GENAIO AGREES TO LEIELSE JEWS FROM CALLES; 1,200 REACH SWITZERLAND; MORE DUE TODAY

GENEVA. Feb. 8. (JTA) - One of the most fentastic feets of rescue of Jewish internees from german concentration comps has been accomplished by a group of tenty orthodox Swiss Jews who sent Jean Me Musy, a former member of the Swiss Federal council, to Gastapo chief Heinrich Himmler in order to negotiate with him concerning the fate of Jews remaining in Germany.

As a result of the negotiations, a group of 1,200 Jews released from the amentration came in Theresienstadt arrived in Switzerland last night from Germany, and 540 more are expected to arrive here tomorrow. The release of these internees is emsidered a very important achievement.

Addressing a press conference today. Swiss Minister of Justice. Rduned von Staiger, said that it is hoped that henceforth regular transports of Jews from Germany all arrive in Switzerland. All the arrivals, he declared, will be placed in refugee says in Switzerland and will be obliged to leave the country at the earliest ressible date.

About one-half of the 1,200 Jews from Theresienstadt are natives of Holland the were deported by the Germans from Amsterdam and other Dutch cities. There are also Schildren under the age of 12 in the group. The remainder are Jews from Germany and sechoslovakia. The 540 Jews who are expected to reach Switzerland tomorrow are deportes from France. The refugees from Theresianstadt were given food to last for the three-day trip from the camp to the Swiss frontier.

MILITARY CURFEW CLAPTED DOWN ON TEL AVIV: HOUSES RAIDED, ARRESTS MADE

TEL AVIV. Feb. 8. (JTA) - Military police clamped down a rigid curfew on the southorn section of rel Aviv at 5 name today. Reiding parties secreted houses and partments and took their occupants to pelice stations for investigations

In Jorusalem it was announced that all police cars in the country will be equipped with radio apparatus enabling them to be in direct contact with headquarters stall times. The system was set up in order to cope more efficiently with terrorist. outbreaks and robberies. The Jerusalem police have already installed such equipment and other police posts will be equipped within two weeks.

Addressing a press conference here today, John V. M. Show, Chief Secretary of the inlesting Government, disclosed that 899 terrorist suspects have been seized since the current outbreaks began. Of these, 279 were sent to Eritron, and later transferred to the Sudan; 266 are still confined in the Latrun Detention Camp here and about 400 have been released.

EGNITIAN DELEGATION INJECTS ANAL-JEWISH ISSUE INTO WORLD TRADE UNION CONFERENCE

LONDON; Feb. & (JTA) - The first effort to inject the Arab-Jewish issue into the World Trade Union Conference here was made by the Egyptian delogation which deranded that an Arab delegate from palestine be appointed a member of the credentials comittee because Borl Locker, who represents Falestine Jewish labor, is on the body.

MINT FOLICY ON REFUGEES BY DRITAIN, U.S. AND RUSSIA DEMANDED IN FARLIABENT

LOHDON, Feb. 8. (JTA) — A joint statement by Dritain, the United States of Busia outlining a common policy on the refugee problem was demanded yesterday in the Mouse of Lords by Lord Templewood. He charged that present methods of dealing ith disclosed persons were totally inadequate:

Lord Strabolgi, discussing the plight of the Jewish refugees in liberated territory, said that eighty percent of them, about 700,000 persons, were willing to eight to lalestine if visas were available. An influx of these people, he added, rails provide more recruits for the Jewish Prigade.

Replying for the Government, Viscount Cranborne, former Colonial Minister, sid that the failure to admit more people to Palestine was not because the immigration quote was extensived, but because of the housing shortage there. Admitting that the majority of the liberated Jews wish to go to Falestine, Lord Cranborne said that the choice of immigrants has been left to the Jewish Agency to when the immigration vertificates are allocated.

The advised against "raising false hopes" of an easy way out of the refugee roller, adding that "however we taskle it, it will be with us for many years to come; it is likely to occupy the whole of our lives and, perhaps, the lives of our children, bursed that the question be dealt with on an international basis.

GREARS FREVENTED RESCUE OF JEWS FROM BUIGARIA; KING INSISTED ON FIRM ANTI-JEWISH POLICY

SCFIA, Feb. 8. (JTA) — Failure of the negotiations to secure the release of 4,000 jewish children and 500 adults from Eulgaria two years ago resulted from pussure brought upon the Eulgarian Government by the German Minister in Scfia, it is revealed in the diary of Degdan Filov, expremier and regent who was executed last mek for treason.

An entry in Filov's diary dated February 17, 1943 states; "Reminded King to days ago that Dekerle (the German envey) told me that his government would not agree us allowing the emigration to Felestine of 4,000 Jewish children and 500 adult as agreed with the Pritish Government through the Swiss legation. The Germans do not sish to interfere in our internal affairs, but would support a government able to liquidate the Communists and the Jews,"

Many other passages in the diary deal with Filov's conferences with the ring and members of the government on measures for further persecuting the jews. One records his decision to utilize the assassination of general pukoff, leader of the Pulgarian troops, by an unknown assailant for a drive on "the jews and Communists," luther, acted worch 15, 1943, says, "Recaived by King for two hours. Discussed the whish questions King insists on firm behaviors."

MISE SERVICEMEN'S CLUE OFENED IN FORMER NAZI ACADEMY IN LRUSSELS

LONDON, bet. 8. (JTA) — A club for Jewish servicemen has been opened in Prissels in a building which formerly housed a Nozi culture academy, it was disclosed here today at a recting of the Jewish Respitality Committee which has established more than 200 servicements centers in pritain and five in Italy.

