## TALIAN CABINET ESTABLISHES DEPARTMENT TO DEAL WITH JEWISH CLAIMS IN LIBERATED AREAS

LONDON, July 16. (JTA) -- The Italian cabinet, which is working in cooperation th the Allied Military Government, announced the establishment of a special departent for Jewish affairs to deal with problems arising out of the annulled anti-Jewish aws in liberated parts of Italy, it was reported here today.

Dr. Anton Zolli, Chief Rabbi of Rome, and M. Robertani, an Italian Jewish myer, have been invited by the cabinet to assist in the work of this department, the port said. Simultaneously it was reported that Fascist authorities in German-held ctions of Italy, especially in the provinces of Modena and Sondrio are continuing he confiscation of Jewish property.

Greek official circles today reported that all Jews in the Greek island of orfu have been seized by the Germans and their property confiscated. After holding ase Jews in an old citadel for several weeks, the German authorities deported them rom the island. The population was warned that all Jews who were still at large and ho did not surrender within twenty-four hours would be punished by death. The same mishment would be meted out to Greeks hiding Jews or helping them to escape deportaion, the warning said.

# UMGARIAN AUTHORITIES ATTEMPTING TO EVADE RESPONSIBILITY FOR DEPORTATION OF JEWS

ZURICH, July 16. (JTA) -- An indication that Allied warnings that the pro-Nazi ungarian Government will be held accountable after the war for the murder and eportation of Jews are beginning to hit home is given today in a statement by high ungarian officials to the correspondent of the Swiss Telegraphic Agency.

The correspondent reports that these officials categorically deny that ungarian authorities have mistreated or killed Jews. Some Jews were deported, they aid, in accordance with a recently concluded agreement between Hungary and Germany nder which the former is to furnish manpower for German war industries. "The Jewish anpower," they stated, "was placed at the disposal of the Reich in order to meet the ishes of our German ally in the interest of the joint conduct of the war."

The deportation of the Jews, therefore, the Budapest spokesman continued, was crely an orderly transfer of workers, in which the part played by Mungarian authorities was limited to "the technical aspect of recruiting." Accusations in the foreign ress, they asserted, are without foundation.

Rumanian newspapers received here today report that two Hungarian Jews who ere captured crossing into Rumania have been sentenced to five years at heard labor y a military court. Their names are given as Martin Berkowitz and Erno Pollock. he place where they were apprehended was not disclosed.

#### RRMAN PRESS OPENS VIOLENT ANTI-JEWISH DRIVE AS RUSSIANS APPROACH REICH TERRITORY

ZURICH, July 16. (JTA) -- As Russian troops drive closer to the borders of ermany, the Reich press has launched a new violent anti-Jewish campaign in an attempt of divert the attention of the German people from the possibility of an imminent avasion of their homeland.

Der Angriff, official organ of Propaganda Minister Joseph Goebbels, carries article stating that all misfortunes afflicting Germany are the fault of the Jews. scriting that Germany is not fighting "Slavism" or the "aryan Russian empire," but are "Soviet Jewish state," the article states;

"In this hour of decision all misleading slogans of lesser importance must be armly pushed aside. The cardinal truth that must always be stressed is - it is the tw, it is the fault of the Jew."

### LY THREE JEWS FOUND ALIVE IN VILNA BY RUSSIAN TROOPS; HEAPS OF BODIES UNCOVERED

MOSCOW, July 16. (JTA) -- Red Army troops who captured Vilna found only three ws in that city, which had a pre-war Jewish population of well over 50,000, according to a front-line dispatch appearing in the Moscow press.

"In one of the streets of the city," the dispatch says, "Redarmymen ran into old bearded Jow. He walked with outstretched hands as if clutching the air. By side limped a woman and boy. These three were the only survivors of the Jewish pulation of the city."

At the wayside station of Panersial, not far from Vilna, the report says, the ssian troops found a field which had been used as an execution center by the Nazis, re thousands of Jews, poles, Lithuanians and Russians had been killed by the Germans. many other places the troops come across piles of bones and charred bodies, traces Gestape executions which the Germans had no time to obliterate before they were reed to quit the Lithuanian capital.

