#### MAZIS TERRATEN TO KILL ALL CAPTIVE JEWS IN REFRISAL FOR GERMANS SENT TO RUSSIA

GENEVA, Pare 15. (JTA) -- The Mazi Government, through its news agency DNB, today issued a werning that all jows now in German hands, as well as jowish wer prisoners who may be contured, will be killed in reprisal for the reported plan to send Germas to Russia as laborers to rebuild the areas devastated by the German Army.

"If Roosevelt now admits that he and his accomplice Churchill undertook at the alta conference to surrender German war prisoners to the Soviet Union, then it is nothing but part of a devilish jewish plan," the Maxi news agency said. Emphasizing that the Hatler government will retaliate, DMB added; "Above all, we shall make every twishe is, or who falls into our hands pay for all others. When the wer comes to an end, there will be no more jews in Europee"

#### ELESTINE RECOGNIZED AS FULL LEMBER OF LEAGUE; WILL HAVE VOTING RIGHTS

100000, Mar. 15. (JTA) -- London invapagers today report that the constitution of the Longue of Arab Nations which was unde public yesterday in Cairo recognizes relesting as a member of the Longue.

The constitution contains twenty-two articles and two protocols, one of which provides that Palestine shall have a vote in the League's Council. Since the future status of Palestine is still undecided, the Council itself will nominate a Falestinian to represent his fellow countrymen as a full-fledged manber of the League, with voting and other rights. The constitution will be presented for ratification to the pan-arab congress which opens in Cairo on Saturday.

## EMPRISON MAURD U.S. MEISER OF INTER-GOVERNMENTAL REFUGER COMMITTEE; SUCCEEDS TAYLOR

MESHIBION, Mr. 15. (JTA) - Earl G. Harrison, former Cormissioner of Imigration and Naturalization, succeeds Myron C. Taylor as U. & representative on the Intergovernmental Committee on Refugees, the Department of State amounced today. Exrison is expected to proceed to London immediately to confer with officials of the committee with respect to the committeets plans to care for the racial, religious and political refugees who cannot return to their homes, according to the amouncement.

"The caring for and repatriction of displaced persons who can be repatriated to their homes is one of UNRA's functions," the State Department said, "Increasing unders of racial, religious and political refugees are now being liberated by the allied arries and the number to be cared for by the countities my eventually exceed one millions."

Asked about the present status of the Intergovernmental Committee, Scoretary of State Stottlinius said at his press conference that the committee had been active right along and doing every thing in its power. Our War Refugee Board, he said, has been closely in touch with the committee's activities. The scoretary declined to comment on whether Herbert C. Fell will be reinstated as Amrican representative on the United Rations for Crimes Commission.

## FIVE JENISH YOUTHS JAILED BY MILITARY COURT IN LABSTING FOR POSSESSION OF ARMS

JERUSAIEM, Ihr. 15. (JTA) - A military court here today sentenced four Jewish youths to seven years imprisonment each, and one to five years on the charge of illegal possession of arms.

The four are; David Levin, 18 years old; Daniel Katz, 19; Abraham Stashevsky, 20 and Gideon Felei, 20. The fifth is Shlom Milar, 17 years old.

The five were arrested on February 23 near a Jewish settlement in the vicinity of the Dead Sea. The police found six rifles and 214 rounds of arrunition on them.

## FREIL SENDS PROTEST TO GERMANY AGAINST SEGREGATION OF CAPTURED BRAZILIAN JEWS

MEXICO CITY, Mar. 15. (JTA) — The Brazilian Foreign Office has sent a protest to Germany against the segregation in special concentration camps of Jews among Smillen prisoners of war captured by the Germans, the Brazil radio announced last right.

Revealing, for the first time, that the Easi were discriminating against Smeilian Jewish captives, the broadcast said: "The Foreign Office today sent a protest to Germany through the International Red Cross against this inhuman treatment of missears of war."

## EMBIAN JEWS IN CORA ARE NOT RAGER TO RETURNATO BELGIUM, HEAR OF ANTI-SEMITISM THERE

HAVAMA, Cubos, har, 15. (JTA) - Jewish refugees from Belgium, who have done a sample job in the diamond industry here, employing about 1,000 Jews and 1,500 Cubos, are not eager to return to their native country.

Reports reaching them from Belgium reveal that there is a good deal of antijoish feelings there due to Mazi propagaria which has left roots in certain sections of the population. One report said that a hotel in Brussels refused to admit Jows which never happened before the war in the Belgian capital. The Belgian Jows here are also disappointed at the fact that German Jowish refugees in Belgium were interned after the liboration of the country.

At present there is a strike going on in the diamond industry here which, if mt settled soon, may arouse anti-Semtic feelings. Cubon workers in the industry receive from sixty to eighty-five dollars a week, which is more than they get in any other occupation. They, however, want the same wages as the Jewish workers who have mre skill and exportence.

Noh interest is centered on the question as to what will happen to the diasord industry here if the Belgian Jows decide to return to Belgium. Some local Jows are now financially interested in the industry and it is certain that they intend to keep it going.
