EMISH SURVIVORS FROM OSWIECIM CAMP ARRIVE IN BUCHAREST; OTHERS REACH BUDAFEST

BUCHAREST, Mar. 6. (JTA) — A group of 44 Jewish survivors from the Oswice in 'extermination camp" arrived here today, including a number of Jews who were deported by the Germans from Faris and Brussels.

At the same time, it was reported here today from Budapest that several groups of Joseh survivors have reached there from Oswiccine. One of the survivors who resubed Bucharest, Hartin Steg, a deportee from Paris, told the correspondent of the Lesish relegraphic Agency that about 100,000 Jews were still alive in the Oswiccin cusp before the Russian Army neared the section of Poland where the comp was located, the mjority of them, however, were neved into the interior of Germany in a hurry and this fate is unknown, he declared.

The Jowish survivors from oswiecim who arrived here today all told the same guesses stories of how hundreds of thousands of Jews were burned alive in the ovens of the campe. They also related how \$,000 Jowish children, brought to the camp from the Polish towns of Sosnowiec and Bendin, as well as from Terceicustadt, were killed by the Germans in the Oswiecim gas chambers. The orematories in the externination sames of Oswiecim and Birkenau were operated under the command of Gestape leaders Sommriciber and Polatisch, notorious throughout Germany for their cruelty.

Jowish Women, Liberated From German Comp, Return to Their Homes In Vilna

VILMA, Ears 6s (JTA) — The government of the lithuanian Seviet Republic today appainted a commission to receive several hundred Jewish women liberated by the Russian Army from the consentration camp which the Germans established in Torum, Foland, for deported Jewish women. The commission is also to provide the liberated women with elething, since and other necessities.

Soveral hundred of the liberated women are vilna residents. Some of the Torun imutes have already returned to Vilna. Others are from Kaunssa. They were separated by the Germans from their husbands in the Kaunss ghette, from where the men were Sent to the neterious Dachau camp in Germany and the women were transported to Danzig.

From Dansig about 1,000 of them were sent, together with 200 Jowish wence from Bungary, to the Torum camp, where they were confined on a starration diet and used for forced labors about two hundred of them died from torture, hunger and colde after six months in the Torum camp, they were liberated by the advance of the Russian amics which forced the Germans to floss

GEN GOVERNMENT WANTS TO RESTORE CONFISCATED PROPERTY TO JEWS, BUTFEW LEFT TO CLAIM IT

SAIDNICA, Mar. 6. (JTA) — Although the Greek Government announced this week its readiness to rescind the law under which Jewish property was confiscated during the German occupation, the problem of restoration is not acute at present in Salonica for the simple reason that there are very few Jews left in this city which had a keish population of about 60,000 before the outbreak of the war.

The correspondent of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency was told today by Jewish leaders here that before the war the property qued by Jews in Solonica was valued at that twenty-five million dollars. It is nowhere near that sum now. The Nazis writed off all liquid assets, emptied stores and warehouses and damaged all Jewish hasses.

The problem of restitution can become difficult, however, if even only a few tousand Jews eventually return to claim their property, it is indicated by the complications encountered in the few cases that have been brought up so far. In an ittend to solve the present problem, the Governor-General of Encodonia has ordered that all Jewish property must be returned immediately to its rightful owner as soon as he appears. If the owner does not return, the property must be handed over to its son, doughter, brother or sister should they return and claim it.

A lengthy editorial in a Salonica newspaper this week urged the government not may to restore all Jewish property to the rightful owners, but to puntsh those Greeks the accepted and used such property during the German occupation. "This is a question of the nation's honor," the paper said.

SURVIVING JEWS IN BEIGRADE REBUILDING CULTURAL AND RELIGIOUS LIFE DESTROYED BY MAZIS

BEIGRADE, Mar. 6. (JTA) — The Jewish community of this city is slowly rewilding its cultural and religious life despite the fact that four years of German weugation reduced Belgrade's Jewish population from 12,000 to about 800 a Jewish felegraphic Agency correspondent who arrived here from Rome this week has found,

Both of Belgrade's synagogues were destroyed and all of its rabbis have been killed, as, indeed, were all the rabbis of Yugoslavia. Nevertheless, services are being held regularly Friday and Saturday, with two laymen of the community in charge.

Dr. Friedrich Pops, for 35 years president of the local Jewish community and for the past 19 years head of the Tugoslav Union of Jews, is still an active leader. Ill during the German occupation pr. Pops hid in the heart of Belgrade in the home of a Serb Christian family. A bearded, white-haired old man, he talks cheerfully of the reconstruction of Jewish life in Tugoslavia where the National Liberation committee has already restored full citizenship rights to the Jewish population.

Rundreds of Belgrade Jews are in Marshal Tito's army, or are still in Albania, Italy or German territory. In the four months since the city was liberated, many femilies have struggled back here from hiding places throughout Yugoslavia. The hondquarters of the Jewish community.

