10,000 CARPATHIAN JEWS LIBERATED BY RUSSIAN ARMY; MANY POUGHT IN PARTISAN UNITS

JERUSALEM, Peb. 2. (JEA) — Reports resching here today establish that among its jews liberated by the Russian Army in Hungary are 10,000 from the Carrathian section of the country which formerly belonged to Caechoslovakia and which ray now been a part of Soviet Ukraine.

SMISE CHILIREN IN POLAND REPUDIATE THEIR PARENTS; PREFER TO REMAIN CHRISTIANS

LUBLIN, Feb. 2. (JTA) — The Central Jewish Committee here today sent representatives to various parts of newly-liberated Polish territory to register the surviving Jews there and to provide immediate relief for them.

At the same time, it was revealed here today that some of the Jewish shidren in the Warsaw ghetto who were given shelter by Christians refuse to return to their prents because they are Jews. These children do not recognize their prents since they have not seen them for several years.

The Central Jewish Committee has established that all Jews in Kieloe were markered by the Germans prior to their retreat from the city. In the town of Ostrowice only 26 Jews remain alive.

Mexican Government Permits Immigration of 100 Jewish Children from Europe

MEXICO CITY, Peb. 2. (JTA) - The Mexican branch of the OSE World Jewish Salth Scalety, was notified today that the Berican Government has approved the imigration of 100 Jewish refugee children from Europe.

The children will come from the OSE homes in France where they have been sheltered since the outbreak of the war. The Maxican Consuls in France have been instructed to issue visas for the children as soon as they are selected, the OSE was informed.

Degotiations for the admission of jewish refuges children to Maxico have been going on for some time following the decision of the united States Government and Canada to admit a number of refuges children from France. 2/4/45

MISCON COMMISSION REPORTS ON DESTRUCTION OF JEWISH INSTITUTIONS BY GERMANS IN VILNA

WASHINGTON, Feb. 2. (JTA) — The Soviet Embassy here today made public a report of the Extraordinary State Committee, detailing mass slaughters and other crimes of German invaders of Lithuania, including the destruction of numbers of finous jowish cultural institutions. The report includes statements of eyewitnesses talling how foreigners including Jews were executed at various places.

Among the Jewish cultural institutions reported "completely smashed" are; the famous Strashun library, the Jewish Scientific Institute, and the Jewish Museum of Ristory and Ethnography, all in the city of Vilna. The Germans also sont to the gai Research Institute on Jewish Affairs in Frankfurt-on-Main paintings and soulptures by Levitan, Chagall, Antokolsky and other well-known Jewish artists, and manuscripts of Sholem Aleichem and other prominent Jewish authors.

Jewish Revols Against Germans in Transmistria Disclosed in Moseow

MOSCOW, Feb. 2. (JTA) — Although the Germans murdered tons of thousands of Jews whom they deported to Transnistria, they did not do so without a struggle, it was disclosed here in a report made public todays.

The report reveals that in many towns in Transnistria, which was the name

given by the Nazis to the section of the Soviet Ukraine held jointly by German and Rummian troops, armed Jewish insurrections took place. In the towns of Smotrichi, Gusiatin, Staraya-Uschitsa and Dunayevtsy, all in the Kamenetz-Podolsk area, groups of young Jews harrassed the Germans, and, in some cases, engaged in pitched battles with them.

At Gusiatin a group of young Jews killed the German sentries guarding an examition dump and made off with tommy-guns which they used to attack a German detachment leading a group of Jewish deportees to Kamentz-Podolsk, The German gurds fled and many Jews escaped. This band was led by Leva Golohaber, now a captain in the Red Army.

In Staraya-Uschitsa about 20 young Jews attacked German guards who had thrown grenades into a column of deportees. In the bloody battle that followed many Germans and most of the Jews were killed, but a few of the latter succeeded in fleeing.

In the ghetto of Dynayevtsy there were about 8,500 Jews who were used as forced labor building roads. The German guards would amuse themselves by placing see of the Jews in rubble up to their necks and leaving them there to die. One day, then they were no longer able to bear these spectacles, the Jews revolted, refused to work and stoned the guards, killing many of them.

. That night a punitive detachment arrived in the ghetto. The residents were stripped of all their clothes, and next morning were driven to work in their under-clothes. Eighteen youths were hanged from telegraph poles. Eventually, when the read building job was finished, all of them were thrown into a flooded mine and left to die.

ALESTER LABOR GROUPS DIVIDED ON ISSUE OF ORGANIZING UNITED HECHALUTZ MOVEMENT

TEL AVIV, Feb. 2. (JTA) — The question of whether the Hechalutz movement should be united, or whether each Zionist party should have its own facilities for training pioneers for Palestine, was the center of discussion today at the Histadruth conference here.

The opposition group within the Histadruth, as well as the Poale-Zion and the Heshows Hatzar, opposed unification of the Hechalutz, arguing that the education of Jemish youth cannot be trusted to groups like the Hapoel Hamizrachi, the religious ring of the Felestine labor movement. David Ben-Gurion defended creation of a united Hesheluts.

A delegation of the Histadruth conference today visited the Chief Scoretary of the Palestine Government and appealed for the opening of Palestine to immigration of Jews from liberated parts of Europe, emphasizing the urgent necessity for such emphasizing the segretions.

LAKER APPRAIS ON SENATE FLOOR FOR MERCY FOR MOYNE ASSASSINS; ASKS HEW PALESTINE POLICY

WASHINGTON, Feb. Z. (JTA) — An appeal to prime Minister Winston Churchill to receive compassion and mercy" in the case of Eliahu Hakim and Ephraim Ben Zuri, consensed rurderers of Lord Moyne, was voiced yesterday in the Senate by Senawilliam Lagar, North Dakota Republican. At the same, time Sen. Langer called on Mr. Churchill wirediately abrogate the present British policy in pelestine "which is directly responsible for the death of Lord Moyne."

Criticizing the censorship which prevented publication of the assassins' widnesses explaining their motives, Sen. Langer stated:

"I wish to appeal to Mr. Churchill, the Prime Minister and leader of our gett ally not only to exercise compassion and mercy in this particular case, but to delay no longer the abrogation of the present Pritish policy in Palestine which to hisself so bitterly and strongly condemned in 1939, when it was first announced by the late arch appeaser, Neville Chamberlain, and which is directly responsible for the tragic death of Lord Moyne, as it is directly responsible for the tragic sett of hundreds of thousands of innocent Hebrew men, women and children in Europe,"

BURAL B'RITH SOLD \$120,178,930 IN BONDS DURING SIXTH WAR LOAN

WASHINGTON, Feb. 2. (JTA) — War bond sales by B'nai B'rith reached \$461,500,000 at the close of the 6th War Loan during which the organization was credited with selling \$120,178,930 worth, it was announced today at B'nai B'rith head-parters by the National War Service Department.

Of the grand total to date, the Binei Birith men accounted for \$509,500,000; the Birith women for \$125,000,000; Aleph Zadik Aleph, Binei Birith Girls and Birith Young Women, \$20,000,000 and Binei Birith Hillel Foundations, \$7,000,000.
