#### HEE HUNGERIAN OFFICERS HANGED IN BUDAFEST FOR KILLING JENS DURING FRO-MAZI REGIME

LOMDON, Mrs. 9. (JTA) — Three Hungarian afficers charged with torturing and making Jawish forced laborers were hanged publicly this week after being convicted by the Peoples! Tribunal in Budapest, the London Jewish Chronicle reports today. They we the first of a group of Hungarian war criminals charged with murdering Jawa.

The report ways that heart-breaking scenes took place in Budapest when the bodies of 6,141 murdered Jews were disinterred from the ruins of the Bungarian capital and a coordance with Jewish ritual. The majority of these Jews were filled by the Gestape and by members of the Bungarian pro-Maxi Arrow Cross Party.

## Trial of 64 Anti-Semitic Bulgarian Officials Opens in Sofia

SOFIA, Hr. 9. (JA) — Indictments against 64 of the less prominent war criminals charged with respectation of Jews were placed before the Peoples' Court here to by by a special grantenary. Booth was asked for some and long prison terms for others. We this instigators of the anti-Senitic measures, such as the regents, ministers and spokes, have already been convicted and many of them executed.

The defendants now being tried consist mainly of officials of the Commissariat for Jewish Affairs, directors of Jewish labor camps, and liquidetors of Jewish property. In reseming the indictments, the prosecutor stressed that the Bulgarian people have always been opposed to a tri-Semitic propaganda and said that recial legislation was exacted an a result of "the servility of the faceist governors to their German masters, and their decire to enrich themselves at the expense of the Jews."

Franking as demagaguery the charge by the fascist prest and radio that jews were a bad influence on the political and economic life of the nation, the prosecutor panted out that with a few exceptions the jewish population was composed chiefly of por workers, artisans, peddlers and intellectuals. The "law for protection of the maiors, which was issued in 1941, struck hardest at the powert jews, he said, since it imposed heavy taxes at the same time that it out them off from the possibilities of earning a living.

The prosecutor reviewed other anti-jewish measures introduced by the pro-German forements and the deportation of several thousand jews to death samps in Foliation. See that "jews have nothing in seminon with the national ideals," he asserted that if they were left unmolested they would support these ideals with the same ferver as the rest of the Bulgarian people.

WASHIGTON, Mar. 9. (JTA) -- Rep. Ardrew L. Somers, New York Democrat, speaking in the House today called for recognition of the Jewish people as a member of the United Extions and domanded representation for it at the San Francisco Conforciose.

He declared it an injustice that Palestine's Wear Eastern neighbors, Egypt, Saudi-Arabia and Frag, will be represented but that "the ration that has suffered nearly as many casualties as all the others combined, the nation whose some have valiantly fought and died on all the fighting fronts, that nation will not be given the same consideration and privilege we have given even to the nations who have been neutral even up to yesterdays.

# FOUR TILES AS MANY JEWISH TAXPAYERS IN PALESTINE AS ARABS, GOVERNMENT REPORT DISCLOSES

JERUSAIEM, Mar. 9. (JTA) — There are four times as many Jewish as Arab taxpayers in Palestine and their per capita tox is five times that paid by the Arabs, it is revealed by the current issue of Statistical Bulletin of the Palestine Governments

The publication reports that there are 1,061,400 Arabs in the country, more than a per capita the number of Jews, of whom 4,947 are texpayers, paying the first text of 260 mills. While the estimated Jewish population is 495,000, there are 17,527 texpayers among them, resulting in a per capita tax of 1,390 mills.

## JEMISH REFUGEES IN ECUADOR CONCERNED OVER NEW REGULATIONS FOR INGIGRANTS

QUITO, Ecuador, Mar. 9. (JTA) — Two recent government directives ordering stricter control over immagrants are causing much concern among the 5,000 European refugees here, the majority of whom are Jewish.

On the occasion of Ecuador's declaration of war against Japan, Minister of government Carlos Gueverra Foreno sent a letter to the newly-appointed Director of Engigation, Ramiro Borja y Borja, asking for closer supervision of the activities of foreigners. He recommended that action be taken against immigrants who received visas upon their promises to engage in agriculture, but who are not doing so. This would effect furticularly the Jewish refugees, the bulk of whom are professionals and business men.