### GAULLE GOVT. HIT FOR ARTICLE WARNING OF TROUBLE IF PROPERTY RETURNED TO JEWS

LOHDON, July 16. (JTA) -- The French Committee of National Liberation is iticized today by the Sunday Dispatch for spreading "via official channels in the ited States" an article by Michael Le Troquer, Paris attorney and son of the missar-Delegate in the Administration for Liberated Territories appointed by the mittee, in which he said that automatic restoration to French Jews of the industrial, mercial and political positions they held before the war will arouse "resentment" ong some circles in France.

The French Press and Information Service in New York, which distributed Troquer's article, published originally in the newspaper L'Algier Republican, is invalent to the French ministry of information, the Dispatch says, and, therefore, an impression is created that the sentiments expressed in the article have the full proval of the De Gaulle Government.

The diplomatic correspondent of the Dispatch, however, writes that French urters here have assured him that the Algiers government intends to undo by progresses the Vichy work of racial discrimination. Le Troquer's article, they say, ressed his personal opinion and does not voice official policy.

#### FECIAL BROADCAST FROM ROME SYNAGOGUE TO VOICE THANKS FOR LIBERATION

NEW YORK, July 16. (JTA) -- A special thanksgiving service from the Temple sraelitico, Rome's famed synagogue, will be beamed to the United States on Sunday, why 23, 1:15 to 1:30 p.m.s. E.W.T.s. in a program presented over the National Broadasting System by the American Jewish Committee in collaboration with the National roadcasting Company. The program will be the first Jewish broadcast from an Alliediberated territory.

The Chief Rabbi of Italy, Anton Zolli, will conduct the services. A cantor and a girls: choir will participate. The arrangements for the program were made by alph Howard, NEC correspondent attached to the American Fifth Army. Rabbi Zolli, he is 73, had been in hiding, at one time with a Catholic family during the nine onths that the Nazis directly controlled Rome.

The synagogue from which the broadcast will emanate is in the center of the dA Roman ghetto, on the banks of the Tiber. A modern structure, it was built at the irn of this century. It stands on the site of an ancient synagogue, for the Jewish emannity of the Italian capital is one of the oldest in the world. The building of a synagogue came at a time when Jews were enjoying equal rights with all other calian citizens. One of their co-religionists, Ernesto Mathan, served as Mayor of time from 1907 to 1913.

#### ITISH PRESS AND RADIO LAUD COURAGE OF GEORGES MANDEL

LONDON, July 16. (JTA) -- The British radio and press today pay tribute to erges Mandel, former French Minister of the Interior, who, the Vichy radio reported iday night, was killed while being transferred from an internment camp.

The London Times says that "by the death of George's Mandel, France loses a true triot whose farsightedness in peace and courage in adversity will stand as a shining ample to generations," It adds that, although doubly menaced because he was a Jew, andel refused to leave France although he could have fled to England. The Evening andard prints an editorial "in tribute to a murdered French patriot, statesman and w." The BBC said that "it would appear from the nature of the announcement that e news of Georges Mandel's death is likely to be true, although previous false nouncements of his death have been made by the Germans and the details of this nouncement may well be false too."

Mandel, who was 59, was active in French politics from the time he became a tege of Clemenceau at the age of 18, until the fall of France. As a member of the yeard cabinet he fought vigorously against capitulation to the Germans. He was one the defendants at the famous "Riom trials"

# MON-VIDE HUNT ON FOR TERRORISTS WHO BLASTED JERUSALEM POLICE HEADQUARTERS

JERUSALEM, July 16. (JTA) -- A country-wide manhunt was on today for terrorts who raided the Jerusalem district police headquarters early Friday morning, and tled one Arab policeman and seriously injured another Arab and a Jewish policeman. Police say that the men planted eleven bombs, all of which exploded before they all be located. They travelled in stolen taxis which they returned after the raid. lice estimate that 20 to 25 men were involved.
