#### MAISH AGENCY REPRESENTATIVE ARRIVES IN ROME; IRINGS 900 PALESTINE IMMIGRATION VISAS

ROME, Feb. 9. (JTA) - An enthusiastic reception was given today by Jews in gene to Dr. Solomon Umberto Nahon, representative of the Jewish Agency for Felestine, who arrived from Jerusalem to distribute about 900 Pelestine immigration cortificates.

Dr. Nahon, who prior to emigrating to Falestine six years ago, was the meretary of the Zionist Organization in Rome, was welcomed by Jowish leaders here at a special meeting this afternoon, immediately upon his arrival, He is the first civil lam to arrive here from Falestine with a message from the Jewish homeland. He is abbuild to remain for several weeks.

pr. Mahon today conferred with officials of the Zionist organizations in mem and with the representative of the Intergovernmental Committee on Refugees, discussing the question of transportation of those who will be selected for emigration to maistine. At present, there are 2,000 applicants for palestine visas already on the list of the Zioniet Organization here. The 900 who will be selected are expected to leave for palestine by the end of March. They will be the first group of Jows to leave Italy for palestine since the liberation of Rome by the Allies.

#### MISCON ARRANGES REPATRIATION OF JEWS FROM TRANSMISTRIA TO THEIR HOMES IN RUMANIA

EUGHAREST, Febe 9. (JTA) — jowish leaders here were informed today by the Soviet members of the Allied Control Commission that the Moscow authorities have seeded a definite decision on the methods of repatriation of Jews who were deported by the former pro-Nowi Rumanian regime from various scettions of Rumania to downstated parts of the Ukraine which the Rumanians named Transmistria.

It is understood that the Moscow decision provides for the repatriation of only those Jows who were born in Southern Dukovina and in the part of Rumania known as the Old Ringdon. Jews born in Dessarabia or in the section of Dukovina which is claimed by the Soviet authorities as integral part of the USSR, are considered Soviet citimess and are not to be repatriated.

Jewish organizations here today opened negotiations with the Allied Armistics Commission to permit their representatives to participate in the work of receiving the repatriated Jews and of organizing for them any assistance they may need.

#### wish refugees from reich suffer in delgium as "german nationals"; many arrested

IRUSSEIS,Fe's 9. (JTA) — About 5,000 Jewish refugees from germany and Austis who manged to escape capture and deportation under german occupation have been elestified as "enomy aliens" by the polgian government and are being subjected to restrictive security measures, a special correspondent of the Jewish relegraphic Agency stablished here today.

These refugees who were deprived of Gorman nationality by Hitler under the pair resial laws, and thus left stateless, were re-classified by the Belgian authorities as "Germans" and are being treated accordingly. Several hundred of them have been created and imprisoned on the sole ground that they are German nationals, while strict police supervision was established over the remainder. They are required to report to the police one or more times weekly and cannot leave the district in which they reside.

The property of all these Jews has been sequestered. Their bank and postalaccounts have been blocked. None of these Jews can receive insurance benefits, nor collect from debtors. They cannot bring action in courts, and are refused permission to well.

Some of these refugees have organized a "Jewish Committee of Refugees and Notins of Recial Lews" and are seeking to bring their plight to the attention of the selging government and Allica military authorities. They protest bitterly against the stigm of being placed in the same category with Maris and seek restoration of their status as refugees enjoying sanctuary until such a time as the future of all victims of Mari racial policy will be determined.

#### AMERICAN JEJS LICK UNITED REFRESENTATION, FROF. IRODETSKY REPORTS IN LONDON

LONDON, Feb. 9. (JTA) — Prof. Solis prodetsky, president of the goard of Deputies of Pritish Jows, reporting today on his impressions of Jowish life in the Matted Statos, from where he recently returned, said that he had come to the conclusion that the most effective way of combining the Jews of America and England in a common effect would be to establish an uncefficial unified body composed of those Jewish communities and any others which would like to join in meeting present and post-war Jewish problems.

There is no single body representing all American Jewry, Prof. E-codetsky isolated. The American Jewish Conference represents an overwhelming majority of American Jews, but even this organization is not like the Doard of Deputies of Eritish Jows which represents all the Jews of England directly. Reporting on the Wise-Silver rift, Prof. Drodetsky expressed the hope that "means will be found shortly to solve this very inportant dispute and to put palestine political work in the United States on the best possible basis."

In Med predicted that the trustees of the ADA would reject the Horner recommendation.

#### M ANTI-JENISH PREJUDICE EXISTS AMONG AMERICAN SERVICEMEN, J.W.L. OFFICIAL REPORTS

NEW YORK, Feb 9. (JTA)— A wholesome prospect for post-war America is the sprint of commadeship which exists among men living together under combat conditions, it was reported at a press conference here today by Rabbi Philip S. Pernstein, executive director of the National Jewish Welfare Board's Committee on Army and Havy Religious activities, who returned this week from a 35,000 mile tour of the Pacific war fronts.

The concern of men coming up against the enemy is "not with the antecetents of a gunner but with his character, his ability," Rabbi Jernstein scide. "As a
result, rejudice is unthinkable, there is a remarkable and healthy spirit of teamturk," farticularly gratifying to Rabbi Tornstein was the evidence he sew of "a
balthy, vigorous Jewish life among the Jowish military personnel." There was no

#### WILD JEWIS! CONGRESS RECEIVES LISTS OF SURVIVING JEWS IN POLAND AND RUSSIA

HEW YORK, Feb. 9. (JTA) — Partial lists of Jewish survivors in more than forty liberated towns of formerly occupied Russia and Poland, received by the World which Congress here from the Jewish anti-Rascist committee in Moscow, indicate the attent to which the Jewish population in those areas has been destroyed, the Congress and today in a statement issued at a press conference.

The lists cover the following towns: of Lublin's 83,000 Jews 605 remain; of \$5,000 in vilna, 506 were found alive; of 40,000 in Lialystok, 113 survived; of 25,000 in Kovno 574 remains. In addition, hundreds of thousands of Jews deported from their parts of Europe were mandered in these cities, the statement pointed cuts. In may smaller towns only one or two Jews were found, and these, frequently, were not residents of the town, but were shipped there by the Germans.

## DAMEL HARRIS, LAST JEWISH CIVIL WAR VETERAN, DIES AT 100, FUNERAL MONDAY

NEW YORK, Feb. 9. (JTA) — Daniel Herris, last surviver of 8,600 Jewish were terrans of the Civil War, died here yesterday in his 100th years.