Subsequently, Borja sent a circular to all government officials urging a curb on "the great number of aliens who constantly violate our regulations."

Up to now there has been no attempt to force the immigrants into agriculture despite their pledges. In fact, Ecuador, under the leadership of President Velasco larre, has had an exceedingly liberal policy towards immigrants. Ibarra, himself a political exile for eight years, has repeatedly expressed his friendship for refugees.

So far, there have been no cases of the new directives being enforced and it is hoped that the position of the immigrants will remain unchanged.

## AMERICAN CONFERENCE ON FRACE PROBLEMS AFFIRMS PRINCIPLE OF EQUAL RIGHTS

EXICO CITY, Mar. 9. (JTA) — The full text of the resolution against racial and religious discrimination adopted by the Inter-American Conference on problems of Mar and Peace which ended yesterday, was made public here last night. It reads:

"The Inter-American conference resolves: 1. To affirm the principle recognized by all the American States of equality of rights and opportunities for all sen regardless of race and religion; 2. To recommend to the Governments of the American Republics that, without projudicing the freedom of the spoken or written word, they make in their respective countries every effort to prevent all acts which tend to provoke discrimination between individuals by reason of their race or religion."

The conference also adopted a resolution recommending that "the international American institutes for the protection of children give special attention to the manner in which the American republics may help in taking care and providing opportunities for the European children who are homeless."

# AMERICAN RED CROSS LAUDS JEWISH SUPPORT; RED CROSS SABRATH TO BE MARKED IN SYMMOGUES

WASHINGTON, Mar. 9. (JTA) — The American Red Cross today made public a statement paying tribute to Jews for their support of the organization and announcing that a "Red Cross Sabbath" will be observed in synagogues and temples throughout the country on March 16-17.

"Jewish people throughout the country have supported the Red Cross, financially as well as by volunteer service in past years", the statement said. "Their continued wholehearted support is vitally needed during the coming year. Red Cross Sabbath, coming in the midst of the 1945 War Fund campaign, will provide an opportunity for rabbis everywhere to urge their followers to continue support of the Red Cross."

#### ROTECTION AGAINST UNEMPLOYMENT WILL HELP TO PREVENT ARTI-SERITISM, MONUTT SAYS

NEW YORK, Mar. 9. (JTA) — "Protection against unemployment is a double protection that will guard our society from such psychological phobias as Jew-baiting, geo-baiting and fascism," Paul V. Monutt, chairman of the War Manpower Commission, stated last night addressing a dinner of the United Jewish Appeal of Granter New york at the Motel Plaza.

We Americans know that among the great evils of unemployment the most dangrous are harred, fear, and race prejudice", 17. MOUNT declared. "Full employment is the difference between a healthy society and an alling society open to the virus of a new fascism and a new war."

Emphasizing that the gigantic task of bringing help to the stricken multitudes of Europe must be shared by all agencies, private as well as governmental, its home has been asked whether the United Jewish Appeal will duplicate the work of UNRRA. The answer is: No. UNRRA's rehabilitation assignment is a gigantic one. It will need not only the resources of its forty-four associated governments, but the support also of public and private organizations, such as the United Jewish Appeal. The United Jewish Appeal with its four agencies—the American Joint Distribution Committee, the United Palestine Appeal, the National Refugee Service and the Edical Jewish Welfare Board—constitute a service that is desperately needed today.

## CONGRESSMAN SOL BLOOM MARKS 75th BIRTHDAY; ARRANGES PARTIES FOR MEEDY

WASHINGTON, Mar. 9. (JTA) — Congressman sol Bloom Chairman of the House Fercian Affairs Committee, celebrated his 75th birthday today by arranging parties for residents of several orphanages and homos for the aged, as he has done on previous birthdays.

In turn, he was given a party by the Foreign Affairs Committee in the House restaurant with former Gov. Herbert H. Lehman, now Director-General of URRIA, and lee Crowley, head of the Foreign Economic Administration, as principal speakers.

A member of the House since 1922, Bloom is one of the most influential manbers of that body and will be one of the eight U.S. delegates to the United Mations Conference at San Francisco. Bloom was born in Illinois of immigrant parents and spent his boyhood in San Francisco.

# SYNAGOGUE COUNCIL CALLS ON AMERICAN JEWS TO JOIN IN WORLD-WIDE DAY OF LIQURITING
