ME-WITNESS REPORT OF JEWISH PARTICIPATION IN INVASION; MANY JEWS AMONG PARATROOPERS

IONDON, June 13. (JTA) -- The participation of Jews in all branches of the plied armed forces which are battling the Germans in Normandy, was described here in amssage received from Simon Blumenfeld, who until recently was active in Jewish sfairs in London and who is participating in the invasion.

Blumenfeld, who crossed the Channel twice last week on a special invasion mission, reported that while travelling he met many Jewish officers and soldiers "all fighting so that Jews can live freely side by side with every nationality." He embasised that the number of Jews among the paratroopers was especially large.

MICE RAID CAFES IN BUDAPEST IN SEARCH FOR JEWS; SURRENDER OF BICYCLES ORDERED

ZURICH, June 13. (JTA) -- Hungarian police raided restaurants and cafes in pulapest last night, and arrested more than 200 Jews who are among the Jewish residents mill permitted to live outside the ghetto, the German radio reported today.

The municipality of Budapest published a list of restaurants, seventy-two pular cafes and fifty bars from which Jews are to be barred. At the same time, it meed seven Kosher restaurants and a number of non-Jewish cafes where Jews can be wired. These places, however, are to display prominently signs reading: "Jews Served Ere."

Hungarian newspapers reaching here report that Jews in Budapest are wearing alitary decorations above the yellow star which they must display on their clothing metr the existing anti-Jewish laws. The papers demand that an order be issued probabiliting Jews from wearing decorations together with their yellow stars.

The Hungarian radio announced today that Jews are henceforth forbidden to own bloples. It also reported that "disciplinary proceedings" have been taken by the testrical authorities against the noted Hungarian actress Katalik Karadi "for her phitical connections with Jews." Karadi has been placed under police supervision, the broadcast said.

The Pueggetlenseg, official organ of the Hungarian Government, reports that leaders of the Calvinist Church in Hungary have requested presidents of educational latitutions and teachers of denominational schools to comply at once with the government request to have all books of Jewish authors removed from libraries. The books may be registered and transferred to teachers colleges for research only.

New regulations issued for the Jews in the ghetto of Miskole provide that the jews may leave the ghetto only on Saturdays and must first obtain special permission; they must not appear in the streets of the ghetto between eight in the evening and six in the morning; they are forbidden to maintain contact with Christians still living in the ghetto area and must not accept food or other presents from their Christian belibbors.

GEMANS INTENSIFY RAIDS ON JEWS IN FRANCE; JEWISH CHILDREN DRAGGED FROM HIDEOUTS

LONDON, June 15. (JTA) -- Intensified German activities against Jews in France were reported here today by central Jewish organizations, while Swiss newspapers resching here from Geneva indicated that the Gestapo, aided by French police, have resmed rounding-up Jews in various French cities and villages where they have been him in order to avoid deportation to Poland.

The Journal de Geneve reports that twenty Jewish children who had been living mith peasants in Thonon, the northern part of Haute Savoie, were arrested this week at taken in German military cars to an "unknown destination." Arrests of Jewish children by the Germans are reported also from other parts of the Haute Savoie region, which is a hideout for many Jews and French partisans.

OWERESSIONAL COMMITTEE HEARS RABBI WISE ON DISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT

WASHINGTON, June 13. (JTA) -- Lauding the accomplishments of the Fair Employest Practice Committee, set up by President Roosevelt, in combatting racial discrimination in employment, Dr. Stephen S. Wise, president of the American Jewish Congress, today charged that while discrimination against the Negro is flagrant, there is an attempt to conceal anti-Jewish discrimination in employment.

This charge was voiced by Rabbi Wise during testimony before the House Labor temittee in support of bills to set up a permanent government commission to halt regial discrimination in employment. "The Congress must pass the bill for a permanent me unless the battle for democracy is limited to the war period," Rabbi Wise said at the hearing. "The FEFC has done a most worthwhile work - allayed fears, distrust, mide millions of Americans feel that the government is battling for democracy at home."

In answer to a question by Rep. A. L. Miller (Rep.-Neb.), Dr. Wise told the simittee that the statistics of the number of Jews employed by the Government were at of the essence of the matter." Rep. Miller then wanted to know whether the troubles in Germany did not start "because of the economic control by the Jews of 70 percent of the best property in all the large cities." Dr. Wise challenged Rep. Miller's figures.

"Hitler was shrewd enough," Rabbi Wise said, "to turn the so-called Christians uninst the Jews by giving them an opportunity for locting and booty. The amount of which economic control has nothing to do with it. The status of the Jew is bound up with the degree of democratic idealism in this and every country. There is a real Pascist peril in America."

Questioned by Rep. O. C. Fisher (Dem.- Texas), Dr. Wise said he would rather the from any group of employers the right to fire and hire than take from any group M Americans the right to employment. "No fundamental right is violated because the twernment takes steps to say you cannot discriminate against a man because of his mee or creed. It is the right of every American to have equality of opportunity. It is the right of every man to labor so that he may live."

MUNITANCE OF MORE THAN 1,000 REFUGEES TO "FREE PORTS" IN AMERICA IS DEMANDED

WASHINGTON, June 13. (JTA) -- Rep. William T. Byrne (Dem.-N. Y.), today became the eighth member of the House of Representatives to introduce a measure urging the hesident to establish "free ports" as temporary havens for refugees.

In a statement to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, Byrne said that the plan to Wing 1,000 refugees to Fort Ontario "should be just a start." He said he thought the sentual number to be brought here would be many thousands. Others who have introduced Malutions on "free ports" are Reps.
