ESUMPTION OF UNITED JEWISH APPEAL SOUGHT BY COUNCIL OF JEWISH FEDERATIONS

NEW YORK, Feb. 23. (JTA) - A renewed effort to bring about resumption of the United Jewish Appeal, whose dissolution was ennounced last week, was made today by the Council of Jewish Federations and Welfare Funds in a telegram sent to Paul Berwald, chairman of the Joint Distribution Committee and to Rabbi James Heller, thirmon of the United Palestine Appeala

The telegram, signed by Sidney Hollander, president of the council of Jewish Federations and Welfare Funds, reads as follows: "Overwhelming Welfare Fund scatiments is that decision to conduct independent appeal by the J.D.C. and U.P.A. threaten to implye communities in extreme difficulties in raising funds and in arriving at equitable decisions on relative needs. Fears are also expressed that loss funds would be mde available under these conditions in spite of largely increased needs. As president of the Council I strongly urge your organization to submit your differences to arbitration by mutually acceptable procedure. Prompt action in response to this telegram is essential to our mutual causes and objectives."

RUSSIA REPATRIATES 10,000 JEWS OF RUMANIAN CITIZENSHIP TO THEIR FORMER HOMES

BUCHAREST, Feb. 23. (JTA) - Approximately 10,000 Jews from Transylvania, Bukowing and Old Rumania will be repatriated from Soviet Russia early next month, it ws learned here today by the Jewish Telegraphic Agency. These Jews were deported from their homes to Transmistria in the then - occupied Soviet Ukraine when Rumania ms an ally of Germany. The repatriated Jews are natives of the sections of Rumania thich have been acknowledged by the Soviet Government to be Rumanian territory.

The Rumanian Government today announced that it will ship back to Odessa 500 tons of tombstones which were taken from the Odessa Jewish semetery by the former Rumnian pro-Nazi regime and transported to Rumania for sale as building material. An official announcement today also reveals that Alexander Cuza, notorious anti-Semitic leader, has been deprived of his title of honorary professor.

UNITED NATIONS CONFERENCE IN SAN FRANCISCO WILL DISCUSS FATE OF MANDATED LANDS

PARIS, Feb. 23 (JTA) - The American Embassy and the French Foreign Office today denied the report that a secret memorandum was submitted by U. S. Ambassador Caffery to General de Caulle outlining a plan under which Franse would surrender its mudates over Syria and Lebonon and the British Government would surrender its Palestine mandate to a new Unit ? Nations! authority.

It was authoritatively stated here today that the question of a new interactional system of mandates replacing the old League of Mations' control will be on the agenda of the forthcoming conference of the United Nations in San Francisco, but no detailed proposals for this new system have thus far been submitted to the French Governments

RESTITIONING OF PALESTINE OPPOSED BY HEBREW PRESS; ARTICLES URGE VIGILATION

JERUSAIEM, Feb. 23. (JTA) — Official and semi-official denials of the Cairo ment that Felestine is to be partitioned and that the Jewish part of it will be detected with Jebanon are published in the local newspapers. Hevertholess, the phrew press continues to discuss the possibility of such a plan and the attitude of plastine Jewry toward it.

Davar, leading Hebtew newspaper, says that it is a fact that Roosevelt and charchill met with the Arab rulers and it is therefore highly possible that they twoked upon the Palestine problem. Although the subjects discussed are not yet known, they will not remain secret for a long time, it adds. "We have the right to hope that we political demends are not unknown to Churchill and Roosevelt and that they have the good will to secure for the Jewish mation a state", Davar says. The paper opposes the witting off of considerable parts of the Jordan and the Jordan Valley waters from the section of the country which would become part of the proposed Jewish state under crititions.

Haarots, another leading daily, says: "Our task in these days is to be on gurd, We must strengthen our political front in London and in Washington," The Electine Post, the Hebrew daily Hatsofe and prectically all other Hebrew newspapers in Jerusalem and Tel Aviv carry articles opposing the partitioning of Palestine.

FRENCH ASSEMBLY GETS TWO DRAFTS OF LAWS FOR PROFERTY RESTITUTION; SENDS THEM TO COMMISS

PARIS, Feb. 23. (JTA) -- Two drafts of a law providing for the restitution of Frogerty seized from Jews and others under the discriminatory legislation of the Viohy regime and during the German occupation were today before the Consultative Assembly.

The was submitted by the Government and the other by the Socialist Party.

The Government draft was signed by Gen. de Gaulle and by the Ministers of Justice, Finance and National Economy. The original text, which evoked much criticism, has been considerably altered, but the draft is still considered defective on many grounds, both regarding the principle involved and the procedure it establishes for the recovery of the property. Both proposals will undergo lengthy scrutiny by a special commission to which they have been referred.

As drafted, the government establishes a distinction between those whose property was transferred without their consent and those who gave their consent. In the former case, the acquirers of the property are held to have acted in bad faith and the transfers are voided. Those cases will come before the president of the civil tribunal sitting as a referee - which is the quickest French legal procedure. But since the defendant has the right of appeal, the recovery of the property can be delayed for boths. Those who gave their consent for the transfer of their property, will have to prove that they acted under duress.

MAQUES DORIOT, FRENCH PASCIST AND ANTI-SENITE, REPORTED KILLED IN ALLIED AND RAID

ZURICH, Feb. 23. (JTA) — Jacques Doriot, founder and leader of the French fascist Farti Populaire, and one of the most active anti-Semites in France, was killed during an Allied air raid on an undisclosed city in Germany, the official German DNB mans agency reported today.

MAISH AGENCY NEEDS \$16,000,000 IN CURRENT YEAR - EXFECTS TWO-THIRDS FROM U.S. JEWS

IONDON, Feb. 23 (JTA) -- The Jewish Agency for Palestine will require \$15,000,000 during the current year to finance its various activities, it was announced to press conference here today by Eliczer Kaplan, Agency treasurer.

