NAZIS IRKED AT ANNOUNCEMENT THAT JEWISH BRIGADE WILL PARTICIPATE IN OCCUPATION OF REICH

LONDON, Sept. 29. (JTA) -- Incensed at Prime Minister Churchill's announcement yesterday that the Jewish brigade will participate in the occupation of Germany, and at Gen. Eisenhower's proclamation to the German people in which he emphasized that all "cruel, oppressive and discriminatory laws" introduced by the Nazis in the Reich will be abolished by the Allied Military Government, the Berlin radio today broadcast a wild anti-Jewish tirade calculated to frighten the Germans with the specter of "Jewish revenge."

"The news that Germany will be occupied by Jewish troops will only strengthen the German will to resist to the utmost," the Nazi broadcast said. "We realized long ago that an Allied victory would also be a victory for the Jews."

The Berlin radio today announced the death of the notorious anti-Semite Joseph Buerckel, who, as Gauleiter of Austria immediately after the German occupation of Vienna, introduced a ruthless anti-Jewish regime and forced Jews to clean the streets of the Austrian capital with their hands. He died of inflammation of the lungs.

JEWISH DOCTORS WITH U. S. FORCES IN GERMANY GIVE MEDICAL TREATMENT TO GERMAN CIVILIANS

WITH AMERICAN TROOPS IN GERMANY, Sept. 29. (JTA) -- Jewish doctors serving with American advance units are now treating German civilians in the liberated parts of Germany, though most of them refrain from informing the patients that they are being treated by a Jew, the correspondent of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency was told today by military medical authorities.

Capt. Dr. A. S. Goldsmith of New York told the correspondent how he has been treating German civilians in Waldheim where the local German doctor fled into the interior. A young woman suffering from a severe case of pneumonia and scarcely able to walk was given sulpha-thiazole treatment and was cured, he related. "I did not tell her that I was a Jewish doctor for fear that she would refuse to take the pills thinking them poison," he added. "But when she is quite well I'll tell her." Dr. Goldsmith also removed shrapnel from legs of German civilians and treated one for acute tonsillitis.

Capt. Julius Rubin of Camden, Mass. and a number of other Jewish doctors in the U. S. units also told the correspondent that when treating German wounded prisoners and civilians they prefer not to tell them that they are being treated by a Jew. However Sgt. Jake Brill, medical aidman from New York, when giving blood transfusions to wounded German soldiers in the field, never fails to tell them that they now have Jewish blood in their veins.

One of the American doctors rendering medical aid to Germans is Dr. Ernest Sears, a refugee from Nuremberg, the seat of the notorious Jew-hater Julius Streicher. "The first case I had after landing in France was a wounded German soldier," Dr. Sears said. "I would prefer to give them brimstone, but when Germans are in need of medical treatment, I give them such treatment. I hope to get to Nuremberg and to stay there long enough to take care of some people like Streicher."

NEW OUTBREAK OF TERROR ALARMS PALESTINE JEWS; POLICE STATIONS BLASTED; FOUR KILLED

JERUSALEM, Sept. 29. (JTA) -- A new outbreak of violence by Jewish terrorists - signaled by a simultaneous attack on four police stations on midnight Wednesday - is causing great concern among Palestine Jews.

The raids were the most serious act of terrorism since the attack on the life of former High Commissioner Sir Harold MacMichael last month, and the most widespread since last March when police stations in Haifa, Jaffa and Jerusalem were blasted. There have been only sporadic disturbances in the past few months including a raid by an armed band on the central station of the Palestine Broadcasting System.

In Wednesday night's raids two constables were killed in battles with the attackers - believed to be members of the Irgun Zvai Leumi - and an Arab and an Army corporal were killed by stray shots. The raiders suffered some casualties, but none were killed. Two arrests were made. According to the official communique issued by the police the following events occurred on or about midnight:

The Beit Dajan police station on the Jaffa to Jerusalem highway was attacked by a large party which poured shots into it and exploded about 13 bombs around the approaches to the station. Police drove off the attackers without suffering any casualties, but after they had fled the dead body of an Arab killed by a stray shot was discovered.

