#### OO WARSAW JEWS STILL ALIVE; CONFINED IN CONCENTRATION CAMP IN GERMANY

LOMDON, Jan. 25. (JTA) -- Polish official circles today reported that 25,000 from the Warsaw ghetto are now interned in a concentration camp in Berensbotel, Hanover. These are the survivors of the 40,000 Jews who were in the ghetto durthe battle which preceded its liquidation by the German authorities.

The Belgian Government-in-Exile, quoting the underground Belgian newspaper Legion Noire, today reported that sixty percent of a large group of Belgian Jews sted last summer by the German occupation authorities have died either in detenacemps, or while being deported.

The clandestine publication disclosed that the Jews were rounded up by the a with the assistance of Flemish nationalists and Rexist storm troops. They were mbled at a detention center where they were stripped and forced to surrender all lry, money, dental plates containing gold or silver and rany other valuables in ir possession. Many were beaten by the guards. In apparent anticipation of post-retribution, however, the guards forced the Jews to sign statements to the effect they had not been mistreated prior to deportation. The underground paper says to some of the prisoners died in the Malines camp in Belgium, while others died on te to camps in Holland or Poland.

## NCH FASCISTS DEMAND EXPULSION OF ALL JEWS; CHARGE ALIEN JEWS ARE "SABOTEURS"

ZURICH, Jan. 25. (JTA) -- A demand that all Jews be deported from France was ced this week at a mass meeting in Paris, it is reported today by the Nazi-controlled is radio. The meeting, which was called by the "French Legion of Volunteers Against shevism," heard speakers urge that an unceasing struggle be waged against Jews "who to be regarded as belligerents in this war."

The Vichy radio today quoted the newspaper Paris Soir as demanding stronger asures against aliens in France, "especially Polish Jews," who, it charged, are boteurs. Demanding the elimination of aliens, the newspaper said that "France for o long has been the dumping ground of Europe."

#### O NORWEGIAN JEWS NOW AT FORCED LABOR IN OCCUPIED POLAND, SWEDISH PRESS REFORTS

STOCKHOLM, Jan. 25. (JTA) -- The number of Norwegian Jews deported by the rman occupation authorities to Poland and to Upper Silesia was reported here today be about 700.

Three Swedish newspapers estimate that between 6,000 and 7,000 Norwegians are wheld prisoner in Germany, including many anti-Mazi students. While the Jews are ing used for hard labor in occupied Polish territory and in Silesian coal mines, my of the non-Jewish deportees are being forced to clear air-raid wreckage from the reets of Berlin, the newspapers stated.

#### IN BULGARIA GIVEN TWO MONTHS TO CHANGE BULGARIAN-SOUNDING NAMES

ZURICH, Jan. 25. (JTA) -- Jews in Bulgaria were today given two months to ge their Bulgarian-sounding names to Jewish-sounding ones, the Sofia radio reports-affected by this order must make the necessary corrections in their identificadocuments no later than April 1. the broadcast said.

#### ISH HOMELAND IN PERU SUGGESTED IN HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES; WHITE PAFER SCORED

WASHINGTON, Jan. 25. (JTA) -- Establishment of a Jewish homeland of one huni square miles in Peru was advocated on the floor of the House of Representatives terday by Rep. Compton I. White, Idaho Dem.

White interrupted a speech by Rep. Joseph E. Talbot, Conn. Rep., against the estine White Paper, with the question: "Would the gentleman consider the possity of establishing a Jewish homeland in the Western Hemisphere, on the coast of the On the Pacific side there is a plain there where it does not rain but it is yfertile. By bringing the waters from the head of the Amazon it would make very wable land. There are 100 squars miles in there of what is the most fertile land, the world, in one of the finest climates of the world.

"I have been trying to find time," White continued, "to make the necessary estigation. As chairman of the committee on Prigation and Reclemation of the se, I am going to propose a project for the establishment of the Jews in Peru at a nt that is not now inhabited. It is one of the finest countries in the world, if youly had water. It seems to me the Jews should look into the possibilities of t project."

Talbot outlined the contributions of Palestine Jews to the war effort, and ted American support of the Balfour Declaration. He made no response to a question om Rep. Samuel Dicksteins New York Dem., on whether he would be willing to admit re persecuted Jews to this country. When Rep. Emmanuel Celler, N. Y. Dem., sugseted that the White Paper violated our treaty with Britain, recognizing the Palesne Mandate, Talbot agreed.

