NUMBIA ARRESTS BUKOVINA JEWS FLEBING TO BUCHAREST; PERSECUTIONS IN HUNGARY MOUNT

ZURICH, May 18. (JTA) -- The Rumanian authorities are determined not to permit lews who fled from Eukovina and Moldavia to come to Bucharest, it was reported today by the German radio. The broadcast said that round-ups of Jews are being made in wherest and that many Jewish refugees from the war-torn provinces of the country are seized during these raids.

Rumanian Premier Antonesou has transferred the Commissar for Jewish Affairs and Lecca from the Labor Ministry to his own office which is now dealing directly ith the Jewish questions, the broadcast also reported.

Hungarian newspapers arriving today give detailed reports concerning the mettos into which the Jews in that country are being moved. Jews from the small om of hyregyhaza have been transferred to a tobacco shed eight miles from the town, a the city of Magyvarad the section designated as a ghetto has been surrounded with igh walls and planks have been nailed over windows of buildings facing the rest of the town. Jews may leave the ghetto only between 9 and 10 A.M.

In Szombathely, Jews are not allowed on the streets between 7 P.M. and 11 A.M., hich is the last hour that the markets are open, making it difficult for them to probase food.

Budapest newspapers report that the municipality has already ousted 417 Jewish flicials and clerks. They also disclose that the director of the Budapest museum of the arts has been appointed to supervise the conflication of art treasures owned by Mas. Many Jewish-owned collections have already been seized.

BREW COMMITTEE FOR NATIONAL LIBERATION ESTABLISHED; ATTACKED BY JEWISH GROUPS

WASHINGTON, May 18. (JTA) -- The establishment of a "Hebrew Committee for tional Liberation" which will apply to the allied powers for the same degree of seguition now accorded to other committees of liberation in exile, was announced to today at a press conference called by the initial members of the Committee.

The new group, spokesmen emphasized, considers itself "the temporary trustee metional interests" and claims to represent the Jews of Palestine and of rope. Its aim is "to redeem Hebrew national sovereignty." It will be financed by oating bonds to be repaid within ten years by the Free Palestine Government which it be established as result of the Committee's efforts, Peter H. Bergson, head of a new organization, said. He expressed the hope that \$1,000,000 could be raised.

A statement issued by Dr. Nahum Goldmann, representative of the Jewish Agency r Palestine, worned well-intentioned non-Jewish groups eager to help the Jewish ople, "not to be misled by the bombastic phrases and claims" made by the newly-

orned group which, he said, is "insignificant and substitutes noise for complete ack of standing, authority and influence in Jewish life."

The American Jewish Conference also issued a statement attacking the new group s "an irresponsible adventurer which comes to the American public without credenials and menaces the cause it presumes to espouse." Similar statements were issued y the American Zionist Emergency Council, the American Jewish Congress, the Hadasah and other national Jewish organizations, charging the Committee with undermining by Jewish Agoncy for Palestine.

The Hebrew Committee for National Liberation, it was announced at the press enference, will be 'led by Peter H. Bergeon, who was also the organizer of the committee for a Jewish Army of Stateless and Palestinian Jews and of the Emergency emittee to Save the Jewish People of Europe. In a statement outlining its aims t said that it had been organized to obtain recognition of the Hebrew people of urope and Palestine as a sovereign nation with the right of self-determination. It ill seek representation in the councils of the United Nations and will demand the 1ght for a Hebrew Army to fight on an equal footing with other United Nations armies gainst the Axis.

New Committee Will Not Speak for American Jews, It Says

"While the Hebrew Committee of National Liberation will not press the settlemot of political and boundary problems of Palestine until the end of hostilities, it
llineist however on the immediate opening of Palestine to all Hebrews who can
mage to escape from Europe today," the statement said. "The ultimate goal of the
brew Committee of National Liberation is the establishment of a free Palestine with
a Arab population as partners in a democratic and civilized Palestine, and with a
gally constituted international authority in control of the Holy Places of all
iths.