The second attack occurred at the Qualkila police headquarters where 20 armed men dressed in British military uniforms flung several grenades causing little damage. Explosives with red warning lights were placed around the approaches to the station. The raiders were driven off after a brief skirmish.

The eastern police station in Haifa was the target of the third attack by 25 men, most of them armed with automatic rifles. After placing bombs bearing the Irgun's insignia around the station the attackers threw grenades which caused some damage. Their attempts to enter the station were repulsed, however, after a short but severe battle in which a Palestine constable was killed, a British constable suffered a brain concussion and a passerby was wounded in the leg. After the terrorists withdrew traces of blood were found in the road indicating that at least one of them had been hit.

The last attack was on the Quatra police station, in southern Palestine. Here an unknown number of armed raiders succeeded in breaking into the entrance of the building and stealing some arms. A Palestine constable and an army corporal who was passing the scene in a truck were killed.

AMERICAN ZIONISTS CABLE THANKS TO CHURCHILL FOR AIDING FORMATION OF JEWISH BRIGADE

NEW YORK, Sept. 29. (JTA) -- A message of thanks in behalf of the Zionists of America was cabled today to prime Minister Churchill by the Zionist Emergency Council for his statement in the House of Commons yesterday on the formation of the Jewish brigade group.

The message, signed by Dr. Abba Hillel Silver and Dr. Stephen S. Wise, thanked Mr. Churchill for his "personal share" in the decision to establish a Jewish brigade and expressed appreciation for his references "to the sufferings of European Jewry and to the moral justification for granting representation to a distinctive Jewish formation which will participate in the final overthrow of the Nazis."

JEWISH NATIONAL FUND CONFERENCE IN PALESTINE ISSUES APPEAL FOR TEN MILLION DOLLARS

JERUSALEM, Sept. 29. (JTA) -- An appeal to the Jews in democratic countries to raise \$10,000,000 within a year for redemption of land in Palestine was issued here today by the Jewish National Fund at its "Voice of the Land" conference, held at the Hebrew University on the occasion of the third anniversary of the death of M. M. Ussishkin, former world president of the J.N.F.

The proclamation also demanded the speedy removal of the "intolerable restrictions still hampering our activity in the sphere of land purchase." It expressed confidence that when demobilized Jewish soldiers return to their homes in Palestine, they will be provided with plots for houses, or with farms.

The conference adopted a resolution thanking the Jews of South Africa for launching a campaign for the establishment of a Ussishkin memorial in the form of a new national assembly building in Palestine to house Zionist congresses and, when Palestine becomes a Jewish State, to serve as seat of the supreme state councils. The sum of \$400,000 will be raised for this purpose among South African Jews of which a third has already been secured.

It was reported at the conference that during the past Jewish year, Jews in democratic countries contributed \$7,000,000 to the Jewish National Fund, the largest sum ever raised during a single year in the entire history of the J.N.F. Dr. Abraham Granovsky, managing director of the organization, reported to the conference that despite the existing restrictions on land acquisition by Jews, the Jewish National Fund acquired 250,000 dunams of land during the five years since the restrictions came into existence, of which 60,000 dunam were acquired during the past year. He disclosed that the J.N.F. has already allotted plots for suburban housing of 2,500 families of Jewish soldiers.

AUSTRALIAN PUBLIC OPINION SPLIT ON JEWISH SETTLEMENT; 37% FOR AND 47% AGAINST

MELBOURNE, Australia, Sept. 29. (JTA) -- Thirty-seven percent of the Australian people would favor a Jewish settlement in northern Australia, while forty-seven percent are opposed to it and sixteen percent are undecided, according to the results of a Gallup poll released here today.