## M GOLDMANN HOPES JEWS OF RUSSIA WILL JOIN WORLD JEWISH CONGRESS AFTER WAR

IONDON, Jan. 25. (JTA) - The hope that the Jews of Russia will be permitted in the wort to join the World Jewish Congress was expressed here today by Nahum imann, chairman of the administrative committee of the Congress, addressing a lio meeting presided over by Lady Reading.

The meeting was called for the purpose of counteracting the opposition of the co-Jewish Association to the planned cooperation between the Board of Deputies of ish Jews and the British section of the World Jewish Congress. Dr. Goldmann onely attacked those sections of British Jewry which "have fantastic notions about activities of the World Jewish Congress."

"The issue," he said, "is very simple. We, Jews, are being attacked on an innational basis by Fascism and Mazism. It is, therefore, our duty to defend ourves on an international basis. Relief for Jews may be necessary, but it cannot be stituted for political action. A large portion of Jews in the democratic countries behind the World Jewish Congress and I hope that Russian Jewry, too, will join in Jewish efforts on the basis of the World Jewish Congress."

Dr. Goldmann indicated that the World Jewish Congress will "in the near future" ress a message to the democratic nations of the world stating that "the democratic eration has responsibility toward the Jews and cannot waive its responsibility for calamity." He demanded financial aid for the Jews in liberated Europe to help restore them to their pre-war economic position "or to take to Palestine those who wish to go there."

# World Jewish Congress Lauds Roosevelt's Establishment of War Refugee Board

NEW YORK, Jan. 25. (JTA) -- The World Jewish Congress today hailed the establement by President Roosevelt of a War Refugee Board "as a historic act of courage d statesmanship which marks a turning point in the attitude of Western democracies the problems created by Hitler's extermination policy."

The statement of the Congress, issued by Dr. Stephen S. Wise, chairman of its ecutive committee, expressed deep satisfaction with the President's order "which cognizes that the democracies have an inescapable moral obligation to discharge in e work of rescue, and that action must be taken without delay."

The statement emphasized that leaders of the Congress have been in constant insultation on rescue work with the appropriate officials of the Government departments whose heads will now compose the War Refugee Board. It promises "wholehearted operation" with the Board.

#### SH ZIONISTS ASK INCLUSION OF JEWISH STATE IN BRITISH COMMONWEALTH

LONDON, Jan. 26. (JTA) - A resolution expressing the hope that Palestine will de a Jemish state and included within the British Commonwealth after the war has adopted by the executive committee of the British Zionist Federation and will be nted to the annual conference of the organization, which opens on Saturday, it samed here today.

While endorsing the "Biltmore Declaration," which calls for the creation of a h Commonwealth in Falestine, the resolution pledges full development of Arab s in any Jewish state that may be established. The conference, which is expected attended by about 700 delegates, will hear Dr. Chaim Weizmann, Prof. Seligately and other Zionist leaders.

#### H FRATERNITY PRESENTS AWARD TO MONSKY; NAMES HIM "JEWISH MAN OF THE YEAR"

NEW YORK, Jan. 25. (JTA) -- The 1943 Phi Epsilen Pi Service award to the Ameri-Jew who has contributed most to his people was presented today to Henry Monsky, ident of B'nai B'rith, by Maurice Jacobs, grand superior of Phi Epsilon Pi, onal Jewish college fraternity, at the Weldorf Actoria.

#### URG MANSION IN NEW YORK DONATED TO JEWISH THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY

NEW YORK, Jan. 25. (JTA) — The fifty-room mansion in which the Warburg family its home for many years has been donated by Mrs. Felix Warburg to the Jewish logical Seminary of America, and will be used to house the seminary's collection ewish religious treasures, it was announced here today. Mrs. Warburg predet the structure in the names of her late husband, her father, Jacob H. Schiff her brother, Mortimer L. Schiff.

Among the objects to go into the new museum are a thirteenth century Ark, one he oldest pieces of ecclesiatical furniture in this country; a fragment of the inal Hebrew text of the last Book of Ecclesiatious, a number of silver cases coning Scrolls of the Lew, a Rembrandt etching of Manassah ben Israel, medieval stries, Hanukkah lamps, and spice boxes. There will also be exhibited the collection to the seminary by the Jewish community of Danzig just before the German asion of the city in September 1959s

"The fift," Mrs. Warburg said, "is not intended as a specific memorial but her as an affirmation of my faith in the fundamental principles of our traditions, on can be helpful and constructive in the problems of our world today, and also as ribute to the men of my family, my father, my husband, and my brother Mortimer, who h in his own way has done so much to build up the seminary toward its present ective usefulness."
