DEGARIAN JEWS WILL BE MASSACRED BEFORE ENTRY OF RUSSIANS, BUDAPEST PAPERS THREATEN

ZURICH, May 17. (JTA) -- The Jewish population of Hungary will be massacred in the ghettos into which they are now being herded, in the event that an invasion by useian troops become imminent, pro-Mazi Budapest newspapers threaten.

The papers sneer at the Allied indignation over the removal of Jews to discits in Hungary which are targets of Anglo-American bombing. "Hungarian selfefense will not be influenced by threats from New York and London," the Esti Ujsag cites.

The organ of the Hungarian Government, Fueggetlenseg, in an article written by is editor, says that the Jews in Hungary, when being moved into ghettos, calmly sment: "We shall wait!" This, the paper says, means that the Jews hope that wither several weeks the Russian Army will break through the Carpathian mountains and cupy the cities where the ghettos have been established. "This Jewish waiting will, mover, be forestalled by National-Socialism and by methods fixed to comply with ther's wish that no Jew be left in Europe by the time the war comes to an end," the per declares.

323,000 Hungarian Jews in Ghettos; Auctioning of Property Speeded

Under-Secretary Lazlo Baky, who yesterday announced that all of Hungary's 0,000 Jews will be in ghettos by the end of this month, today revealed in a broadthe from Budapest that 325,000 Jews are already in ghettos or concentration camps.

The newspaper Magyerorszag, welcoming the segregation of Jews in ghettos, urges at the government take "immediate measures" to put all the Jews of Hungary "to use-lwork." It emphasizes that "800,000 Jews constitute an important labor reserve."

Meanwhile, the Hungarian authorities have decided to speed the disposal of nfiscated Jewish property, and the Minister of Interior today warned in Budapest at any hidden Jewish property must be reported to local authorities within ten days, ser which severe punishment will be imposed upon anyone found guilty of failing to port Jewish belongings.

The warning was broadcast over the Hungarian radio together with an announceth disclosing that it was motivated by the fact that many non-jews possess hidden tish property "partly with a view to material gain and partly because of misguided fruism." The broadcast invited applications for 190 Jewish drug stores which were ten over by the government under the anti-jewish regulations after the owners were loved to ghattos.

The Bar Association in Budapest announced that it has struck from its memberprolls 1,260 Jewish lawyers. It also sent out a circular letter to its non-Jewish bers warning them of disciplinary proceedings if any of them ere found guilty of ding "as dummy for a Jewish lawyer."

ANSFER OF JEWS FROM POLISH ARMY TO BRITISH WILL NO LONGER BE PERMITTED, EDEN SAYS

LONDON, May 17. (JTA) -- The trensfer of Jews from the Folish Army to the itish will not be permitted any longer "under any circumstances" Foreign Secretary thony Eden told the House of Commons today. This applies to the Folish-Jewish idders who were amnested by President Racklewicz and who are refusing to leave a places where they are imprisoned unless they are admitted to the British forces, ten said.

pointing out that the amnesty decree completely annuled all punishment imposed a polish court martial upon the 21 Jewish soldiers who left the Polish Army because anti-Semitism and sought to enter British units, Eden said that the pardoned men ire been sent to a central Polish replacement depot from where they will be assigned parious units in accordance with their previous training.

Eden stated that the British Government warmly welcomed the action by the blish Government, and expressed the hope that the incident would now be considered losed, and that "the men involved would go forward to play a part in the great titions which are impending."

The London News-Chronicle publishes an editorial stating that the disagreeable pression resulting from the court-martialling of the Jewish soldiers has not been tirely effaced by the amnesty "since it is plain that these unhappy men were freed by under the pressure of public opinion."

Mernwhile, the commission appointed by the Polish Mational Council to inquire to anti-Semitic conditions in the Polish Army met today and elected Adam Ciolkosz, cialist, chairman. Emanuel Szerer, Jewish Socialist, was named secretary.