Commenting on the results, the organizers of the poll state that they would seem to indicate that Australians are not opposed to normal Jewish immigration into towns and cities but that many fear that a separate Jewish settlement would create a minority problem. Some expressed the fear that the Jewish settlers would eventually leave such a settlement and come to the cities.

OSE OPENS OFFICE IN FRANCE TO REUNITE CHILDREN WITH PARENTS

NEW YORK, Sept. 29. (JTA) -- The OSE - Jewish Health Society - has opened an office in France to reunite children with their parents from whom they were separated during the German occupation, it is reported in a cable from the Geneva office of the OSE received today by the organization's local headquarters.

The OSE has also sent food and medicine into France for the use of Jewish children and is planning to reopen children's homes in several cities in southern France. At present OSE has 400 children under its supervision.

MAYORS OF 300 CITIES ASKED TO BAN ANTI-JEWISH PROPAGANDA IN PRESIDENTIAL CAMPAIGN

NEW YORK, Sept. 29. (JTA) -- The mayors of some 300 cities - all those in the U. S. with populations of more than 300,000 persons - were called on today by the National Conference of Christians and Jews to issue a proclamation urging political leaders in their communities to ban the injection of racial and religious issues in the current campaign.

In a letter to the mayors, Dr. Everett R. Clinchy, Conference president, said: "The campaign managers of the two major political parties Robert Hannegan and Herbert Brownell, Jr., on Sept. 14 committed their parties against the injection of racial and religious animosities into the current political campaign. This was an unprecedented event in our political history but it is essential that the influence of all American leaders be exerted to keep this campaign free from hate and bigotry.

"We now turn to you and to all other members of the U. S. Conference of Mayors for assistance. We are confident that a proclamation along these lines from you to the people of your city would prove to be of immeasurable significance. If you will do so you will be making a vital contribution to the integrity and security of the American system of government."

ROOSEVELT AND DEWEY PRAISE WAR RECORD OF AMERICAN JEWS IN MESSAGE TO WAR VETERANS

NEW YORK, Sept. 29. (JTA) -- Tributes to the valor of American Jewry were expressed by President Roosevelt and Governor Dewey in statements to the Jewish War Veterans of the U. S. on the occasion of their 49th annual encampment which opens at the Hotel Commodore on October 5th.

In letters addressed to National Commander Archie H. Greenberg, President Roosevelt declared that the Jewish War Veterans "in peace and in war, over the forty-eight years since it was founded, have lived up to the highest traditions of loyalty and service" and Governor Dewey said that "in war, the Jewish Veterans created for themselves a record of valor in consonance with the noble traditions of Jewish history."

J.D.C. ESTABLISHES RESEARCH OFFICE; WILL SYSTEMATIZE 30-YEAR RECORDS OF J.D.C. WORK

NEW YORK, Sept. 29. (JTA) -- The Joint Distribution Committee today announced the establishment of a research department under the direction of Prof. Nathan Reich, who is on leave of absence from Hunter College where he was acting chairman of the department of economics.

The newly established office will arrange the records of the 30 years of J.D.C. relief activities and will gather, digest and interpret existing data concerning the current welfare and community needs of Jews in war-torn Europe, Joseph C. Hyman, executive vice-chairman of the J.D.C., said.

BEN-GURION HAS NARROW ESCAPE WHEN CAR STRUCK BY MILITARY TRUCK IN PALESTINE

JERUSALEM, Sept. 29. (JTA) -- David Ben-Gurion, chairman of the executive of the Jewish Agency for Palestine, narrowly escaped serious injury yesterday when the automobile in which he was travelling collided with a military truck near Hadera. The auto was badly damaged but Ben-Gurion escaped with minor bruises.

N. LAZARUS, ZIONIST LEADER IN ENGLAND, DIES; WAS CORRESPONDENT FOR NEW YORK NEWSPAPER

LONDON, Sept. 29. (JTA) -- Nathan Lazarus, veteran Zionist and a member of the executive council of the British Zionist Federation, died here today. He was 57. He was the London correspondent of the New York Jewish Morning Journal for about thirty years.
