ANOMESCU DECREES DEATH FOR JEWS ENTERING RUMANIA ILLEGALLY AND FOR THOSE HELPING THEM

STOCKHOLM, May 30. (JTA) -- Jews entering Rumania illegally will be sentenced to death, as will all other persons helping them to enter the country, it was announced today over the Bucharest radio, which quoted a decree just issued by the pro-Nazi manian Premier Ion Antonesou.

"The measure is taken in order to prevent the undermining of Rumania's defenses by foreign Jews," the broadcast said. At the same time it quoted articles from the manian press violently attacking Jews.

The anti-jewish campaign in the Rumanian newspapers, which had been on the sciline for several weeks, has now resumed in a manner reminiscent of the early days if the war when thousands of Jews were slaughtered by Rumanians on the pretext that have were helping the Russian Army. Articles in newspapers reaching here from beharest blame the Jews for the defeat on the Bessarabian front and for Allied combing of Rumanian towns.

EGREGATION OF JEWS IN GHETTOS WAS NECESSARY BECAUSE THEY AIDED THE ALLIES, HUNGARY SATE

ZURICH, May 30. (JTA) -- Many Jews in Hungary have assisted the Allies by comting sabotage, aiding partisan groups and by spreading "false and alarming rumors," was charged today by Hungarian Commissar for Jewish Affairs Lazlo Endre during an explanation" of why the pro-Nazi puppet government found it necessary to confine win shettos.

In an interview with German newspapers, Endre added that the Jews in the secloss of Hungary which are menaced by the Red Army cooperated with the Russians, servoyed food stuffs and assisted the enemy in "other treacherous ways."

Eungarian papers reaching here today disclose that the anti-Jewish drive is till in full swing throughout Eungary, with professional bodies, government administers and local officials cooperating in custing all Jews from the country's ecomon, social, and cultural life and segregating them in ghettos where they will be explotely isolated from the rest of the population. The following reports, taken had local newspapers, indicate what is happening to Hungarian Jews.

In Budapest, the Lawyers Chamber approved the ousting of 182 Jewish lawyers, though they are exempt from the anti-Jewish laws because of service at the front prier the chamber had expelled 1,839 Jewish attorneys.

In the large city of Satu-Mare, the authorities decreed that Jews must sell all fiber clothing, aside from what they could wear at one time, to Rungarians at fixed rices far below their value. In the city of Subotica the police announced that Jews must use "Jim Crow" platforms on the rear of street cars and are banned from theatres, also, restaurants, public baths and public promonades. In the town of Mohae the mayor stablished two ghettos with a total capacity of 226 rooms and 85 kitchens to accommate 1,169 persons.

MBBI OF SANDOMIERZ FALLS ON BATTLEFIELD FIGHTING GERMANS; DECORATED FOR HEROISM

MOSCOW, May 30. (JTA) -- Moscow newspapers today carry a report of how Rabbi isso Zavada of Sandomiers, Poland, and his brother-in-law Mendel Kohn of Lods, joined the Polish Kosoiussko Division as volunteers and fell in the division's first battle against the Germans on the Byelorussian front. The Soviet military authorities have sethumously swarded Rabbi Zavada the Order of the Red Star and the Cross of Valor.

The two joined the Polish division in Russia as soon as it was formed. At first everyone in the unit looked upon the two orthodox Jews with surprise. Their less beards attracted special attention. They refused to eat non-kosher food and received dry rations and prepared their own food. The actonishment grew as the rabbins his brother-in-law, given the right as volunteers to choose their branch of service, elected to join a mortar unit.

The two religious Jews showed themselves during training to be among the best soldiers in the division. The rabbi was promoted to a sergeant's rank and later made smander of a mortar platoon where he won a reputation as a sharpshooter and excelent commander. "I owe it to my Sandomir congregation;" he said when commended by his sperior authorities.

The first to fall in battle was Mendel Kohn, who had been a textile manufacturer in Lods. JERUSALEM, May 30. (JTA) -- A 22-year-old Jewish youth, Zvi Saul Tabori, was subcoosd today by a military court here to seven years imprisonment for possessing revolver and several rounds of ammunition. He had been under arrest for about two withs.

The youth, who declined the assistance of a lawyer, made the following statement to the court after hearing the verdict; "I confess the possession of arms, but to the consider that this was illegal and without any logical explanations. You have right to try me. I do not recognize your sentence. I demand the status of a war discoer. The sole authority which I recognize in issuing permits to carry arms is be Fighters for National Liberation' (the illegal extremist organization known as the Stern Group'), which strives to return to the Jewish people its lawful status many matter to the establishment of a Jewish State."

SEMMIE RESOLUTION ASKS USE OF ELLIS ISLAND AS "FREE PORT" FOR REPUGEES

WASHINGTON, May 30. (JTA) -- A resolution urging the U. S. Government to provide a temporary haven of refuge for Jews from Nazi Europe at Ellis Island and other special centers was introduced in the Senate yesterday by Sen. Guy Gillette of Iowa.

In a statement to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency today, Senator Gillette said that he hoped for Presidential action even before passage of the resolution. "The resolution is, at best," he said, "but the expression of the views of the Senate turges the President to provide temporary havene, and it was introduced to crystallize the opinion of the Senate so that the President might feel free to act."

The measure makes the War Refugee Board responsible for determining the most to be accepted, and provides that "transportation and other facilities be accepted, and provides that "transportation of the war." The vioting acceptance of the war. The vioting fair oppression would be maintained "until the President has determined that they ay be returned to their homeland without undue risk to their personal safety."

Declaring that the War Refugee Board has "accomplished wonderful things, but has reached a point where it needs help," Gillette stressed that his resolution has nothing to do with Palestine or with the political problems involving providing homeland for the Jewish people. It has nothing to do with changing in any way our migration laws or policies."

"We have in this country at the present moment more than 100,000 prisoners of ar," Gillette told the Senate. "We are feeding and clothing them, and when the war sower they will be returned safely to their homes. We ought at least to do this set for the thousands of harmless and defenseless people who are the especial texts of Mazi brutality and sadism and who have committed no crimes but have been writed for brutal death for no reason other than their racial derivation or religious therence."

LESTINE JEWRY PROCLAIMS DAY OF FRAYER FOR JEWS OF HUNGARY AND BALKAN COUNTRIES

JERUSALEM, May 30. (JTA) -- A day of fasting and prayers for the Jews of mgary and the Balkans and all other Jews remaining in Europe was proclaimed today the Jewish National Council and the Chief Rabbinate. It will take place on June 5.

The day will be marked by a country-wide rally to be held here in the morning, the wish leaders and representatives of local settlement councils participating. I Jewish shops and non-war plants will close down at 2 p.m. and prayers will be ld in all synagogues at 4 o'clock.

In the afternoon a delegation will call on the High Commissioner and United ates Consul-General Lowell C. Pinkerton and present a petition urging immediate d for all Jews menaced by the Masis. The observances will be concluded by mass stings in the evening.

The Chief Rabbinate today cabled to Chief Rabbi Joseph Herts of Great Britain to the Union of Orthodox Rabbis in the United States asking them to proclaim a Milar day of prayer for June 11.
