

# CAMADIAN ZIONISTS PLAN INTER-PARTY CONVENTION TO OUTLINE DEMANDS FOR COMMONWEALTH

MONTREAL, Nov. 29. (JTA) -- An inter-party Zionist convention will be held in Montreal to declare the adherence of Canadian Jewry to the Biltmore program and the demand for a Jewish commonwealth in Falestine, it was announced here today.

A resolution urging the calling of such a convention was recently adopted at the meeting of the United Zionist Council on a motion submitted by the representatives of the Zionist Labor movement.

### OSE ESTABLISHES TRAINING SCHOOL AND HOME FOR ORPHANED REFUCEES IN SWITZERLAND

GENEVA, Nov. 29. (JTA) -- A home for Jewish refugee boys whose parents have disappeared has been opened here by the OSE, the Jewish Health Society. The youths are receiving technical training under the direction of experts in various fields.

#### GOVERNOR SALTONSTALL, CHURCH, LABOR LEADERS CONDEMN RACE HATRED

BOSTON, Nov. 29. (JTA) -- A mass meeting here of 2,500 persons called to promote racial amity was told last night by Governor LeverttSaltonstail that it is the responsibility of individuals and civic groups to prevent repetition of the attacks on Jews which have occurred in Boston recently. The Governor said, "In dealing with this problem in Massachusetts, we must look primarily to the future. The utmost pains must be taken to deal fairly and thoroughly with what has happened. But our chief concern must be to prevent it happening again."

Church and Labor leaders also spoke condemning persons who spread racial hatred. The Rt. Rev. Monsignor Richard J. Haberlin, vicar general of the Archdiocese of Boston, representing William Cardinal O'Connell, warned: "To deny our neighbor his inalienable rights amounts to a rejection of God and to despise him because of his race or religious belief is neither Catholic nor American." Bishop G. Bromley Oxnam, of the Methodist Church, stated: "I can't prove there's a definite tie-up between the recent outbreaks and the vast national Fascist movement, but I know for a fact that the former constitute a real menace to our form of government."

"Prosecution of American fascist leaders and distributors of literature that promotes racial hatred" was demanded by Joseph Salerno, head of the state Clo. Rabbi Herman H. Rubenovitz, president of the Boston Rabbinical Assn., condemmed remarks by Boston's new police commissioner, Col. Thomas F. Sullivan, who upon appointment Fridey, shrugged away questions of what he planned to do about anti-Semitism with the reply that all cases of it here were "kid stuff" and that racial prejudice was "an ancient malady."

### JEWISH WELFARE BOARD FINANCE BODY VOTES \$1,171,590 BUDGET FOR 1944

CINCINNATI, Now. 29% (JTA) -- The National Finance Council of the Jewish Welfare Board woted last night, at the conclusion of a two-day session, to allocate the sum of \$1,171,590 for various JWB services in the coming years. Irving Edson of St. Louis, chairman of the Council, pointed out that the increase in the budget from this year's appropriation of \$620,000 is necessitated by the increase in the number of Jews in the armed forces.

The 1944 appropriation will be used to furnish the following services to Jewish men and women in the Army, Navy, Coast Guard and Merines:

Supervising religious supplies and conducting religious services for Jewish soldiers and sailors at home and abroad. Providing Jewish hospitality in areas not covered by the USO. Work with cadets and other students on college campuses. Work with discharged veterans of the armed forces. Work with wounded soldiers and sailors in general hospitals. Providing guidance, program material and other help to YeMsHaha's, YaWaHaAs's and Jowish Community Centers.

### ZVI HIRSCH RUBINSTEIN, JEWISH JOURNALIST, DIES AT 54; FUNERAL TODAY

NEW YORK, Nov. 29. (JTA) -- Zvi Hirsch Rubinstein, 54, well known Jewish journalist, and city editor of The Day for more than 20 years, died here today after a long illness. Mr. Rubinstein was born in Lemberg, Poland in 1899 and came to the United States when he was 20 years old. He was a contributor to many Jewish periodicals. Funeral services will be held at the Park West Chapel at 1 P.M. tomorrow.