"Let it be clearly understood" - the statement goes on to say - "that the break (comittee of National Liberation does not attempt to speak for the Jews of the ited States. They are an integral part of the American nation, an integral part of mation made up of people of every descent. They do not 'belong' to Palestine, and ereby to the reneasent Hebrew Nation neither, anymore than Justice Frank Murphy elongs' to the Irish Nation or Lt. Gen. William Knudsen 'belongs' to the Danish tion, though they both certearnly are proud of their ancestry."

Urges Postponement of Settlement of Palestine Political Problems

Proclaiming the Hebrew Nation "a co-belligerent in the United Nation's war inst the Axis tyranny," the statement continues; "In the present condition of our inn, we are dedicated to only one task - the resous of our people. We, therefore, claim that the Hebrew Nation postpones the settlement of the political and bound-problems of Palestine until after victory when, as one of the United Nations, we set opatake in the postwar settlement of political territorial problems. Until it time we shall cooperate with and assist Great Britain as the Mandatory for Paline. We do however insist, in the name of humanity, that the right and the ability all Hebrew in Europe to find shelter in Palestine be facilitated by the Mandatory for, lest it be guilty of sacrificing them to their ruthless German murderers."

Emphasizing that the Jews "have contributed more fighters to the common strugthan most of the United Nations," the statement declares, "Because we are, in t, a co-belligerent against the Axis, we consider ourselves one of the United ions and shall seek recognition as such. And as the nation against whom more countries have been committed than against all the other United Nations combined, surely should be represented on the United Nations Commission for the Investigation

War Crimes. We also seek a seat on the Board of the United Nations Relief and habilitation administration and on all other United Nations councils in which the terests of our nationals are involved."

Zionist Emergency Council Calls New Group "Colossal Hoax"

The American Zionist Emergency Council, which speaks for all the major Zionist dies in the United States, issued a statement branding the new Committee "a handful young men who are attempting to perpetrate a colossal hoax upon the American people."

"We would warn the public, the press, and all official circles against being ken in by such a brazen fraud," the Council said. "The self-appointed thebrew Comttee of Mational Liberation' is made up of half a dozen adventurers from Falestine the ostanding, no credentials, no mendate from anyone unless it be from the Irgun win Leuni in Palestine, an insignificantly small pistol-packing group of extremists to are claiming oredit for some of the recent terrorist outrages. Every movement is its lunatic fringe and irresponsible splinter factions, and it is natural that sy should exist also in our midst. The danger is that uninformed people may be ken in and may be led to believe that a new Moses has arisen in Israel."

The American Jewish Conference, in a statement emphasizing that it speaks for miscomal Jewish membership organizations and every Jewish community in the United ates, said, "The so called 'Hebrew Committee for National Liberation' pretends to which has no expected the conference of the 'Hebrew nation' in Palestine, but it has no mandate from the wish National Assembly, which is the authorized and democratically-elected spokesman the Jews of Pelestine. Dr. Stephen S. Wise, speaking for the American Jewish Congress, condemned the rew Committee of National Liberation as a group which has not "the slightest vese of authority to speak for any important Jewish body in Europe or in Palestine."

"That Mr. Bergson and a few of his Palestinian associates, together with a dful of American dupes, should declare themselves to be the representatives of a brew nation' would be a farcical jest if it were not a ghastly tragedy at a time a united effort for the rescue of Jews in Europe ought to be the aim of American support for a free and demotito Jewish Commonwealth in Palestine," Rabbi Wise saids. "This willful little composition of irresponsibles makes confusion worse confounded, and appears to be ready by devices and unscrupulous tactics to render the greatest possible disservice to Jews.

Dr. Israel Goldstein, president of the Zionist Organization of America, issued statement in behalf of that body assailing the establishment of the Committee and proposals.