RMER ITALIAN JEWISH SENATOR DIES WHILE BEING DEPORTED BY GERMANS

WASHINGTON, May 17. (JTA) -- The Swiss newspaper Basler Nachrichten said today at "deep regret and anger" had spread through Nazi-occupied northern Italy follow-gether tragic death" of Senator Elio Morpurgo, 85-year-old Italian who "formerly kyed an important role in Italian political life," the Office of War Information reports.

Because of ill health, Morpurgo had been permitted to live in a place where soist authorities had promised be would be unmolested, the Swiss newspaper said.

Were, it was reported, the aged Morpurgo was arrested "contrary to promise" by clist SS men and ordered deported with other Jews. He died after a few hours of wel.

TE DEPARTMENT SETS UP COMMITTEE TO SPEED ACTION ON VISA APPLICATIONS

WASHINGTON, May 17. (JTA) -- In order to speed action in visa cases a special mittee has been set up in the visa Division to examine newly received applications, State Department announced today.

The statement explains that advisory approvals for the issuance of visas may sent to American consular officers in cases, other than those of alien enemdes, of are recommended by the committee as not requiring consideration under the stretgeartmental visa committee procedure. A simplified form of application will be ced in use within a few weeks, according to the State Department.

REFERENCE OF JETTSH SOCIAL YORKERS OPENS IN CLEVELAND; PIRSE SESSION HEARS SILVER

CLEVELAND, May 17. (JTA) -- Plans concerning Jewish community life in America ring and after the war were discussed here today by various commissions of the five-yannual conference of Jewish social workers which opened this afternoon at the tell Statler, with more than 500 delegates in attendance.

The conference, which is being held jointly by the Mational Conference of wish Social Welfare, Mational Association of Jew. sh Center Workers and Mational buncil for Jewish Education, was addressed tonight by Rabbi Abba Hillel Silver on the Stake and Responsibility of the American Jewish Community in the Present World." whasiing that neither American nor American Jews can be isolationist in theory or ratice, Dr. Silver said: "America is the center of world. Politically, economically declivally it is now enmashed in common destiny with rest of the world. Mation Jews we also come to share, however reluctantly, the common, inescapable destiny of their illow Jews in the rest of the world."

American Jews therefore have a double responsibility, Dr. Silver continued.

BIJAN COMMITTEE WILL RAISE \$1,000,000 THIS YEAR TO AID RUSSIAN JEWS

NEW YORK, May 17. (JTA) -- The American Biro-Bidjan Committee, will raise 1,000,000 this year to finance relief activities in Russia, which include the settlent and care of 3,500 Jewish war orphans in Biro-Bidjan, it was reported here last
ght at a dinner marking the tenth anniversary of the Jewish Autonomous Region.

Speakers, who included Senator Elbert D. Thomas of Utah and Vilhjalmur tefansson, noted explorer who is vice-president of Ambijan, praised the contributions as Russian people have made to victory. Senator Thompson said that the aid given by bijan to the orphaned Jewish children in Russia would oreate friendship for the mited States when the young refugees grew up.

(JTA) -- A reading guide and index to the recently completed -volume Universal Jewish Encyclopedia in English was issued today under the title we seven-Franched Candle Light" The book, identical in dimensions and in binding the Encyclopedia itself, is designed to enable the reader to pursue home studies at least 100 major courses and to facilitate utilization of the thousands of other bjects of Jewish interest contained in the ten volumes of the Universal Jewish cyclopedia.

"The Seven-Branched Candle Light" was compiled by Rabbi Simon Cohen in collaration with Louis Rittenberg and Rabbi Abraham I. Shindeling, research director, cutive-literary editor and revision editor respectively of the Universal Jewish valopedia. This guide and index groups the themes of study under seven prime eds: Religion, Jewish Life, Jews and Non-Jews, History, Literature, Jewish Contritions to Civilization and General Subjects.
