IONDON, June 7. (JTA) -- All Jews who had been arrested by the Germans in Rome and held in the infamous Regima Coeli prison there are now free men, as are all political prisoners in the liberated Italian capital, the British press reported today.

Jewish organizations here were mapping out plans today to send representatives to Rome to contact Jewish leaders there for the purpose of restoring Jewish communal life and Jewish activities in the liberated part of Italy,

London newspapers carry reports from their correspondents in Rome describing hm Italians rushed to the gates of the prison, as soon as the Allied armics entered fome, and demanded the immediate liberation of all Jewish prisoners who had been held in two special wings. Uthers presented the prison administration with a list of non-lemish political prisoners and asked for their immediate release.

Estimating that several hundred Jews were set free, the correspondents give detailed descriptions of the scenes at the gates of the prison where the liberated Jews were met by Italian friends. Many of the Italians who witnessed the release rushed to the families of the Jews so as to be the first to bring the news of their liberation.

NEW YORK JEWS FIRST TO GO ASHORE IN FRANCE DURING INVASION

NEW YORK, June 7. (JTA) -- A 22-year-old Jewish officer from New York, Lt. braham Condicti, who comes from a Sephardic Jewish family, was the commander of the first wave of small assault boats in the invasion landing between Cherbourg and Le Eure, while another New York Jew, Robert Halperin, was one of the first Americans - perhaps the very first - to go ashore in France, it was reported here today from the invasion front.

Condictti's own boat, the first to hit the beach, landed less than 60 seconds after H-Hour, B. J. Moquaid, the New York Post correspondent, related in a dispatch written "aboard the combat transport U. S. Barnett in the transport area." His boat carried members of an infantry company commanded by Capt. Leonard T. Schroeder, 25, of Baltimore, Mr. Quaid wrots. "Just as Condictti's was the first boat to hit the beach, Schroeder may have been the first American or even Allied soldier to invade Brops." he said.

The news about Halperin's landing, as related by William H. Stoneman, correspondent of the N. Y. Post in a dispatch dated "Off the Coast of France," reads, "one of the first Americans to go ashore in France - perhaps the very first - was Bob Ealperin, formarly of the "grocklym bodgers professional football team. ZURICH, June 7. (JTA) -- Hungarian farmers were ordered today not to sell milk and dairy products to Jews. Peasants who violate this order will be severely punished and their property will be conficated, it was announced over the Budapest radio, which produces the government decree.

JENS IN PERSIA GIVEN A SEAT IN PARLIAMENT, GERMAN RADIO REPORTS

JERUSAIEM, June 7. (JTA) -- For the first time in the history of modern Persia, a Jew has won a seat in its parliament, it was reported today by the Gorman radio. The meme of the Jewish member was not given, nor were any details divulged in the breadcast, which warned of "growing Jewish domination" in Iran.

The position of the 50,000 Jews in Persia has improved greatly during the last few years. But the majority of the Jews there still live under miscrable conditions. He war, which has made Persia an important link between America and Russia, has remuled in American Jewish soldiers and officers coming in direct contact with Jews in Persia. A Jewish delegation from Palestine which visited Persia recently found that lewish cultural life is developing among the youth. The delegation was asked to fecilitate the emigration of Jewish youth from Persia to Palestine.

WESTAPO DEPORTS 2,000 GREEK AND FOREIGN JEWS FROM ATHEMS TO FOLAND

CAIRO, June 7. (JTA) -- The Greek Government-in-Exile today reported that approximately 2,000 Jewish residents of Athens, including holders of Spanish, Italian and Turkish passports, were deported by the Germans to occupied Foland last month. The deportation took place despite protests of foreign ambassadors in Greece, the report stated.

"The conditions under which these victims of German barbarism were transported are terrible," the statement of the Greek Government said. "Trucks in which men, wash and children, healthy and sick alike, were loaded were formerly used to haul tel and wood, and have only one entrance which is scaled by on iron bar, and one small railed window. The Germans closed even this small window with barbed wire, thus taking any communication with the outside impossible.

"The Jews had to remain for two whole days in the trucks in the reilway station before they were loaded onto trains. During this time one woman died and another gave birth to a child without any medical assistance. The Germans gave no food or water to their victimes. The Greek Red Cross, when informed of what had happened, sent some twelloads of food to the railway station. The German officers in command, however, truckloads of food to the railway station. MEEC AUTHORITIES CHARGED WITH INDIFFERENCE TO ACTS OF VIOLENCE AGAINST JEWS

MONTREAL, June 7. (JTA) -- The Canadian Jewish Congress today made public a tatement expressing regret at the fact that "not one word of public protest or public agression of disapproval" has been uttered by any of the responsible members of the revincial Government of Quebec, or the clergy, condemning the anti-Jewish acts in webscity, which culminated in the recent attempt to burn down the new synagogue there.

"Whilst the Jewish community appreciates the statement attributed to Attorney peral Leon Casgrain that 'this Province is one where freedom of worship exists in its scaplets form,' it is regrettable that these sentiments are apparently not shared y many influential citizens of this Province, and certainly not by the majority of the civic authorities of Quebec City," the statement says.

"The Jewish community of Quebec City comprises about one hundred (100) families. Size 1932 they have endeavored to obtain permission to eroot a synagogue where they light worship the religion of their fathers. Every conceivable obstacle was utilized to obstruct their laudable efforts, until finally in 1943 the city Council passed a W-Law to expropriate the land purchased by the Jews whereon to erect their house of wrship. This by-law has been attacked in the courts and the issue is still to be tried. In the meantime, while the building was being constructed, mass meetings were prmitted to take place, where anti-Jewish feelings were aroused, to the knowledge of the authorities, civic, provincial and clerical, meetings even staged at the time then Churchill, Roosevelt and other dignituries of the United Nations met in Quebec to plan their flight against Fascism, Nazis, etc.

"Strange to say, not one word of public protest or public expression of disapfrom has yet been uttered by any responsible member of the Provincial Government, or of the prevailing clergy condemning these anti-religious acts. Is there any wonder that irresponsible persons have gained the impression that they are free to resort to test of violence against a small Jewish community?" the statement points out.

"The broken windows of the Quebec synagogue will be replaced; the charred walls will be repaired. In the meantime, the very right of the congregation to worship in their new synagogue is still being contested in the courts by the City Council of (Nebec, and this at the expense of the citizens," the statement concludes.
