CONTESTED HOME RABBI HAD LONG BEEN ADMIRER OF JESUS; WHOTE BOOK ON SUBJECT

ROME. Feb. 19 (JTA) - Israel Zolli, former chief rabbi of Rome who caused a mention by his conversion last week to Catholicism has long been an admirer of Jesus mi even wrote a book on the subject several years ago, it was revealed here today.

The S70-page book, entitled "The Nazarone" and published in the Italian largere in 1938 by the Institute of Academic Editions in Udine, is a study of the angesis of the New Testament, In it, Zolli refers to Jesus as a greet crater and measher, emphasizing that "the oratory of Jesus is of a prophetic oheracter",

Zolli wrote this book on Jesus when he was teaching at the University of Palua ofter he became a member of the Fascist Party in order to retain his position at the University. Asked by newspapermen last week as to what prompted kim to adopt atholicism, he said, "This has been going on in me for years, tens of years,"

golli complained of Starvation, Wanted 900,000 Liras from Jewish Community

NEW YORK, Feb. 19 (JTA) — The Jewish Telegraphic Agency learns from reliable moves that prior to adopting Catholicism, Zolli, in a communication received in this many, complained that he was facing starvation. He indicated that there was a rift three him and the leaders of the Jewish community in Rome, and that he was at odds about the Zionists, despite the fact that he had, in his speeches and articles, married Zionism.

Zolli also revealed that the Jewish Community in Rome was willing to give him 20,000 lires, but that he had asked for 900,000 lires "just to buy a hut and a piece of had order to keep from starving." According to all indications, Zolli was unable assure that sums.

Although Zolli mentioned to newspapermen in Rome that his wife had joined to enthelic church without being persuaded by him to do so, he failed to state that at the time he married her, she was only half-jewish.

The differences between Zolli and the leaders of the Rome Jewish Community bear when the Gormans took over Italy. At that time he advised that the list of meres and contributors of the Jewish community be destroyed and that wheter money was in the treasury of the community be taken out and that the Jews be advised by their laders to hide, this advice was not heeded. As a result, about 2,000 Jews were arrested by the Germans in Rome and deported from the city. The Germans also levied on the impures a tribute of 50 kilograms of gold.

Zolli himself went into hiding during the time when the Germans were in Rome. Then the liberation of the city by the Allies, the president of the Rome Jewhelmunity took the position that Zolli should not be reinstated as chief rabble because is and not been available during the compation period. WANTA KIROPRIATES 500 JEWISH BUILDINGS FOR USE AS GOVERNMENT OFFICES

BUCHAREST, Feb. 19. (JTA) — The Rumanian Government today released a list of M Jewish-owned buildings which have been expropriated by the Cabinet for use by present institutions which are now occupying them.

The Federation of Jewish communities has applied to the Ministry of the Interior for a plot of land in the village of Commr, in Transylvania, for burial of 156 first messacred there by Mungarian troops last Soptember. The Pederation has also demaid that Mungarians who assisted in the massacre be compelled to exhume the bodies, which are now in a mass-grave, and re-bury them in new graves.

BEND, Feb. 19 (JTA) — The Swiss radio today reported that Gestapo chief mimich Himmler has issued a statement in Berlin asserting that about 700,000 Jews at still alive in various sections of Europe ruled by Germany. The statement did mitimicate whether Himmler's data included hulf-Jews and quarter-Jews whom the state outly classifies as Jews.

The broadcast emphasized that the Swiss Government was to a large extent which in securing the release by the Gestapo of 1,200 Jews from the Mazi camp in thresienstadt who recently arrived in Switersland. It added that more transports of one released from German camps are expected to arrive on Swiss soil. "The Swiss menument is gladly giving shelter to the Jowish refugees until transport facilities while them to find homes in other countries," the broadcast declared.

AMBICAN JEWISH COMMITTEE INVITES OTHER GROUPS TO FORMULATE JOINT POST-WAR POLICY

MEN YORK Feb. 19 (JTA) - A call for an informal conference to consider the fermitation of a unified Jewish post-war program was made by the American Jewish comittee in invitations extended today to the Agudas Israel of America, the American wish conference, the American Jewish Congress, and the Jewish Labor Committee.

In identical letters to Rabbi Elieser Silver, president of the Agudas Israel d Merica: Louis Lipsky, co-chairman of the American Jewish Conference: Dr. Stephen s, risc, president of the American Jewish Congress and Adolph Held, president of the wish Labor Committee, Judge Joseph & Proskauer, president of the American Jewish comittee, asked the four other organizations to collaborate with the American Jewish comittee in espousing "under the general provisions of the numberton Oaks proposals. three Commissions, 1, a Commission on the Protection of Aman Rights; 2, a Cormission m Harabion, and 3, a Commission on Statelessness."

Pointing out that these three Commissions were recommended by the group of scholers and Jewish community leaders composing the American Jewish committee's "comittee on Peace Problems." Judge Proskauer wrote. "I think these projects will no doubt enlist the support of all shedos of Jewish opinion and that they are of vital importance to the protection of European Jewry. "I write, therefore, to inquire whether you would come to an informal conference to consider the possibility of unified Jewish support for these three projects. If you will indicate to me your willingsess to do this, I will immediately take up with you the time and place. It is not my like that this conference would act in any formal or definitive manner, but that it wild revely lay the basis for action by all organizations, if they are so advised, for a common effort to achieve these results."

IMEZ-AMERICAN CONFERENCE WILL DISCUSS POST-WAR JEWISH TEXTERATION, DELEGATE SAYS

MEXICO CITY, Feb. 19.