It is hoped, Mr. Kaplan said, that two-thirds of the \$16,000,000 budget will be mt by contributions from Jows in the United States, while the remainder will come from various sources, including a \$2,700,000 loan from Lloyds Bank.

Over \$5,000,000 will be spent for immigration, the Menoy treasurer said, and mre than \$4,000,000 for establishment of eleven or twelve new settlements, including five for demobilized soldiers and two for Oriental Jews. Part of the expenses for one of the letter settlements, which it has been preposed to name after Ychuda Halevi, will be covered by Argentine Jewry.

To alleviate the housing shortege, the agency will allot \$4,000,000 for the construction of 2,000 roms in urban areas and 1,000 in rural districts, Mr. Kaplan stated E also disclosed that the Agency has assisted many citrus growers who did not receive prerment subsidies, or whose subsidies were delayed.

Discussing other financial activities of the Jews of Palestine, Mr. Kaplan and that the Jewish Agency was awaiting the results of consultations with major Jowish bodies in the country before adopting a stand on the new increased taxation shows reposed by the Palestine Governments. He announced that efforts are being made to soure new materials and agricultural machinery from Britain, but said that if they are unsuccessful, the material will be purchased in the United States. Mr. Kaplan rewaled that the Agency is caring for the property in Palestine of many Jews still in coupled territory in Europe.

DEPACHMENT OF JUSTICE FRANKFURTER DEMANDED IN ANTI-JEWISH SPEECH IN CONGRESS

WASHINGTON, Feb. 23. (JTA) — The impeachment of Supreme Court Justice Frankfurter was demended from the floor of the House by Reb. Dun R. McGehee, of Essissippi, in an anti-Semitic speech in which the Congressman charged that Justice Frankfurter "connived with other of his faith and belief behind closed doors," to secure the appointure to men to key government positions.

"I am suggesting to the Dies committee that they go immediately into and delve into the actions of Frankfurter, with a view of bringing impeachment proceedings spainst him and relegating him back to private life and, if possible, send him back to the land from whence he came and let him teach his un-American doctrines there rather than try to contaminate a patriotic American citizenship", the Hississippi Refresentative said.

STATELESS JEWS FORMERLY OF GERMAN NATIONALITY WILL NOT BE COMPELLED TO RETURN TO REICH

WASHINGTON, Feb. 23. (JTA) -- Fred K. Hoehlur, director of the displaced persons division of the United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation Administration, today said that no prossure will be exerted on stateless Jews in UNRRA camps to compol them to return to Germany.

asked about UNRRA'S prigrom for German Jews and other anti-Nazis of German mationality, Hochlar declared that it would be UNRRA'S job to give them assistance. To estimated that less than 20,000 Jews are in all the WRRA camps, including poles and Germans. The reason for this small representation, Hochler said, was the fact that many Jews are still in unliberated parts of Europe or where UNRA is not yet functioning.

IMISH REFUGEES WERE BURIED ALIVE IN WELLS BY GERMANS IN FRANCE

ERIS, Feb. 23 (JTA) — Thirty-five Jewish refugees, aged mea and domes from ilsace-forreine, were buried alive in three wells of a little town in central procedure, after a roundup by German military police and viehy militiamen, the masspor France au Combat charges.

All the victims had been living quietly in the town of St. Amand when, on the night of July 22-23, the Nazis and militiamen descended on the community and ranked up all the Jows, according to the newspaper's special correspondent, who inmatigated the orimes.

One of the intended victims, named Kramaison, escaped from one of the tracks enrying the refugees to the prison at Blurges, and hid out in the woods. It was thrugh his efforts to locate his wife, who had been taken off in another truck, that the etrocities came to light.

Lfter spending the night at the Bourges prison, the victims were releaded in the trucks which set off in the direction of Nevers. When the Germans were finally driven cut of the area, the bodies of 35 men and women were found jamned in the three wells, situated on the Guery estate in the commanne of Savigny-on-Saptaine.

Since then, medical evidence has established that the victims had been burled down the wells, and then herribly crushed to death by huge rocks thrown on top of them. The rocks filled the wells to the top. Among the 34 victims identified was a sels Benheim, aged 76, a commander of the Legien of Honor; Elie Raymond Grumbach, 42, a native of Switzerland; I. Dreyfus, 85; A. Bruschwig, 75; Edouard Weil, 76; Badame Levi, 68; Marthe Kramison, the wife of the man who escaped; and a girl of 18, Colette Strauss.

AMERICAN JEWISH COMMITTEE ESTABLISHES & EUROPEAN OFFICE IN LONDON

MEW YORK, Feb. 25 (JEA) -- Max Gottschalk, director of the oversees department of the American Jewish Committee, has arrived in London where he will set up a European office of the American Jewish Committee, it was announced by Dr. John Slawson, Executive vice-President.

Dr. Gottschalk, who will be abroad for an extended stay, has a dual mission that of arranging for Committee representation in the major capitals of Europe and of creating the machinery for the development of closer working arrangements between the principal European Jewish organizations and the American Jewish Committee, the announcement said.

ZIONIST ORGANIZATION IN CANADA LAUNCHES \$1,100,000 CAMPAIGN FOR 1945

MONTREAL, Feb. 25 (JTA) — The national executive committee of the Ziomist organisation of Canada has decided to call upon Canadian Jewry to contribute in 1945 the sun of \$1,100,000 to the United Palestine appeal.

The Mizrachi Organization of Canada has decided to establish a Hachsharch farm for the training of religious chalutzim who will ultimately make their home in Palestine. A site for this purpose has already been secured at Brente, Ontario, it was announced at the annual convention of the organization.