MAND OF AMERICAN DENTAL ASSOCIATION MEETS TO STUDY FLAN TO LIMIT JEWS IN COLLEGES

NEW YORK, Peb. 8 (JTA) — The board of trustees of the American Dental issuciation will nest in Chicago tomorrow to consider the confidential reports of F. Erlan H. Horzor, secretary of the Council on Dental Education of the Aspeks, recommending the limitation of the number of Jewish students admitted to New York texts colleges, it was learned here today.

The trustees plan to make a thorough investigation of the Horrer reports and the circumstances of their submission to columbia and New York Universities and Education of the House of Representatives, it was indicated by the patal Information Dureau here. A bureau executive said that, in the opinion of the trustees, noither Dr. Horner, nor the council had the power or authority to submit these reports without the knowledge or consent of the A.D.A. It was indicated, too, that unless Dr. Horner had some unequivocal explanation for his action, he would be relieved of his post.

A statement issued by the Dental Information Eureau, which speaks for the minus h.D.A. affiliates in the New York and New Jersey areas, reads; "The Dental Information Dureau is reliably informed by an American Dental Association trustee that the Council on Education had no power or authority to submit the Dr. Farlan H. Berner rejects to any institutions without the consent of the A.D.A. The bureau deplaces the acute embarrassment laid on the A.D.A. by what appears to have been an unawherized and unwarranted action by the Council on Dental Education. This is the first time in the long and meritorious history of the A.D.A. that such a situation has arisen. It may be safely presumed that offective steps toward forestalling similar future situations will be taken by the board of trustees."

Students Ask Removal of Dr. Horner; Dental Groups Criticize His Report

A petition describing the reports of Dr. Horner as an Waffront to the overwhelming majority of the A.D.A. membership was being circulated today among the students and faculty of the New York Dental College. Removal of Dr. Horner from his position is demanded by the student council, headed by Hichael Wris. Among the dental societies associated with the A.D.A. directly or through their membership, which have adopted resolutions attacking the Horner reports are the Dental Society of the State of New York, the First and Second District Dental Societies of the State of New York and several groups of the New Jersey State Dental Society.

Dr. Williard C. Rappelye, dean of the Columbia Medical School, denied any discrimination there. He reinted out that in accordance with the original charter of the King's College, Columbia University has always selected students on the basis of arit clone, without reference to race, color or creed. Whe have no quota, never had one and never intend to have one, he declared in a statement to the press, additional Columbia's policy has not been swayed by Dr. Horner's recommendations concerning racial unbalance. A similar statement was issued yesterday by Chancellar Harry W. Chaso of the New York University.

MALESTINE GOVERNMENT ESTABLISHES DODY TO SECURE JOES FOR DEMOLILIZED SERVICEMEN

JEMUSALEM, Feb. 8 (JTA) — A special advisory council to facilitate the return of demobilized servicemen and women to their pre-war occupations has been established by the High Commissioner, it was announced today. Various government departments and representatives of the Jewish and Arab communities will be represented in the council, which is to be headed by the Deputy Director of the Laior Department.

HAS FOR FOST-WAR DEVELOPMENT OF FALESTINE ANNOUNCED BY PALESTINE ECONOMIC CORP.

NEW York Feb 8 (JTA) — Fost-war plans for development of industry and agriculture in Felestine were announced today by the Felestine Economic Corporation, the largest American business enterprise in that country. The Corporation will carry mitte program of expansion as soon after the war as possible, in order to accelerate the tempo of absorption of new immigrants by creating more opportunities for employment, according to Robert Szold, chairman of the board of directors.

To provide the increased capital necessary, hr. Szold said, the Corporation has rejistered with the Securities and Exchange Commission an issue of \$1,500,000 minimal common stock, consisting of 15,000 shares priced at \$100 per share. At the present time, it has capital reserves and surplus in excess of \$3,500,000. There are 1,000 American stockholders.

Included in the post-war plans of the Falestine Economic Corporation is the purchase of machinery and machine tools in the United States on order for the requirent and modernization of Falestine's industry and agriculture. Fuch of the investil equipment of the 7,000 workshops, small plants and manufacturing establishments in Falestine, costing \$50,000,000, will have to be replaced as soon as possible because most of this machinery is old, worn out and out of date, ir. Szold pointed out.

Other post-war plans provide for the construction of modern irrigation , materiors on a public utility basis; development of low cost housing rojects; direct investment in basic manufacturing undertakings; indirect investment in industry through erection of factory buildings for lease to small manufacturers; and extension of credit for agricultural developments.

DETAIN FOR JETTISH REPRESENTATION ON WAR CRIMES COMMISSION MADE IN HOUSE

WASHINGTON, Feb. 8 (JTA) — A demand for official Jewish representation on the United Nations War Crimes Commission was made yesterday by Rej. Thomas J. Lane, 1988, Denocrat, speaking on the floor of the House.

Rep. Lane also urged that the united Nations issue a declaration placing punishment of war crimes against Jews in Axis courtries. He criticized the removal of Earbert C. Fell as American representative on the War Crimes Commission.

SUCCESSOR TO KU KLUX KIAN FOUNDED IN GEORGIA TO CONTAT JEWS AND NEGROES

NEW YORK, Feb. 8 (JTA) — A successor to the Ku Klux Klan, calling itself the "Commoner Forty," has been established in Georgis, it was learned here today. A pumplet outlining the organizations aims declares that "the Commoner Forty proposes the fornation of a Gentile political party bloc to combat the jew and Negro racial bloc, now active in the political affairs of the nation."