O FLORENCE JEWS IN CAMPS; PROPERTY VALUED AT \$25,000,000 CONFISCATED

IONDON, May 18. (JTA) -- More than 500 of the 1,600 Jews living in the city of oremee, in northern Italy, have been placed in concentration camps, while the hers are under constant police supervision, it is reported today by the Nazi Transenn news agency.

About 500,000,000 lire (\$25,000,000) worth of property have been confiscated on the Jews, the report said, as well as 100,000,000 lire (\$5,000,000) worth of pragogue property. Valuable works of art have also been seized.

Information reaching Polish circles here today states that many Italian Jews ported to Poland have recently been executed outside of Lwow as part of the German reparations to evacuate the city which is menaced by the Red Army.

PORTED DAMISH JEWS NOW DOING SLAVE LABOR IN NAZI WAR PLANTS

STOCKHOLM, May 18. (JTA) -- Danish Jews under 60, including men and women, are wemployed at forced labor in German war plants, the Stockholm newspaper Svenska rrombladet reports today.

The Jews are part of those who were deported from Denmark in November and cember of last year. Most of the Danish Jews succeeded in fleeing to Sweden at at time, but it is known that at least 1,600 were deported.

Those working in the military factories are kept isolated from other workers the plant. Older Jews, who are not sufficiently able-bodied to be used for forced for are confined in a camp which is somewhat better than the usual Nazi concentration camps for Jews, the paper says. The immates, however, are not permitted to ceive parcels from friends abroad.

JERUSALEM, May 18. (JTA) -- Jewish scamen paraded through the streets of Tel iv and Haifa today as the entire Jewish community of Palestine observed "Maratime y." Mass-meetings were held throughout the country and flags were flown from the ildings of Jewish national institutions.

MERA CONFERENCE POSTPONED; DIVISION FOR DISPLACED PERSONS EXTENDS ITS WORK

WASHINGTON, May 18. (JTA) -- Director General Herbert H. Lehman today announced that the Central Committee at a meeting called by him had decided to postpone the session of the Council of UNERA which had been scheduled to be held in Montreal on Nume 23. The postponement was made necessary by the emergency restrictions on travel and telegraphic communications from the United Kingdom, which would have impeded efective preparation for the scheduled June meeting by European Governments.

The Central Committee of UNRRA has decided to meet at regular intervals to consider when circumstances make it possible to set a definite date for the session. It was agreed that forty-five days notice of any date set would be given to the maker governments. When a new date is established, it is contemplated that the seting will be held in Canada.

T. T. Scott, an Englishman, has been placed in charge of the London office of the Displaced Persons Division of UNRRA, it was learned today. Scott was formerly the the International Labor Office and has more than ten years experience with efuges services in Europe. He will work under the supervision of Fred K. Hochler, irector of the Displaced Persons Division, who expects to spend the major part of is time in Europe.

MAGOGUE COUNCIL APPEALS TO ROOSEVELT FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF "FREE PORTS"

NEW YORK, May 18. (JTA) -- The Synagogue Council of America, representing the eligious voice of American Jews, today appealed to President Roosevelt for the establishment in the United States of "free ports" as a temporary sanctuary for refugees.

The appeal, signed by Rabbi Israel Goldstein, president of the Council, asked by the scient to take "heroic measures" to save the Jews that can still be rescued to the Balkans and other Nazi-dominated territories.

"We urgently plea for the establishment of 'free ports' that is, temporary ergeny refugee camps, in the United States in which refugees may find a sanctuary or the duration of the war," the appeal said. "This will not only assure life for one who can escape from the Nazi hangmen and can be brought here, but it will prove effective instrument for the implementation of your March 24th statement. It will courage the people of Europe and Asia to resist Nazi savagery and it will in addition rave as an example to other nations who may be influenced to follow America's leaderpand establish similar havens."

"Wonder Rabbis" Appeal to War Refugee Board to Speed Rescue of Jews

JERUSALEM, May 18.