ERUSAIEM, Mar. 6. (JTA) — The Jowish Agency is taking steps to facilitate the transportation to Palestine of the Jows being released from internment on the island of Meuritius, it was announced here by Moshe Shertok, head of the Agency's political department. He revealed that Palestine High Commissioner Lord Gort had strongly recommended to the Colonial Office the immediate release of the Jows from puritius and their re-admission to Palestine from where they were deported as illemal attraction.

According to figures made public by the Falestine Government, there are about 1,400 Jews interned on Mauritius. Approximately 100 Jewish internees died there, some of the internees enlisted in the Czeohoslovak Army, others volunteered for Fritishkapper units, while 70 recently joined the Jewish Brigade.

ESTING OF EUROPEAN SOCIALISTS SUPPORTS JEWISH DLMAND FOR PALESTINE; SCORES ANTI-SEMITS!

IONDON, Mar. 6. (JTA) — The civilized world must guarantee to the Jowish people full opportunity to establish a national homeland in Palestine, it was stated tody in a resolution adopted at a meeting here of representatives of the Socialist Erries of Britain, France, Belgium, Italy, Sweden, Norway, Czechoslowskin, Spain, Poland - including representatives of the Jewish Socialist Bund - and Palestine.

The resolution was adopted after speakers representing the Jewish Bund and the Palestine Socialists and discussed the various aspects of the Jewish problems. The meting also passed a resolution stressing that the international labor movement never countenanced discrimination between persons of different races and creeds and had always supported the principle of equality of rights and opposed anti-Semitism. Pull reparations for orimes committed by the Germans was also demanded by the delegates.

12 JEWS SURVIVE IN KISHINEV WHERE 65,000 LIVED BEFORE WAR; 15,000 MIRDDERED

MOSCOW, Mar. 6. (JTA) — The city of Kishinev, capital of Bessarabia, which had 65,000 Jews on June 21, 1941, the day the Germans launched their attack on the Soviet Union, now has 12, according to a report published here today. Of the remainder, 52,000 were evacuated into the interior before the German-Rumaian troops captered the city and the other 13,000 were murdered within one year after Kishinev's seizure.

The destruction of the Kishinev Jews followed the usual Nazi pattern of crowsded ghettos, mass executions, random shootings, deportations and torture. Even the
ded were not left in peace. The Germans uncarthed boddes in the Jewish cemetery
den order to secure gold teeth and fillings. All the rabbis in the city were crowded
into one house, together with their wives, and shot after having been stripped naked
and tortured for 24 hours.

EN YORK BECOMES FIRST STATE IN NATION TO OUTLAW DISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT

ALEANY, Mar. 6. (JTA) - New York became the first state in the nation to officially har racial and religious discrimination in employment when the senate last night, by a vote of 49 to 6, adopted the Ives-Quinn bill. Seven more states are extended to adopt similar legislation.

Governor Thomas E. Dewey, who will sign the measure this week, issued the following statement hailing the Senate's action: "Passage of the Ives-Quinn bill to combat rainl and religious discrimination in employment is a historic step. I am happy indeed that our state has led the entire nation in this great social advance which will assure equality of opportunity for all our people, regardless of race, color, creed or maional origin."

The bill becomes effective on July 1. It creates a five-man commission charged with fighting recial and religious discrimination in employment as the opening gun in long-range and broader program aimed against all types of discrimination. To prepare the way for the long-range goal, the bill provides that the commission may begin immintally to administer educational and persuasive anti-discrimination programs all over the state. In the field of employment, the bill carries maximum penalties for aftenders convicted of discrimination of a year in jail or \$500 fine, or both.

Similar legislation is under consideration in Massachusetts and New Jersey, this California, Illinois, Pennsylvania and Connectiout. A public hearing on bills for a permanent FERC is to be held in Beston tomorrow, and prominent ovice leaders have voiced their approval to such legislation. In New Jersey, both Democratic and lepublican legislators are supporting measures to bar discrimination. The Democrats have already introduced several bills and the Republicans announced this week that they will introduce one which has the support of the state's chief executive, gove Walter E. Massachusetts.

WRID ZIONIST EXECUTIVE IS URGED TO CONVOKE MENTING OF SUPREME COUNCIL IN U. S.

NEW YORK, Mar. 6. (JTA) — The immediate convocation of the Zionist General Council, surrome Zionist body next to the World Zionist Congress, was demanded today by the Jewish State Party of America in a cable sent to the Zionist executive in Jerusalem.

The cable emphasized that the "grave political situation in Zionism" makes an imediate meeting of the Council imperative. It wrond that the Council be convoked "Preferably in the United States otherwise in England," Private discussions by leaders of Zionist groups cannot substitute for the Council, the Jewish State Party dealered in the cable which was addressed to David Ben-Gurion, chairman of the World Zionist executive.

DR. WEIZMANN DUE IN THE UNITED STATES NEXT MONTH; ACCEPTS INVITATION TO HELP U.P.A. DRIVE

NEW YORK, Mar. 6. (JTA) — The United Palestine Appeal today amnounced that Dr. Chain Weizmann has accepted its invitation to help in the UFA campaign during his forthorning wisit to the United States. Dr. Weizmann is expected to reach the United States next months.
